MONDAY MARCH 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTON

Topic: JESUS FIRST

Colossians 1:18 ***“And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.”***

There is a fundamental divine principle in life that God wants His children and mankind to be awakened to. Living according to this principle is what ensures that you are living the best life. It is so painful to see people struggling in life because they are living against this fundamental principle unknowingly. What is this fundamental principle? It is the principle of putting Jesus first. This does not mean Jesus is now going to be made first. Jesus has always been first as our opening scripture shows and His place as first in life must be maintained. This principle is not only for Christians, but the principle for existence. Nothing can function at its best if it is not in accordance with this principle. We are at a point in time where Jesus must really remain first in your life irrespective of the “consequences” you may face in this world (Luke 22:56-62).

TUESDAY MARCH 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JESUS FIRST - WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Colossians 1:18 ***“And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.”***

Being first means three things. The first meaning is to be the foremost i.e. to come before everyone else, the one in front, the one from whom counting begins, the numeral one. Everything else comes after this. Secondly, it means to be of the highest priority, i.e. the most important to be considered or factored in into something. Thirdly, it means to have the highest value i.e. the most honoured, the most revered. Thus, Jesus first in your life means He is the foremost in everything not an afterthought or a backup. It means He is of the highest priority and of the greatest value in your life. Nothing comes before Him, He is the first to be considered in everything you think, say, or do and He is the most honoured and revered in your life. Spend a few minutes thinking through your life, can you genuinely say Jesus remains first?

Affirmation

I boldly affirm that Jesus is and remains first in my thoughts, speech and actions. I think Jesus, talk Jesus and act Jesus. Glory!

WEDNESDAY MARCH 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY MUST JESUS REMAIN FIRST - I?

Colossians 1:17 ***“And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.”***

Jesus must remain first because God who is the monarch of the universe, in His infinite wisdom decided that Jesus must be first in all things. This is the divine order of life. Everything that has ever existed or exists today was made by Jesus and for Him (John 1:3, Colossians 1:16-17). Everything emanates from Him. He is the first born of every creature (Colossians 1:15). This means that in all of creation, He is the most preferred by the Father. He is God's choicest. With respect to the Church, He is the beginning, the first born from the dead (Colossians 1:18) and He has the pre-eminence in all things. Thus, in your consciousness, Jesus must remain first. Do not try to replace Him with someone or anything else otherwise you will be in disorder and this disorder will reflect in every other aspect of your life.

Declaration

Wow! Jesus You are first. I will never trade You for silver or gold neither will I place anything or anyone before You. All honour and reverence belongs to You. I refuse to be in disorder. I fully embrace the divine order. Glory!

THURSDAY MARCH 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY MUST JESUS REMAIN FIRST - II?

John 14:6 ***“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”***

The second reason why Jesus must remain first is because He is the way, the truth, and the life. As the way, He is the only channel through which the world was reconciled to God after the fall of Adam (2Corinthians 5:19) and He is the only way through whom reconciled mankind can be adopted into Godkind (Ephesians 1:4-5, Galatians 4:4-5). As the way, He is the mode, order or pattern by which God has determined that things should be done. Anything done in a way outside Jesus, be it ministry, marriage, parenting, etc is in disorder and will certainly not be acceptable before the Father. There is therefore no need to struggle. Just follow the blueprint of life which is Jesus - the Word. No Jesus, no way!

Prayer

FRIDAY MARCH 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY MUST JESUS REMAIN FIRST - III?

John 14:6 ***“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”***

Truth is one and Jesus is the truth. Truth as used in the scripture above means reality. Jesus is the truth/reality about anything. Many of the activities people carry out in the world today are not being done in reality. They are meaningless repetitions. There is a reality about your health, marriage, parenting etc. and Jesus is that reality. He is the Word (John 1:1-2). There are some people who make the Word secondary. They look elsewhere for reality and consider human/physical opinions above God’s Word. This is a disorder. God’s Word must be first. What Jesus says about any situation is your reality. Forget about what man is saying and focus on what Jesus is saying because that is your reality. What has the Word said concerning that situation or circumstance you are facing? Believe it because that is the truth about it.

SATURDAY MARCH 6

Topic: WHY MUST JESUS REMAIN FIRST -IV?

John 14:6 ***“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”***

God’s plan, before the foundation of the world is for mankind to be adopted as His children (Ephesians 1:4-5, Galatians 4:4-5) and this adoption was going to be by the reception of Life through the new birth (John 1:12-13, Titus 3:5, John 3:3). This Life is eternal life which is God’s own life and can only be found in Jesus (John 1:4). The Life became available to mankind when Jesus was made alive from the dead with it (John 5:26, 1 Peter 3:18). He was thus the first begotten of God from the dead with the Life (Revelations 1:5). Our opening verse today says that in Christ, one is a new creature, one that never existed before. It further says that all things are become new for this new creature. In other words, the new creature came into being with his own reality and order. This order of expression of life is new to the human perspective. But, to the born again, this new order completely different from the old, is his normal. This is the reality of the new creature. The only connection with the old is the tabernacle (body) we live in. Until your mind is renewed, your own normal will appear new or strange to you. As long as it is new to you, you can never permanently function there. And so, the Bible teaches you to renew your mind so you don't conform to this world and it's order (Romans 12:2). Accept your normal.

Confession

I am born again. My order is completely divine. This is my normal. This is how I think, this is how I talk, and this is the way I live.

TUESDAY MARCH 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GOD'S WORD, YOUR REALITY? IT'S NORMAL

John 17:17 *"Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."*

Our opening verse says the Word of God is truth. Truth is reality. The born again is born from the Word (1Peter 1:23). The Word of God is therefore your life. The world has its own appreciation of what it thinks reality is. No wonder many are chasing shadows. Not so for the born again. The Bible says the Word of God is truth, that is reality. It has always been so (Psalm 119:142, 151, 160). It is normal for you not to have any other alternatives to the Word. Consider Abraham, his normal was what had been spoken by God according to Romans 4:17-21. Set your gaze on the Word alone, see only the Word, think only the Word, and live only by the Word. The Word of God never fails (Numbers 23:19)

Prayer

Daddy, I pray that having been enlightened, I am enabled never to be absorbed with the things of the world. I declare that Your Word is my only reality in Jesus' name.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: UNPOPULAR PATHS? IT'S NORMAL

John 15:19 (ERV) ***"If you belonged to the world, the world would love you as it loves its own people. But I have chosen you to be different from those in the world. So you don't belong to the world, and that is why the world hates you."***

It is always amazing when a Christian strives so much just to fit in, so that men can embrace and applaud him. Be careful when the world hails you. For the born again, because you are not of the world, the world cannot understand your paths. The world will not understand the basis of your decisions and ways, because they are made from the convictions of the realities of your life, the Word. This will not be popular to the world but remember ours is few on a narrow path (Matthew 7:13-14). Look at the example of Moses in Hebrews 11:24-27, it was not a popular path he took, but God was pleased with that path. You must be certain of the audience of popularity in this world. In this world, it is humans. When the audience is humans and not the great cloud of witnesses in heaven, then you are playing on the wrong pitch. It is normal to tow paths unpopular to the world.

Thanksgiving

Dear Father, I thank You for bringing me into the truth to know who my real audience in life are. Thank You, that now I know that so long as You is pleased, popularity before men means nothing. Thank You Father. Amen.

THURSDAY MARCH 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: INVISIBLE YET VISIBLE TO YOU? IT'S NORMAL

2 Corinthians 4:18 ***“While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.”***

You must renew your mind to see from God’s perspective. In the outplay of your life as one born of God, you must train yourself to see things that may not be visible to the world. Just as there are tangible things in the physical, there are spiritual realities more tangible than the physical. What is important is, is it in the Word? The Bible says to us, to look at things which are not seen. It is normal if what you are seeing is not visible to the world and so they can’t understand when you talk or act in a certain way based on what you see. The Bible characterises that succinctly in 1Corinthians 2:14. They cannot see it. What has Daddy shown you in the Word, what have you seen in the spirit, that is not visible to the world? Hold on to it. It is normal if the world cannot see it.

Declaration

I am convinced of the things I have seen in the spirit. It may not be visible to the world, but they are real to me and visible in the realm in which I live. I hold on to these and I live by them. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY MARCH 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ALWAYS HEAVENLY MINDED? IT'S NORMAL

Colossians 3:2 (ERV) ***“Think only about what is up there, not what is here on earth.”***

There is a common phrase among humans that “too heavenly minded, no earthly good”. Although it sounds correct, it falls flat when subjected to a careful analysis from scripture. In Colossians 3:1-3, the Bible teaches us to only think of heavenly things. That is where we live from. Any attempt to live from an earthly perspective is unprofitable to the child of God. You can only be of use to the people of the earth when you operate from a higher, heavenly perspective. It is normal to fill your thoughts always with the realities of heaven and not with the distractions of the earthly realm. Heavenly things are not amorphous, utopic spiritual things. They are the realities of the Word. Because heaven is where you hail from and are a citizen of as seen in Philippians 3:20 (ESV), it is normal to only think about heavenly things.

Meditation

Meditate on this throughout today. I am part of the colony of heaven on earth. I feast on the treasures of the heavenly realm. My thoughts are only of those of heavenly realities. I am alert to what is going on around the heavenly Christ. This is where the real action is, so I get heavenly results.

SATURDAY MARCH 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU SPEAK DIFFERENTLY? IT'S NORMAL

1 Corinthians 2:12-13 ***“Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man’s wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.”***

The people of the world speak and understand their language. The language of the world is earthly (John 3:31). The born again is born from above (John 3:3) and is from a different world. In our realm, there is a language. It is the language of the Word revealed to us by the Spirit of God. Some people find it strange when we say the “Spirit of God said...”, or “Daddy revealed that...” etc. It should not however be new or strange to the born again. It is normal and should be a regular feature of your life. You must speak only what the Father says, reveals or does (John 5:19, Exodus 4:12, Matthew 10:20). It is normal to speak what is revealed by the Holy Spirit.

Declaration

I am bold to declare what the Spirit of God says always. My mouth is the mouth of the Holy Spirit on earth.

SUNDAY MARCH 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Being born again, I am awakened to the realities of the normal for me. I do not shuffle along with my eyes fixed and absorbed with the distractions of this natural realm. I see, I think, and I act from God's perspective. I have embraced my normal and the world cannot make me think or feel abnormal. My normal is in the Word. My normal is paths pleasing to God. My normal is what the Spirit of God says. These are the facts of my normal. Hallelujah!

MONDAY MARCH 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: OTHER TONGUES

Acts 2:4 *“And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.”*

At the new birth a human being steps into God’s eternal plan for his/her life as an adopted child of God. But this isn't the end of the journey in Christ. You must go ahead to meet the Holy Spirit to avoid having a frustrated Christian living in which the powerful realities of being in Christ are absent. When this important transaction of meeting the Holy Spirit happens, there are immediate results the first of which is speaking with other tongues. Our opening verse says the disciples spoke in other tongues as the Holy Spirit gave them utterance. “Other tongues” is a strange language or diverse languages. They are called “strange” because they are not natural human languages that are learnt. They are heavenly utterances given to those who are awakened to the Holy Spirit’s personality in them. No one can speak in other tongues by any level of education or enlightenment neither can it be bought. God spoke before in Isaiah 28:11-12 that the times of refreshing to come would be manifested by the speaking in other tongues to His people. Other tongues was also described as a stammering speech, but make no mistakes about it, they are distinct and power laden utterances in the spirit.

Prayer

Daddy Holy Spirit, I am really blessed by this enlightenment and I pray that this truth will spread to the whole world by Your power in Jesus’ Name.

TUESDAY MARCH 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DIVINE BEINGS HAVE A LANGUAGE

1 Corinthians 14:2 ***“For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries”***

The born again is not a human being who has a relationship with a mighty God. He is God’s authentic child begotten through the gospel (James 1:18). God the Holy Spirit is his spiritually biological father (Romans 8:15). The born is a God-begotten being with the very life of God. This has been God’s dream for mankind. According to 2Peter 1:4, the born again is now a partaker of the divine nature. So, Christians are fully divine in nature although they live in human bodies. The primary means of fellowship/ interaction among beings of the same kind is through language. Just as humans communicate through human language, divine beings also communicate by other tongues. Other tongues are not just religious utterances for prayer, but the primary language of the God beings. When we speak in other tongues, we are not speaking to men so don’t worry when men do not understand you because it is not man’s language. It is a spiritual language of the divine associates. Hallelujah!

Celebration

Wow! I am born of God and by the Spirit I have received the utterance of other tongues by which I enjoy the fellowship of the God-kind beyond human comprehension. Glory!

WEDNESDAY MARCH 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: OTHER TONGUES, A MUST FOR EVERY CHRISTIAN

Mark 16:17 *“And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues”.*

The subject of other tongues is one area where many have been deceived to think that it is not for all Christians. If God’s children would study the Bible with its author, the Holy Spirit, no church doctrine or a minister of God can deceive any Christian. So called controversial questions about speaking in other tongues exist because many Christians have not read the scriptures to know for themselves (Matthew 22:29). Unlike the Berean Christians who would go and search the scriptures to be sure what they were taught was the truth (Acts 17:10-11), Christians today swallow popular teachings without a spirit-led and Biblical scrutiny. When it comes to whether every Christian must speak in tongues, Jesus Himself said in our opening verse, that these signs shall follow THEM THAT BELIEVE. He was not talking to the “charismatic” nor the Pentecostal nor church leaders. Jesus was referring to anyone that believed in Jesus Christ, thus, the born again. So, do you believe in Jesus Christ? If you answer yes, then you should be speaking in other tongues or something is wrong. It is likely you have not believed right (according to the scriptures) or you have been wrongly taught on the subject, because everyone who believes should be speaking in other tongues.

Thanksgiving

Father in Jesus’ name, I thank You for showing me in Your Word that speaking in other tongues is neither a Pentecostal nor Charismatic thing but a sign that should follow every child of Yours.

THURSDAY MARCH 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TONGUES KEEP YOU SPIRITUALLY FIT

1 Corinthians 14:4 ***“He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; ...”***

Apart from growing in size, it is important for a person to keep fit to be able to function effectively on the earth. Human beings understand that they need to grow and be strong, so they feed their children, nourish and nurture them through various avenues. They do not end there, they embark on physical exercises to keep fit. As children of God, we have our substance for feeding (Matthew 4:4) and nurturing (2Timothy 3:16; Acts 20:32) which is the Word. For keeping ourselves fit, built up, firm, emboldened and full of vigour, we speak in other tongues. God does not take delight in weak, frustrated and beggarly Christianity. Speaking in other tongues is God’s revealed mode of keeping us charged up, strong and firm in spirit. The righteous is not as bold as a lion by quoting that verse, it happens by profuse and unapologetic speaking in other tongues. We have not been called to be subservient but to reign, dominate our worlds in all fields of life and the worldly systems. So, prop yourself up for the kingdom lifestyle of dominion through speaking enriched tongues.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus, I am a profuse enriched-tongues speaker, therefore I am spiritually fit for any divine task on this earth. I take my place as a son of God and reign in my world. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY MARCH 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAY FIRST IN OTHER TONGUES

1 Corinthians 14:15 ***“What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.”***

When we were born by our earthly parents, we were flesh and fleshy (John 3:6a). It was consistent with our nature to do things first from the flesh. Having been born again, we are begotten of the Spirit, we are now spirit (John 3:6b) and are alive to God’s spiritual realm of life. It is therefore inconsistent with our nature to do things like those who are earthy and of the flesh. When spirit beings live like flesh, it is carnality. Carnal Christianity is one that begins prayer in human language and then occasionally introduce some tongues. The Holy Spirit through Apostle Paul shows us what to do in 1Corinthians 14:15 that, “I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also”. So, you should pray with the mind after you have prayed with your spirit. Do things from your spirit not from your body. Because you are fully divine living in a physical body.

Confession

I am born from above, born from the spirit and born by God. Therefore, I do things first from the spirit. I from hence pray first with the spirit and then with the understanding also in Jesus’ name.

SATURDAY MARCH 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW CAN I SPEAK IN OTHER TONGUES

Acts 2:4 ***“And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance”.***

The main reason why some Christians do not speak in other tongues is the misconception they have in their minds. When one understands that, other tongues is the result of a child of God becoming awakened to the person, presence, and function of the Holy Spirit in his/her spirit and it happens, the Holy Spirit gives you this beautiful divine language called other tongues. We do not learn it, it is given because it is the privilege of every child of God. We speak in other tongues by faith because we know from the Word that the Holy Spirit gives the utterance. The moment you become awakened to the personality of the Holy Spirit, begin to speak as the people in Acts 2:4 did. They were not waiting for an emotion or any shaking movements of the jaw. The means of becoming awakened to the Holy Spirit could be by a spirit-filled Christian laying hands on you, or in your personal prayer or through your reception of the Word.

Prayer

Dear Holy Spirit, I am aware of Your presence, power and function in me. I hereby receive Your embrace in my heart. I thank You for the utterance You have given me right now in Jesus' name.

1 Thessalonians 5:5 ***"Ye are all the children of the light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness."***

One of the beautiful effects of understating who you are in Christ is the ease with which you can live and manifest fully your divine nature. There is no need to struggle. Our opening scripture tells us that children of God are children of light and of the day. This is describing your nature and state, not something you must struggle to become. How so? The principle of a being/thing producing after its kind was set in motion by God according to Genesis 1:12 and reiterated by Jesus in John 3:6. 1John 1:5 states clearly that God is light thus whatever is born of God is also light. You were born again as light and it is characteristic of light to shine. You were born shining so continue to shine. Awaken to the reality of your nature as light and decide from today to shine. Allow no room for any appearance of darkness. Follow through this week as we look at what it means to shine and how to shine.

Declaration

I am born of God therefore I am born of light. Light is my nature and I have decided to shine. I shine in this dark world!

TUESDAY MARCH 23

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IT MEANS TO SHINE – I

Genesis 1: 17-18 ***“And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth and to rule over the day and over the night, ...”***

The first thing shining implies is to give light or to brighten. This means to reveal or make known what is true. This world lies in darkness (Isaiah 60:2) and it is obvious from decisions people take and how they live their lives. To brighten or give light means that in this dark world, your life reveals the truth (reality) which is in essence God’s Word and directs people. When your speech, actions and life give people direction according to God’s Word or reveals the truth to men then you are shining. Another meaning of shining is to rule or dominate over darkness. Anything that is contrary to God’s Word is darkness whether it is a disease, poverty, ungodliness, evil or fear. So, you are shining as a child of God when you rule over or dominate any of such darts or systems of the enemy. When your dominion and the influence of God is felt on earth because of you, then you are shining.

Thanksgiving

Thank You Daddy for revealing these facts about what it means it shine. I declare that my life shines brighter and brighter in every field of life as I direct men and dominate the world with my light.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 24

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IT MEANS TO SHINE – II

Genesis 1:18 “...and to divide the light from the darkness...”

Another meaning of shining is to create a dichotomy between light and darkness. In an age where it is sometimes difficult to differentiate between children of light (Christians) and those of darkness, because of the kind of life they seem to live, shining as a child of God has never been more important. When you are shining, your life manifests a clear dichotomy between righteousness and sin, good and evil and between the truth and falsehood. You should not be counted among the masses. There should be no questions about what you believe. You only stand for the truth of God’s Word. People should feel uncomfortable to have evil/ungodly/fear filled conversations around you. A final meaning of shining can be seen in Genesis 1:14 “...and let them be for signs, and for days and years.” When your family, children, work and school colleagues and nation can look at you as a sign which directs and as a reference point even for new seasons and excellent things then you are shining. The church is to dictate to the world what season it is in.

Prayer

Thank You Father for these truths. My light is shining as I create a clear dichotomy between light and darkness and direct the world to the truth in Jesus’ name.

THURSDAY MARCH 25

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SHINE IN YOUR THOUGHTS

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 *“(For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;”*

Knowing that you are light and what it means for light to shine will be meaningless if you are not shining. Shining begins first at the thought level. If you are not shining in your thoughts, your shining will not be visibly expressed in the physical. Many struggle with their thoughts and it is reflective in the way they speak and act. Some live in perpetual depression, but this is not your portion. Rise up and shine in your thoughts. Our opening scripture shows us how. Cast down imaginations and thoughts that are not biblical. Anything that is contrary to the truth of God’s word must be cast down. Do not entertain thoughts of fear, failure, death, lack, poverty. Cast them down and subject them to the obedience of Christ. Philippians 4:8 spells out clearly the kinds of thoughts that you should allow to fill your mind. These are the things that define shining in your thoughts and as you think on these things you will see it outplaying in your life.

Declaration

I shine in my thoughts! I cast down every unbiblical imagination. I refuse to tolerate thoughts of lack, fear, death or evil. My mind is filled with lovely, pure, honourable and praiseworthy thoughts. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY MARCH 26

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SHINE IN YOUR SPEECH

Colossians 4:6 ***“Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.”***

Words are powerful. Even more so as one born again, your words carry power. Life and death are in the power of the tongue (Proverbs 18:21). You must therefore shine in your speech. Do not talk like the world. Do not add your voice to speech that depresses, speech that does not edify or anything unscriptural. Speak only things that are consistent with the Word of God. Jesus in John 8:28 gave us an example of how to talk “...as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.” No matter the situation you are facing, shine in your speech by speaking only God’s mind concerning the issue. Repeatedly calling your child disobedient is not going to change him or her. Speak into being the excellent child God gave you. As you shine in your thoughts, let your speech align with it and enjoy the blissful life in Christ on earth as you shine.

Declaration

My words are seasoned with grace. I only speak what my Father has taught me. My words edify, encourage, and build up. I shine in my speech as I declare the truth of God’s Word over every circumstance. Glory!

SATURDAY MARCH 27

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SHINE IN YOUR ACTIONS

Matthew 5:16 ***“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”***

Shining in your actions is reflective of shining in your thoughts and speech. As you shine at the thought level and in your speech, it automatically reflects in your actions. Many try to do “good works” in order to please men, but since it does not originate from the thought level, it is on today, off tomorrow. They shine intermittently and infrequently. As one born again, your path shines brighter and brighter (Proverbs 4:18), so be consistent in shining. Your light cannot be hidden so do not feel “shy” if by shining your actions make you stand out from your colleagues or the general course of the world. Be excited to be shining forth the light you are! Your Father is glorified when you shine in your actions so shine!

Celebration

I shine everywhere! I stand out from the world even as I shine forth the light in all my actions. My Father is glorified every time I shine. Glory!

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Glory to God! I am the light of this world and I shine. In my thoughts, speech, and actions, I create a clear dichotomy between light and darkness. I rule over every circumstance that comes my way. I shine so bright and give direction to all who need it. By my life, seasons are determined. Glory to God. I shine! I shine! I shine!

MONDAY MARCH 29

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY JESUS DIED – I

Romans 5:12 *“Wherefore as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.”*

Mankind is very special to God. The scriptures tell us in Ephesians 1:4-5 that God had an eternal plan for all mankind, which was to adopt them as His own children in Christ Jesus at an appointed time. God locked this plan up in predestination and so it had to be fulfilled. Before the time for the adoption however, Adam the first man, fell through sin. WEDNESDAY MARCH 31

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FOR WHOM DID JESUS DIE?

1 John 2:2 ***“And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.”***

Many people have the wrong notion that Jesus is a religious leader for Christians and so they believe he died for Christians. This is false. Jesus is not a religious leader and He did not die for Christians. Jesus died for the world (mankind). When Adam fell, sin passed unto all men (Romans 5:12). According to John 1:29, Jesus came to take away the sin of the world. No one could have been born again (become a Christian) before Jesus' resurrection from the dead. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
