GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO BE REAL WITH OTHERS

Romans 12:3-5 (BSB) *“For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but think of yourself with sober judgment, according to the measure of faith God has given you. Just as each of us has one body with many members, and not all members have the same function, so in Christ we who are many are one body, and each member belongs to one another.”*

Also be aware that in Christ we are one. We have the same Jesus, and Holy Spirit and no one is “better than another. Do not “size people up” or have preconceived ideas about them that determines how you treat them even before they come to you. Genuinely love, honour and respect all people.

As a son or daughter of God, develop the mindset of living and doing things for your betterment in life not for your disadvantage. Depending on your spiritual understanding, everything you think of, say or do is either for better or for worse to you. Now, today, God is calling on you to live for the better and not for the worse. In our opening verse today, the brethren in the Corinthian Church came together to celebrate the glorious sacrament of the holy communion. However, instead of being edified and living gloriously, some were weak, others sick and some dead (verse 30). This happens in people's lives all the time when they are celebrating anniversaries, festivals etc. Yes, Easter is here. Of course, whether you celebrate it or not is not the issue but if you choose to celebrate it, then do it for the better not for the worse. What do we mean? During Easter, Jesus was crucified, and He rose again and later ascended into heaven. Celebrating Easter with a focus on how Jesus suffered for an “unworthy you”, pitying him and yourself and so on, is for worse for you because it won't add anything to your life. But celebrating Easter with a focus on Jesus seated at the right hand of the majesty on high and you being jointly seated with Him (Ephesians 1:19-20; 2:6) will be for better for you because it will stir the victor in you up and take you to a higher level in life.

TUESDAY APRIL 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FOCUS ON THE END, NOT THE MEANS

Hebrews 2:10 "*For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings*".

Dear son or daughter of God, it's important to understand that today, Christ is no more suffering. In fact, the scriptures testify that He died once and will not die again (Romans 6:9-10). The acknowledgment of the cross (the sufferings and death of Jesus) is so that one can track things unto His current status and function after resurrection. For without the suffering and the death, there will be no resurrection. This is the meaning of preaching and glorifying in the cross (1 Corinthians 1:17-18; Galatians 6:14). Not to stay at the facts of the cross in self-pity because that doesn't save or get anyone born again. It is the belief in the resurrection and confession of Lordship that saves or regenerates (Romans 10:9). Thus, the cross was a means to an end not the end in itself. The end is to bring sons into glory. Learn to celebrate Easter by ruminating more on the facts of the resurrection and ascension and how they relate with you because the realities of the life in Christ are in focusing on the end not the means to the end.

WEDNESDAY APRIL 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEATH FOR THE WORLD, NOT FOR THE CHRISTIAN - I

Romans 5:10 *"For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life."*

It is time to wake up to the fact that Jesus, did not die for the Christian. Please don't take this as a matter of splitting hairs on unnecessary issues. This understanding can change your Christian experience forever. Yes, Jesus did not die for the Christian. It is simple. When Jesus was about to die, who was a Christian by then? No one. Who is a Christian? The results from the human belief in the resurrection of Jesus and confession of Lordship to become a son of God (Romans 10:9; John 1:12). Christians are, therefore, the result of Jesus' death. Who then did Jesus die for? Jesus died for the world (the human race in the state of sin and separation from God). Our verse today says, God reconciled enemies through the death of Jesus. 2 Corinthians 5:19 clarifies that to be the reconciliation of the world. So, when the Holy Ghost by the Apostle Paul speaks of preaching the cross and not making it of none effect, he meant explaining the cross to unadopted human souls as the means by which Jesus reconciled the world and paved way for eternal life by the resurrection to get them born again not as a focus for the Church.

Prayer

Oh Dear Jesus, I receive the light of the knowledge of this truth by the Spirit without argument, even now. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY APRIL 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEATH FOR THE WORLD, NOT FOR THE CHRISTIAN - II

2 Corinthians 5:17 "*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new*".

Let us continue our discussion from yesterday on the fact that Jesus did not die for the Christian but for the world and unravel its importance in your life. Why is this knowledge vital to you? When you as a son of God can say, "Jesus died for me" it means you are assessing yourself at the level of the sinful world or sinful human souls. Thus, revealing that you haven't yet appreciated that you are a new creature. So, it is simple, just check yourself; are you able to say, "Jesus died for me or for us with ease?" Then you need to seriously work on your new creation foundation. Topic: YES, JESUS DIED

1 Corinthians 1:18 ***"For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God."***

It is funny how with no understanding, some people of the world try to mock the preaching of the fact that Jesus Christ died for the sin of mankind brought by Adam's sin. They will often mock by saying, "if God is God, why does he need someone to die for the sins of mankind" They will say, "why should they be linked to Adam's sin" and many more. But sons of God, don't be moved or carried along by such displays of gross ignorance. Jesus didn't die to pay Satan. Jesus didn't die to answer the shallow questions of limited human minds. Numbers 32:11-12 (BSB) “*Surely none of the men who came up from Egypt, from twenty years old and above, shall see the land of which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, because they have not wholly followed Me, [12] except Caleb the son of Jephunneh, the Kenizzite, and Joshua the son of Nun, for they have wholly followed the LORD.*”

The Bible like in our opening scripture, and life experiences are full of people; beginning with Adam, who began their walk in Christ loving and living for God but did not do so wholly. Not doing so wholly means not following God “FULLY” or “TILL THE END” or both. This should not be your story as you invest some prayer today into your life.

2. According to the scriptures, people faint in challenging times because their strength is small (Proverbs 24:10). Build yourself up beyond ever fainting in your journey in Christ as you pray fervently in other tongues or with your understanding.

THURSDAY APRIL 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WEEK OF PRAYER – TAKE HEED TO YOURSELF (III)

Hebrews 5:12-14 (NKJV) *“For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.”*

We understand from our opening scripture that sometimes sons of God are slow in reaching the Father's expectation of them. There are many who ought to be mature in the ways of God and yet seem to be stagnated in their spiritual growth for various reasons. It is possible, however, to be on time in terms of spiritual growth and achievements in life. We must avoid worldly distractions to achieve our highest in Christ because the world is crucified to us and vice versa (Galatians 6:14).

Let us pray:

1. Pray fervently in other tongues as you speak mysteries into your life to eliminate all causes of delays in personal spiritual growth and achievement in Christ.
2. Affirm in fervent prayer that the world is crucified to you, and you are dead to all its influences. You are therefore at liberty to live your life in Christ to the full.

FRIDAY APRIL 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WEEK OF PRAYER – INVEST IN YOURSELF (I)

Jeremiah 3:15 (NKJV) *“And I will give you shepherds according to My heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding.”*

According to our opening scripture, God gives us shepherds to feed us with knowledge and understanding. Your positioning in the spirit to receive from your shepherd is key to enjoying his or her role in your life. Each one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of God in Christ, Ephesians 4:7. You want to make divine investments into your life in prayer to position you rightly to receive all God has for you.

Let us pray:

1. That you are by the Spirit made an easy son/daughter to bring up in righteousness (John 10:2-5)

Galatians 6:7-8 (NKJV) *“Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. [8] For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.”*

It is important for you to be realistic as a son or daughter of God. Many of God's children think that if they can wish for some good in life then one day by some “supernatural” means it will just happen. Our opening scripture tells us not to deceive ourselves. We will only reap what we sow. You want to make some divine investments into your life for the next few years 5, 10, 20 or more years if Jesus tarries.

Let us pray:

Focus on one area at a time, such as your health, marriage, finances, children etc., and spiritually invest into it with intense prayer, speaking forth what you want to see in that area.
2. Prayerfully invest into the area of excellence in your personality and ministry. Focus on nothing but the excellence of your personality and ministry and pray fervently that like Joshua any mention of you before the Father, will only be of good.

Prophesy that you are so full of grace that it is visible on you wherever you go in life (Acts 11:22-23)

SUNDAY APRIL 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Why You Must Belong to a Church

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)

Church fellowship is an important aspect of the life of a child of God on this earth. In our opening scripture, the Holy Spirit instructs us to take our meeting together seriously and to not neglect them. According to the scriptures, when we go for church fellowship meetings, we go

1. To fellowship to worship God (Psalm 29:2)
2. To fellowship with one another as the family of God (Psalm 133:1)
3. To pray (James 5:16)
4. For instruction in righteousness (2 Tim. 3:16)



When you get born again, you must be planted in a Church. This is God's idea, not man's. In Psalm 92:13, we learn that "those that be planted in the house of the Lord, shall flourish in the courts of our God". In 1 Timothy 3:15, we also learn that the house of the Lord is the Church, the pillar and ground of truth. So, it is evident that to flourish in Christ, you must be a member of, and be planted in, a Church. Many people however have not understood the subject of Church membership and how to find a Church.

Church membership is the spiritual addition of a member of the spiritual

body of Christ to a fellowship of other members of the same body located at a certain part of the earth.

1. It is a spiritual addition. The Father who knows you and knows your function in the body, knows which of the fellowships you must belong to function properly (Jeremiah 3:15). The Holy Spirit Himself will guide you to the Church fellowship He has prepared for you.
2. It is an addition of a member of the spiritual body. Until a person is a member of the spiritual body of Christ, that person cannot be a church member. How does one become a member of the spiritual body? It is through the new birth. A human should have heard the gospel of Jesus Christ, be born again and become a member of the body of Christ (Titus 3:5).

Every child of God was made for a purpose, and there's a ministry or shepherd God has chosen for him or her to fulfill that purpose (Jeremiah 3:15).



Ephesians 1:4-5 *“According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will.”*

John 3:16 ***"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."***

Making sons of God out of human beings is not only about fulfilling a calling but also the natural expression of our love nature. Beyond the emotion, love is the person from whom the force of endearment that drives the emotion, comes. That person is God (1 John 4:8). It takes God to love and without God, there is no love.
