

FRIDAY DECEMBER 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT YOU DON'T FEAR, FEARS YOU

Romans 8:15 "*For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father*"

I have been amazed at how frequently the scriptures enjoin us to, "fear not". I later discovered that most of people's physical experiences were the result of their inner fears. Job said it in Job 3:25, "For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me". The fear of death was Satan's trick of keeping mankind in bondage for thousands of years. When you develop the basis not to fear something, naturally that thing begins to fear you. It is a principle of the invisible dimension that controls the physical world. But you cannot just get up and fear not. 1 John 4:4 *"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."*

MONDAY DECEMBER 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: UNDERSTANDING DIVINE HEALING

Mark 5: 26, 29 *"And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,...And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague"*

According to the scriptures, God's plan was for man in His image to be formed after His likeness and later adopted into the glory of sonship (Genesis 1:27; 26; Ephesians 1:4-5; Romans 8:29). There was no plan for disease, decay and death. These are the result of Adam's fall (Genesis 2:17). But even in the fall, it has been realized that the human body has an in-built self-healing mechanism that is very effective at restoring the body to a normal state of function. However, certain injuries and disease processes go beyond the natural ability of this healing system and require external augmentation. Divine healing is the process of supernaturally bringing about the healing of the body with the healing power of God. Divine healing can happen by augmenting the natural healing processes of the body (John 4:52) in which case it will be gradual or by totally superseding the natural healing process in which case it is a sudden miracle. In our scripture today, the woman instantly felt healing in her body by just touching Jesus' garment. This is divine healing.

Prayer

Thank You Daddy, that even in the face of the most debilitating health conditions that beggars the natural and medical healing mechanism, healing is available in Jesus' name.

TUESDAY DECEMBER 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU CAN EXPECT DIVINE HEALING

Psalms 103:3 "***Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases***

Sometimes people find out that there is sickness in certain parts of their body, and they wonder whether or not they can receive divine healing. Yes! Brother; yes, Sister! Divine healing is available for you, and you have the right to expect to experience it. You are not stupid or unreasonable if you desire divine healing. There is a strong basis for you to expect to receive divine healing. We have already learnt that disease, decay and death weren't part of the project of man. but everything including human bodies started malfunctioning after Adam got disconnected from God. After millennia of suffering the havoc that resulted from sin, the love of God sent Jesus to take away the sin of the world (John 1:29). Now if sickness came into the world through sin, then the taking away of sin, is a guarantee of the removal of sickness. So, the Psalmist exclaims "God forgives all iniquities and heals all diseases". The reason why people should expect to be divinely healed today is that the same death of Jesus that took away the sin of the world, also took away the sickness of the world. 1 Peter 2:24 says Jesus Himself bore the world's sins in His own body on the tree and by His stripes they are healed.

Prayer

Father, I thank You that healing is in the atonement of Christ. Being righteous in Christ, I am forever free from sickness. Divine health is at work in my body always in Jesus' name.

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IS DIVINE HEALING NECESSARY WHEN THERE ARE DOCTORS?

Mark 5:26 *"And had suffered many things of many physicians and had spent all that she had and was nothing bettered but rather grew worse"*

We are grateful for all the scientific discoveries that have augmented the natural healing system and brought healing to so many in this life. However, despite all the great work of medical science, there are always disease conditions that defy all medical treatments or are beyond current medical discoveries. As long as there are diseases beyond what all human efforts can ameliorate, people still need divine healing today as in the days of Jesus. It is a fact that science and other human ways of healings are inadequate to offset the human disease burden. People who trust so much in medical healing and even speak against divine healing only do so as long as they are healthy. If they are suddenly labeled with a medically incurable condition, they will either give up to die or start running helter-skelter looking for a remedy. Do not follow them. Believe in divine healing because it is still relevant today.

THURSDAY DECEMBER 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RECEIVING DIVINE HEALING

Matthew 9: 20-21 *"And, behold, a woman which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him and touched the hem of his garment: for she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole."*

Even though there are situations where the overflowing power of God can heal people who were not even ready for healing, the reception of divine healing depends more on the decision of the one who is sick. For instance, in John 5, the impotent man by the pool in Bethesda did not do anything special to be healed. Jesus passed by and knew that he had been there for a long time and by mercy healed him. This kind of healing is mostly the exception rather than the rule. That was the only one noted to have been healed at the pool. In Luke 4:40 however, all who were determined to receive healing and took a step to Jesus got healed. As seen in Matthew 9:20-21, the surest way is to determine in your heart to contact the healing power of God. This can be done through the Word (Proverbs 4:20-22), a Christian who can pray the prayer of faith (James 5:14-15), or a minister of Christ with the gift of healing (1 Corinthians 12:7-9).

Prayer

Thank You Daddy for making it possible for anyone to receive divine healing by a wholehearted personal determination through Your Word or Your ministers in Jesus' name. There is hope for the sick in this world through Jesus Christ.

FRIDAY DECEMBER 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IT IS NOT A “TRY AND SEE”

Matthew 9:21 *“For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.”*

On my personal journey from divine healing into divine health, I found out there's this stage that I can best describe as "try and see" when people desire divine healing. Now I can boldly tell you, that it takes a long time to experience total healing from a "try and see perspective" and many who are not determined enough, or patient enough do not see the manifestation of divine healing at this stage. It can be frustrating because you know you must be healed but the healing is not manifesting physically. In such cases what you need is to grow in your practice of receiving divine healing for every ailment that hits your body and deepening your scriptural convictions in the certainty of divine healing until you are definite of divine healing for any sickness. No doubt it happened suddenly. Divine healing is so real for any disease but not easily experienced with the "try and see" approach.

SATURDAY DECEMBER 9

Topic: LIVE IN HEALTH

Proverbs 4: 20-22 *"My son attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them and health to all their flesh."*

To know that divine healing is readily available and accessible is great news to the sick. However, the more refreshing news is that you can live in health. Even if you received divine healing for any illness, you must learn to live in divine health. The surest way to do this is seeding God's Word on health into your spirit through meditation. The bible says the Word is medicine to all your flesh. Wow! The Word of God is the most effective daily supplement you need to keep you healthy. Though God is everywhere, one of the reasons why we go to church is to worship God. That corporate atmosphere enhances our focus on God and deepens our communion with Him. 

TUESDAY DECEMBER 19**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION****Topic: JESUS IS GOD MANIFESTED IN FLESH**

John 1:14 (NLT) *“So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father’s one and only Son.”*

The essence of man is the life in his spirit, though he has a soul and lives in body. Jesus in spiritual analysis was a body of cells from Mary covering a spirit and soul from God containing the life of the Word at a human level. Jesus was the separation of God’s Word in a personality wearing the body God prepared for Him from Mary (Hebrews 10:5). So, though He was walking in the world as a human He was one of His kind - the only begotten (John 1:14). Thinking that Jesus was a normal human as anyone else, is the greatest mistake a person can ever make on earth. For unlike all humans from Adam & Eve, whose lives result from human sperm and egg, Jesus’ life never came from the seed of a man. The life in the eternal Word (John 1:4) released at the human level of being was what got clothed with a body prepared from Mary to be the Jesus of Nazareth we read about in the gospels. Jesus of Nazareth was actually God’s matured man living as the manifestation of God in a human body (1 Timothy 3:16).

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTIONAL

Topic: THE POSSIBILITY OF JESUS

Philippians 2:7 (ERV) *“Instead, he gave up everything, even his place with God. He accepted the role of a servant, appearing in human form. During his life as a man,”*

Because the human mind is used to a lot of impossibilities, there are people who are always racking their brains to unravel what they think of as the impossibility of God becoming a man. Relax! God is God and He can do anything (Mark 10:27) and the good news is that He showed us how. Philippians 2:7 says this Word which in the beginning was with God and was God, gave up everything, even His place with God, accepted the role of a servant and appeared in human form during His life as a man. This is what we meant when we stated yesterday that the life of the eternal Word was released at the human level of being. That is why in many cases Jesus of Nazareth plainly stated the superiority of God the Father to Himself (John 5:30; 14:28; 20:17) and had to be exalted to His pre-incarnated divine glory (John 17:5; Philippians 2:9). So, Jesus of Nazareth is possible. In other words, the Word of God becoming flesh is possible and that is who Jesus was. Glory to God.

Worship

Father, I worship Your greatness because all things are possible with You, even Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Wow!

THURSDAY DECEMBER 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE NECESSITY OF JESUS OF NAZARETH

Hebrews 2:14 (NLT) *“Because God’s children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death.”*

Without spiritual insight people wonder why God had to go through the “complex” process of becoming flesh. But the Word becoming human as Jesus of Nazareth was necessary for the following reasons. Firstly, God’s justice demanded a sinless representative of the human race to take away their sins through death (Hebrews 2:9). If the Word came in the fullness of divinity as God without condescending to the human level, He couldn’t have taken the sin of mankind upon Himself, died for mankind and entered the regions of death to abolish death (2 Timothy 1:10). Secondly, it was to show the world how God’s matured spiritual mankind was intended to be (John 1:14). If Adam and Eve had not fallen, they would have been formed into God’s likeness (Genesis 1:26) as matured spiritual mankind as Jesus Christ of Nazareth was. This is what mankind was intended to become (Romans 5:14; 1 Corinthians 15:45-46). Finally, it became a means accomplishing God’s predestined adoption of mankind (Ephesians 1:4-5).

Worship

Father, I worship You for Your immeasurable love for the world that made Jesus of Nazareth a necessity for the salvation of mankind, in Jesus’ Name.

Topic: JESUS IS GOD'S LOVE REVEALED

John 3:16 ***"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."***

Luke 2:20 *"And shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen as it was told unto them."*

The scriptures tell us that when the shepherds found Jesus Christ by divine direction, they returned with celebration - glorifying and praising God. WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 27

Topic: INTENTIONS OF THE INCARNATION

Luke 2:14 "*Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace, good will toward men.*"

We have understood that Christmas is a celebration born out of the understanding of the reality and purpose of the incarnation- which is the Word became flesh. In Christianity, incarnation is the process of the eternal Word and God in John 1:1, becoming flesh in John 1:14 at the human level in the person of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. This is not reincarnation because there is nothing like that in the scriptures. Luke 2:14 reveals to us the two important divine intentions of the Word becoming flesh in the person of Jesus. Dear Father, being fully awakened to the truth of my righteousness and that I am a new creature in Christ, makes me celebrate Christmas with shouts of joy. Gooorrryyy!

THURSDAY DECEMBER 28

Topic: THE BEST GIFT GOD GAVE

Luke 2: 14 *“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men”*

Jesus Christ is the best gift that God gave to mankind. We have learnt also, the two-fold intention of His incarnation and for that matter Christmas: peace and good will toward men. Today we will look at the first, which is peace.
