TUESDAY DECEMBER 13**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION****Topic: THE KEY OF REPETITION**

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 *"And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: and thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates."*

One divine method which the Father uses in bringing up His sons and daughters is repetition. As powerful as repetition is, if you do not approach it properly it will affect your study of the Word because you may become over familiar with the Word. Our opening scripture shows us God's divine means of using repetition with the children of Israel. He asked them to not only have the Word in their heart, but to teach it to their children, talk about it in their homes, on their journeys, put them as symbols on their hand, faces and in their homes! The same Word in different forms and at different places so they could interact with it over and again. Don't be tired of hearing the Word of God again and again because repetition drives it deeper into you. Do not miss certain services because you think you have already heard what is going to be taught. Maximize the power of repetition.

Confession

Wow! I have been enlightened. I maximize the power of repetition and do not miss any opportunity to interact with God's Word.

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE PURPOSE OF REPETITION - I

Philippians 3:1 (CEV) *“Finally, my dear friends, be glad that you belong to the Lord. It doesn’t bother me to write the same things to you that I have written before. In fact, it is for your own good.”*

The Bible is not like any other book that has ever existed. It is the living word of God. It is alive (Hebrews 4:12). Though the words in it remain the same, like John 1:1 will always be “in the beginning was the Word”, every time you read it in reality with the Holy Spirit, you receive a fresh insight and fresh divine virtues are released into your spirit. Repeated interaction with the Word either in church or on your own firstly strengthens your basic foundations in the faith and your convictions of this life in Christ. It is the one who has deep roots in Christ that will not be shaken or moved when the winds of challenges blow. This is the purpose of repetition. Secondly repetition enhances your retention of the Word and improves your meditation on the Word. Through meditation our profiting (progress) in Christ appears to all and so like our opening scripture says to hear or receive the Word of God repeatedly is not burdensome but for your own good.

Affirmation

I joyfully receive the Word of God no matter how many times I may have heard it because it is for my own good.”

THURSDAY DECEMBER 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE PURPOSE OF REPETITION - II

Luke 8:18 (NLT) *“So pay attention to how you hear. To those who listen to my teaching, more understanding will be given. But for those who are not listening, even what they think they understand will be taken away from them.”*

One other important thing that repeated interaction or engagement with God's Word does, even if it is the same scripture, you are hearing or reading over and again is that it eliminates errors that have to do with transmission and perception. Our opening scripture clearly tells us to pay attention to how we hear. Sometimes the first time you hear a message preached you may have had a certain preformed mindset about the issue it is addressing or may even be thinking of someone you know who "needs" the message. But as you listen a second or third time, you realize it is meant just for you. You may even have missed some important aspects of it, possibly because you were distracted in one way or the other, but repetition eliminates those errors. Repetition also improves precision and the accuracy with which you communicate the Word. One clear example is how many have assumed that to be born again you must confess your sins and ask Jesus to be the Lord of your life when Romans 10:9 states that one must confess Jesus as Lord in order to be saved.

Declaration

I give myself to the repeated exposure of God's Word. By the Spirit, I am humble to receive every Word that comes to me with joy in Jesus' name.



FRIDAY DECEMBER 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MAXIMIZE REPETITION - I

Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) ***"For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart"***

Repetition when engaged properly can be maximized to enhance our walk in Christ. Acts 20:32 (NKJV) *“So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.”*

MONDAY DECEMBER 19

John 5:23 ***"That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him."***

So many people say, "I believe in God", and yet want to have nothing to do with Jesus. Some have even theorized that mentioning Jesus, brings division whiles God is universal. Some Christians in the name of "not being divisive" like to avoid using the name of Jesus. TUESDAY DECEMBER 20

John 5:22 ***"For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son."***

The place of Jesus in our relationship with God is more serious and non-negotiable than some have been deceived to think. The timeline of the world is broadly divided into BC (before Christ) and AD (after Christ). Before Jesus came, there was hope for everyone because whether Jew or Gentile, all were under sin (Romans 3:23). WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 21

Topic: JESUS, THE WAY TO GOD

John 14:6 *“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me”*

Humanity was confused with several religions saying one thing or the other and claiming to offer some relationship with a certain invisible being supposed to be God. But Jesus came to make it plain.
