FRIDAY MARCH 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RE-COLONIZING THE EARTH – II

Galatians 4:1-2 *“Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.”*

QUESTION: According to Matthew 7:7, it says “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened to you:” Now my question is, what are we to ask or to seek or which door are we to knock? **Rev Elisha Agbonyitor** (Ghana)

RESPONSE: John 14:13 *“And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.”*

Jesus revealed an outstanding principle in Matthew 7:7-11 about the Father’s willingness to give them what they needed. Asking and seeking were different dimensions of approaching something needed. The dimension of praying from the Greek word “aiteō” which strictly means making a demand of something due, was used. Concerning seeking, the dimension of praying in which one searches for something hidden was used. It is the Greek word “zēteō”. Concerning knocking, the Greek word “krouō” which means to rap or to audibly knock is used. Expounding later to His disciples, Jesus clarified that what to ask, seek and knock for is “whatsoever”. It is a blank cheque because everything pertaining to life and godliness has already been given to us (2 Peter 1:3).

TUESDAY MARCH 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PURPOSE AND ITS FULFILLMENT

QUESTION: Hello Dr. Bindan, God richly bless you for the Good Life Devotion. I have been so blessed by your messages. My question is, as a son of God, how do I discover the purpose of God for my life and how do I fulfill that purpose after discovering it. Thank you. **Frank Yeboah (Ghana)**

RESPONSE: Psalm 25:14 *"The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant."*

After predestining mankind unto adoption as sons in Jesus Christ, He chose us in Him to be holy and unblemished in His presence in love (Ephesians 1:4-5). This is the ultimate purpose of each son of God - to attain a state of consciousness of our eternal holiness, righteousness and incessant fellowship of love in Him. WEDNESDAY MARCH 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE FULLNESS OF GOD

QUESTION: Is the fullness of God the same as the attributes of God as in omnipotent (all powerful), omniscient (all knowing) and omnipresent (everywhere at the same time)? My question is, is the new creature in Christ all powerful, all knowing and everywhere at the same time according to your recent teachings about the born again having the fullness of God? (2 Peter 1:4). Please can you tell us the difference between fullness and attributes? **Pastor Anthony Oduro (Ghana)**

RESPONSE: 1 John 4:15 "*Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.*"

What is referred to as attributes, are dimensions of God's transcendent nature revealed as inherent characteristics of His nature. No one can fully enumerate the attributes of God. They constitute what the Bible describes as the fullness of God. Now, concerning the maturity of the sons of God into the realization of the fullness of God, we must appreciate that when God makes His abode in us in Christ, He doesn't come in bits and pieces of His nature. He dwells in us in the fullness of His nature comprising all His attributes. The Bible says, the full load of deity dwells in Christ and we are complete in Him (Colossians 2:9-10) and He said, "that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God" - Ephesians 3:19. In other words all that God is in His divine DNA dwells in His sons and daughters, and it is His will that we mature to express Him in full.

Confession

Oh glory to God! The fullness of God dwells in me, and I am growing to fully manifest God in every area of my life in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY MARCH 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FORGIVENESS AND REMISSION

QUESTION: Sir, what is the difference between forgiveness and remission of sins? **Ebenezer Jesse Abban (Ghana)**

RESPONSE: Ephesians 1:7 *"In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace."*

Forgiveness and remission are synonyms from the same root word "aphesis" in Greek which simply means pardon or freedom from the consequence of sin. Because they are interchangeably used the difference is only noticed in God's dealings. If it is freedom from the consequence of sin without the removal of the sin, it is generally known as forgiveness as was predominant in the Old Testament. So, though they were pardoned, the sins were not taken away, they were remembered yearly (Hebrews 10:4). On the other hand, as predominantly stated in the New Testament, when there is freedom from sin because it has been taken away and wouldn't be remembered anymore, it is generally known as remission. This is what Jesus procured once for all for the whole world by His death and resurrection (John 1:29). Today, remission of sins is already available, people only need to receive it and get awakened to life in Christ (Acts 26:18).

Confession

I am a new creature, a product of the remission of sins in Christ Jesus for the world. Glory, hallelujah!

FRIDAY MARCH 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FAITH VERSUS TEMPTING GOD

QUESTION: What is the difference between Jesus' second temptation, where he was told to jump off the temple and when a believer, who is facing challenges, stands on the Word and takes a decision of resolution, which in the eyes of all is utterly risky?

RESPONSE: Matthew 4:6-7 "*... Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.*"

Jesus knew He was the Son of God, so there was no need proving it to Satan. Whether an action based on God's Word will be a temptation or "faith" is determined by the motive and maturity of the one involved. If the motive is to prove a point or to get God to act, it is presumption and tempting God. But if it is the appropriate response according to God's Word, it is reality and not a temptation. When it is "risky" to you, but you want to go ahead it is temptation but when it is in the peace of the reality of God's Word in you, it is not. To some, exposure to Covid patients was risky so if they did, they might have died but to us, it was the appropriate Word-based response of matured sons of God. Hence the people got healed and we never got it.

Dear Father, I receive grace to mature in Your Word and to act in reality and never in presumption, in Jesus' Name.

SATURDAY MARCH 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: UNIQUENESS OF EACH CHILD

QUESTION: Pastor, you once said "each child is unique" in one of your teachings about children. Can you shed some more light on that Sir, with regards to raising children? **Ghang Cidwine (Cameroon)**

RESPONSE: Jeremiah 1:5 *"Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations."*

The glory of God is so transcendently multi-dimensional. Every one of His creations is a revelation of an aspect of His glory and so it is with every human spirit dispatched from Him into a conceptus on earth. This divine uniqueness is what is revealed as individual differences in DNA fingerprints. The uniqueness of every individual is expressed in the way they look, understand, respond and even behave. Things that steal from humans the quality of life God ordained for them, ultimately kill and destroy their lives. TUESDAY MARCH 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE LIFE JESUS GAVE

1 John 5:11 *"And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son."*

We know now that Jesus came into this world, to give life. The next important thing is to know which life He came to give because humans, animals and so on were "living" when He came. To understand this, we must first realize that what differentiates the various classes of God's living creatures is the kind of life they were given by Him. So, human life is what differentiates humans from animals and angels. Our verse today clearly states that the life Jesus came to give is called eternal life. What is eternal life? According to the scriptures, eternal life is the God-kind of life. The very life of God the Father Himself (John 5:26). It's amazing but true that Jesus entered into the human world, to impart God's kind of life into the human species (1 John 5:11-12).

WEDNESDAY MARCH 13

FRIDAY MARCH 15

Topic: AN INCREDIBLE REALITY

1 John 5:11 "*And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.*"

This is God's record, "that He has given us eternal life". That means all of life (1 John 1:1-2) which is His very kind of life (John 5:26). Now Jesus testifies that He came to give us this life in fullness. And of His fullness have we all received. Hahaa! Testimony





GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HUMANIZED GODS

1 Corinthians 3:3 ***"For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?"***

MONDAY MARCH 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MINISTERING TO GOD

QUESTION: What does it mean to minister to the Lord? **Jeffrey Akuoko Frimpong (Ghana)**

RESPONSE: Acts 13:2 *“As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.”*

The word “ministered” as used in the verse above, is from a Greek Word that generally means to render public service to the state or to a king or to do a service of priests in the temple. In our context, the aspect of rendering service or ministry to God is what was being referred to. In Christ, this means offering spiritual sacrifices to God our Father by Jesus Christ as a holy priesthood (1 Peter 2:5). Generally speaking, whatever we do to express our divinity directly towards God or indirectly towards our brethren in Christ or people of the world as part of our worship relationship with our Father, is a ministry to God. But in prayer it means loving, worshiping and praising Him. Hebrews 13:15 defines it by saying, “By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name”.

Worship

Oh everlasting Father, You're amazingly lovely and gracious and I worship You forever in Jesus' Name.

TUESDAY MARCH 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: EFFECTIVE MEDITATION

QUESTION: How can one meditate effectively on a scriptural truth to achieve the intended results? **Ghang Cidwine (Cameroon)**

RESPONSE: 1 Timothy 4:15 ***"Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all"***

Meditation is the spiritual exercise of ascending from a person's current state of spiritual consciousness into the position of a scriptural truth in his consciousness. In other words, it means intentionally thinking through the reality of a scriptural truth until you assume that state in your consciousness and repeating it until it becomes the unconscious drive of your thoughts, speech and actions. I have often taught that according to the Hebrew word "hâgâh" as used in Joshua 1:8, meditation practically involves the steps of pondering, imagining, muttering and speaking out the realities locked up in a scripture. So to effectively meditate on a scriptural truth to achieve the intended goal, just think through it enough in the light of present truth until you assume its reality in your thoughts, speech and actions.

Confession

I boldly confess that by the Holy Spirit, I have mastered the exercise of meditation in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 20
GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ASKING IN JESUS' NAME

QUESTION: According to John 14:14 Jesus says, "If you shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.", The same Jesus said in John 5:30 "I can of my own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not my own will, but the will of the Father which has sent me." What did Jesus want us to ask in His name? If as stated in John 5:30, He can of His own self do nothing; why did He say we should ask anything in His name, and He will do it? **Rev Joshua Agbonyitor (Ghana)**

RESPONSE: John 14:14, *"If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it."*

First of all, this was in a conversation from John 14:12-14 in which Jesus stated that He was going to the Father after which we could ask anything in His Name and have it accomplished. Jesus meant you can ask anything. In His Name is much more than asking in the authority of His Name. It also means asking in His stead. Meaning asking as Him because as He is, so are you in this world. Secondly, the statement in John 5:30, was emphasizing more of working in union with the Father than the lack of ability. He was stressing the truth that it was impossible for Him to do anything without the Father because of His oneness with Him (John 10:30) and constant consciousness of Him (John 3:13; Acts 2:25).

Prayer

I receive wisdom to ask anything in the Name of Jesus and have it established.

THURSDAY MARCH 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RESPONDING TO THE WORD

QUESTION A pastor once said, “we should learn to respond to God's Word”, please how is that done Sir? **Ghang Cidwine (Cameroon)**

RESPONSE: Hebrews 4:2 *“For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.”*

When God brings us His Word, either as we read the Bible, receive ministrations from our shepherds or other brethren, He does so, on purpose. His Word comes to us to accomplish specific assignments. But our reception and attitude towards His Word, will determine whether it will be of none effect (Mark 7:13) or become productive as always (Isaiah 55:11). Our primary response is to take God at His Word until we think, talk and act according to it. In our main verse, the Word was unprofitable to them because they didn't respond to it (mix it with faith). Apart from this, some people are quite Charismatic at responding to the Word with nodding, clapping, shouts of hallelujah, amen and so on while others respond by showing no obvious emotions but a rapt attention. Whichever way, receiving God's Word and meditating on it until we think, talk and act by it, is the ultimate response to God's Word.

Confession

By the power of the Holy Spirit, I positively respond to every Word of my Father that comes to me in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY MARCH 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MINISTERING TO GOD

QUESTION: Please how does God receive? Sometimes I “feel” even our praises may not even “touch” Him or may never be enough to ‘satisfy’ Him. Emefa Ghunney (Accra, Ghana)

RESPONSE: John 4:24 ***“God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”***

God is a spirit being. How does He receive our offerings, our praise, our thanksgiving and so on? All the means of ministering to God are physical avenues of generating and transmitting spiritual signals. When these signals are according to His Word from the right state of heart and consciousness, they resonate with what they mean to Him. For instance, in Genesis 8:21 the signal that Noah’s offering generated was communicated as “And the LORD smelled a sweet savour...” What really does that mean? It is a spiritual communication of the signal of the chord that the sacrifice struck. God doesn’t spend money, drink blood, listen to music as done in the physical but responds to the spiritual signals that these things generate as He ordained.

Topic: INHERITANCES IN CHRIST

QUESTION: In Ephesians 1:13-14, the Holy Spirit is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance and in 1 Peter 1:3-4, according to His great mercy, He gave us a new birth to an incorruptible and undefiled and unfading inheritance. What are these inheritances?

RESPONSE: Ephesians 1:11 *"In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will."*

The scriptures speak of our inheritance in Christ from various perspectives. To properly understand it, consider a son and a neighbour's son. A person can enumerate some things as gifts to his neighbour's son but concerning his son, everything in the house belongs to him. So, instead of trying to figure out our inheritance one after the other, realize that inheriting sonship in Christ, makes us heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ (Romans 8:16-17). From Ephesians 1:5, it is the adoption into sonship that we were predestined to, according to the Father's good will. So, our prime inheritance is our sonship in Christ and it gives us access to all other inheritance in the kingdom of our Father.

The world is so poisoned with the wrong notion of the impossibility of holiness that if one Christian were to declare today, “I am holy”, others including Christians will call him a braggart or hypocrite. Many are even deceived to think that the human adage, “To err is human” is scriptural. Brethren in Christ, let it settle with you that holiness is an easy possibility for everyone in Christ Jesus. Holiness is possible because God the Father plainly said it. How could God’s Word plainly say, “be ye holy in all manner of conversation” when He knows no one can live a holy life? When the authority of the scriptures as God’s Word settles in your heart, you’ll suddenly believe without an iota of doubt that holiness is an easy possibility because God says so.

Ephesians 1:4 *“According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.”*

Allow all the strongholds of the falsehood about the impossibility of holiness to dissolve in your life by the power of the truth being shared this week. Another clear indicator that holiness is possible is that the Father chose us to be holy even before the world began. How can God the omniscient and the almighty choose us to be something that we cannot be. One may argue that the fall of Adam and Eve brought corruption into the human nature and made it impossible to live holy. But that is half-truth because whatever Adam brought to mankind in the fall, Jesus' death and resurrection canceled. Hence Romans 5:19 (TPT) says, “One man's disobedience opened the door for all humanity to become sinners. So also, one man's obedience opened the door for many to be made perfectly right with God and acceptable to him”. As the new door to holiness everyone in Christ, can be holy.

Confession

Because I am in Christ, holiness is not just a possibility but my daily living with ease in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 27

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOLINESS IS POSSIBLE – III

1 Peter 2:9 *“But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.”*

Apart from the definite pointers mentioned so far, the most concrete basis for holiness with ease as far as the sons of God are concerned is that we are holy beings. We are God's holy workmanship in Christ Jesus. Our Father reveals to us in our verse that in Christ, we are a holy tribe. The world and even ourselves would have never thought that we were anything near holy but our Father knowing how He begot us (James 1:18; 1 Peter 1:23) with His incorruptible and holy seed, joyfully told us, “ye are a holy nation”. That means in Christ, we are born physically pure and morally unblameable. Oh hallelujah! Nothing can beat this. To live holy lives is a possibility with ease because we are holy by nature. Praise God!

Confession

I am complete in Christ with the full load of divinity including holiness. I am a holy being in Jesus Christ.

THURSDAY MARCH 28

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOLINESS IS POSSIBLE - IV

1 John 1:7 "*But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.*"

A common reason why many of God's sons and daughters fear to even accept His Word about their holiness and the possibility of living as such, is the dominant consciousness that they will by all means do something wrong as long as they live in these bodies. They are so worked up concerning sins of omission and commission. But the good news is that our Father knew ahead and took care of all of that. He told us how to live so that omissions and commissions that will be judged as wrong on this side of life, will be fully taken care of by Him. He said, "walk in the light as He is in the light". That is to say, if you accept that you are holy as He has said and express that holiness in your living as He has said, then if you ever omit or commit anything unknown, you are automatically cleansed. So, at any point in time, you are holy. Oh hallelujah!

Topic: HOLINESS IS POSSIBLE – V

1 Corinthians 15:33 *“Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.”*

It is amazing how many times our Father warns us not to allow ourselves to be deceived. This is because, by the Word He has given to us in the Bible and the ever presence of the Holy Spirit in us, He has invested in us beyond deception. So, we have the power to individually avoid being deceived. One area you must watch out for, not to be deceived in, is the possibility of your holy living. Topic: MANIFEST HOLINESS TODAY

1 Peter 1:15 ***“But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation.”***

So, with all you've learnt so far, start manifesting your holiness today in every area of your life.
