## THURSDAY JUNE 1

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: LOVING GOD

John 14:15 *"If ye love me, keep my commandments."*

**FRIDAY JUNE 2**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: LOVING OTHERS**

John 15:13 ***“Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends”.***

Generally, for humans, God demands that they love others as themselves (Galatians 5:14) yet it seems so difficult for them. But for us who are sons of God, Jesus added the dimension of going further to even lay our lives down for others. ## SATURDAY JUNE 3

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: LOVE NOT THE WORLD

1 John 2:15 ***“Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him”***

Generally, people without Christ are referred to as people of the world. But the scriptural instruction not to love the world, does not mean to hate people without Christ. The instruction points towards the principles, inclinations and practices of the people of the world which originate primarily from Satan (Ephesians 2:2; 1 John 2:16). The instruction not to love the world is directly referring to the lust of the eyes, lust of the flesh and pride of self which are the baits of Satan that draw people's hearts away from the love of God. Thus, God doesn't even want you to entertain friendship with these things (James 4:4). If you love the world, you'll hate the ways of God. You'll reject the truth of God and the sacrifice or persecution that comes with it - 2 Timothy 4:10. Learn to bury your life in the activities of God's fellowship and His Word and the world will become dead to you (Galatians 6:14).

## TUESDAY JUNE 6

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### **Topic: CHRISTIANITY BEGINS AT REGENERATION**

**Titus 3:5 *“Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost.”***

Because of the human history of the fall in Adam (Romans 5:12), the adoption of men as sons of God by which they get born again into the kingdom of God is included in the general meaning of salvation because they are all part of the work Jesus did when He came into this world as man. As a result, the understanding of salvation is broad because each stage is understood at different levels to mean salvation. So, for some, salvation means forgiveness of sins. For others it means deliverance from the power of Satan, the world and sin. Further still others understand it to be becoming born again. If the first and or the second are your only understanding of it, they will not give you the complete picture of who you are, what you are entitled to and what you are capable of doing in Christ. It is important to get to know that salvation involves the regeneration of the human spirit. This will solidify your Christian foundation because it defines the real transaction of a man receiving Christ and enables the appreciation of what he has become as a Christian (Romans 6:6; Colossians 3:9)

**WEDNESDAY JUNE 7**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: CHRISTIANS ARE NEW CREATURES INDEED**

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”***

Once the truth that being in Christ is a regeneration, it becomes easy to appreciate your real newness. The newness of a Christian is a real one because of regeneration in spirit. The above verse is so plain in its statement that no religious watering down is required. A man in Christ is a new creature. The old (human life) is passed away. It died in the regeneration process (Romans 6:4). The person is now the son of God with eternal life. Eternal life is God's kind of life with all His nature and ability (John 5:26; 1 John 5:10-12). Don't take it at face value as though it is just about a new nice behavior and has nothing really to do with your nature. That suggestion about this truth is a serious deception that will forever keep you out of the top life in Christ. Be simple and meek to accept this truth that you are indeed a new type of being in Christ who is totally different from human beings though you still live in this human looking body and your foundation will be solidified.

Oh dear Jesus, I am really excited to discover that in You, I am a divine being with eternal life. Humanity and all of its infirmities are not part of me. Glory to God.

## THURSDAY JUNE 8

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: THE AWAKENING TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

**Acts 2:4 *“And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.”***

The regeneration brought into existence in your spirit the divine life of God making you the son or daughter of God. Like a midwife, it was by the Holy Spirit that you were born of God through the Word. Having come into being now as a new creature, you must get awakened to the person, presence and power of the Holy Spirit. This happens in a warm spiritual embrace of the Holy Spirit often referred to as being filled with the Holy Spirit in which he imparts you with the ability to speak the heavenly language of other tongues. A Christian who hasn't given attention to be filled with the Holy Spirit has a weak Christian foundation. Give attention to getting filled with the Holy Spirit to make your foundation strong because the vitality and reality of the Christian journey depends on your relationship with the Holy Spirit. If you're already born again, you can by faith get filled with the Holy Spirit right now. If you so desire, pray this:

Dear Holy Spirit, in the Name of Jesus Christ, I receive Your warm embrace and the overwhelming awakening to Your person, presence and power. Thank You for the utterance You have given me now to speak with other tongues. (At this open your mouth let out that divine utterance and continue for about 5mins).

**FRIDAY JUNE 9**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: CULTIVATE FELLOWSHIP WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT**

2 Corinthians 13:14 ***"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen"***

You came into being as a son of God in Christ in union with the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 1:13). His union with you is to enable Him to fellowship incessantly with you. By your being filled with the Holy Spirit, you're awakened to His personality so that you can learn to respond to His fellowship until that mutual communion becomes incessant. Many just stop at, "I am filled with the Holy Spirit, and I speak in other tongues" but that's just the introduction into the life long relationship with the Holy Spirit. Begin today! Take some time to intimately talk with the Holy Spirit. Express your love and adoration to Him as you enjoy Him too. Practice this often until you're unconsciously drawn into it at any least available time. When you cultivate this mutual fellowship until you master it, your Christian foundation will be solid enough to bring you into your fullness in Christ.

Acts 17:11 ***"These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so."***

If you have an effective fellowship with the Holy Spirit, you'll naturally love the Word. The Spirit will draw you more into the Word because that is where He teaches and nourishes you from. When He draws you, yield to His prompting and avail yourself for His ministry in the Word. **Exodus 31:3 *“And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship.”***

As the Lord taught us before, there are clear differences among knowledge, understanding and wisdom though in a few cases they are used interchangeably. In these final days of the Church’s history on this earth, it is imperative that you understand what understanding is all about. Primarily, understanding is the bridge between knowledge and wisdom. Basically, knowledge is the acquisition of new information; understanding is insight into knowledge that makes it relevant to you and wisdom is ability from understanding to act on the knowledge. **TUESDAY JUNE 13**

**Topic: THE POWER OF UNDERSTANDING**

**Job 17:4 *“For thou hast hid their heart from understanding: therefore shalt thou not exalt them”***

The above scripture is seriously heartbreaking! It first reveals that a person's heart should have a part of God's universal understanding for life on this earth. Then it further shows that if that understanding is withheld from a person's heart, that person can never rise or live a high life. May you never merit the hiding of God's wisdom from your heart; for without it, you cannot go far in life and your entire experience in life will be as one in the regions of death (Proverbs 21:16). Understanding is the power to live a holy and righteous life. Without it, you can't avoid living a sinful life (Job 28:28; Proverbs 6:32; Psalm 119:34). It takes understanding to seek knowledge (Proverbs 15:14); to express excellence in life (Proverbs 17:27) and to draw counsel from your heart for situations in life (Proverbs 20:5). Without understanding, you will live a careless, wasteful and wicked life without knowing (Job 39:13-17). Hmm! Truly, in all your getting, get understanding (Proverbs 4:7).

## WEDNESDAY JUNE 14

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: KINDS OF UNDERSTANDING

Proverbs 3:5 ***“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding”.***

In our verse today, the Lord admonished against dependence on their own understanding. But where did they get their understanding from if He didn't put it in them? Why will He then reject what Himself gave? Always bear in mind that the disobedience of Adam brought corruption into this world (1 Peter 1:4) and got everything and every human under the influence of Satan (Luke 4:6; Romans 8:20, Ephesians 2:2; 1 John 5:19). So, whether people believe it or not, everything natural or human is satanically influenced until purified by the life in Christ. This natural or human understanding is what God warned against dependence on. Thus, we see two kinds of understanding now: the understanding of men which God doesn't work with (1 Corinthians 1:19) and the understanding of God which must be gotten by all means (Proverbs 4:7). So, when we are talking about the understanding of life, we are not referring to the common sense of men into issues of life but the clean, holy and divine insight of God's Word into issues of life. It's no understanding at all if it is a practice or prescription of men's understanding.

#### Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I refuse to live and function by the understanding men. My life is the expression of divine understanding. Hallelujah!

**THURSDAY JUNE 15**

**Topic: YOU NEED UNDERSTANDING IN LIFE**

**2 Timothy 2:7 *“Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things”***

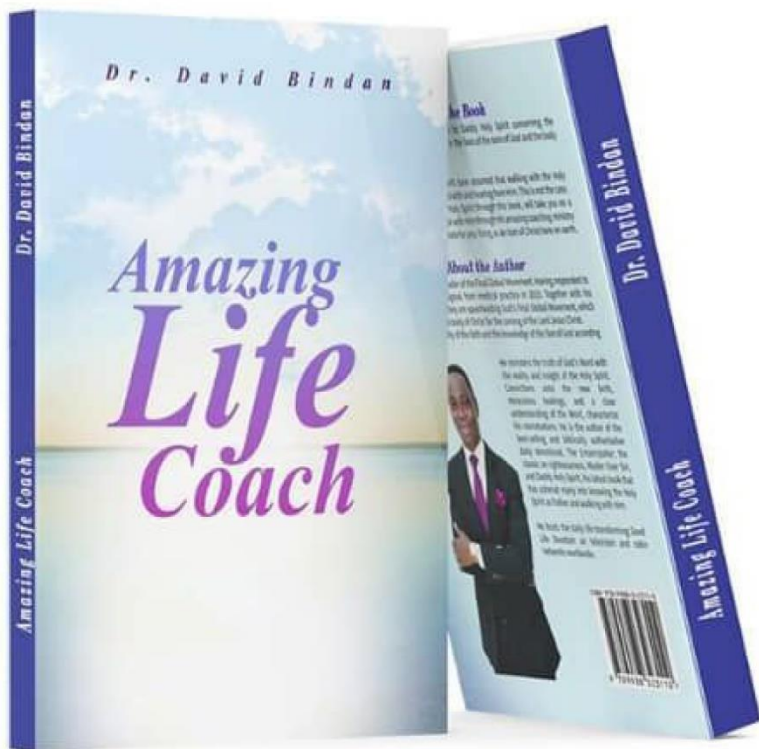

**FRIDAY JUNE 16**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: RECEIVING UNDERSTANDING**

**Job 32:8 *"But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding."***

Having understood that understanding is indispensable for a successful life, let's look at how a person can access this understanding of God. The scripture above clearly indicates that understanding is imparted by the inspiration or breath of the Almighty. When Jesus of Nazareth attained the status of Almighty after resurrection, He breathed on His disciples and imparted understanding (John 20:22; Luke 24:45). For a person to graduate from the understanding of men which is corrupt and start functioning in divine understanding, he must first become one with the Holy Spirit in new birth by receiving Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 1:13). Secondly, he must avail himself for the ministration of understanding through the Word of God (Psalm 111:10, 104, 130; Proverbs 9:10; Jeremiah 3:15). Outside of God, the best a person can have as understanding is understanding that is corrupt, which God nullifies (1 Corinthians 1:19).

### **Confession**

As a son of God, I am one with the Holy Spirit. From today, I expose my heart to His ministry of understanding as I give serious attention to my Father's Word, in Jesus' name.

**SATURDAY JUNE 17**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: STIR YOUR UNDERSTANDING UP**

***Isaiah 11:2 “And the spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.”***

One of the distinct ministries of the Holy Spirit is understanding. Everyone who has received Christ has the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 1:13). Immediately you were made one with the Holy Spirit at the new birth, understanding became part of you. However, to live as the expression of this understanding you must learn to stir it up like any other divine grace in you (2 Timothy 1:6). To do this, get filled with the Holy Spirit (get awakened to His presence, power and person to have the ability to speak with other tongues). Then give attention to receiving understanding by an intentional and regular interaction with God’s Word. Then, proceed to speak forth your expression of understanding in life until understanding dominates your thoughts, speech and action. Hallelujah!

Glory to God. I am a package of divine virtues including understanding. I have and function in understanding in all things in the name of Jesus Christ.

**SUNDAY JUNE 18**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK**

Being born again, filled with the Holy Spirit with speaking in other tongues; take some 10 minutes this day, to speak fervently in other tongues with an intense focus on stirring your understanding up. Hallelujah!

**MONDAY JUNE 19**

**Topic: THE CHRISTIAN LIFE IS A JOURNEY**

**Ephesians 4:13 *“Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ.”***

It's important that you become one of the children of God who understands that the Christian life is a journey. It makes a whole lot of difference in the way you'll apply yourself for a greater life on this earth. **TUESDAY JUNE 20**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: GROWTH IS DIVINELY INSTITUTED**

***Ephesians 4:11-13 “And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; ... For the perfecting of the saints, ... Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ.”***

Become aware that the issue of progress or spiritual growth in Christianity is a divine institution. It is not pastor or shepherd designed, but God our Father by His Wisdom ordained that when you come into being as His son or daughter, you should be equipped to grow. Refusal to recognize and conform is a denial of divine fatherhood provision and its accompanying benefits in this life and after. 1 Corinthians 3:1-3, indicates God's institution of growth from babyhood into spiritual maturity. Hebrews 5:12, indicates God's desire that you graduate from a basic pupil into a teacher. Progress or advancement in the Christian journey is divinely instituted therefore take advantage of the revealed avenues to grow for your own good.

**WEDNESDAY JUNE 21**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: THE BEGINNING OF CHRISTIANITY**

2 Corinthians 5:17 ***“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”***

People are born into this world as humans created by God through the natural process of birth (Genesis 1:28). But before the world was founded God had already determined that humans would be made to get adopted in Christ to become His own sons (Ephesians 1:4-5). This happens through a second birth which is spiritual (John 3:3). When a human receives the life of God in the gospel of Christ, he becomes regenerated by the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5) into a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17). This is where Christianity begins. Real Christianity begins when a person (who is a human) becomes re-created in spirit into a new creature (who is a divine being). However, the experience of real Christianity begins when one who is a new creature becomes aware that he or she is indeed a new creature in Christ. As wonderful as that is, it's just the beginning of life in the Christian journey but it is the foundation without which, there can be no authentic Christian growth.

**THURSDAY JUNE 22**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: CHRISTIAN ESTABLISHMENT**

Romans 1:11 ***“For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established.”***

As part of the Christian journey, every new creature must proceed to the stage of establishment. The Greek word used in our verse today is “**stērizō**” which means to be made stable, placed firmly, fixed, strengthened and set fast on the path of the Christian journey. Establishment takes one beyond vacillation in faith and stagnancy at the babyhood with all its human experiences. How does this happen? For the foundation, all that a human being needs to do is to receive Christ and be metamorphosed into a son of God. But to become established, the new creature must first get filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:4). This results in the impartation with the ability to speak with other tongues, ability to operate in the gifts of the Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:7) and live in the fullness of the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18). Concurrently, the new creature must crave the nourishment of God’s Word (1 Peter 2:2) till he enjoys strength in the Word (Acts 20:32).

**Topic: ADVANCED CHRISTIANITY - I**

Acts 2:25 (TPT) ***“This is the very thing David prophesied about him: ‘I continually see the Lord in front of me. He’s at my right hand, and I am never shaken.’”***

The general pool of what is even called “serious” Christianity is up to the stage of establishment as described yesterday. For at that level, people can have fervent and regular prayers, operate in gifts and perform miracles and so on. But in the Christian journey, God planned that we should advance beyond that. **Topic: THE PRINCIPLE OF CONCENTRATION**

1 Corinthians 10:31 (TLB) **“Well, I’ll tell you why. It is because you must do everything for the glory of God, even your eating and drinking.”**

One reason many Christians struggle to abound in the work of the ministry is because they have compartmentalized their lives so their “spiritual life” is different from their “family life”, “work life”, “finances” etc. The day you got born again, you came into being as a son of God with one life, the divine life and it is this life that must have expression in every area of life. The principle of concentration is essentially taking every aspect of your life and narrowing it into ministry. **WEDNESDAY JUNE 28**

**Topic: BE COMPETENT**

2 Corinthians 3:5-6 (RSV) ***“Not that we are competent of ourselves to claim anything as coming from us; our competence is from God, who has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant, not in a written code but in the Spirit; for the written code kills, but the Spirit gives life.”***

To abound in the work of the ministry, you must be competent. Competence here, is not just in having sufficient physical knowledge, skill and strength to perform a function. For a child of God, your overarching competence must be your divine competence. Competence for doing the work of the ministry and abounding in it is in being full of divine substance. Being born again, you have the nature of God and that is your sufficiency. You have only truly ministered to someone or in a particular assignment when you minister spiritual substance that will bless, uplift or promote. Ministry is beyond the words and actions, and this is why you must be spiritually competent – full of divine substance in prayer, the Word and grace. **Topic: BE LOYAL**

**1 Timothy 1:12 (NKJV) *"And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry."***

Loyalty or faithfulness is another key to abounding in the work of the ministry. True loyalty is a state of the heart and not just in profession of words. You must be faithful to Jesus who called you (1 Timothy 1:12) because you will be judged and give an account one day. Being born again, you are faithful in nature therefore manifest your faithfulness. In the body of Christ, Jesus who is the head has put in place an order in which things ought to be done and thus has given people gifts to equip us for the ministry (Ephesians 4:7-13). **Topic: LEAD BY EXAMPLE**

1 Timothy 4:12 (AMPC) ***“Let no one despise or think less of you because of your youth, but be an example (pattern) for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.***

When you carry out true ministry, the evidence is seen in the lives of those to whom you ministered. You will abound in the work of the ministry when you lead by example. Our opening verse admonishes us to live an exemplary life. Your speech, conduct, and faith must reflect the present truth of God’s Word. You give what you have. Anything you don’t do well in the spirit, will not have the intended impact when preached or shared. Remember that the purpose of ministering is to bless, uplift and promote someone, bringing them up to the place God has for them. Be an example in all things, and at all times, never slacking. Be disciplined in your ministry and you will succeed.

**Prayer**

Father, I stir up grace to lead by example to abound in the work of the ministry in Jesus’ name.

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
