Topic: HEALTH IN FELLOWSHIP

Romans 8:11 ***“But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.”***

John 16:20 *“Verily verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy”*

Many of God’s children live below the realities of life in Christ because of a lack of understanding of what the Word says about them. One of such realities is living in a state of joy. When the scriptures speak about joy, many think of it as happiness, but they are not the same. There are several Hebrew words that are translated as joy and have meanings ranging from gladness, rejoicing, brightening up, excited leaping and so on. In our opening verse today, joy is translated from the Greek word “chara” which means cheerfulness and it describes a state of calm delight or gladness. Happiness on the other hand is an excited state based on circumstantial happenings. Joy portrays a baseline delight in a person’s heart beyond external happenings. What many people know is happiness. They feel sad when things do not go as expected and are happy when they have things going their way. But God wants His children to live in joy because joy is part of the nature of the born again (Galatians 5:22). When men are cast down, you say, there is a lifting up because joy is the state of your heart. It is good to be happy but learn to build your life on joy and you will always be productive.

Prayer

Father, thank You for enlightening me on what joy really is. Having understood that I ought to live in joy, I affirm that this is my current state from now. I live in joy by the power of the Spirit. Hallelujah!!!

TUESDAY JULY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JOY, MY DEFENCE

Nehemiah 8:10 *"Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the Lord is your strength."*

To be born again is the most valuable thing that can take place in a person's life. By receiving the gospel of Jesus, one becomes a son of God who is divine in nature. Being a God being, you are a person of omnipotence, a person equipped for success forever in life. Many God beings are weak in life because most of the time, their strength is withered. You are a package of strength and the only way to express this strength is when you express joy which is your nature. When you lose the expression of joy, the devil gains the upper hand. Do not lose your joy concerning your life, marriage, children, work etc. because if your joy is intact, you can through prayer restore any seemingly hopeless situations. Learn to express joy because it is the foundation of your defense.

Prayer

Knowing this truth, I refuse to entertain worries in life. I give expression to the joy of the Lord in my heart no matter the circumstances around me. For the joy of the Lord is my strength. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY JULY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JOY, THE KEY TO DIVINE INHERITANCE

Isaiah 12:3 ***"Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation."***

When the human that once lived in your body received the gospel of Christ, you were born again into a place of inheritance. The born again is an heir of God. He is the owner of all the estate of the Father. So, Christianity is an arrival at a place of abundance. This makes you a package of solutions (2Peter 1:3). Jesus likened it to having a well in you springing up unto everlasting life (John 4:14). These wells are to be flowing from within us (John 7:37-38). Confession

THURSDAY JULY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CHRIST, THE SOURCE OF JOY

John 17:13 ***"And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves."***

The best anyone without Christ can have in life is happiness which is temporary because happiness depends on happenings which are subject to change. But for a perpetual state of joy in one's heart, a person must receive Jesus because joy is only of God. Do not be deceived by what the world calls joy, it is not joy at all. There is no joy in money, fame, power, achievements, entertainment etc. At best they can only bring happiness. According to Galatians 5:22, joy is part of the divine life that is imparted to your spirit in the new birth process. So, Christ is the source of joy. Joy is of God and so it is called the joy of the Lord (Nehemiah 8:10). God gave the children of Israel in the Old Testament joy as an external endowment because they were not born again, but in Christ, we are born with joy in our spirit. Hallelujah! What is required of you the child of God, is to learn to live in this baseline calmness of pleasure in your heart. Because joy is in Christ, and you are part of the body of Christ.

Confession

Wow! I do not look for joy from the world. Being a member of the body of Christ, I have joy. I can shout, the joy of the Lord is my strength. Glory!

FRIDAY JULY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: THE FOUNDATION OF JOY

Romans 8:28 ***“And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.”***

The challenge some of God's children face in the expression of joy, is the ignorance of who they are and what they have in Christ. Ignorance of the Word is the undoing of many in life. Many people are better placed in life than the level of joy they express in life because they are looking at the wrong things due to the ignorance of who they are and what they have in Christ. Many wrongly think that all they need to be joyful in life is money, marriage, job, children etc. That is a wrong focus. Joy is only in Christ and so Christ is all you need to express joy. Many Christians are full of worry, grief, fear, and uncertainties because of the wrong focus in life. So, it matters what you know as a Christian. Imagine a person who knows that because he loves God and is called according to His purpose, every situation he is facing now is bound to turn out for his good. Where will worry or fear be? SATURDAY JULY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JOY KILLERS

1 Thessalonians 5:19 ***“Quench not the Spirit”***

Though joy is the nature the born again has in his or her spirit, the expression of joy can be stifled by certain things when they are allowed in one's life. One of the things that suppresses the expression of joy in Christians is quenching the fervour of the Spirit. The born again is inseparably one with the Holy Spirit and He is in you to carry out a ministry. Not allowing Him to carry out His ministry in you quenches Him. But when you are full of Him, you will be full of joy because in the kingdom of God is joy in the Holy Ghost (Romans 14:17). Carnality also quenches the expression of joy in the life of a child of God. Living by the senses (sight, hearing, taste, touch, smelling) instead of the Word dries up the expression of joy of any child of God. When one deviates into living by the flesh, they focus on the wrong external things to be joyful and that stifles their expression of joy. Living to please men instead of God suppresses the expression of joy because not all will be pleased by your ways no matter what you do. Worry is another thing that can put out the expression of one's joy. That is why Nehemiah 8:10 admonishes us not to create worry.

Confession

Dear Holy Spirit, having been awakened to You as my Daddy, I choose to walk with you all the days of my life. I refuse to be carnal or worry in life. I choose to live to please You alone.

SUNDAY JULY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Being born again, I have joy resident in my spirit. By the power of the Spirit, I never allow anything to suppress the expression of my joy. I give my heart to the study of the Word to live by it. I choose to walk with the Holy Spirit as my Daddy in reality. I am always full of Him. My joy springs up everyday and with this unstoppable flow of joy, I bring forth all things that pertain to life and godliness. Hallelujah!

MONDAY JULY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BREAK CAMP AND ADVANCE

Deuteronomy 1:7 (NIV) ***“Break camp and advance into the hill country of the Amorites; go to all the neighboring peoples in the Arabah in the mountains, in the western foothills, in the Negev and along the coast, to the land of the Canaanites and to Lebanon, as far as the great river, the Euphrates”***

Every child of God must recognize that the Father has an ultimate destination for His children, which is to be the very expression of the fullness of Christ in this world (Ephesians 4:13, 1John 4:17). No matter the level at which you are in attaining this fullness, you must know that there is more for you. The land God promised the Israelites was Canaan. They moved out of Egypt, crossed the red sea, travelled the wilderness and arrived at Mount Horeb. They became comfortable there and settled but the Promised Land was Canaan. Many Christians are living as mere humans with human experiences though they are born again. They are comfortable at just knowing they are born again. This is not God's final destination for His children. His ultimate for them is to live as icons of Christ on earth. Thus, like God told the Israelites through Moses that it was time to break camp and advance, it is time to break the camp of knowing you are born again but living as human. You are different from humans. Your thoughts, speech and actions must reflect this difference.

Declaration

I refuse to settle anywhere apart from God's ultimate for me. I break out of the camp of humanistic thoughts, speech and actions because I am divine not a human.

TUESDAY JULY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU ARE DIFFERENT

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”***

Do you remember the day the “old man” got born again? Do you remember the “old man” believed the gospel and confessed Jesus as Lord? Do you really understand what happened to him or her? God wants you to know that when the old man believed that Jesus was raised from the dead and confessed Him as Lord (Romans 10:9), something happened. Titus 3:5 makes it clear that a spiritual transaction took place: there was a washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Ghost. You are the product of that transaction. This means you are different from the one who believed the gospel. This is also seen in John 1:12 which says that those who believed were given the power to become sons of God. This means that the one who believed is different from the son of God that came into being. This difference is reiterated in 2Corinthians 5:17 which says any man who is in Christ is a new creature. He is a new type of being different from the old. So, the born again is different from the old man (human).

Thanksgiving

Thank You Father for showing me that I am different from humans. The process of my birth is a demonstration of Your excess love for me. I am eternally grateful to You for that.

WEDNESDAY JULY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY IS THE BORN AGAIN DIFFERENT?

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”***

When the old man (the human being) received Christ, a new creature emerged. This creature has never existed before. He is of a new type and totally different from the old. This old life (human life) which was buffeted with sickness, poverty and frustration was crucified with Christ and died with Him (Romans 6:6, 2Corinthians 5:17). In the same way Christ was made alive with a new life which is God’s own life (John 5:26, 1John 5:11), you were also made alive with this new life and was raised up together with Him. You are now a divine being seated together with Christ in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:5-6) and have also become a partaker of God’s divine nature (2Peter 1:4). Your body no longer carries the human life with the human nature. This is why the born again is different. Refuse to see yourself as the old man. All things have become new, behold it.

Affirmation

I am different. I am not the same as the old. I am a new type of being with the life of God. I am a partaker of divinity. I behold this now.

THURSDAY JULY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: IMPLICATION OF THIS DIFFERENCE

Romans 6:4 ***“Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life”.***

Knowing that in Christ, you are different from humans is only the first step. You must live in the consciousness of this knowledge and walk in the reality of it. What happens to you in life is not as important as your response to it and this is dependent on who you see yourself to be. How you respond to situations is the primary determinant of your experience. Many Christians are mounting up false responses because though divine, they respond to situations as humans and therefore have human experiences. David saw Goliath and heard him when he spoke as did the other Israelites but his description of what he saw and heard was different (1Samuel 17:23-26). He was conscious of his difference that as one who was circumcised, he was in the Abrahamic covenant (Genesis 17:10, 14) and thus was not subject to one who was uncircumcised. Stop describing challenges by their capabilities, describe them by who you are. The born again can be described as the “circumcised” but this circumcision is not a physical one made by hands (Colossians 2:10-11). This is an even better circumcision. You are therefore not subject to any challenge (uncircumcised Philistine), that shows up. You are different, enjoy your life.

Declaration

I am different. I live in the consciousness of this difference. I deal with challenges according to who I am. What destroys others cannot destroy me because I am different.

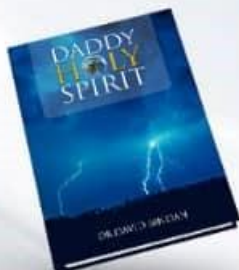
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FRIDAY JULY 16

Topic: DISMANTLE YOUR LOCATION AND ADVANCE

Acts 20:32 “And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.”

Now that you know you are different and its implication, you must dismantle the old humanistic mentality. Until you break down your house, you will continue sleeping in it. Until you break down the ‘I am human’ mentality, you will still think, talk, and act as human. Topic: ACTS OF FULFILLING PURPOSE – REIGNING

1 Corinthians 15:25 ***“For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.”***

You must not be the one responsible for the break in the reign of Jesus on earth. As a king-priest, (1Peter 2:9), you have a priestly ministry of interceding for the world and the church daily (Ezekiel 22:30, Revelations 5:10). By your intercession, people will hear the gospel and get born again. The church will also be preserved and be matured to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ (Ephesians 4:13). This is fulfilling purpose.

Affirmation

Glory to God. I know who I am. I was born to reign. The reign of Jesus will never be cut off on earth because of me. God will always find someone standing in the gap and preserve the earth because of me. I fulfil purpose. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY JULY 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ACTS OF FULFILLING PURPOSE - MEDITATION

Acts 20:32 “And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.”

Building yourself up in the Word daily is also an act of fulfilling purpose. Our opening scripture affirms this. Giving yourself wholly to the Word of God’s grace is what builds you up. No day should pass by without you meditating on a scripture. There is a difference between reading the scriptures and meditating on them. Acts 5:42 *“And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.”*

Topic: BE A SIGN

Philippians 2:15 ***“...the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world.”***
