FRIDAY OCTOBER 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HONOUR YOUR SHEPHERD

1 Timothy 5:17 ***“Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.”***

The born again is fully divine in nature because in his or her body resides the fullness of the Godhead. Therefore, whenever you see a child of God, honour the person no matter who he or she is. Our opening scripture today enjoins us to count elders (in our context this week, our shepherds) worthy of double honour. These are the ones who labour in the Word and doctrine to feed and nourish us. Our shepherds pray for us and minister to us in various other ways. We must hold them in high esteem and honour them at every opportunity we get. This is the mark of a wise child of God. Be careful (not out of fear but reverently) in how you speak to and about your shepherd and do not at any time become familiar with him or her no matter how “friendly or close” you are. Never be bitter in your heart towards your shepherd (Hebrews 12:14-15). The Holy Spirit who gave him to you as a gift does not make mistakes and so go to Him in prayer if any challenges show up and He will guide you in dealing with it.

Prayer

I honour and hold in high esteem the gift Daddy has given me in my shepherd. By this I benefit fully from his grace and ministry to me in Jesus’ name.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAY FOR YOUR SHEPHERD

Matthew 26:31 (MSG) ***“Then Jesus told them, “Before the night’s over, you’re going to fall to pieces because of what happens to me. There is a Scripture that says, I’ll strike the shepherd; helter-skelter the sheep will be scattered.”***

If there is one simple but powerful thing any son or daughter of God can do for their shepherd, it is to pray for them. Many times, children of God forget to pray for their shepherds, but our opening scripture shows us an important principle. The simplest way the devil can scatter the sheep is if he strikes the shepherd. If the shepherd is led astray, be it in doctrine or character, the sheep will follow suit. So, pray for your shepherd that his walk with the Holy Spirit will be an ever increasing one. That he will remain in the present truth of God’s word and for grace and strength to fulfill his ministry as excellently as ordained by the Father. Praying for your shepherd keeps you free from offences and turns out for your own good as well. It is also a means of partaking of grace.

TUESDAY OCTOBER 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU MUST FULFIL YOUR CALLING

Colossians 4:17 ***“And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it”.***

It is not enough to know you have been called, you must take heed to this call to fulfil it. This is where the role of the gifts as stated in Ephesians 4:11-12 come in. Church services and Church Conferences are avenues primarily for perfecting (building up, equipping) the saints for the work of the ministry which is the call. The saints are those who have received Christ and are born again. This should be one of your main reasons for going to church or attending these conferences. If you have been entrusted with a flock by God, take heed to equipping them for the call (Acts 20:28). There are those who a lot of times are praying for miracles, breakthroughs and so on. WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GOD WORKS IN TIMES AND SEASONS

Acts 1:7 ***“And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power”.***

Life is not a cycle of repetition of meaningless events. God works in times and seasons and is always doing something at every time. For instance, God before the foundations of the world predestined that He was going to adopt mankind to Himself through Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:4-5). Afterwards He created the world including man and generations came and left each fulfilling specific calls towards the manifestation of His original plan. In the fullness of time, this plan was fulfilled (Galatians 4:4). Jesus will come again in the same way He ascended into heaven (Acts 1:11). He spoke about this (John 14:3), the apostles spoke about it (1 John 2:28), great Ministers of God have spoken about it and now the fullness of time for this to happen is so close, closer than it was when Jesus said it and when the great Ministers of God reiterated it. Topic: OUR CALL IN THIS GENERATION

Luke 2:25-26 *“And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord’s Christ.”*

This generation is so special. We are alive in the generation in which the Church is coming to the fullness of the stature of Christ; the glorious Church Jesus is coming for (Ephesians 4:13, 5:26-27). FRIDAY OCTOBER 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO FULFIL THIS CALL - I

Colossians 4:17 *"And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it".*

Now that you know what you have been called unto, you must ensure you fulfil it. Life is about fulfilling a call, accomplishing a mission, achieving a purpose. To fulfil this call, you must first accept that we are indeed in the days of the final work of the Holy Spirit on earth before the rapture which is the harvesting of the remnants and the Church being ripened for Jesus Christ's soon return. This is the present truth of our day and you must be established in it (2 Peter 1:12). You will not be able to fulfil your call if you don't believe this. Topic: HOW TO FULFIL THIS CALL - II

1 John 4:17 ***“Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world”***

To fulfil this call, you must also make your mind up to manifest God everywhere and at all times. To manifest is to rise up to be who you really are as a divine being and ensure that things are the way God has ordained them to be in your time. Manifestation first begins in you - how do you think when challenges show up? You are not manifesting if you are still thinking like a human instead of the divine being you are. In your manifestation you may seem to be conflicting with the “normal” but stand your ground because you are not of the world and its systems and the world does not know you neither can they understand you (John 15:19,21; John 1:5). There are things in God’s timetable that need to be done. Ensure it is done. Lastly refuse to go back. The devil will try and overwhelm you, so you go back to humanity but refuse to go back and keep manifesting divinity (Daniel 7:25, Hebrews 11:24-27; 35-40).

Ephesians 1:4-6 "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, to the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved"

Knowing who you are in Christ prevents an identity crisis. For lack of knowledge, children of God perish (Hosea 4:6). Our opening scripture shows us that we are chosen by the Father to be holy and blameless living before Him in love. If you are in Christ, this is who you are. You have been accepted in God's beloved! TUESDAY OCTOBER 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU ARE A SAINT

Ephesians 1:1 ***“Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God to the saints which are at Ephesus and to the faithful in Christ Jesus.”***

The Apostle Paul, in his letter to the Christians at Ephesus, addressed them as saints as seen in our scripture above. This was not peculiar to the Ephesians but in almost all his letters, he addressed the brethren as saints. A saint refers to a holy person. Knowing and acknowledging this about yourself is vital to you walking in the fullness of your holy nature. Many Christians do not consider themselves saints, they think it is even blasphemous to say so. To them a saint is someone dead and gone who has been given that title by some system because of his or her good works, but the Bible does not teach that. If you are born again, you have the nature of your Father God. That nature is holy therefore you are holy by birth (the new birth), and as such a saint. Hebrews 3:1 states it emphatically as ***“wherefore **holy brethren**, partakers of the heavenly calling...”***. Know this basic fact about yourself in order to easily manifest your holy nature. Also enjoy the benefits of your holiness, because as one consecrated (holy) to God you are exempted from all forms of evil.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BE A FAITHFUL SAINT

Ephesians 1:1 ***“Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God to the saints which are at Ephesus and to the faithful in Christ Jesus.”***

Faithfulness is an attribute that every child of God must exhibit. Though part of your nature as a born again, you must express faithfulness. The Apostle Paul in our scripture above, made specific mention of the faithful saints in our scripture above. Faithfulness to Christ is expressed when a son of God adheres to the Word no matter how challenging things may seem. There is no double mindedness for the faithful saint when it comes to living by the Word of God. Jesus described those who continue in His Word as His true disciples (John 8:30-31). Topic: YOU ARE THE BLESSED

Ephesians 1:3 ***"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ."***

The born again is the blessed one! A good understanding of what our opening scripture means will re-orient every child of God and position him or her to enjoy the good life here on earth. Our opening verse states that God has blessed us with all spiritual blessings. This is something that has already happened, and when did this happen? It happened the day you got born again. Blessing here means that God the Father, invoked by speech into you spiritual endowment that causes you to prosper, be favoured, be full of joy, be protected and consecrated to Him. All this was deposited into you the day you got born again. And He blessed you with, as the verse continues to say, all spiritual blessings. This means that nothing was left out, you lack nothing! Do you understand now why you should not be living a downtrodden or beggarly life? And why you should not be begging your Father to bless you? He has already done so! Ephesians 1:3 ***"Blessed be the Good and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ."***

It is exciting to know that in Christ, you are the blessed one. Not knowing your blessed state deprives you of enjoying the goodies in life. On the other hand, there are others who are at another extreme and so "blessing-focused" that they forget the purpose of it all. In "chasing after and enjoying the blessing", they forget the primary purpose of fellowship with the Father- fellowship that leads to walking in purpose. Topic: STIR UP SPIRITUAL REALITIES

Ephesians 1:2 ***"Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father; and from the Lord Jesus Christ."***

Oh my! Just reading our opening scripture and I've received grace! Wow! There is an attitude and positioning that every child of God must have towards the scriptures. It is one of knowing that the Bible is a living book, authored by the Holy Spirit and interacting with it in real time. Some read certain verses of scriptures, especially the opening salutations like the one in our opening verse casually. They do not appreciate the fact that this is the Holy Spirit ministering to them (in this case grace and peace). Learn to appropriate the benediction to your life in real time. Do you need grace for the day? Week? A particular task? Do you want to enjoy peace? You do not need to wait for a special service in church before you enjoy these. Right in your room daily, with the Holy Spirit in and with you, you can stir up these spiritual realities by appropriating them to yourself. The more you read, the more you receive. Celebrate the Word as coming directly to you and stir them up into physical reality as you interact with it. Receive grace and peace now!

Meditation

Spend about 5 to 10 minutes reading and meditating on Ephesians 1:2 and speak fervently in other tongues as you stir up grace and peace in your life.

SUNDAY OCTOBER 17

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY OCTOBER 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU ARE NOT ORDINARY

2 Corinthians 5:20 (BBE) *“So we are the representatives of Christ, as if God was making a request to you through us: we make our request to you, in the name of Christ, be at peace with God”.*

It is particularly important for you to understand that the one in Christ is not an ordinary person subject to the systems of the world. He or she wields authority. This is a biblical fact. Christians need to wake up to this truth. They are people of authority, and they need to discover and function in that authority. What is authority? Authority is the ability to influence. It is the capacity or force of control over a realm. This means you can influence any situation to your advantage. You are not helpless, neither are you at the mercy of the systems of the world. You are a person of authority. This is not motivational speech, it is the truth. So, the next time any challenge shows up, remember you can change its result. This is why James wrote in James 1:2 (NLT) that when troubles of any kind come your way you should consider it an opportunity for great joy. Do not run away from challenges, embrace them for they are opportunities to exercise your authority.

Affirmation

I am not ordinary. I wield authority. I have the ability to influence my realm. I do not run away from challenges. No! I meet them squarely and deal with them because I am a person with great authority.

TUESDAY OCTOBER 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: AUTHORITY BY REPRESENTATION

2 Corinthians 5:20 (BBE) *“So we are the representatives of Christ, as if God was making a request to you through us: we make our request to you, in the name of Christ, be at peace with God”.*

Why is the authority of the Christian verified? Because he represents Christ right here on earth. To appreciate the extent of your authority, you must know the extent of Jesus' authority. Jesus Himself said in Matthew 28:18 (RSV) that all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Him. The description of this authority can be seen in Philippians 2: 9-10 and it was given to Him by the Father. This is the one whom you represent. A regional minister has authority because he represents the President in the particular region. You do not represent the president of a nation but the Monarch of the universe. Your authority transcends the heavens and the earth. It cuts across galaxies. Based on this authority, you have been commissioned to make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:19). No system can oppose this mission. Rise up in this knowledge and exercise your authority. Praise the Lord!

Confession

I am a representative of Jesus Christ in this world. I am not ordinary. I am a person of authority on a mission. My influence transcends the heavens and earth. By me, souls will be harvested and disciplined for Christ. Glory to God.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR AUTHORITY IS BY NATURE

1 John 4:17 (TPT) *"...because all that Jesus now is, so are we in this world."*

It is good to know that the born again is a person of authority because he represents Jesus Christ on earth. The challenge however of viewing your authority from this perspective is that many Christians do not get it right. They think they are humans with a relationship with God through Jesus Christ and because of this relationship, God has delegated them to function in His divine authority. They have not understood that whoever receives Jesus Christ is a son of God by birth (John 1:12-13, James 1:18) and thus a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17), fully divine (2 Peter 1:4). Lack of this understanding is why many Christians are living as weaklings. Your authority is not just an ordinary delegation but is your nature. You wield authority because of who you are. You are a son of God with the very life of God. In this life is the nature of God which is one of authority. Our opening scripture shows that the born again is exactly as Christ is now on earth. Christ is his life (Colossians 3:4) and since Christ is the holder of universal authority, he is also the holder of universal authority. Do not pray for authority, you have it by nature. Praise God!

Celebration

Glory! I am so excited to know the authority I wield is by virtue of who I am. I have the nature of Jesus Christ. The nature of Christ in me is one of authority. I consistently exercise my authority because it is my nature. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY OCTOBER 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR AUTHORITY IS BY CORONATION

Ephesians 2:6 ***“And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:”***

Nothing short of a miracle happens when one gets born again. The day a human being believes in and receives Jesus, he gets born again in the spirit and becomes adopted as God's son. Instantly in the spirit, he or she is backdated and jointly coronated with Jesus and made to sit together with Him in heaven. This is what our opening scripture shows us. Luke 7:8 *“For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it”.*

Now that you know you are a person of authority, you must be conscious of it. It is sad to see many people living beggarly lives despite who they are in Christ.
