MONDAY AUGUST 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR RIGHTS IN CHRIST

1 Peter 1:3 (NLT) ***“All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation”***

Dear child of God, do you know your rights in Christ? The Christian lives on earth as an ambassador of the heavenly kingdom but unfortunately, many are either ignorant of their rights or have allowed the devil through his tricks to prevent them from enjoying them. They focus more on the “rights” this earth affords them and get frustrated when they do not seem to be enjoying life as they should. Matthew 6:33 tells us to seek first the kingdom of God and all other things shall be added unto us. Our opening scripture explicitly states that we have all things we need to live a godly life. So, we must spiritually educate ourselves to lay hold on these heavenly rights because any rights you enjoy on earth here which do not emanate from the word of God are but fleeting. This week we will remind ourselves of some of these rights we have in Christ.

Thanksgiving

Glory to God! I am born again and a child of the monarch of the universe. I have all things that pertain to life and godliness, and I take my place to enjoy it fully in Jesus’ name.

TUESDAY AUGUST 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE RIGHT TO ENJOY INTIMACY WITH THE FATHER

Ephesians 1: 4 (WNT) “*...even as, in His love, He chose us as His own in Christ before the creation of the world, that we might be holy and without blemish in His presence.*”

The first right we will look at is the right to enjoy intimacy with the Father. For some people. God is so holy and so awesome that relating with Him as a father seems unreal. To others it is only certain kinds of Christians such as pastors, who should have such close relations with God. This is untrue because our opening scripture clarifies the reason why God chose mankind in Christ - it is to live in his presence. Now that you are in Christ, it is your right to enjoy intimacy with the Father. The Father so desired this that in the process of you becoming his child, you were made inseparably one with the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 12:13, 6:17). Do not let the distractions or cares of work, school, family, business etc., prevent you from enjoying this right. This is actually the key to unlocking and enjoying the full package of the good life in Christ. Give attention to daily fellowship with the Father. It is your right!

Fellowship

Spend 10 to 15 minutes communing with God. Not bringing any requests to Him but just enjoy the right of being His child.

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE RIGHT TO JOY

Romans 14 :17 ***“For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost”***

Are you in the kingdom of God? Then according to our opening verse, joy is your right. The world has seen challenging times and will continue to face even more as this age draws to an end according to God’s Word because of its fallen state. There may never be the “perfect conditions” for anything, but for you the child of God, the Word says joy is your right. Refuse to be anxious about anything. Jesus tells us to be of good cheer because He has overcome the world (John 16:33). Do not let physical circumstances or challenges bring you down. Do not give room to sadness and depression. Even in the most challenging of situations, James 1:2 tells us to count it all joy. The joy of the Lord is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10), and a cheerful heart doeth good like medicine (Proverbs 17:22). Stir up the divine files of joy in you even when you hear seemingly bad news and be always joyful in hope (Romans 12:12).

THURSDAY AUGUST 4

Topic: THE RIGHT TO DIVINE GUIDANCE

Psalm 32: 8 ***“I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: will guide thee with mine eye”***

There is no need to be confused in life, neither should you be worried about making the wrong decision. The born again has a right to be divinely guided in life. The greatest advantage we have as people of God is our oneness with the Holy Spirit. He knows all things and searches the deep things of God (1 Corinthians 2:10). Jesus said before leaving the earth that He would guide us into all truth (John 16:13). And so, whether you are a babe in Christ, unsure of a step to take or mature and needing to decide between good and the best the Holy Spirit is your sure guide. All you have to do is to be consistent in your fellowship with Him and it will be so easy to recognize His voice in the Word or in other circumstances of life. One trick the devil uses to distract Christians is the ignorance of thinking they lack something and then drive them to toil in the flesh for that which was already theirs. They sometimes think that without the help of man they cannot make it in life. Many sons of God have been swayed by “the need to be rich” when in fact the scriptures have told us that all things are ours. SATURDAY AUGUST 6

Topic: THE RIGHT TO VICTORY

1 John 5:4 *“For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.”*

There will always be one challenge or the other on this earth to overcome whether you are born again or not. But the born again is not the underdog. Victory is your right because it came with the salvation package to all mankind. Our opening verse tells us that so far as you are born of God you have overcome the world. TUESDAY AUGUST 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MINISTERING TO THE LORD

Acts 13:2 *“As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.”*

The privilege of enjoying intimacy with our Father is two sided because in enjoying fellowship with Him, it is also our responsibility to minister to Him. The understanding that our Father is God must dawn on everyone who is born again. There is only one God and all of creation just by existence testifies to this truth (Psalm 19:1). This is your nature which you express in every avenue of life. Your primary work is to make other sons of God out of men. This is why you are still here on earth, and it is a responsibility you must carry out diligently. Some think this work of making sons is only for the evangelists. Others see it as secondary to their secular jobs. 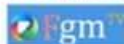

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WEEK OF PRAYER – THANKSGIVING

Ephesians 5:20 ***“Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;”***

The year 2022 is halfway through and with united hearts, it is right that we thank God our Father for all things as the scripture today enjoins us. One of the primary modes by which God functions on earth is through stewardship. He makes people stewards of His heavenly treasures so that they can bring them forth on earth on His behalf. It is important that every child of God understands the subject of stewardship to be relevant to God. From the scripture above, dominion over the earth and all that existed in it was entrusted to man making him a steward of God’s rule on earth. Generally, a steward is one who has the privilege and responsibility of managing something on behalf of another. He has been entrusted with the duty of taking care of, protecting, and putting to appropriate or beneficial use, that which has been entrusted to him according to the master’s will. In the Kingdom of God, a steward functions on behalf of God. He has authority over that which has been entrusted to him, but this authority is subject to God’s overarching authority. (Luke 12:42-43, Acts 20:28, Genesis 1:26, 2:17).

Topic: THE SERVANTHOOD IN STEWARDSHIP

Romans 1:1(NKJV) *“Paul, a bond-servant of Christ Jesus, called as an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God,”*

Stewardship in the Kingdom is a free will service, not a service done under compulsion. Once you yield your will wholly to God, you have no will and live as a bondservant though you are technically not one. This is the difference between the servanthood of stewardship in the Kingdom and that in the world. Paul described himself as a bondservant of Christ (Romans 1:1). He became a bond servant by counting everything as a loss for Christ. He readily let go of everything that gave him value or importance in the sight of man and described them as dung that he may win Christ (Philippians 3:7-8). A steward of God does not argue with Him. What God wants is what he does.

Topic: EXAMPLES OF STEWARDS IN THE BIBLE

1 Corinthians 4:1 ***“Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.”***

The subject of stewardship is detailed in the scriptures. There are examples of stewards who were entrusted with heavenly treasures and mysteries to be displayed on earth. Some succeeded in this role, while others failed. This reveals the importance of succeeding in your stewardship. Adam was made the first custodian of the whole earth (Gen 1:25-28). He was to be lord over the earth under the Lord God but failed as this task when He disobeyed God. The result was the introduction of sin into the world (Romans 5:12) and the condemnation of mankind to death. Noah was also made a steward of the whole earth including human life after Adam. Topic: FEATURES OF GOOD STEWARDSHIP

Colossians 3:23 *“And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;”*

It is important to know the features of good stewardship, so that you can carry out your God given assignment in the best possible way. Good stewardship involves working for or unto the Lord. In the parable Jesus told in Luke 12:42, the household is the Lord's the work being given to the steward is a work for the Lord. What have you been made a steward over? Are you handling it as yours instead of the Lord's? All that you have: your body, spouse, children, house, business etc. have been given to you by the Lord (2Peter 1:3). It is His to give. You are thus a steward of these things and must use it for or unto the Lord (Romans 14:8, Colossians 3:23). Again, a good steward is mindful of the Lord's return (Luke 12:43). How are you taking care of that which has been entrusted into your care by the Lord? Every good steward works for the Lord because he loves Him and thus works, expecting His return (2 Thessalonians 3:5). Thirdly, a good steward is aware that there is accountability at the end of his work (Romans 14:12, Matthew 25:20-25).

Topic: FEATURES OF BAD STEWARDSHIP

Luke 12:45 ***“But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken;”***

It is important to know some features of bad stewardship to avoid them. Firstly, a bad steward works for self-satisfaction. The servant described above is an example of a bad steward. God has given life to people, to live on earth but many are living unto themselves- eating, drinking and getting drunk (Luke 12:19-20), not caring about the Master’s will. Secondly, a bad steward is identified as one who is not mindful of the Lord’s return. Again, the servant described in the scripture above mishandled what was given to him because he was not mindful of the return of the master. There are glaring signs in the world showing that the Lord’s coming is nearer than ever, but some Christians are living not conscious of this. Like the servant, they are mishandling what has been given them and are living unto themselves. Thirdly, a bad steward forgets accountability and thus misuses or abuses that which has been entrusted in his care. A bad steward abuses resources and does not care to produce profit (Matthew 25:24-25).

Topic: QUALITIES OF A GOOD STEWARD

Luke 12:43 *"Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing."*

Three important qualities a good steward demonstrates are occupation, faithfulness, and profitability. A good steward occupies (Luke 19:13, 12:43). To occupy is to work or be engaged or do business to produce a result. The occupation requires that the steward be diligent, hardworking, and willing to take steps of faith to bring the profit required. A good steward is faithful (Luke 12:42; 1Corinthians 4:2). Faithfulness comes from a strong conviction about the calling and reverential fear and love for God who called you. Paul was deeply convinced about the stewardship given him and this showed in the way he fulfilled it (Ephesians 3:1-2, 2Timothy 4:7). Faithfulness also comes with persistence. No matter how long it takes, you must be committed to the same truth to the end. Paul preached daily for two years in Ephesus (Acts 19:9-10) and had the results we are quick to talk about in Acts 19:11-20. A good steward is profitable. In stewardship there must be a profitability the master will see so you can be duly rewarded and entrusted with more (Matthew 25: 20-21, 28, Luke 12:44).
