1 Timothy 3:15 "*But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.*"

By the grace of God, we are starting a two-part series of teachings entitled "In the House of God", in which the Lord has planned to direct our attention to our lives in His house in a way that will mature and make us profitable sons and daughters in this life. As in all other fields of the Christian life, the Bible has righteous instructions for us on how we ought to conduct ourselves in His family. The house of God is much more than a church building. It is the household of God's family, beyond the four walls of a church building (Ephesians 2:19). This household of God comprises all who have become sons of God in Christ by the divine birth (John 1:12-13). That includes all sons of God who have passed into heaven and those of us who are physically alive here (Ephesians 3:15). That means everyone in any denomination, any local assembly of the body of Christ on earth, is part of this house of God. This is called the Church or body of Christ. So, you can see that the subject of "In the house of God" is quite broad but in the following days we will focus on what Daddy wants us to deal with at this time. Are you excited? Get excited because it is time for family matters.

## **TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 6**

### **GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

#### **Topic: THERE ARE STRUCTURAL ORDERS**

1 Corinthians 14:33 *"For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints."*

It is heartbreaking to realize that the house of God on earth that should be the most organized and orderly institution is rather ravaged with so much disorder and schisms due to immaturity, carnality, and penetration of falsehood. But the truth remains that God has structural orders in His house and those who are truly His, love to know them and function accordingly (2 Timothy 2:19, Matthew 13:24-30,37). The scriptures teach clearly that the house God has the structural orders of relationships and functions. In terms of relationship, Jesus Christ, the king of the kingdom of heaven is the head of the church which is His body (Ephesians 1:20-23). He appointed gifts (shepherds) through the Holy Spirit to rest of the body (Ephesians 4:11, Acts 20:28) which forms the broad-based interconnection of the body (Ephesians 4:16). In terms of function, Jesus by the Holy Spirit equips the shepherds with teachings, understanding, graces and gifts to equip the rest of the body to minister in an interdependent union to each other (John 1:33, Ephesians 4:11-16, 1 Peter 4:10)

Oh heavenly Father, how marvelous are Thy ways and Thy works. We worship You for the amazing wisdom displayed in the structural orders of relationships and function instituted in the church that is bringing us into the fullness of Your glory in Christ.

**WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 7**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: SHEPHERDING IS DIVINE**

Acts 20:28 *"Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood."*

One of the hard truths especially for today's postmodern and secularly educated Christians is that though there are many avenues to Christian teachings and ministrations, there can be no authentic Christianity without a shepherd (1Corinthians 4:15). For yourself, you must understand that the omniscient God who is your Father, instituted shepherding in His house (Jeremiah 3:15; Ephesians 4:11-12). It is not something you can outgrow because of your gifts, wealth, education, or the type of work you do. In our main verse for today, the people did not choose to be shepherds but the Holy Ghost Himself made them overseers of His flock. Are you a flock of Christ? Show me your shepherd! For all those to whom Christ is Lord, He gave them gifts to perfect them until they come to full spiritual stature (Ephesians 4:11-13). If you cannot show me your shepherd, then all is not well with you in the house of God! No matter what reasons you give for not having a shepherd, the bottom line remains that in the house of God, you are not in order, and this is which is anti-scriptural (1Corinthians 14:40).

**Intercession**

Pray for yourself (where necessary) and others that, "by the special ministry of the Holy Spirit, their hearts will be flooded with divine truth through these teachings concerning the real value of shepherding in God's house".

**THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 8**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: YOU AND YOUR SHEPHERD**

Jeremiah 3:15 "*and I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.*"

Now that you have understood shepherding as a non-negotiable divine institution in God's house, you must appreciate the spirituality of that relationship. It is in the fact that it is God who gives you a shepherd. A shepherd is not someone you just follow on television or social media sites like Facebook or YouTube. A shepherd is one that the Holy Spirit bears witness with your spirit that he or she was sent into your life to feed you with wisdom and knowledge to equip, mature, guide, guard and present you blameless before Christ (Jeremiah 3:15, Hebrews 13:17, Colossians 1:28). There are no games to it. If you meet your shepherd, these will result in your life. Also, as the Lord cares for you through your shepherd, He has also instituted that you honour your shepherd in His house for his or her works sake (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13). You may be physically better placed in life than him or her but honour him or her highly because of his work as shepherd. According to the scriptures you do this by being "shepherdable" (Hebrews 13:17, John 10:4-5)

**Prayer**

Dear Holy Spirit, I receive Your direction in my heart to my real shepherd in life OR Thank You Holy Spirit, for blessing me with (mention your shepherd's name) as my shepherd.

## **FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 9**

### **GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

#### **Topic: YOU AND THE FLOCK**

Acts 20:28 *"Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood."*

The instruction of God to shepherds in the house of God, begins first with ensuring that you have not made yourself a shepherd in God's house for one reason or the other. Those who make themselves shepherds and not God, can never avoid becoming hirelings no matter how genuine their beginning reasons were (John 10:1-2,9-13). Secondly, God clearly shows that as a shepherd you are a steward. The sheep are Christ's, and you are a caretaker (Acts 20:28, John 10:3-4). The sheep (flock) is not the caretaker of the shepherd, God who appoints the shepherds is their caretaker (Psalm 23:1-2). Thirdly, God's instruction to shepherds gives them their vision and job description (Ephesians 4:11-13, Jeremiah 3:15, Acts 20:28). Finally in this context, God warns all shepherds of the trust and accountability (Acts 20:28, Hebrews 13:17, James 3:1)

#### **Prayer**

Pray that having received this responsibility of being a shepherd of God's flock you will walk in the vision God has given you OR Pray for your shepherd for grace to fulfill his calling.

**SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 10**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**MEDITATE ON THESE THINGS**

1 Timothy 4:15 *“Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.”*

Before we go on to the second part of this series of teaching on “In the House of God”, take a break today to meditate on what we have learnt this week. Meditation is the spiritual digestive process that makes the life and spirit of God’s become part of you so that you can grow and mature (Acts 20:32). That is why when you meditate, your advancement in life will become apparent. People who take time to meditate on the Word of God that comes to them, are always ahead of those who don’t. Meditation simply means brooding, interrogating, imagining, and speaking forth the Word as it relates to your life and circumstances. For instance, concerning this week’s teaching, you can think through and ask yourself the following questions. Do I really now understand the place of shepherding in God’s house? How has this transformed my attitude towards it? Do I really have a shepherd according to the Bible’s definition? I am shepherdable to my shepherd according to the teaching? As you prayerfully ask yourself these questions, and genuinely allow the Spirit to give you personal responses, you’ll be amazed at the changes that will take place within you and the actions you will take after that. Try it.

## **MONDAY SEPTEMBER 12**

**1 Peter 2:5 “Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ”**

By the grace of God, we will continue to study the second part of our series of teachings entitled, “In the House of God” in which God is directing our attention to how we ought to conduct ourselves in His house, to be efficient members of His household. Realize that it takes an accurate discernment of the house God to properly relate with and in it. When the spirituality of the house of God is not clear to you, you are likely to step into the error of unconsciously perceiving and relating with it as another social group. As stated in our opening verse, the house of God is a spiritual house. The building blocks are the individual sons and daughters of God. Though individually connected to the Head (Jesus Christ) we form a very strong, interconnected, and interdependent network of living beings (1Corinthians 12:27; Ephesians 4:15-16). Learn through meditation to appreciate that you are strongly connected and interdependent on sons and daughters of God in other denominations and local assemblies of the body and let this transform your relationship, love, prayer, and value for them. This will make you more efficient in your fellowship with the Father, and ministry on the earth.

Dear Father, I receive divine insight to discern the spirituality and reality of Your house in the name of Jesus Christ.

**TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 13**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: RECOGNIZING THE FATHERS**

2 Peter 3:2 *“That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour”*

It is wise to recognize that every multi-generational venture always has a generation before and one after. The preceding generations form part of the foundation upon which the following ones stand. It is the same with the unfolding of God's plan on earth. Before the Apostle Peter could talk about his generation, he recognized the place of the holy prophets before them. In the house of God, His ministers in the outgoing generation, are referred to as the Fathers and they form the rich pool of grace for the following generation. **WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 14****GOOD LIFE DEVOTION****MINISTERING TO THE FATHERS**

1 Corinthians 12:26 *“And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it”*

The scriptures reveal that our interrelationships and interdependence in the house of God is such that the success or failure of one part is the success or failure of the whole body in a way. So, despite that the lesser is blessed of the greater (Hebrews 7:7), there is a place of the latter generation ministering to the former and it is mainly in the demonstration of love through prayer. At the level of the Fathers, there are some that may be regretting concerning things God told them, but they did not carry out, others may have challenges with finishing well and so on. But it should be our corporate goal that everyone in this divine household finishes well in the faith (2 Timothy 4:7). So, while we are busily receiving grace to establish the good works of our Father in our generation, we must consistently and wholeheartedly pray for the Fathers to finish well. Unlike Elisha who died with grace locked up in his bones, we must yearn to have them download every grace into us before they depart if they must before Jesus comes. I inspire you to personally commit to praying for your gift in Christ and all the Father figures in the faith that you know, and I have no doubt that you will also abound in grace.

**Intercession**

Dear Father, we pray for all the fathers of our faith that according to Your riches in Christ, they will be strengthened with might in inner being to finish their courses according to Your call on their lives, in the name of Jesus Christ.

**THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 15**

**GOOD LIFEDEVOTION**

**Topic: RELATING WITH OTHER MINISTERS**

Galatians 2:8 EASY, *“God gave Peter the authority to be his apostle to the Jews. God also gave me the authority to be his apostle to the Gentiles.”*

If you happen to have been given by Jesus as a gift to the body of Christ, it is important to discern the big picture of the Father and His kingdom. Every minister is given a certain level of the light of the scriptures and grace to bring to the rest of the body and the earth. By God's own choice, some have more light and grace than others as in the case of the talents (Matthew 25:15). These differences are not a measure of importance but rather the level of responsibility and accountability. Like the Apostle Paul, you must clearly appreciate the uniqueness of your light and grace and that of other ministers and relate healthily with them. Unhealthy comparisons with other ministers generate unhealthy competition, bitterness, and limitation of God's flow in one's (2Corinthians 10:12). The key to a scriptural inter-ministerial relationship is in the understanding that we are all of one Father in One Lord by One Spirit who calls each one uniquely according to His will (1 Corinthians 12:11)

**Prayer**

Dear Father, I stir up the wisdom of the Spirit in me, to relate healthily, in truth and in love with other ministers of the gospel of Christ in the name of Jesus Christ.



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
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
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


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**FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 16**

Genesis 1:1 ***"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth"***

You need to first believe that God exists, to think about who He is. The scriptures say, for a person to conceive that there is no God, is foolishness (Psalms 14:1). Having settled that there is God, we are told that we cannot find Him out by human research (Job 11:7) because God is spirit (John 4:24). That means to know God, He must reveal Himself to you. **Topic: WHO IS JESUS?**

John 1:14 *"And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth"*

Jesus is not a figment of human imagination like Santa Claus as some theorize. We just got to know that God is that self-existent person who created all things. The Hebrew Word for God in Genesis 1:1 is “elohiyim” which is the plural form “eloahh” which means Deity or God. This tells us that God-the self-existent one, exists in a plural form and the scriptures explain that to mean a plural oneness of the Father, the Word, and the Spirit (1John 5:7 KJV). John 1:1 further confirms the self-existence of God and the Word. This Word was received by a Jewess called Mary and through a supernatural work of the Holy Spirit, put on human flesh (Luke 1:35, John 1:14) and was divinely named Jesus (Luke 1:31). Born in a Jewish human family, history proves that He lived and confirms the things recorded in the Bible about Him. So, Jesus, is God the Word in human form also called the Son of God (Luke 1:32).

## **THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 29**

### **GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

#### **Topic: WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?**

John 15:26 *"But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:"*

The scriptures show that the Holy Spirit is one of the divine persons in the plural oneness of God (1John 5:7 KJV). He is described as the one proceeding or emanating from the Father to point to us the inseparable union of the divine persons in God (the Godhead). God is spirit. Therefore, the Father is spirit, the Word is spirit (John 6:63) and the Spirit is spirit. In terms of revelation to human understanding, God the Father has been revealed in figurative terms to people before. The Word (Jesus/the Son) dwelt in human form and was visible to humanity. The Spirit, however, has not been revealed in any physical form to human understanding yet He is eternally self-existent with the Father and the Word and was part of creation (Job 26:13). So, the Holy Spirit is God and the divine person predominantly at work on earth today after the ascension of Jesus. He is not an influence, a force, or a power but a divine person.

#### **Worship**

Dear Holy Spirit, You are the eternal God the Spirit. I worship and adore You for Your beauty, glory, and splendour in all of creation. Forever I will worship You in Jesus' name.

**FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 30**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: ONE OR THREE GODS?**

Mark 1:10-11 "*And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased*".

Some immature Christians and non-Christians often get confused as to whether Christians worship one or three Gods. The scriptures reveal that there is only One God (1Timothy 2:5) who exists as the Godhead of three distinct personalities in a perfect divine union (Genesis 1:1; 1John 5:7). The union is so perfect that you cannot easily separate the Father from the Son (John 10:30, John 17:21-22) nor the Son from the Spirit (John 14:10). This however, does not mean that God is one person that manifests himself in three forms as some erroneously teach. In our opening text, Jesus (the Word or the Son) was being baptized and the Spirit came one Him as separate person while the Father spoke from heaven as a separate person. So, Christians worship one God – the Godhead of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit.

**Prayer**

Father, I receive great insight by Your Spirit to fully appreciate Your nature as one God in three distinct personalities in the name of Jesus Christ.

## **YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN**

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
