Topic: SONS AND DAUGHTERS, PROPHECY.

Joel 2:28, "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions"

To prophecy means to either foretell or forthtell. Foretelling is a gift or exercise of the prophetic office by which one tells of things yet to happen by the Holy Spirit. To forthtell is to speak forth an inspired Word by the Spirit. It could be a word of prophecy or an inspiration from the scriptures. So forth telling is the practice of speaking forth Words with power to come to pass. Prophet Joel foretold that in the era of the Holy Spirit, God's sons and daughters will forthtell. This is the era. So, beginning from today, start forthtelling the Words God has spoken concerning you this year. It is not enough to have calendars, stickers and hand handles with the inscription of the Word. That is good to keep the Word before your eyes, but go beyond that and cause the Word to come to pass by taking the same Words and prophesy them.

Dear Father, I am strengthened to be diligent at consistently professing Your Word for my life throughout this year. Hallelujah!

MONDAY JANUARY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU'RE NEVER A VICTIM OF LIFE

1 John 5:4 ***"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith"***

The greatest challenge of the world today, is that "Christians" have not clearly understood what it means to be in Christ. They therefore have issues and consequently are unable to solve the issues the world faces as well although they are the solution to the world's problems. The truth is that being in Christ is a real spiritual transaction that produces a new kind of being (2Corinthians 5:17). This is a being born of God, not by human parents (John 1:13). As one born of and in the class of God, he is one that overcomes the world. This is his state forever. Therefore, if you are in Christ, you're not one that should lift your hands in despair before any situation. Your constitution is such that you can change any situation in life. You are never a victim, rather you're always a victor. All you need is the truth about who you are in Christ (so don't miss the New Creation Conference in November this year) and also follow closely what the Lord is sharing with you this week.

Confession

I am in Christ therefore I am a new creature. I am divine, not human. I am a victor not a victim in the name of Jesus.

TUESDAY JANUARY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DESIRE THE CHANGE

Acts 12:5 *"Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him"*

Knowing that in Christ you're not victim of any circumstances in life, you must now learn how you can change unfavourable situations in life. The first step is to have a strong desire to get the circumstance to change. Sometimes people are faced with unbiblical situations that they wish changed but their desires are not strong enough to change it. This shows in the trial and error manner in which they engage the principles of change. In the early Church they were faced with serious persecution they didn't like but they kept "toying" with the situation until Apostle James was murdered. This woke them up and so when Apostle Peter was arrested, they refused to stop praying until they obtained the change. There are principles in the Word to change any situation but when people are not desirous enough of a change, they are not serious in engaging them. They try today, and stop tomorrow. No, if you want to change that situation, get "angry" enough with it not to accept a no for an answer about its change.

Prayer

Dear Father, I receive a supernatural strengthening of my desire by the Holy Spirit, to change any unbiblical situation that ever appears before me in Jesus' name

WEDNESDAY JANUARY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: AGREE WITH GOD

Ezekiel 37:3 *“And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord GOD, thou knowest”*

After you’ve developed a strong desire to change the situation, turn to the Word and be in agreement with God. God has spoken His Word about your situation, find it out and agree with Him. Sometimes people are their own enemies in that they don’t think their situations can change. There are times people may be in certain situations that are bad but they have become so used to it that they think it will never change. Everyone would think every sick person is ready for healing. No! If it were so, Jesus would not have asked the impotent man, “do you want to be healed?” (John 5:6). Jesus’ question in John 5:6 and what God asked Ezekiel in our verse today, were to show us that God requires that we agree with Him that those dire situations can change. What situation are you faced with now? Do you agree that it is changeable? You should meditate on God’s Word until you fully agree in your heart that it can change. Otherwise, it may never change.

Confession

I apply myself to the meditation on God’s Word until I am fully certain that every unbiblical health, financial, marital and work challenge can change in Jesus’ name.

THURSDAY JANUARY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RISE UP

1 Samuel 1:9 *“So Hannah rose up after they had eaten in Shiloh, and after they had drunk. Now Eli the priest sat upon a seat by a post of the temple of the LORD”*

I believe you are now certain that you are not a victim in the situation you find yourself in. Is your desire strong enough to get it changed? Have you agreed with God's Word that it can change? Then rise up. Decide on a definite Biblical action to take. Hannah had a challenge with childbirth. Her husband showered her with a lot of love to comfort her and even tried to make her satisfied with the alternative that he was enough for her. But for some reason, Hannah refused to be a victim of that situation even as a human being in a covenant with God through Abraham. She was so desirous of a change that while others ate, she fasted. When they got up to rest, she headed to the temple to pray. The Bible says that Hannah rose up. The popular Jabez, nearly became a victim of his name until he rose up to do something scriptural (1Chronicles 4:10). Note that it is the principle of rising up that we are learning from Jabez and Hannah not the kind of prayer they prayed. Such prayers are not scriptural for the born again.

Confession

Every unbiblical situation in my life is in trouble. I hereby rise up with insight and by the power of the Holy Spirit to get it changed in Jesus' name.

FRIDAY JANUARY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RESPOND

Mark 11:14 ***"And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it"***

If you are in Christ, there are two ways to act when you rise up to change a situation. Depending on your level of maturity, you can respond to the situation either by calling on God to do it, or taking charge for God. Many Christians like to shift the responsibility on God by crying and calling on Him to do everything for them. That may work for a babe in Christ but it is unscriptural for the mature. With what we learnt last month on prayer, there is nothing concerning the born again that is yet to come from heaven. Everything is inside you (2 Peter 1:3). So initially as you call on God He will do them for you but as you grow, you are expected to know from the Word what is yours and bring it forth by command. If you are a babe, ask Him or others to intercede for you but don't remain a babe forever. You will never get results by asking God to do for you what He has asked you to do, or to give you what He has already given to you. This is why in the Good Life Devotion we keep emphasizing the need to be planted in a Bible teaching Church so you can grow in Christ.

Prayer

Father, I receive insight by the Spirit to know my level in order to respond appropriately and change situations in Jesus' name.

SATURDAY JANUARY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BE COMPOSED

1 Samuel 1:18 ***"And she said, Let thine handmaid find grace in thy sight. So the woman went her way, and did eat, and her countenance was no more sad."***

There is a way a person looks when tired and very thirsty but after quenching the thirst, he looks different because something has changed. In the same way, if you change a situation, your composure must reflect it. Every visible thing you see today came from the invisible (Hebrews 11:3) so changes of situations begin first in the spirit before they appear in the physical. Some changes may take time to appear physically but you must know and be appropriately composed. For instance, after prayer, Hannah's countenance changed. Was she pregnant? No! Did Samuel suddenly appear? No! But why was she no longer sad? Because she knew the change had taken place in the spirit. You must do this because you're engaging spiritual principles which could be disengaged by your own thoughts, speech and actions if they are counteractive to the results. You must learn to maintain the composure of change in your thoughts, speech and actions after you change things in the spirit.

Confession

By the engagement of divine principles, I see the situations changed in my heart. This is how I think, talk and act about it all the time in Jesus' name.

SUNDAY JANUARY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSIONS OF THE WEEK

Father, I affirm that in Christ, I am born of God. I am therefore divine and not human and never a victim of any situation in life. I am a solution to my world because I have what it takes and know how to change any unbiblical situation. Everything in my life and world is rapidly conforming to God's Word in Jesus' name. Hallelujah!

MONDAY JANUARY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU MUST ENJOY GOD

Ephesians 1:4 ***“According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.”***

God’s ultimate plan for us is that we will live in His presence in the spirit of love, in union with Christ. God never made man to afflict him with pain and confusion as some think or even experience. God made man in order to adopt him into the divine class and to enjoy us as we to enjoy Him. 1 Corinthians 1:9 ***"God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ"***

Christianity is a call unto fellowship with Christ. That means a call unto oneness, partnership or communion and celebration with Christ and for that matter the Father and the Holy Spirit (1John 1:3, 2Corinthians 13:14). When a person gets born again, he is baptized into Christ and made to drink into the Holy Spirit making him inseparably one with Him (1Corinthians 12:13). 2 Corinthians 13:14 ***"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen."***

THURSDAY JANUARY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SEE GOD DIFFERENTLY

1 John 4:18 ***“There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.”***

One of the things a child of God should be settled on is God’s excess love for His children. It is really unfathomable. Yet people do not enjoy God because of the wrong picture they have of God. In their minds God is a consuming fire, with terrible wrath holding a big stick always ready to flog erring sons and never rewarding them. This idea is satanic. For instance, the military are very “fierce”, yet they are the friends of the civilians. The fierceness of the military is only towards the rebels. We do not deny that God’s wrath is terrible and that He is a consuming fire but towards who? Those who refuse Christ (2Corinthians 5:11, Romans 1:18). But concerning the Christian, God says I will guide you (Psalm 32:8), He says even in tests, I make it cool for you not to fail (1Corinthians 10:13) etc. Until you separate God’s relation with the unbelievers from that with His children, you will see God in the wrong light, and you can never enjoy Him. See God as the Father He is and then enjoy Him.

Fellowship

Spend 15 minutes fellowshiping with the Godhead – loving Him and enjoying His love.

FRIDAY JANUARY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: COME BOLDLY

Hebrews 4:16 ***“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”***

One of the most important things we must do is to keep the consciousness of the abiding presence of God. Many Christians are busily trying to kill enemies when these are the wrong targets. If there is anything for a Christian to kill, it is the thing which kills the consciousness of God’s presence in his/her life. This is because once you are conscious of God’s presence, enemies, lack, fear, sickness etc., will not be your consideration anymore. The thing that kills people’s consciousness of God’s presence is sin-consciousness. A good number of God’s children are so sin-conscious that they cannot relate boldly with God their Father. Such people feel unworthy and unqualified before God. So, they beg to worship, they beg to give, they beg to pray and in every way they relate with God, they have to beg for mercy. This kind of life cannot enjoy God. Take time to study about your righteousness in Christ, and this sin-conscious Christianity will die, then you can spring up into enjoying God. Topic: MOVE INTO REAL CHRISTIANITY

1 Peter 2:2 ***"As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby."***

The ultimate goal of the Holy Spirit in you is to bring you to a place where you recognize Him as your Father and walk with Him as such. By this, you can become the expression of the full measure of the stature of Christ (Ephesians 4:13). Yes! the Holy Spirit is your real Father. He is the one Jesus promised will come after He ascended into heaven, to father us (John 14:18 GNB). Also, the process by which one gets born again is by the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5) and this makes Him a Father to us by birth. Now, the moment you get born again, you become inseparably one with the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 12:13, 1Corinthians 6:17). You must understand that this presence of the Holy Spirit in you is an abiding presence as stated in our opening scripture. It is not fleeting or one in which He comes and goes like in human relationships.

TUESDAY JANUARY 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE ABIDING PRESENCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT - II

John 14:16 ***"And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;"***

To abide is to stay, remain, dwell or tabernacle. In the Old Testament, the Holy Spirit did not abide in the people. He could therefore leave when He was grieved (Judges 16:20, Psalm 51:11) and come upon them when He needed to (Exodus 33:14-15, Exodus 13:21-22). In the New Testament however, you became inseparably one with the Holy Spirit the day you got born again (1Corinthians 12:13, 1 Corinthians 6:17). He does not come and go. He abides fully in you. Statements like 'I feel He is faraway', 'let us invite the Holy Spirit into our midst', 'Holy Spirit, I want more of You' sound nice but they are not scripturally accurate in our dispensation. He is a person (John 14:17); you either have all of Him or none of Him. You cannot have Him in parts. Knowing this enriches your fellowship with Him and ushers you into a real relationship with Him.

WEDNESDAY JANUARY 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO DEVELOP THE ABIDING PRESENCE

Ephesians 5:18 ***"And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;"***

It is important to recognize that, the Holy Spirit in you is not the same as the Holy Spirit functioning in you. A good number of Christians have the Holy Spirit in them, but their lives and experiences are no different from unbelievers. This is because the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit in them is not functional. For His presence in you to be functional it must be developed. What does this mean? It means you must cause this abiding presence to grow, advance, become active and functional in you. Our opening scripture tells us to be filled with the Holy Spirit always. This means we must always be awakened to the person, presence, power and function of the Holy Spirit in us. Our lives must always be under the influence of the Holy Spirit just like how the life of a drunkard is always under the influence of alcohol. The primary means of developing this abiding presence is through fellowship.

Prayer

Dear Holy Spirit, I am grateful to You for teaching me that Your abiding presence in me must be developed. I choose to develop this abiding presence in order for You to be functional in me to be the full expression of Christ on earth.

THURSDAY JANUARY 21

GOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FELLOWSHIP

2 Corinthians 13:14 ***"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen."***

Fellowship is your response to the Holy Spirit's incessant communion with you. The Holy Spirit started communing with you the moment you became inseparably one with Him and He has never stopped. Now, what you must do is to respond to this communion and that is fellowship. How do you know you are fellowshiping? You will know you are fellowshiping when in worship, prayer or word study you have that deep, sweet, spiritual pleasure that creates in you a strong desire to linger on in momentary fellowship and afterwards drives you towards frequent momentary fellowship. At this stage, you don't feel like stopping and even when you stop, you can't wait for the next opportunity to fellowship (Psalms 16:11). This is the joy of fellowship. Without this, you are just going through religious motions.

Topic: TRAINING FOR EFFECTIVE FELLOWSHIP - II

1 Timothy 4:7-8 *“But refuse profane and old wives’ fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness. For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.”*

Some Christians have been so involved in the mechanics of doing “Christian things” that there is no reality in what they do. This is partly because they have not been trained to do them in reality. 1 Timothy 4:7 tells us to exercise ourselves unto godliness. Exercise as used here refers to training. Godliness is from the Greek word “*eusebia*” and it means well or good (eu) devotion or worship (sebia). It is everything that has to do with our life in Christ that falls in line with the gospel of Jesus. It is the gospel scheme. So, you are to train yourself unto prayer, worship, giving, winning souls etc. There is also a training required to be effective in your fellowship with the Holy Spirit and thus develop His abiding presence in you. 1 Timothy 4:8 tells us the profit you get when you engage in bodily exercise and when you exercise unto godliness. Bodily exercise only profits your body which will end when you leave this world. However, exercising unto godliness not only helps you fulfil divine mandate now but also follows you into eternity. This is a huge profit.

Topic: TRAINING FOR EFFECTIVE FELLOWSHIP - II

Galatians 4:2 ***“But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.”***

Many Christians are ready to spend months and years to be trained in school. They do not give up when they fail. They repeat the class or prepare to retake the exam. This is same for fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit. You do not stop because you are having challenges. No, you persevere till you get it. If you do not know that training is required for effective fellowship, you will not permit the discipline that comes with fellowshiping and thus will not be effective. To be effective in fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit you must train yourself to focus on Him in fellowship. Proverbs 4:7 ***“Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: with all thy getting get understanding.”***

Another important key in the kingdom is the key of understanding. As important as wisdom is, you cannot function in it if you do not have understanding and that is what our opening scripture shows us - with all thy getting, get understanding. Galatians 5:6 ***“For in Jesus Christ, neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.”***

Love is such a big deal in the life of children of God and it is because love is the very essence of who we are. Our nature is that of love because we are born of love (1John 4:7-8). Having somewhat misunderstood the subject of faith, some are busily “putting their faith to work” and yet refusing to manifest their divine nature of love.
