MONDAY JULY 31

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SOME WILL SUCCEED, YET OTHERS WILL FAIL

John 12:8 *"For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always."*

While still growing up in Christ, I discovered from the Bible the kind of superior beings that Christians are and I began having a few challenges with certain portions of the Bible that addressed Christians as weak like Romans 15:1. But after decades of a personal walk with God, I understood that even God had to accept those lower states for some people including some of His sons and daughters because they are just not ready for His perfect will for their lives. This is why there are different levels of His will - the good, acceptable and perfect (Romans 12:2). A typical example is our main scripture for today. How can Jesus, who took human poverty to usher all of humanity into divine wealth according to 2 Corinthians 8:9, easily accept that the poor will always be on earth? It is because He knows that irrespective of how much is revealed about their wealth, some will still not believe and will remain poor. In the same vein, there will always be people among the masses, the failed, the downtrodden, frustrated and confused but that is not God's perfect will. The ball is in your court! Choose which quality of life you want.

TUESDAY AUGUST 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FAILURE IN LIFE IS A CHOICE

Genesis 4:7 (NLT) *“You will be accepted if you do what is right. But if you refuse to do what is right, then watch out! Sin is crouching at the door, eager to control you. But you must subdue it and be its master.”*

One truthful fact of life is that failure in life is a personal choice. Some will disagree with this because they are not even aware that by their attitude, they have unconsciously made a choice to fail. Though there may be very compelling environmental factors, ultimately, it takes your decision to fail in life. Examining our scripture today, we can see that though with the same God, same parents and same instructions, Abel succeeded but Cain failed. Why? Cain chose to. How do you know if you've chosen to fail in life? When you are careless about God's instructions concerning life e.g., King Saul; when you mainly blame others for the conditions of your life and do nothing e.g., Cain; when you refuse to see that you are a major player in your own success, e.g., positive lesson from four lepers, and when you are lazy e.g., the sluggard of Proverbs 6:10-11. Take time to personally brood on each of these and if you realize there is any in your life, subject it to the purifying ministry of the Spirit in prayer and meditation until they are flushed out of your life.

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SUCCESS IN LIFE IS A CHOICE

2 Kings 7:3 (AMP) *“Now four men who were lepers were at the entrance of the [city’s] gate; and they said to one another, “Why should we sit here until we die?”*

Like failure, success in life is a personal choice. Luck and chance are delusions of Satan that don't give durable success in life. If you want to be a success in life as God ordained for you, you must decide today. How do you decide to be a success in life? First realize that success is God's will for you. Let no one deceive you that you were born to be a nobody, sickly, downtrodden, poor and subjugated in life. Then rise up to challenge your current situation. Secondly, instead of worrying, choose to sit down and do a positive analysis of the situation with the goal of finding a righteous way out. Thirdly, instead of complaining and blaming others, choose to accept that you are the one to change your state. Fourthly, believe that no matter how huge the odds or challenges to your success may seem, there is always a righteous way out. Finally, choose to rise and take action no matter how little or insignificant your steps may appear to be.

THURSDAY AUGUST 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE SUCCESSFUL MENTALITY

Philippians 4:13 (AMP) ***"I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens and empowers me [to fulfill His purpose-I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]"***

Successful people have a certain mentality. By successful people we don't necessarily mean humanly wealthy, influential or famous people but those who have harnessed their divine potentials and resources in Christ Jesus to fulfill their God ordained purpose in life. The mentality of the successful people is one of absolute conviction in their ability to succeed despite any kind of challenges. A mindset is a spiritual voice that attracts or repels things. Colossians 1:29 (AMP) ***"For this I labor [often to the point of exhaustion], striving with His power and energy, which so greatly works within me."***

MONDAY AUGUST 7

Topic: SATAN AND HIS KINGDOM

Matthew 12:26 (NET) *“So if Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand?”*

Satan is a real living angelic creation of God Almighty. The scriptures reveal that he was so specially gifted of God that he was the covering Cherub of a secret place around God referred to as the sides of the north (Ezekiel 28:14-16). In addition, he was granted a throne to rule over some pre-Adamic race of man. But in his trafficking between God's holy mountain and hence earthly territory, he got his ways corrupted and thought to exalt his throne above the stars of God. The fury of God against his plans resulted in a judgmental flood that cast him down to the earth and destroyed it (Isaiah 14:12-14; Jeremiah 4:23-27; Genesis 1:1-2). Together with some other rebellious angels and the dis-embodied spirits of the pre-Adamic creatures, Satan has a well-structured kingdom set up in the darkness under heaven which Jesus refers to in our opening verse. Every child of God must understand these basic facts about Satan and his kingdom to live above his distractive tricks on earth.

TUESDAY AUGUST 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE TOTAL DEFEAT OF SATAN

Revelation 20:10 "*And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.*"

The overview of scriptural truth reveals that the total defeat of Satan will be in six stages. The first stage of Satan's defeat was his casting down during his attempt at personal exaltation (Isaiah 14:12-14). The second stage was when Jesus defeated him in hell and took Adamic authority from him (Colossians 2:15; Luke 11:21-22). The third stage is the enforcement of his defeat by the Church as he tries to lord his nefarious tricks over humans and immature sons of God (Matthew 16:18; Mark 16:17-18). The fourth and the fifth stages will be his defeat when he deceives nations to fight Christ at His second coming and in the earthly millennial kingdom (Revelations 19:19-21; 20:7-9). The sixth and final stage will be his incarceration into the lake of fire forever (Revelation 20:10). So, it is important to understand that though defeated and powerless over sons of God, he is still around for the stages of his defeat to be completed. As a creature in rebellion, he will still try to see if he can through deception steal, kill and destroy.

Confession

The devil is a defeated foe. As a son of God, I cast out his demons and establish the victory of my Lord Jesus wherever I go, in Jesus' name.

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE CHRISTIAN AND THE HUMAN

2 Corinthinns 5:16 (TLV) *“So from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Messiah according to the flesh, yet now we no longer know Him this way.”*

One aspect of Biblical truth which has taken much too long for the body of Christ to recognize so that the rest of the world will know, is the fact of the absolute difference between the Christian and the human. Talking about the result of substitutionary work Jesus did for mankind, the scriptures says it is time to stop recognizing people according to their flesh because anyone in Christ has ceased to be human but a new creature. That the Christian continues to live on earth in a human body poses the risk of being miss assessed hence the scriptures instructs us not to. It is time for the body of Christ to wake up to this fact that we are born of God (John 1:12-13) through the seed of the Word (1 Peter 1:23) and are therefore totally different from humans who are born of men through the human sperm. No Christian can properly “relate” with Satan and the numerous spiritual creatures as God desires without a clear understanding of your divine nature and placement in spirit (2 Peter 1:4; Ephesians 2:6).

Confession

Being born of God, divinity is my nature. I am now a being of a superior breed to Satan and all creatures in his kingdom. Glory to God!

THURSDAY AUGUST 10
GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE CHRISTIAN AND DEMONIC INFLUENCE

2 Peter 1:4 (NLT) *“And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.”*

If the understanding of the divine nature of the new creature in Christ dawns on you, it will suddenly become clear to you that by nature, the Christian is too superior a being to be influenced or controlled by Satan or his demons. Thus, in absolute terms, real Christians don't waste their time on Satan and his issues but are focused on God's will and purpose because not only are they totally free from his tyrannical influence (Colossians 1:13) but also they are commissioned to eject and abort his work everywhere (Mark 16:17). However just like all other goodies available in Christ, maturity is the key to enjoyment. So, an immature Christian with a carnal mindset and ungodly bodily desires is an open access to demonic control. So, it is common to find sons of God still controlled or influenced by demons into anger, immorality, worldliness, addictions of all kinds only because their minds have not yet been renewed neither are their bodies living sacrifices into God (Romans 12:1-2). However, the truth remains that a Christian is an absolute master over Satan and all his demons.

Prayer

Dear Father, I apply myself by the power of the Holy Spirit to the study and practice of Your Word for my maturity in Christ, to enjoy my mastery over Satan and all his demons in Jesus' name.

FRIDAY AUGUST 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE CHRISTIAN AND SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Ephesians 6:12 *"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."*

Beware of experience-based perspectives on spiritual warfare in Christianity arising from occultic information and not the scriptures. A simple scriptural understanding of the divine nature of the Christian will give you a clear understanding of real Christian spiritual warfare. Satan and his kingdom are not a bother to the mature Christians. They are focused on fulfilling God's assignment in life and being bothered, Satan and his demons go about trying various means to distract them. But being submitted to the will of their Father, the devil is resisted by their renewed mind, and he flees all the time (James 4:7). The story is difficult for the immature to whom Satan is a big problem because their unrenewed mind and fleshly lusts are a constant hold for Satan's control. So, while growing they must always be on the watch out for Satan and cast down imaginations that give him access to control their lives (1 Peter 5:8; 2 Corinthians 10:3-6). So, whether your spiritual warfare will be because you're a "headache" to Satan or he is a headache to you, is simply a matter of maturity.

Confession

Satan will never be a bother to me again; rather, by the power of the Holy Spirit I choose to mature until I become a serious "headache" to Satan, in Jesus' name.

SATURDAY AUGUST 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE CHRISTIAN AND DELIVERANCE FROM DEMONS

Mark 16:17 *"And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;"*

Scripturally speaking, one who believes in Jesus Christ is such an absolute master over Satan and his kingdom that it is inconsistent with his nature to speak of his deliverance from demons who by nature should fear him. However, as we have been discussing throughout the week, the unrenewed mind and the lustful body are open accesses to demonic control in the immature. The most effective and durable form of "deliverance" that an immature Christian needs is the preaching and teaching of the Word of God's grace. By the Word their minds get renewed as they discover who they are, what their abilities are and what they are entitled to in Christ. In addition, through fellowship with the Holy Spirit, they mature in the mortification of the flesh (Romans 8:13) and experience of bodily purification (1Thessalonians 5:23) to walk in the spirit. Where need be, the demonic influences can be cast out but after that the Word must be taught or else re-control through the unrenewed mind and lustful body is inevitable.

Confession

I am born again. I am an absolute master over Satan and his kingdom. I choose to mature rapidly and live as a natural expression of my dominion over Satan.

SUNDAY AUGUST 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Make the following confession and edify yourself along those lines as you speak fervently in other tongues. "I am born again. I am an absolute master over Satan and his kingdom. I choose to mature rapidly and live as a natural expression of my dominion over Satan."

MONDAY AUGUST 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PURSUE GOD'S AGENDA

Acts 26:19 *"Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision"*

It is important for every son or daughter of God to realize that there is a difference between ambition and purpose in life. When born into this world as humans, people develop strong desires to achieve different things in life based on certain cultural, environmental and societal standards. These are mere human ambitions. Purpose on the other hand is the desire in the hearts of God's children to achieve His plans for their lives. In other words, ambitions are purely human-generated and largely influenced by the ungodly systems of this world (2 Corinthians 4:4) but purpose is God originated, defined and revealed (Acts 26:19). A life that pursues God's agenda (the purpose of our being) not the humanly defined pursuits (2 Corinthians 5:15).

Topic: GIVE ATTENTION TO YOUR LIFE IN CHRIST

1 Corinthians 9:24 ***“Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain”***

An effective way to fulfilling God's purpose for your life begins with giving attention to your life in Christ. Coming into being as a son or daughter of God through the new birth was the greatest miracle that ever happened in your life because it made you a partaker of the divine nature of God (2 Peter 1:4). WEDNESDAY AUGUST 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: VALUE SPIRITUAL THINGS

Genesis 25:31-34 (BSB) "First sell me your birthright, Jacob replied. "Look" said Esau, I am about to die, so what good is a birthright to me? Swear to me first, Jacob said. So Esau swore to Jacob and sold him the birthright. Then Jacob gave some bread and lentil stew to Esau, who ate and drank and then got up and went away. Thus Esau despised his birthright."

The next important factor to the fulfillment of your divine assignment in life is your value of spiritual things. Life is spiritual. It takes a high value for spiritual things to finish well. As revealed in today's verse, Esau failed to maximize his place as the firstborn because he didn't value spiritual things. Moses on the other hand valued God's calling in his life above the pleasures of Egypt. He gave up the possible rise to become Pharaoh to fulfill God's calling (Hebrews 11:24-25). Esau exchanged his birthright for food. What are you unconsciously exchanging your calling in Christ for? Re-examine your value system and put first things first and you will maximize your divine potentials to fulfill divine assignment.

I am born of God and a divine being. I choose to value spiritual things more highly than any other in Jesus' name.

THURSDAY AUGUST 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DESIRE SPIRITUAL PROGRESS

Ephesians 3:15-19 *“...That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, ... And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God”*

Your life is a journey with many stages towards the ultimate successful point. Knowing that life is spiritual and valuing spiritual things are the initial steps to the fulfillment of your divine calling in life. It is important not to become comfortable with the fact that you are born again, occasionally serving in church and will one day have a reward in heaven. Remaining in that state for years can create a false sense of spiritual maturity when you are still a babe in spirit. Spend 15 minutes speaking fervently in other tongues to stir up or build upon your desire to make progress in the spirit.

FRIDAY AUGUST 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: COMMITMENT IS REQUIRED

Mark 8:35 (NLT) ***"If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will save it."***

The Christian life is one that is lived from a position of rest, but it does not equate to laziness. It requires hard work. The commitment for success in Christ involves hard work and discipline. It also involves letting go of seeming pleasures of the world and even certain things that may not be bad in themselves, but which will not help you to be a success in Christ. You must be ready to stand for the truth, ready to bring your body under, ready to think, talk and live exactly as the Holy Spirit directs you in the Word. You may be given names by others, tagged as being too "serious with this Christianity thing" but do not be perturbed. If you are pursuing success in Christ, you have an even greater cloud of witnesses cheering you on (Hebrews 12:1). Whatever it costs you cannot be compared to the eternal weight of glory. Don't give up. You are well able.

Topic: IT IS NOT IN VAIN

TUESDAY AUGUST 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE WORD IS NECESSARY FOR THE GOOD LIFE

Matthew 13:23 (TPT) *“But what was sown on good, rich soil represents the one who hears and fully embraces the message of the kingdom. Their lives bear good fruit—some yield a harvest of thirty, sixty, even one hundred times as much as was sown.”*

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 23

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WELCOME THE WORD

Matthew 13:23 (TPT) *“But what was sown on good, rich soil represents the one who hears and fully embraces the message of the kingdom. Their lives bear good fruit—some yield a harvest of thirty, sixty, even one hundred times as much as was sown.”*

The good life can only be enjoyed by putting God's Word to work. Putting the Word to work begins with accepting the Word. This means to be so persuaded that God's Word is what you really need that you assume an internal position that welcomes the Word as it comes to you. Welcoming the Word will bring you to that state of persuasion required to accept it.

THURSDAY AUGUST 24

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RECEIVE THE WORD

Acts 17:11 (BSB) *"Now the Bereans were more noble-minded than the Thessalonians, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if these teachings were true."*

When you accept the Word, it means you have opened yourself for the Word to come to you. After the Word has been accepted, the next stage of putting the Word of God to work is to receive the Word. This means giving so much credit to the Word that you become deeply convinced about, seize it and make it yours. Many people are casual with the Word and usually see it from a collective and general point of view. This approach will not bring to you what God's Word talks about. Believing is good but to enjoy the good life you must take it and make it yours. When something is yours, you do not doubt it. Receive God's Word because it is vital to your enjoyment of the good life.

FRIDAY AUGUST 25

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RELEASE THE WORD

Philippians 4:8 (BSB) *“Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think on these things.”*

Once you welcome and receive the Word of God as yours, the next step to engage in order to put the Word to work and realize its results in your life is to release the Word. Releasing the Word of God is also in three stages which are: think the Word, talk the Word and act the Word. How you think is key to your enjoyment of the good life. Thinking on the Word is the foundation to talking the Word. If you don't think on the Word, you disconnect its power to produce what you desire. Topic: THE FACTOR OF PATIENCE

Hebrews 10:36 (ERV) ***You must be patient. After you have done what God wants, you will get what he promised you.***

Patience is a virtue that is required if you want to see the results of God's work at work. Many times, people short circuit their miracle or that change they have long desired because they are not patient enough to see it come to pass. They disengage the power of the word that is at work.
