TUESDAY OCTOBER 4

Topic: WISDOM IS A PERSON

1 Kings 4:29 “and God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore.”

It is important to have the right understanding of what wisdom is in order to maximize it. First of all, wisdom is a person. In our opening scripture, God gave Solomon wisdom. You can only give what you are and what you have. Just as God is love, God is wisdom. Proverbs 9:10 says “the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the Holy one is understanding”. To know or have wisdom, you must know and have God. Anything that presents itself as wisdom, minus God is no wisdom at all. 1Corinthians 1:30 affirms this truth, that Christ Jesus has been made wisdom unto us. According to Isaiah 11:2, the Holy Spirit is wisdom. So in order to have wisdom you must have God and this essentially begins by being in Christ. Outside of Christ there is no true wisdom.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 5

Topic: WISDOM IS A VIRTUE

James 1:5 *"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. "*

Wisdom is not only a person (God), it is also a divine virtue. It is the active or operational divine insight into realities of things and situations of life. In the day-to-day activities of life, many are sometimes stuck in a place where they know what they ought to do, but somehow are unable to take the steps or actions required. This often leads to missing divine timing and opportunities. You can speak to someone who knows what to do about a situation but somehow is not taking the necessary steps to get the desired results. It is a reflection of lack of wisdom. This is because as a virtue, wisdom is active and operational. Wisdom causes you to do. It is not theoretical, neither is it wishful thinking. It gives you the ability and drives you to walk in the insight it brings. This is the divine virtue that every child of God must walk in, to enjoy the realities of the life in Christ.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 6
GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: KINDS OF WISDOM - I

James 3:14-16 *"But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but it is earthly, sensual, and devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work"*

What the world calls wisdom is completely different from what true wisdom is. Our opening verse describes one kind of wisdom which is the wisdom of this world. It is earthly, sensual and devilish. Many in this age, equate wisdom to being cunning, or sly or smart. When they are able to cheat the system or through ungodly means attain strides in various fields or make some quick cash, they feel they are wise. Some sons and daughter of God, due to immaturity and lack of knowledge of the truth, sometimes seek to apply such kind of human or worldly principles in their marriages, businesses, parenting etc. This worldly wisdom is foolishness in God's sight (1Corinthians 3:19). Any child of God who runs his life by this kind of wisdom is only walking into destruction.

Thank You Father for this enlightenment on worldly wisdom. I refuse to govern my life by this kind of wisdom in Jesus' name.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: KINDS OF WISDOM -II

James 3:17 *“But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.”*

True wisdom is God's wisdom which our opening scripture so aptly describes. This wisdom comes from the spirit (it is divine) and it is in God. This wisdom puts you in the right place at the right time and causes you to say the right thing at the right time. Because it is of God, it usually does not make sense to people of the world and thus sons and daughters of God walking in divine wisdom are sometimes referred to as naïve. A truly wise person operates by the principles of God's Word and not what the world's educational, philosophical or economic principles teach (1 Corinthians 2:5, 13). Wisdom resides in God (Proverbs 8:22), thus anyone who wants to succeed at living a purposeful life must find himself in the wisdom of God. The good news for the born again is that you have access to this wisdom. Glory!

SATURDAY OCTOBER 8

Topic: DO NOT FORSAKE WISDOM

Proverbs 8: 11 *"For wisdom is better than rubies; And all the things that may be desired are not to be compared with her"*

Having learned over the past few days what wisdom is and the different kinds of wisdom there are, it is important for you not to forsake wisdom. True wisdom from God is the means by which you can have a really successful and meaningful life. Only by it can you exercise your kingly duties and decree justice as one born of God. Psalm 119:19 *“I am a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me”*

But when man disobeyed and was separated from God, he became a wanderer in the earth without divine guidance. The earthly systems went out of his control into the control of the devil. TUESDAY OCTOBER 11

Topic: GUIDANCE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

Hebrews 1:1 *"God, who in ancient days spoke to our ancestors in the prophets, at many different times and by various methods"*

Before the Old Testament was instituted, God guided people in various ways but the Old Testament brought some formality into how He guided men. In the Old Testament, God gave guidance to His people mainly through His prophets. And these prophets received from God by various methods at different times. For instance in Daniel 8:1, Prophet Daniel received the message in a vision but in Daniel 7:1 he received a message in a dream and visions. Also after Moses, God revealed His will to Joshua and the people through the priest by mediums like the Urim and Thummim (Numbers 27:21). In all this, we should remember that these people were God's people by the atonement of the blood of bulls and goats. They had imputed right standing but they were not born of God and could not understand spiritual things. Hence God used methods that appealed to the senses like dreams, vision, Urim etc.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GUIDANCE IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

Romans 8:14 *"For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God"*

In the New Testament, ratified in the blood of Jesus, sins are wiped out and the new creation comes into being. These new creations are God's sons and daughters. As sons and daughters of God, divine guidance is a different thing all together. The person without Christ is separated from God and confused but the born again is one with Christ and not a stranger to the will of God. He is actually one with God's Word which is His will. In the New Testament, the leadership of the Spirit is natural and differentiates us from the world. Romans 8:14 does not mean you become a son of God when the Spirit leads you because that happens when you receive Christ. What it means is that being led by the Spirit, differentiates God's sons from others in the world. Being one with God's Spirit (1Corinthians 6:17), our fellowship is so intense that we naturally move in God's will by the Spirit.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW GOD GUIDES BABES

Acts 10:17 *"Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made enquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate"*

God is sovereign and can choose to do things in any way He wants and so there are no hard and fast rules about how He can guide anyone. However, generally speaking, when people do not have clear understanding, like babes in Christ, he uses things that can appeal to their understanding. In Acts 10, the Word of God had not yet been put together like we have it today as the Bible. Peter never had clue that the gospel was for all people apart from the Jews and yet he was a pillar God wanted to use to communicate that truth. God had to use a vision of unclean animals and vessels three times to get his attention. Today, God still uses prophets, dreams, visions etc. to guide people when the direction is above one's present level of maturity so that he can appeal to our understanding. The early church in Acts was still immature and so God guided them these ways most of the time.

Prayer

Dear Lord, I am glad that even concerning things that I am yet to fully grasp, You have wonderful ways of causing me to walk in Your will in all things in Jesus' name.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GUIDANCE FOR THE MATURE

Hebrews 1:1 *"In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets; but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world"*

The highest revelation of God's will is His Word. Jesus the Son of God, is the Word of God made flesh. Though God communicated in time past by various means, His chosen method for our dispensation is His Son (the Word). For those who have a good grip of the Word of God and have learnt to live in their union with the Spirit, they know what to do by the Word. If there are any details that are not clear in the Word, the Spirit who walks, talks and lives through them causes them to know by the inward witness and they just walk on in right paths. At this level, it's like Jesus saying in John 8:28-29, "...When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things. ... for I do always those things that please him". It's a level where you're the living expression of God's will. This is so beautiful. Isn't it?

Daddy, I am so glad that being one with the Holy Spirit and having a great understanding in Your Word, my life is the expression of Your will in everything we do on earth in Jesus' name.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE PLACE OF FAITH IN GUIDANCE

Hebrews 11:8 “By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went”

Because this world is dominated by ungodly systems ruled by Satan and his evil agents, things are set against the will of God. Also, because mankind is flesh, they're sensual – controlled by what they see, hear, taste, feel or smell. Now that we are spirits by the new birth, we are no longer sensual. We walk in the spirit because we are alive in the spirit (Galatians 5:25). Especially when we have not grown to the point where we live in our union with the Spirit, certain directions from God may appear to be against natural ways of doing things. Without conviction in God's Word, one cannot be guided by God. So, remember that God's guidance may not always make sense to the natural so move by the evidence of the Word – faith. 



All the 40 different writers being moved by the same Holy Spirit, there can be no contradictions. When people do not understand the background, the audience, the dispensation, and the intention of God for an aspect of the Bible, they think there are contradictions. Without holding brief for the Bible, reading it with the right perspective clearly shows there aren't any contradictions. We are told the walls of Jericho were so tough and shut that none went out and none came in. The walls of Jericho were a great limitation to the progress of the Israelites until they fell. This experience of Joshua has become a Christian perspective that we call the Early Joshua Perspective. With this perspective, people always have huge walls limiting their marital, educational, financial or health progress. Most times these walls are thought to be caused by human enemies, curses or demons etc. Holders of this perspective are always praying for a “breakthrough” in life. At every stage in life, they need a “breakthrough” to advance to the next level. This kind of priming to God’s Word will deprive you of learning to use the keys of the word to open doors and enjoy life (Matthew 16:19). With this perspective, you are not begging God to do something new for you because everything you will ever need is already yours (2Peter 1:3; 1Corinthians 3:21-22) and you get them through the Word.
