THURSDAY FEBRUARY 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYING EFFECTIVELY – II

Matthew 6:6 (NIV) *“But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.”*

Achieving spiritual focus in prayer is the greatest secret to praying effectively. In our verse today, the reason for going into your room, closing the door and praying to your Father, who is unseen, isn't to make prayer secretive but to enhance focus. Prayer is a spiritual activity and since we must be 'prayers' to have effective lives on earth, it means we must practice till we master focus in prayer. Common distractions in prayer are bodily, mental and environmental. At times, anxiety or worry concerning the very things being prayed about become distractions to focus. Apart from planning to minimize bodily and mental distractions, one way to master focus in prayer is learning to pray for long. The longer you keep your focus in the spiritual realm, the more it stays with you. If prayer means much to you, you will apply yourself to the discipline of long prayers to master focus. Selah!

I receive the grace for the discipline for long prayer in order to develop focus in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CONSISTENCY IN PRAYER

Matthew 6:11 "*Give us this day our daily bread.*"

The dominant need-consciousness of many people has hidden the truth of this verse from many who only see it as an affirmation to ask God daily for physical needs. Jesus was however, restating the principle behind the daily going out to collect manna as was instructed in the wilderness (Exodus 16:21). Why wouldn't the Lord allow them to gather more manna than was required for that day? It wasn't really about manna but a daily consistent communion with God. If you are really serious about your life in Christ, do all to grow beyond praying and missing some days. Develop the habit of effectively praying everyday including the days you go for Church fellowships. Consistency is the seed for incessant fellowship in the Godhead (Acts 2:25; 1 Thessalonians 5:17). Even if it is just 30 minutes a day, doing it daily is better than hours of inconsistent praying. I write as an elder on this subject. Selah!

SATURDAY FEBRUARY 3

Topic: START TODAY

John 13:27 “*And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.*”

This is a very interesting verse to learn from today, isn't it? Haha. Anyway, the divine principle here is obvious. Whatever you have determined to do, do not delay. All that you have learnt this week will not move you forward one bit in life if you do not act on it now. SUNDAY FEBRUARY 4

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY FEBRUARY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY THE “CONTROVERSIES” ON GIVING

Exodus 6:3 *“And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.”*

I have often observed with amusement when people with Biblical convictions contend with each other and even with worldly people about Biblical doctrines as if there are controversies in the Bible. In our verse today, God tells Abraham, my name is, “El-Shaddai”, then centuries later He tells Moses my name is, “Jehovah”. Has God changed? Of course not, because He changes not (Malachi 3:6). It is just a progressive revelation of Himself. I keep saying plainly that there is no controversy in the Bible. What often appears to be controversial is either due to God’s dealings with people based on their maturity or state of heart or the progressive revelation of Himself. It is the lack of knowledge concerning the three Biblical levels of giving that accounts for all the global hullabaloo concerning all forms of giving in Church. Are you ready to know them? Get set for tomorrow’s devotional teaching.

Intercession

Pray fervently in other tongues or with your understanding that these liberating truths will transform the entire earth through the body of Christ.

TUESDAY FEBRUARY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEVELS OF GIVING - I

Romans 15:27 (NLT) *“They were glad to do this because they feel they owe a real debt to them. Since the Gentiles received the spiritual blessings of the Good News from the believers in Jerusalem, they feel the least they can do in return is to help them financially.”*

The first level of Biblical giving is giving as a babe. It can be termed carnal giving or giving under obligation. According to Romans 15:26, the believers in Macedonia and Achaia eagerly took up offerings for the poor among the believers in Jerusalem and verse 27 says, “because they feel they owe a real debt to them”. What a reason to give. Yet it is the Father’s way of dealing with babes in Christ. So, if a preacher is heard saying, “If I have sown unto you spiritual things, let me reap your carnal things”, you will hear grumblings, “he’s a charlatan, he wants our money etc.” But he is actually blameless according to 1 Corinthians 9:11. If you have the “feeling” to give to a preacher or someone just because you “feel” you owe it to them, you are not wrong and do not condemn someone who feels so. The Good Life Devotion is only presenting plain scriptural truths and giving you understanding that even the Father is okay with them though that is not the ultimate.

Celebration

Oh Dear Father, I celebrate You for this teaching because it is the truth and has nothing to do with carnal feelings. Be praised forever in Jesus’ Name.

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEVELS OF GIVING – II

2 Corinthians 9:6 *“But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.”*

The second level of Biblical giving is giving as a spiritual “adolescent”. It can be termed giving by faith or giving as an engagement of the earthly principle of sowing and reaping. Though addressing the same giving to the poor in Jerusalem, yet in 2 Corinthians 9, it wasn't from the perspective of an obligation but of the principle of sowing and reaping. The Bible is clear that as long as the earth remains, that principle is active (Genesis 8:22) and anyone who positively engages it will get the results. It really doesn't have anything to do with being blessed or cursed because the state of blessing is a gift in Christ (Ephesians 1:3). However, if someone interprets the results of the yield of sowing as a blessing and its absence as a curse as it was under the Old Testament, he is not wrong. If someone cheerfully gives to the poor, or gives offerings, tithes, firsfruits etc., as seeds sown, you can't stop his harvest. Again, the Good Life Devotion is only presenting plain scriptural truths and giving you understanding that even the Father is okay with this too though that is not the ultimate.

Prayer

Thank You Father for the truth of Your Word. I actively engage the principles of giving cheerfully according to Your Word even as I mature unto giving in perfection.

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEVELS OF GIVING – III

Genesis 12:2-3 (CEB) ***"I will make of you a great nation and will bless you. I will make your name respected, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, those who curse you I will curse; all the families of the earth will be blessed because of you."***

The third level of Biblical giving is giving as a matured son or daughter of God. It can be termed giving as an expression of your God-being. This is God's ultimate level of giving for His sons in Christ. At this level, one does not give as an obligation but an expression of the divine nature of love to people and honour to the Father (Proverbs 3:9). Yes, it is no more giving as a means of getting to increase, but a discharge of our blessed nature into our world because we are the result of the above promise of the Father to Abraham (Galatians 3:29; Ephesians 1:3; 2 Peter 1:2-3). This is the level of being the express manifestation of the spiritual state of possessing all grace in abundance to always have all sufficiency in all things to abound to every good work (2 Corinthians 9:8). One goal of the Good Life Devotion is to bring the body of Christ to this state of giving through matured teachings.

Confession

Oh Dear Holy Ghost, I receive grace to rapidly mature in the truth to arrive at giving as a God-being, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU NEED THE PROCESS

1 Corinthians 13:11 *"When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things."*

If you are born of God, giving is your nature and you will only get confused if you try to suppress it. So, put aside emotional attachment to denominational doctrines on giving and embrace these plain scriptural truths, and rapidly mature in this area. Even God our Father, knowing that His ultimate goal is to get you to where you are an inexhaustible blessing to your world, is patient to allow you to go through the maturity process. This is the conclusion, "Depending on your current level of maturity, confidently and cheerfully engage all the scriptural kinds of giving (to the poor, offerings, tithes, first fruits, kingdom projects etc.) - 2 Corinthians 9:7. Then, gradually you will put away giving by obligation, followed by giving by faith, as you mature to give as a blessing. All the stages are necessary. The one who hasn't learnt to give as an obligation will never master it enough to give by faith. The one who hasn't let go so much by faith cannot step into the experience of being an inexhaustible blessing.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I stir up every ability to give with confidence and joy at my current level until I grow beyond it.

SATURDAY FEBRUARY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: NO MORE JUDGEMENT

Romans 14:4 “Who art thou that judgest another man's servant? to his own master he standeth or falleth. Yea, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand.”

From today when you see or hear people contending and defending doctrines on giving according to their understanding, just relax, smile and reserve your spiritual and emotional energy. They are talking from their level of maturity. Judge none of them but rather assist them to also get this truth and become settled as you are. The principles of giving in both the Old and New Testaments are the same before God. How God prescribed them to the people, the reward systems attached, and the names given are all not the issue. What really matters is God's overarching plan of getting His children to function as joint heirs of His universal estate with our Lord Jesus Christ. It is not about these meager and quantifiable human offerings, tithes, firstfruits etc. The new creation in Christ is actually the actualization of God's dream to administer His blessing to all creation (Ephesians 1:3) and must urgently mature into that by “heavy givings”.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I boldly affirm that as a new creature in Christ I am a heavy, confident and cheerful giver from today. Hallelujah.

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY FEBRUARY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOU ARE DIVINE IN CHRIST

1 John 5:1 “Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: ...”

When someone receives Christ, something real actually takes place. It is not a mere agreement to the gospel message, forgiveness of sins or recital of a prayer. It is a begetting by God in a spiritual process of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5). The scriptures testify that it is a second birth (1 Peter 1:3), a birth of the spirit (John 3:6) and a birth by God Himself which is different from the human birth by blood, flesh and will of man (John 1:12-13). Hebrews 6:1 (GW) *“With this in mind, we should stop going over the elementary truths about Christ and move on to topics for more mature people. We shouldn't repeat the basics about turning away from the useless things we did and the basics about faith in God.”*

Every one of us has our understanding of the walk in Christ framed by the perspective of the gospel that is first presented to us and the dominant teachings of the church we start fellowshipping with. THURSDAY FEBRUARY 15

Topic: PRACTICE DIVINITY - I

1 Corinthians 1:9 (Voice) *“Count on this: God is faithful and in His faithfulness called you out into an intimate relationship with His Son, our Lord Jesus the Anointed.”*

Human babies are born fully human with ten toes, two legs, two eyes and so on, yet they are immature humans. When they grow, they do not become more human but rather mature to function as the humans they are. Similarly, every one of us comes into being in Christ as fully divine beings in the nature of our Father. But we must grow into fully functioning sons of God in the full measure of Christ. In Christ, we mature in our divinity by practicing our divinity. The first means of practicing our divinity is learning to live in the communion of the Godhead. This is our calling in Christ. Psalm 25:16 (GNB) ***“Turn to me Lord and be merciful to me, because I am lonely and weak.”***

Loneliness is a human state of feeling sad, helpless or hopeless because there are no people around. Sometimes, the feeling of loneliness grips people even when people are around but are not satisfying their expectations of them. Thus, loneliness is more of an emotional state than a physical state of being alone. As an internal environment, loneliness creates and attracts negative thoughts that work against the positive drive of a person's life. Loneliness doesn't belong to sons of God because it is an impossibility. If you were living in loneliness or experienced it from time to time, this is your week of truth to enable you to live forever above loneliness. Are you ready?

TUESDAY FEBRUARY 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ALONE BUT NOT LONELY

John 16:32 *"Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me."*

Loneliness is a purely human experience that should never happen in the lives of sons and daughters of God. The impossibility of loneliness to those in Christ is in the truth that we are inseparably one with God - 1 Corinthians 6:17; 1 John 4:15. People may desert us for many reasons and though you may physically be alone, yet you can never be lonely because we are always in a divine community - John 14:20. We cannot be deserted enough to feel sad, helpless or hopeless by human disappointments. Jesus made this clear in our verse above. Yes, it is possible for us to be alone because people are physically not around us, but we are never lonely because we are forever in a divine community. Glory!

Confession

I am in an eternal union with the Godhead; therefore, I am never lonely if even all men desert me. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IN CHRIST, THERE'S NO LONELINESS

Romans 14:17 "*For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.*"

Anyone who has truly received Christ is a son of God begotten into the kingdom of the Father - 1 John 1:12; John 3:3,6. He has become wired into union with the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:13, 6:17). This beautiful and amazing Holy Spirit is a being of everlasting positive energy of joy, so he becomes saturated with this joy unspeakable in the kingdom of our Father. This is called the joy of the Holy Ghost. Whoops! What this means is that his emotional base is of such a highly positive energy that the weak, corrupt and hopeless emotions of loneliness cannot survive around. If he remains full of the Spirit or incessantly communing with Him, loneliness is no possibility. The joy of the Lord constantly keeps him strengthened irrespective of happenings around in the physical. Embrace this truth - in Christ, there is really no loneliness.

Confession

I refuse to ever experience loneliness because I am infused with the joy of the Holy Ghost as my nature, in every circumstance of life in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LONELINESS OF PEOPLE IN CHRIST

Romans 8:13 *"For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live."*

Though loneliness is a purely human experience there are people in Christ who still experience it. How? The sin-ruled bodies in which our past human selves lived, were programmed into the practice of fallen humanity like loneliness, sinful acts, sickness, etc. By receiving Christ, those bodies of sin got crucified (Romans 6:6; Galatians 5:24) yet they left illusory perceptions around our consciousness as if they were still real and present. With a renewed mind concerning one's new nature in Christ, these illusory perceptions get neutralized by the spirit. Otherwise, people succumb to them in their minds, and then physical real experiences result. This is the only way loneliness occurs in people in Christ - they succumb to the illusory perceptions of their past human selves instead of aborting them by the spirit.

Confession

By my new divine nature in Christ, I constantly neutralize every illusory perception of the body and soul in the Name of Jesus.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 23

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DANGERS OF LONELINESS – I

Proverbs 15:13 "*A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.*"

There is nothing good about loneliness. It is only one negative repercussion to another. When people don't know the dangers of loneliness, they like to play and pamper loneliness thinking it will bring them some sympathy. One major danger of loneliness is sickness. A person's vigor in soul and body is driven by the liveliness of his spirit. In the sad or sorrowful state of loneliness, a person's spirit is broken. In other words, the lightness, excitement and vigor of spirit has evaporated. When this happens, the body loses vitality, and any disease can begin to thrive. Simply put, "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones" - Proverbs 17:22. Don't exchange your precious health for loneliness, it is not worth it.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I refuse to cheaply sell my precious health to loneliness. I'm out of its coverage area forever!

SATURDAY FEBRUARY 24

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DANGERS OF LONELINESS – II

Psalm 25:16 "*Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted.*"

Another dangerous result of loneliness is depression. The Psalmist in the above verse said he was desolate and afflicted. The Hebrew rendering of that phrase means to be lonely and depressed in mind or circumstances. Loneliness easily leads to depression which is an unpleasant mental state of persistent sadness and a lack of interest or pleasure in previously rewarding or enjoyable activities. Normal sleep and appetite patterns can be disturbed resulting in tiredness and poor concentration. Ultimately reduced productivity in all normal life activities will result. We can go on and on but suffice it to say that there is nothing good about the experience of loneliness. Maximize your being in Christ, never to experience it.

Psalms 45:6 "*Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre.*"

Kingdom is the governing system comprising a sovereign being wielding the governing influence over his territory. This sovereign being is called a king and the territory is often referred to as his domain of influence. Technically, kingdom is kind of a derivative from king and domain. In simple terms, a kingdom is all that has to do with a king and his domain. Ultimately, all kingdoms anywhere in creation are headed up in God our Father in Christ Jesus. Colossians 1:16-17 NLT says, "... He made the things we can see and the things we can't see— such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world" and Romans 13:1 NLT says, "...For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God." So, when a being is of a caliber that has inherent or delegated governing influence over a realm, there is kingdom.

Topic: HUMANS ARE KINGDOM BEINGS

Genesis 1:26 *"And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth."*

Topic: THE LOST KINGDOM

Luke 4:5-6 *“And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.”*

According to our Father God's plan, humans were created to be the sovereign beings on earth (Genesis 1:26; Psalm 115:16). But humans lost the kingdom through Adam and Eve, who yielded to obey Satan instead of God (Romans 6:16). Satan became the prince of the world (John 14:30) and humans his subjects (Hebrews 2:14). Having taken over the human position of sovereignty, he colonized the earth realm with his evil influence through the same humans whose hearts he controlled (Ephesians 2:2). Jesus Christ spoke a lot about God's kingdom because He was going to displace the devil and reinstate humans to their place of sovereignty by His death and resurrection (John 12:31). Humans lost their earthly kingdom in Adam but regained it in Jesus Christ.

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 29

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RE-COLONIZING THE EARTH - I

Romans 5:17 (CEV) *“Death ruled like a king because Adam had sinned. But that cannot compare with what Jesus Christ has done. God has treated us with undeserved grace, and he has accepted us because of Jesus. And so, we will live and rule like kings.”*

That Jesus Christ displaced Satan's kingdom on earth, appears incredible to many because they think God's kingdom should have physically taken over the earth once Jesus Christ rose from the dead. But it is not so because earthly power is given to humans (Psalm 115:16) and it takes the cooperation of humans to colonize the earth with any influence whether good or evil. Even when Satan received the authority from Adam and Eve, it took several centuries to colonize a significant portion of the earth to warrant the judgment of Noah's flood. After Jesus Christ rose again from the dead, He instituted a re-colonization process which starts with getting human hearts to align with God's kingdom (Matthew 28:18-19). This is the secret of preaching the gospel to beget men into the kingdom through the new birth (John 3:3).

Intercession

Pray in the Name of Jesus Christ, speaking forth the intense activation of the effective preaching of the gospel all around the world by the power of the Holy Ghost.

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

A wholehearted belief and an acknowledgement/confession. Believe that Jesus is the one whose resurrection from the dead made mankind's adoption as God's sons/daughters possible and acknowledge His Lordship. To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
