FRIDAY JULY 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO BE SILENT

Habakkuk 2:20 ***“But the Lord is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.***

Today's topic sounds very interesting but it is important to know the right way to put God's Word to work so that you can maximize its impact in your life. Like with many things, you must grow from one stage to another. To be silent before God is simply to be quiet before Him, focused on Him in your thoughts with no distractions, either internal or external. If you however are now learning this art of silence, you could easily drift off to sleep. You can begin practicing silence in your times of fellowship by speaking or singing undertone words of love and worship to God while listening for His response. As you keep doing this you can move higher to another level where words do not necessarily come out of your mouth but your thoughts are filled with these words or songs of worship to God. You can be so in tune with the Father that you maybe in a service and it feels like it is just you and God. As you progress your silence alone is an act of worship as your spirit communes with God. There may be no words or thought but the reality of your fellowship with divinity is undeniable.

Worship

Spend 15 minutes practicing silence as we've learned depending on your level.

SATURDAY JULY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEVELOPING THE DISCIPLINE OF SILENCE

Exodus 34:2-3 ***"And be ready in the morning, and come up unto mount Sinai, and present thyself there to me in the top of the mount. And no man shall come up with thee..."***

The Word of God which is yours is the one which you have to put to work. It is important to develop the discipline of silence so that you can make the most of its benefits to your walk in Christ. Start by separating yourself daily to be alone and quiet. It may be 10 minutes a day but go ahead and start. In those times be sure you are not distracted by your phone, or anything else. These are special and intense moments of refinement. The more you practice this the easier it will be for you to "tune in" to God even if you are in a marketplace and be able to pick up signals from him. These times of silence are not times to pour out prayer requests to God, they are times to just be there with God (Exodus 24:12). When God alone can occupy your attention for long periods of time without any distraction, then you can say that God is your all.

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Set aside 30 minutes today to practice being silent before God as you worship or wait on Him. You'll certainly have a testimony

MONDAY JULY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD

1 John 5:7 (AMPC) ***“So there are three witnesses in heaven: the Father, the Word and the Holy Spirit and these three are One.”***

The Holy Spirit is God. He is the third divine personality predominantly at work on the earth now. Many people have a challenge recognizing Him as such. Our scripture today tells us that the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit are one. That He is the third divine personality does not make Him less than the Father or the Son. In the Old Testament God (the Father) was predominantly seen to be at work. When the Word became flesh, the Word (Jesus) was the predominant personality through whom divinity was at work. When Jesus was leaving, He stated in John 14:16 that the Father would send another Comforter. The Greek rendering of *another* here is *allos parakletos*, one of the same kind. Jesus told us that the Holy Spirit who was to come is divine. Because of His nature as a spirit personality and the many things that have been used to symbolize His manner of operating such as wind, water, fire, oil, etc., many have not fully recognized His divinity. The Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:3-4).

Worship

Wonderful Holy Spirit, I recognize You as God, because that is who You are. You are worthy of my honour, adoration, and praise. I love You.

TUESDAY JULY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE HOLY SPIRIT IS A SPIRIT PERSONALITY

John 16:13 *"Howbeit, when he the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come"*

Contrary to the perception of many who think the Holy Spirit is an impersonal force, the "presence of God", a wind or a dove, the Holy Spirit is none of these. He is a real person and is described several times in the scriptures using personal pronouns as in our scripture above. Being spirit in nature has made it difficult for some to relate with Him as a person. For the born again however, it should not be so (1Corinthians 2:10). The Bible tells us that "the world cannot receive, because it sees Him nor knows Him, but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you" John14:17 (NKJV). The Holy Spirit teaches (John 14:26), He leads (Romans 8:14), He guides (John 16:13). He has emotions that can be grieved (Ephesians 4:30), He can be lied to (Acts 5:3). The Holy Spirit is real, and you can always enjoy a sweet fellowship with Him because He is a person.

Thanksgiving

Wow thank You Father for this insight into the reality of the Holy Spirit being a person. From today, my fellowship has moved to a higher level of reality in Jesus' name.

WEDNESDAY JULY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE HOLY SPIRIT- THE CREATOR

Job 33:4 *“The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life”*

The first chapter of the book of Genesis shows us clearly that the Holy Spirit was present and involved during creation (Genesis 1:2). In Job 26:13 we see that “by his spirit he hath garnished the heavens; his hand hath formed the crooked serpent”. The Holy Spirit was actively involved in decorating the heavens. Being God, He is creator. Not only in the creation of the world but also in the creation of man. In our opening scripture today, Job testifies that the Spirit of God made him, indicating that He was involved in the work of creating mankind. In Genesis 2:7, we are told that “the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground...”. The expression “Lord God” is Jehovah Elohim, which is the description of the only true God in a plural nature. Thus, it was not just God the Father but the Godhead of the Father, Word and Spirit that formed man. It was by Him that life was imparted to man (Psalm 104:29-30, Acts 17:24-25, Job 33:4).

Prayer

Father, I pray that the reality of the divinity of the Holy Spirit will dawn on the hearts of all in the body of Christ today in Jesus' name.

THURSDAY JULY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE HOLY SPIRIT IS YOUR FATHER

Titus 3:5 *“Not by works of righteousness which we have done but according to his mercy he saved us by the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost.”*

The Holy Spirit is the father of the born again. According to John 1:12-13, believing on Jesus gives you the right to become a child of God- one born of God. Jesus is the one who authorizes the new birth of anyone who receives Him. The process of being born again involves the removal of the old human life and supplanting it with the life of God (eternal life) in your spirit. Titus 3:5 describes this as the ‘washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost’. The Holy Spirit carries out this process, so indeed He is your father if you are born again. 1Corinthians 12:13 tells us that it is by the Holy Spirit that we are baptized into the body of Christ. Ephesians 1:13 emphasizes this by letting us know that it is the Holy Spirit that authenticates the new birth. He is the real father of the born again, not only because he gave birth to us but because he fathers us as well (John 14:16-17, AMPC).

Thanksgiving

I am excited to know that the Holy Spirit is my real Father. With Daddy Holy Spirit, I am never alone. I am confident because I have a father.

FRIDAY JULY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE HOLY SPIRIT, THE FATHER OF THE CHURCH

John 14:16 *“And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever.”*

Understanding that the Holy Spirit is the Father of the church will set the body of Christ on the right course to glorifying Jesus. Jesus declared concerning the Holy Spirit in John 16:14 that “he shall glorify me for he shall receive of mine, and shall show it unto you”. The disciples though they had walked with Jesus were not born again until the day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit came on the earth and filled the upper room where they were seated, and after that filled each of them. That was the day the Jewish church was birthed (Acts 11:15). In a similar manner the Gentile church was born in Cornelius’ house (Acts 10:43-47, 11:17-18). The Holy Spirit is not only the Father of the church because He gave birth to it but also because He fathers the church. Jesus, before He ascended told the disciples that he would not leave them comfortless. The expression in Greek for comfortless is *“orphanos”* i.e. orphans. He would not leave them as orphans, ones without a father. So the Holy Spirit has a fathering ministry to the body of Christ (John 14:16-17, AMPC). At every stage of the growth of the church He leads us as a Father does his children (Romans 8:14).

Prayer

Father, I pray for the church worldwide that the reality of the Holy Spirit will dawn on us like never before and that the Holy Spirit will be restored to His rightful place in the church in Jesus’ name.

SATURDAY JULY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WALKING WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

2 Corinthians 6:16 ***"...as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God and they shall be my people."***

The Father's ultimate for all His children is a walk with the Holy Spirit. That is why He is in us. Many of God's children have limited their relationship with the Holy Spirit to speaking in tongues and enjoying occasional "supernatural encounters" with Him. It is however impossible to achieve the full measure of what God has for you or live a purposeful life if you are not walking with the Holy Spirit. The first step to walking with Him is to recognize Him as your real father. Do it not just because you have heard or read about His fatherhood but as an individual who personally recognizes that being born again, the Holy Spirit has become your real father. Fellowshiping consistently with Him will be the next step you will take. Just like you have conversations with your father of the flesh, talk to Daddy Holy Spirit, ask Him all the questions you have and He is ever ready to answer you because He desires this walk with you more than you could ever think.

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY JULY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IF ANY MAN BE IN CHRIST

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new”***

2Corinthians 5:17 is one verse of scripture that has been so frequently quoted yet so least explained. Note that it begins with a condition – if any man be in Christ. So, to claim the next part you must fulfil the condition. What does it mean to be in Christ? It literally means to be brought into Christ and refers to the process by which a sinner (outside Christ) is brought into Christ. Scripturally, this is talking about how the Holy Spirit, baptizes the person who receives the gospel into Christ (1Corinthians 12:13; Galatians 3:27). Thus, to be in Christ is to be brought into that divine environment of the body of Christ because your belief in the resurrection of Christ has made you righteous and your confession of His Lordship has rescued you from Satan’s authority (Romans 10:9-10; Colossians 1:13). This is what it means to be in Christ, not to be born into a Christian home or just to be part of a church.

Thanksgiving

Father, I am so grateful that having believed with all my heart that you raised Christ from the dead, and confessed Him as Lord of my life, I was brought into Christ. Glory, I am in Christ.

TUESDAY JULY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HE IS A NEW CREATURE

2 Corinthians 5:17 (MNT) ***“So there is a new creation when any man is in Christ. The old life has passed away, behold, the new is come”***

He is a new creature, is the first result of the condition, “if any man be in Christ”. Again, let’s look at what that means. It means that when that human being is spiritually baptized into Christ through the gospel by the Holy Spirit as said in John 3:5; a being different from the first, results. The Montgomery’s New Testament renders it clearer by saying “... there is a new creation when any man is in Christ...” So, watch this: A man gets into Christ, and not the same man appears again. “Something else” emerges that was so strange that human words were not enough to describe, so they called this being, a new creature. Note that when he was coming into Christ, the scriptures were clear that it was a man (a human being). After he got into Christ, the scriptural name changed to a new creature. Now, let it soak today, that when any man be in Christ, it’s not a transformed man that emerges but a being called a new creature.

Confession

Wow, thank you Father, that when the human being I was, got into Christ, I emerged as a new creature. Glory, I am the new creature in Christ the Bible talks about. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY JULY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: OLD THINGS ARE PASSED AWAY

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new”.***

Don't forget the dramatic scenario. A human being gets into Christ, and suddenly a being appears that's not a human again but a new creature. What happened? We are told that old things are passed away. Now, there are many Christians who wrongly think that the old things refer to features of the sinful life like fornication, drunkenness etc. So when they say they are born again, they mean they have stopped one sinful act or the other. No! That's not what this verse talks about (its results include disappearance of sinful acts). Reading from the TCNT version, 2Corinthians 5:17 reads, “Therefore, if anyone is in union with Christ, he is a new being! His old life has passed away; a new life has begun!” So, it is the old life in the spirit of the man that came into Christ, that passed away and a new began. Scriptures clearly prove that this new life is the life of Christ (the Word) – Colossians 3:4. Wow, are you there?

Confession

Wow, when the old human that I was, got into Christ, that old human life passed away and a new life came into being. Christ is this my life. Hallelujah! I can only shout Glory!

THURSDAY JULY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ALL THINGS ARE BECOME NEW

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new”***

Remember that a human being gets into Christ, and a new creature emerges. We learnt that this happened because the life in that human passed away and a new life came into being. All things are become new, means that it is a new being with a new kind of life. To understand what these new things are, let's find out their source. Verse 18 begins with “And all things are of God ...” So, concluding verse 17 into 18 will read “...all things are become new, and all things are of God ...” So, the new things came from God. Since we know it is a new life, we are definite that it is God's life. Hmm! I want to shout here. Wow! This life was brought into being through the Word (gospel) which the human being received. Hence James 1:18 succinctly says God willingly brought forth the new creation through the Word of truth which is the gospel of Christ (Ephesians 1:13). The life of the new creature is God's life imparted through the Word.

Confession

As the new creature in Christ, I now fully understand that my life is God's life which came into being when He gave birth to me through the gospel. Now I am ready to live in Jesus' name

FRIDAY JULY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHO IS THIS NEW CREATURE?

Galatians 2:20 (MNT) ***"I have been crucified with Christ, so it is no longer I who am living, but it is Christ who is living in me; and the life I am now living in the flesh, I am living in faith of the Son of God who loved me and gave himself up for me"***

We have understood that when the human being got into Christ through the gospel, his life passed away. A new life from God came into existence and the new being is now called a new creature. Our verse today, is a further explanation. The human life passed away in a spiritual crucifixion when he was identified with Christ in baptism (not water baptism) – 1Corinthians 12:13. Hence the human being ceased living. But a certain life continues in the same body. We are told without apologies that "IT IS CHRIST WHO IS LIVING IN ME". Oh, now I know why he is called a new creature. When he is coming you see a human body with one head, two eyes, two legs etc., yet right within his spirit is JESUS CHRIST. Heeeeish! That's the new creature, the life of God perambulating in a physical body. This is the mystery of God in the new birth that the Church must grasp to function in our place of glory in life.

Confession

It is Christ who is living in me. I am no longer the human my mother gave birth to. It is Christ living in me. I am a new creature - The life of God in a physical body. Oh Hallelujah!

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new”***

“Are they now equating themselves to God? They’re propounding the God class heresy!” goes the religious person. We are just speaking and living out what has clearly been written in the scriptures. Luke 12:15 *“And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man’s life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.”*

Many people keep wondering what life is all about. Some regret ever being born. They never seem to have a moment of respite from challenges, and some have even developed theories like “life is full of ups and downs”. Proverbs 4:18 however testifies otherwise. They keep searching for that one thing that can make life meaningful, enjoyable and worth living. WEDNESDAY JULY 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THAT ONE THING

John 16:13 *“Howbeit when he the Spirit of truth is come, he will guide you into all truth for he shall not speak of himself; But whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come”*

The one thing that can make life meaningful, enjoyable, and worth living is not a thing, He is a person. He is the Holy Spirit. The reality of the presence of the Holy Spirit in you is the answer to this question on the real treasure of life that has been asked so many times. As one who is born again you are sealed with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13) and inseparably one with Him (1Corinthians 12:13, 1Corinthians 6:17). Knowing that you are one with the Holy Spirit is different from being awakened to the reality of His presence in you. The day you step into this reality and His fatherhood dawns on you and His Deity grips your heart, you begin to walk hand in hand with Him and you will testify that this is that one thing; the real treasure of life. A walk with the Holy Spirit makes you His expression on earth. You do not look for security, health, wealth, blessings. You are the expression of all these. This is your reality.

Isaiah 34:16 (NLT) *“Search the book of the LORD, and see what he will do. Not one of these birds and animals will be missing, and none will lack a mate, for the Lord has promised this. His Spirit will make it all come true”*

2 Corinthians 5:21 ***“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”***
