MONDAY MAY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WAITING ON GOD

Hosea 12:6 *“Therefore turn thou to thy God; keep mercy and judgement, and wait on thy God continually.”*

In the fast-paced generation in which we live, many of God’s children have not learnt the art of waiting on God. Waiting on God is perceived as something ministers of God do in order to get some “deep revelation” from Him. The scriptures however are replete with evidence that indicate that our lives as children of God must be in a continual state of waiting on God. Our opening verse is one of such. Waiting on God is the spiritual practice of remaining consciously in His presence until a righteous expectation is fulfilled. Since God is our all-in-all and our lives are always in expectation of the fulfillment of His Word to us, Waiting on God is thus a fundamental activity in the life of every child of God and key to living in divine realities.

Dear Father, my heart is aligned to receive Your truth concerning waiting on You so that I can step into it as my lifestyle in Jesus’ name.

TUESDAY MAY 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE PURPOSE FOR WAITING ON GOD

Luke 2:25 *“And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him.”*

The purpose of waiting on God, is to have a righteous expectation fulfilled. Waiting on God is not and should not become an aimless religious activity one carries out ever so often. One could be waiting for the manifestation of the results of a prayer, or the fulfillment of a personal word in your life or a general word in your generation. These expectations are according to God's Word or that which He has directly spoken. Waiting thus demonstrates absolute trust in God for the expected result. From Luke 2:25-38, Simeon and Anna are two classic examples of people who waited on the Lord concerning the consolation of Israel and indeed on the day that Jesus was being dedicated in the temple, they were there to witness the fulfillment of this righteous expectation. The expectation of the righteous is never cut short and thus the purpose for which you are waiting on God will surely be fulfilled.

WEDNESDAY MAY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMPORTANCE OF WAITING ON GOD - I

Psalm 62:5 ***"My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him."***

One of the basic principles of life is this: that everything must remain connected to its source in order to remain pure and functional. So, a fish out of water will certainly die, no matter how long it wiggles outside of its source. The child of God came into being having been born by God Himself (John 1:12-13), thus disconnected from Him he/she will malfunction and be corrupted. Waiting on God as a daily and lifelong activity is important for the child of God because it enhances the reality of absolute dependence on or trust in God and thus protects one from the corruption of independence from God. Our opening scripture tells us that our expectation is to be from God and Him only. It is very easy to be caught up in the technological and scientific advancements of this age, but the child of God must be quick to recognize that for us, God is our source and our all. The arm of flesh fails, and so except the Lord builds the house, the builders build in vain (Psalm 127:1).

I wait only upon God because all my expectations are from Him

THURSDAY MAY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMPORTANCE OF WAITING ON GOD – II

2 Chronicles 16:9(NLT) ***“The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him...”***

Apart from enhancing the reality of our absolute dependence on God, what waiting on God does is to refine us to become divinely aligned for God’s operation in and through us. The born again is perfect in nature just as God is. The process of the new birth downloaded the very life of God into our spirit. We however still exist on this earth in a body and with a soul that did not get born again. Waiting on God thus refines our soul and body so that God can operate in and through us. Though perfect in spirit, there may be certain attitudes or habits that the mind and body try to replay from the old man in our daily living. But when one waits on God, He refines us such that we are in perfect alignment so that He can operate in and through us with no barriers. God is light and He does not change thus as you grow in Christ you must constantly be refined so that you are in alignment for His purposes to be accomplished or even for your expectations to be met. Anything you are not well aligned and prepared to handle, you will abuse or be destroyed by it.

Prayer

Pray fervently presenting your heart to the Father to be refined as you wait on Him

FRIDAY MAY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WAIT IN SILENCE

Habakkuk 2:20 ***“But the Lord is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.”***

It is important not only to know about waiting on God but to know how to wait on Him. Our opening verse shows us one of the ways of waiting on God. It is to wait on Him in silence. Many Christians nowadays, do not know how to be silent before God and listen to Him. This is not referring to just being physically quiet but also being quiet in the mind during prayer. Some have used speaking in other tongues to cover up for periods of silent focus on God. It is important to have times when you are silent in the presence of God. In such periods, it is easier and faster to pick up divine signals and directions. In these silent moments, you are consciously waiting as you focus on the scriptural pictures of your desire or commune with Him in your thoughts. You can also be reading the scriptures while being expectant to hear from Him. As you mature, you will be able to “go to” God and just be quiet, doing or saying nothing and be so focused in waiting on Him.

I worship You Daddy for these priceless truths. I am surely attaining results as I wait on You.

SATURDAY MAY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WAIT IN PRAYER

Colossians 4:12 ***"Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God."***

Prayer is another avenue by which sons and daughters of God can wait on Him. Again, in an age where almost everything can be done "instantly", some of God's children are yet to master the art of waiting in prayer. Some after praying for a day or two, or even a week for something, "give up" and assume that it is probably not for them. Others on the other hand think prayer is all about declaring and calling it into being as done. No. There is a dimension of prayer where though you may have laid hold on the substance of your request in the spirit, you continue (wait in prayer) until you see its physical manifestation. In Galatians 4:19, Paul was in prayer for the church in Galatia (these were born again) "... till Christ be formed in them". There is no time limit to waiting on God. How soon your expectations are met depends on how well aligned you are.

I celebrate You Father. With this truth, I don't short circuit my waiting. I'll wait on you continually until I see the results. Glory!

SUNDAY MAY 8

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY MAY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DIVINE EXPERIENCES – WHAT ARE THEY?

Isaiah 6:1 ***“In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up and his train filled the temple.”***

A divine experience is a practical contact with God or an observation of the fact of a divine occurrence that leaves a tangible impression on the heart of the person who has that experience. Some Christians have had a form of divine encounter or the other, but majority believe that divine experiences are limited to special people such as Prophets or “very spiritual” Christians. Others not having understood accurately the reality and importance of divine experiences have shut themselves up and look strangely at those who talk about their experiences. The amazing truth is that divine experiences are for all who are born again. They are God generated spiritual or physical moves or activities on a person’s spirit, soul, or body. Being born again, you have been ushered into the kingdom of God which is a spiritual kingdom (John 3:3-5) and thus you can and must interact with spiritual (divine) things. Divine experiences ought to be commonplace among the saints. Position yourself by these teachings to step into the reality of divine experiences.

Prayer

Father, I pray that the eyes of my understanding be enlightened to receive Your truth concerning divine experiences that I may step into this new state of walking in them in Jesus’ name.

TUESDAY MAY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FEATURES OF DIVINE EXPERIENCES

Acts 9:3-4 “And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: and he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?”

An accurate study of the Scriptures with the Holy Spirit reveals some features of divine experiences. The first is that they do not originate from the flesh. They are God generated. Divine experiences may occur in the spirit, soul (with its faculties) or in the body. They are generated by God and thus no one can claim to have caused him/herself to have had such an experience. One can however prepare to have a divine experience and as such it is commoner for people who spend more time with God to have them. Another feature of divine experiences is that they are very personal to the individual or group of people that have them. It is often challenging for one to communicate with words clearly what they experienced. Divine experiences though challenging to communicate, are very definite and impressive. The impression is so deep and real that no one who has had such experience can be convinced otherwise. A typical example is the divine experience Paul (then Saul) had in Acts 9:1-8.

Worship

I bless You Daddy for the reality of my life in Christ. Thank you for the privilege to have divine experiences daily.

WEDNESDAY MAY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SOME FORMS OF DIVINE EXPERIENCES

Exodus 3:2-4 “And the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and behold the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said I will now turn aside and see this great sight why the bush is not burnt. And when the Lord saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said Moses, Moses. And he said here I am.”

Divine experiences, being God generated, can occur by various means. We will look at a few of them. This is by no means exhaustive simply because God deals with each of his children in a unique way and once perception of a divine experience may be totally different from another's. From biblical examples, a divine experience can be a definite perception of God's presence or reality, with or without physical excitement (Gen. 28:12-16). It can be a definite perception of a change in texture of the environment, though no one else may be aware of it. It could come as a sudden visual perception of a spiritual reality with or without the physical eye (Acts 10:3, 9-16) or a definite auditory perception of a spiritual reality (Acts 9:3-7). A divine experience can be a definite impression or sudden understanding of a scriptural truth (Luke 24:45) or a definite answer, direct word about a situation. It could also be a definite vision of divine beings such as angels, the Father, Jesus or the Holy Spirit (Isaiah 6:1, Revelation 1:10-17)

Prayer

Dear Father, I pray that the body of Christ will be ushered into a new state of consistently having divine experiences

THURSDAY MAY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE NECESSITY OF DIVINE EXPERIENCES - I

John 3:3 *“Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.”*

Are divine experiences necessary in this day and age? This question has probably crossed your mind before. The answer to it is an emphatic yes! Divine experiences are a primary part of our lives in the kingdom. It is unfortunate to note that some Christians associate divine (spiritual) experiences with people who are “unenlightened” and as such they like to deal with “only the Word”. But from our opening verse, we are told that the son of God is born into the kingdom and is the one to see(experience) kingdom realities. Hebrews 12:22 tells us the different categories of beings in Zion - where the born again is – how many of them are you consciously aware of? We are citizens of heaven (Philippians 3:20), in this world but not of this world and so our dealings must be from the realm of the spirit. This makes having divine experiences fundamental and vital for anyone who is born again. Do not settle for humanistic Christianity. Arise to your real life in Christ today.

Thank You Father that being born again, it is my privilege to have divine experiences. I rise to be stabilized in this realm in Jesus’ name.

FRIDAY MAY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE NECESSITY OF DIVINE EXPERIENCES – II

Job 42:5 *"I have heard of thee by the hearing of the ear: but now mine eyes seeth thee."*

Divine experiences, in addition to being a primary part of our lives in the kingdom, are God's own direct interaction and ministry to us. As a direct ministration of God, they consciously prove His reality to us. God is real and His children know this, but we are not always consciously aware of Him. Through divine experiences, He consciously makes us aware that He is real. He ministers reality to us. Job 9:11 and 42:5 paint a clear picture of this. The born again is in God and God is in Him but he wants us to be so aware of this and so gives us these experiences. Divine experiences affirm His love and interest in us, and they are the means of God getting our attention. Some Christians have unfortunately become so busy, even about the work of ministry, that God must draw our attention and divine experiences are the means He uses (Exodus 3:1-6).

Declaration

Daddy You are real, and I am always conscious of this as I enjoy the divine experiences You give me. In Jesus' name.

SATURDAY MAY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PREPARING FOR DIVINE EXPERIENCES

1 Peter 1:22 *"Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently."*

When a child of God is not prepared or ready for a divine experience, he may have one and brush it over, not giving it the due attention. Divine experiences are God generated but it is the child of God who is well positioned that is more likely to have that experience. One important key to being prepared for divine experiences is the key of holiness. Holiness (ceremonial cleanliness) can only be realized in the life of one who is holy by nature. As a born again, your nature is holy, but the purification of your soul and body is important so that divinity can function fully through you. An unpurified mind is a locking up of divinity. Submit yourself to the Holy Spirit for the purification of your soul and body and step into the lifelong walk, in divine experiences.

Prayer

Father, I pray that by the work of Your Spirit, my heart will be aligned to submit to every preparation required for divine experiences in Jesus' name.

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

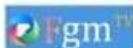

MONDAY MAY 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TESTIMONIES

Psalm 66:16 (NLT) ***“Come and listen, all you who fear God, and I will tell you what he did for me.”***

It is quite common to hear testimonies in Christian gatherings. Testimonies have however over time become avenues for advertising the gifts ministers of God operate in, their ministries and times for showing off how ‘spiritual’ the testifier is. The main aim for which testimonies were instituted by God has been lost. People hear testimonies and unconsciously glorify the vessel instead of the maker of the vessel. They boast in the abilities of the vessel. It is as though the miracle or divine experience originated from the vessel. This is not biblical. Testimonies are very important to God. It is one of the means by which He ministers to people. It is therefore important to understand what testimonies are and maximise it to achieve its greatest impact. A testimony is a written or spoken evidence of what God has done in or through someone. We will look at testimonies in a greater light over the next few days.

Intercession

Dear Lord Jesus, I pray that the body of Christ will be awakened to the reality of what testimonies are and experience its impact in an amazing way.

TUESDAY MAY 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT TESTIMONIES ARE NOT FOR

Luke 17:10 *“So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.”*

Testimonies are not to glorify or draw attention to a minister of God, the ministry or the person through whom God worked or the one who experienced it. Our opening verse intimates that people through whom God ministers should not think it is to their glory or that of their ministry when someone has a divine experience or receives a miracle through their ministration. They are fulfilling their duties as ministers of God. The glory and attention must be given to God and rightly so. Testimonies are not to show how powerful you are as a minister of God or how powerful your ministry is. Some people also like to give testimonies to show off how ‘spiritual’ they are. They end up embellishing the testimony with jargons thus lose the transmission of divine substance in the process. If a testimony is shared in this manner, its purpose to bless or uplift the brethren will not be achieved.

Prayer

Father, thank You for this enlightenment. From today, my testimonies glorify You only in Jesus’ name.

WEDNESDAY MAY 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TESTIMONIES – GLORIFYING GOD

Luke 17:15 *“And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God,”*

Testimonies are given to glorify God for what He has done in the life of the person sharing. In the verse above, Jesus interacted with ten lepers and sent them off to show themselves to the priest. They received their healing on their way. Out of the ten, only one returned and he returned with a loud voice glorifying God. Some people have amazing divine experiences but keep quiet about it because they are shy or think it does not matter. They are like the nine lepers who never returned to give God glory. God ministers to His children through testimonies too. Keeping quiet about what God has done for you is depriving someone of God's ministration and not being appreciative. In Luke 17:19, Jesus asked where the other nine lepers were because He knew for certain they were also healed and expected them to have come and glorify God like the one did. Do not be silent about your testimonies. Share with your household, friends, and the brethren. Be a source of God's ministration to others.

Declaration

I do not keep quiet about my miracle. I do not keep quiet about my divine experience. I shout it out loud to the hearing of all that my God may be glorified.

THURSDAY MAY 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TESTIMONIES – THEY ARE EVIDENCE

Luke 5:14 *“And he charged him to tell no man: but go, and shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.”*

Testimonies are given as evidence to what God has done. There are so many things the Father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit did and have been recorded in the Bible. We would not have known these things if they had not been recorded. The chief priest would not have known that a man with leprosy which was an incurable disease at the time could be healed if he had not gone to show himself to him. His healing was to be a testimony of God's great power to them. Testimonies reveal what God is willing and ready to do. God is no respecter of persons (Acts 10:34). If He has done it before, He can do it again under the same circumstances. Thus, when listening to testimonies, be excited knowing that God is willing to do the same thing you are hearing in your life and position yourself for it. Testimonies also reveal what God can do. When a testimony is being shared, it is God informing you of what He can do in your life. Having understood this, your celebration of a brother or sister's testimony will be meaningful.

Celebration

Wow! How exciting it is to know that my God is willing and able to meet my expectation. If He did it before, He will do it again. This is why I clap my hands. This is why I shout. My God is too much!

FRIDAY MAY 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TESTIMONIES – THEY INSPIRE FAITH

John 20:31 ***“But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.”***

Testimonies are given to inspire faith in God. They enable us to believe God to do the same thing in our lives and His ability to meet our expectations. Every testimony of God’s working should inspire something in you. For example, if someone shares a testimony about how he came to church with a headache and received his healing as the Word was being ministered or as songs were being sang in worship to God, it should inspire you to come to church no matter how you feel because you know you will receive relief in the course of the service. Jesus did so many things in the presence of His disciples that were not written. However, those that were written were written so that when you read, you will believe (John 20:30-31). Do not have an attitude that frowns on testimonies or think that they are a waste of time. Testimonies are a serious part of God’s ministration to you. Do not trivialize testimonies. Learn to draw nuggets of spiritual nutrients from them.

Affirmation

I position myself to be inspired by every testimony I hear. When I hear, I believe and when I believe I will see same in my life. Hallelujah.

SATURDAY MAY 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TESTIMONIES – A LEARNING GROUND

1 Samuel 17:35 *“And I went out after him, and smote him, and delivered it out of his mouth: and when he arose against me, I caught him by his beard, and smote him, and slew him.”*

Testimonies reveal practical steps that you can use to receive the same ministration. What did the person do for that divine experience or miracle to happen? Do not only look at how God works when a testimony is being shared, also pay attention to how the testifier positioned himself to receive that testimony. Open your heart when a testimony is being shared because that period is a critical moment when God wants to minister the same thing to you or what you are expecting. David when he was looking for deliverance from the Philistines testified of a deliverance from a lion and a bear (1 Samuel 17:34-37). He likened his sheep to the Israelites and Goliath to the bear and the lion. By this, he positioned himself for God to do the same thing he enabled him to do, to the bear and the lion, to Goliath and he killed him. Glory to God! As a testifier, you must be conscious of the fact that you are transmitting divine substance and minister accordingly. The more you celebrate your testimonies the more of them you will have.

Ezra 7:10 *“For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it...”*

If you do not mature, there are some things in the kingdom you cannot enjoy and certain responsibilities that cannot be handed to you. Prompt response to divine instructions is the key to rapid maturity. WEDNESDAY MAY 25

Topic: LOOK OUT FOR DIVINE INSTRUCTIONS

Isaiah 30:21 ***"And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand and when ye turn to the left."***

The right positioning and attitude for anyone desirous to mature is to be on the lookout for divine instructions. God is always speaking and giving instructions but only the one who is well positioned and on the lookout for them will hear and respond to them. God can speak to you directly when you are reading the Word or in prayer. The instructions may come during times of meditation. They may come in church when your pastor is ministering the Word. If you are not alert, you will miss out on them. Some miss out on instructions because when the pastor is preaching, they listen and, in their minds, assign the message to others. When you don't spend time in personal prayer, fellowship, and study of the word, you will certainly not hear divine instructions. Even in your daily activities like cooking, working, etc., God speaks but it is the one who is in tune with God and on the look out for instructions that will receive them. Have a notebook (either physical or digital) always with you to quickly put down divine instructions because your Father is always speaking.

Topic: ACT IMMEDIATELY

Psalm 119:60 (CEV) ***"As soon as you command, I do what you say."***

How fast a child of God will mature depends much more on him than on God. Many people delay or prolong their maturity because they procrastinate in responding urgently to divine instructions. The quality of your life cannot be above the divine instructions you hear and act on. The Father will not allow you to skip steps in your journey of maturity therefore no matter how "small" an instruction may seem respond to it immediately. John 4:35 says "Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, lift up your eyes, and look on the fields for they are white already to harvest.". Do not be careless about your maturity because of procrastination. The longer you delay the more likely you are, not to act on it. You will continue to give excuses until sometimes it's too late. Psalm 119:103 (NIV) ***“How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!”***

The truth is that the voice of God is not a burden but a joy. There is no instruction from God that can ever be to your disadvantage. YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN
