TUESDAY MARCH 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR NEXT LEVEL

Philippians 3:12-13 ***“Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also, I am apprehended of Christ Jesus. [13] Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,”***

At the beginning of this year, the Lord revealed to us that the body of Christ has been ushered into a new season, a season of the dramatic greatness of the church. This is a new level with a corresponding grace. Take advantage of this and move to your next level. What is that next level that you so desire? Walking perpetually in health? WEDNESDAY MARCH 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CHALLENGE THE SITUATION

2 Kings 7:3-5 ***"And there were four leprous men at the entering in of the gate: and they said one to another, Why sit we here until we die? "If we say, We will enter into the city, then the famine is in the city, and we shall die there: and if we sit still here, we die also. Now therefore come, and let us fall unto the host of the Syrians: if they save us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall but die. [5] And they rose up in the twilight, to go unto the camp of the Syrians: and when they were come to the uttermost part of the camp of Syria, behold, there was no man there.***

How do you change your state to move to, and be stabilized in your next level? You must first challenge the situation. How do you think concerning your current state? Have you grown comfortable with it? Have you come to accept that this is how far you can go in that business, marriage, etc.? Have you settled for second or third place thinking that the best is out of your reach? The four lepers in our opening scripture asked themselves an important question in a time when there was famine in their city and yet the possibility to get food was at hand: why sit we here till we die? Rise up and take responsibility to change your state by challenging the situation you are facing right now. You hold the key to change. Don't wait on someone else. Challenge the situation as the first step to changing your state.

Declaration

I hold the key to changing my current state. I rise in the spirit and challenge my current situation. I can be and have the best and I am going in for it in Jesus' name.

THURSDAY MARCH 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ANALYZE THE SITUATION FOR CHANGE

2 Kings 7:4 ***"If we say, We will enter into the city, then the famine is in the city, and we shall die there: and if we sit still here, we die also. Now therefore come, and let us fall unto the host of the Syrians: if they save us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall but die."***

Looking again at the attitude of the four lepers in 2Kings 7, they analyzed the situation they found themselves in and took the next step. The next thing to do for change to happen, after you have challenged the situation is to analyze the situation for change. What some people do when they "analyze" a situation is to step into worry, fretting and anxiety. But that will never bring you a solution. You must analyze the situation for a change. If it is in the area of your spiritual growth for instance, and your desire is to move from being a casual Christian to one who is maturing and making strides in the kingdom, sit and analyze your current state. Is the input I am making now in my prayer, fellowship or Word study going to move me to this next level of growth I am seeing? If not, what can I do about it? This applies to every other area of life. Analyze for change and not for worry, because there is certainly a way out and you are on your way to changing that state.

Prayer

Spend 10 to 15 minutes meditatively praying about and analyzing a particular situation in your life that you would like to change.

FRIDAY MARCH 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TAKE RESPONSIBILITY

1 Kings 20:39-40 (AMPC) ***"And as the king passed by, the [prophet] cried out to him, Your servant went out into the midst of the battle, and behold, a man turned aside and brought a man to me and said, Keep this man. If for any reason he is missing, then your life shall be required for his life, or else you shall pay a talent of silver. [40] But while your servant was busy here and there, he was gone. And the king of Israel said to him, Such is your own verdict; you yourself have decided it."***

Taking responsibility to change your state in order to walk in your next level requires an attitude of persistence and focus. Persistence is the ability to pursue a particular course of action despite delays, difficulties or opposition till you arrive at the intended goal. Persistence is so vital as you take responsibility because it prevents you from shifting blame on others. It also keeps you from becoming weary since not every change is instant (Luke 9:62). Focus is another attitude required as you take responsibility to change your state. It is the ability to concentrate or centralize your attention, energy and resources on a particular course of action until you have achieved the goal. Persistence without focus can delay your arrival and possibly frustrate it because you will be easily distracted, like it happened to the servant in our opening scripture. Take the responsibility for changing your state by being persistent and focused no matter what shows up.

Affirmation

I take responsibility for the change I desire. I am persistent and focused. Never distracted and never giving up no matter the challenges that show up. I am changing my state. Glory!

SATURDAY MARCH 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HAVE GODLY PRINCIPLES

1 Corinthians 1:9 ***“God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.”***

Changing your state and walking in your new level as a child of God requires some undergirding principles. Principles are a determined mode of action. There must be in the fear of God or in reverence to God. Without principles, you will do things anyhow and be open to anything that comes your way. But for the Christian it is even more important that your principles are godly. If not, you would be no different from the people of the world and whatever change or next level you attain will come crashing. The principle of a strong relationship with God is number one. Nothing should compromise your relationship with God. If this principle is not in place, you will step into error along the way. When this principle is in place, you will not seek to please men, neither will you be “consumed” with trying to change your state by “any means possible”.

Prayer

Dear Father, I keep this primary principle in place. My relationship with You is most important to me and I do not compromise it in anyway in Jesus' name.

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

I have accepted the responsibility for changing my state and as I persist with a strong focus, I am certainly arriving at the new state and walking in my next level. Glory!

MONDAY MARCH 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE PLACE OF FELLOWSHIP

Hebrews 10:25 ***“Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.”***

According to our verse for today, missing the assembling of the brethren is not commendable. Unfortunately, quite a number of God’s children have not come to appreciate the place and value of fellowship meetings in Christ. Some wrongly think attending church meetings is a favor done the pastor or the one who invited them. Some even attend fellowship meetings to satisfy their conscience as part of their religious lives. It is also not uncommon to even have leaders attend fellowship meetings out of duty to please their superiors. In these days when the final move of the Spirit is just about to be birthed physically and the return of the Lord Jesus imminent, it is essential for every child of God to value attendance at all fellowship meetings to mature rapidly in the things of the spirit. It takes the knowledge of the present truth to mature and the church is God’s appointed place to receive the truth required for your maturity (Isaiah 2:3, 1 Timothy 3:15, Ephesians 4:11-12). This is the time to be awakened to the importance of fellowship meetings.

TUESDAY MARCH 14

Topic: NO TWO MEETINGS ARE THE SAME

Acts 20:20 *“And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house.”*

One of the errors that can stunt a Christian's growth is to assume that all meetings are the same. People with such a perspective are selective in church attendance and think that Sunday service is enough for the week. They neglect other fellowship meetings, thinking that those are for some “special brethren”. Some even think the other fellowship meetings are in excess. But these are all signs of the lack of understanding of what fellowship meetings really are in Christ. The truth is, no two meetings are the same. Every meeting the Spirit of God directs your shepherd to organize is only meant for your growth. Paul had different meetings. He had house meetings, and public meetings and each was important for the brethren. And above all, God honors the meetings for the purposes for which they are held. Be inspired to attend all fellowship meetings in your local assembly even as we look at various types of fellowship meetings this week.

Topic: PRAYER FELLOWSHIP

Acts 16:13 (ERV) ***“On the Sabbath day we went out the city gate to the river. There we thought we might find a special place for prayer. Some women had gathered there, so we sat down and talked with them.”***

Every child of God must see prayer meetings as an important part of the life in Christ. It should be seen as a golden opportunity to participate in every prayer fellowship in church. The early apostles had prayer meetings and they really prayed. The Apostle Paul and his company in Philippi, got to know there was a place where the brethren met to pray, and they went there to pray. There are many prayer programs organized today but unfortunately, most of them are not based on present truth from the scriptures. Much of these prayers is to “kill enemies”, “break curses” and so on. But this is as a result of the immaturity of the church. As the church matures in our dispensation, it will discover that prayer is more than asking for things. 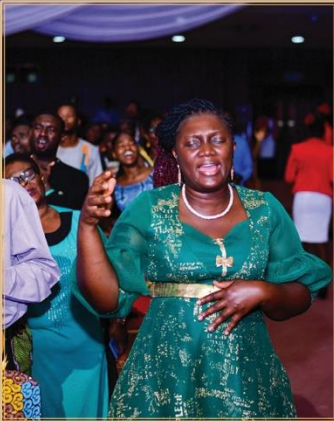
For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

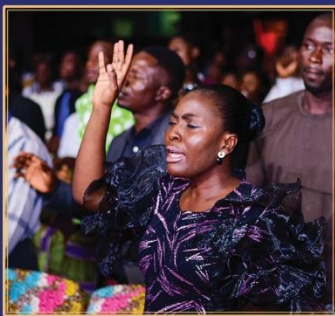


NCC DAY 1 Excerpt

Topic: TEACHING MEETINGS

Act 20:7 "And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight."

Another important meeting every child of God must attend always is teaching fellowship meetings. Not many teaching meetings are organized in our days. In this final dispensation when the church must rapidly mature for the coming of the Lord Jesus, you must yearn for teaching meetings and be quick to be there at all times.

Topic: WORSHIP MEETINGS

Act 13:2 *“As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.”*

Worship meetings are another type of church fellowship meetings, you should not miss. Scripturally speaking, worship is an act of paying homage to God as King. The acts of worship can be by posture (kneeling, lying prostrate, lifting hands etc.), words (adoration or praise), giving or through your attitude. The Christian life must be a complete life of worship, but our focus today is on the aspect of adoring, hallowing and declaring God's laudation. To adore or hallow is what it means to minister to the Lord. Worship enriches your fellowship with the Godhead and seasons your spirit for a greater and realistic walk with God. One of the fellowship meetings the apostles had regularly was communion fellowship meetings. Due to inaccurate teachings of the Word, communion days have become days of differentiation of the “sinners” from the “righteous” in some denominations. And in order not to be seen as a “sinner” some do not even attend church on communion Sundays. A good number of God’s children seem to have an unbiblical fear generated around the holy communion. God instituted it for your current state, so come boldly to participate in all communion services no matter your experiences.

Topic: WHAT IS GRACE?

1 Corinthians 15:10 ***“But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace [which was bestowed] upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.”***

Grace is that divine endowment upon your spirit that makes you what you should be in Christ. Without grace, you cannot turn out to be what you were made to be in Christ. This is a fact of the life in Christ. The Apostle Paul was a minister that declared that he had finished his course. (1Timothy 4:7) He did so much work in the kingdom, in fact about one-third of the New Testament scriptures came through him. He revealed his secret to us in our opening scripture, “by grace I am what I am”. If you want to be successful at your being in Christ, one thing to give attention to is grace. It is the number one thing required in the life of every child of God to be successful. That you are in Christ is not automatic that you will be a success in Christ. Success in Christ is not about the physical parameters, like getting married, having children, doing well in business etc. but turning out to be in this life, exactly what God ordained you to be in Christ. Success in Christ is not automatic, you must understand grace, believe in grace and learn to maximize grace. Grace is a virtue in your spirit like love, power etc. that appears outwardly as an acceptable personality and the ability to succeed with little effort.

Prayer

Topic: ACKNOWLEDGING GRACE IS BIBLICAL - II

1 Peter 4:10 ***"As every man hath received the gift, [even so] minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."***

The scriptures teach that there are various ways a Christian can receive grace and today we will look at few of them. We all have grace to give to each other. In our opening verse, we see that every person in Christ has received grace and this grace must be ministered to others. The Greek translation for the word "gift" is a divine endowment. TOPIC: YOU MUST BELIEVE IN GRACE

1 Corinthians 15:10 ***“But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace [which was bestowed] upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.”***

Grace is the divine enablement for divine living. The Christian is to live by grace and not by the law. Anything that you do as a child of God by the strength of the flesh and not from grace does not register in the kingdom. Topic: MAXIMIZE GRACE

Galatians 2:21 (ESV) ***“I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.”***

Grace is real, powerful and functional, not for decoration. When you receive grace, you must do something with it. Never receive grace in vain. Your ability to use grace to produce results is what we call maximizing grace. Any grace you receive that you do not use will become vain in your life. It is not about having grace but using it to produce results. If you do not learn to maximize grace, you will receive so much grace, but your life will be one of daily struggle. This is what nearly happened to Timothy, and Paul had to remind him to stir up the grace he had received (2 Timothy 1:6). Maximize grace by using grace to be what you should be in Christ (1 Corinthians 15:10). Use grace to reign in life (Romans 5:17). Use grace to successfully carry out your ministry (Ephesians 3:8-9). Use grace to multiply grace through prayer (Hebrews 4:16), through the Word (2 Peter 1:2) and through giving (2 Corinthians 8:7).

Topic: NEVER LACK GRACE

Ephesians 4:7 *“But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.”*

I am certain that you understand how important grace is in your life. What you must determine now is to never have a life that lacks grace at work. To do this, recognize first that you already have grace according to 1 Peter 4:10 and Ephesians 4:7. This grace is according to your gift (Shepherd, Pastor – Ephesians 4:11). TUESDAY MARCH 28

Topic: HOW TO BE REAL WITH YOURSELF

Jude 1:20(TPT) "But you, my delightfully loved friends, constantly and progressively build yourselves up on the foundation of your most holy faith by praying every moment in the Spirit."

Being real with yourself as a child of God is hinged on personally defining the level of your most holy faith. Your most holy faith is your most basic or solid conviction upon which as our opening scripture says, you are to build. For many a Christian, their quantum of knowledge of the scriptures and even their prayer does not correlate with the lives they live. They know what the Word says, they can quote it or even preach it, but when it comes to the daily living or expression of the Word when they face a "real-life" situation, what they know seems to have disappeared because they did not really have conviction in what they said they believed. To be real with yourself, define the level of your most holy faith. For example, you believe that by his stripes you are healed, but when a dart of sickness attacks your body, what is your first course of action? That first thought and step you take is what you really believe. Once you do this for the different areas of your life, you can be real with yourself and through fervent prayer in the spirit and meditation on the Word, build yourself up from that level to a higher one.

Meditation

Spend 15 minutes meditating on yourself to define the level of your most holy faith and pray in other tongues to build on it from there.

Topic: BE REAL WITH JESUS

John 4:23-24 ***“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”***

Reality with Jesus is a must for every child of God. It may seem obvious because if one says he is a Christian then he knows or believes in Jesus, right? This is unfortunately not the case for many children of God. Who is Jesus to you? This Jesus that you sing songs about and worship, and preach and whose greatness you proclaim, is He real to you? Meditation

Spend 15 minutes meditating on your life and how real Jesus is to you. Pray that by the spirit you walk in reality in every area of your life with Jesus.

THURSDAY MARCH 30

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO BE REAL WITH JESUS

John 16:13-14 (BSB) ***“However, when the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. For He will not speak on His own, but He will speak what He hears, and He will declare to you what is to come. He will glorify Me by taking from what is Mine and disclosing it to you.”***

To be real with Jesus, He must be made known to you. At every stage of your maturity in Christ, there is a settled knowledge of Jesus that you have. It is only the Holy Spirit that can reveal Jesus to you in reality. Yes, you can read books about Him, but it takes more than head knowledge to know Jesus. This knowing is a definiteness in the spirit that only the Holy Spirit can give. This is what makes your worship and interaction with Him real. The Jesus you know is the Jesus that the Holy Spirit has revealed to you, not just the one you have read or heard about. How does He do this? Through your personal and consistent fellowship with the Holy Spirit, He reveals Jesus to you. When Jesus is revealed to you and you are real with Him, your worship is never empty. When you declare Jesus is Lord, there are no doubts in your mind as to the weight of this truth and it is upon this authority that you conduct your life about.

Fellowship

Spend some time fellowshiping with Daddy Holy Spirit and receive a revelation of Jesus at the level in Christ.

FRIDAY MARCH 31

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BE REAL WITH OTHERS

Romans 12:3-5 (BSB) ***“For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but think of yourself with sober judgment, according to the measure of faith God has given you. Just as each of us has one body with many members, and not all members have the same function, so in Christ we who are many are one body, and each member belongs to one another.”***

Much of the distrust and strain in relationships is due to people not being real with each other. Many people put up facades and are not honest with each other for various reasons. Some for purely selfish gain and others to “protect” themselves. But you must understand the uniqueness of the body of Christ. We are one. This oneness is not just a Christian jargon, it is a spiritual reality. Our opening verse says we who are in Christ are one body and each member belongs to the other. You are as much a part of me as my arm is a part of my physical body. Being conscious of this, you will not lie to, despise or hurt a brother or sister because in reality, you are doing it to yourself. Be real (truthful) in your intentions and actions dealing with others whether with your spouse and children at home, brethren in church or colleagues at work. It removes a lot of “sandy particles” from your life.

Prayer

Dear Father, I position my heart by Your Spirit to be real with everyone I interact with in Jesus’ name.

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

A wholehearted belief and an acknowledgement/confession. To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
