MONDAY JULY 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IS SPIRITUAL GROWTH?

Ephesians 4:14-15, ***"That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, ...But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ."***

Every true minister of Jesus Christ will be seen desiring and heard teaching that his brethren in Christ should grow spiritually. Though the issue of spiritual growth is so important, it appears many do not even understand what it is all about. The born again is a complete divine spirit being and the spirit doesn't grow from a baby spirit into an adult spirit. But as living from a human consciousness is gradually chipped off by the ministry of the Holy Spirit, the true divine character of that spirit being, gradually emerges into expression. This is spiritual growth. Spiritual growth, therefore, is simply the advancement in the manifestation of our divine nature in Christ. What does it look like when one is growing spiritually? The fruit of his spirit being is increasingly expressed in life. With spiritual growth, the expression of love, joy, peace, patience etc. become effortless from one's being instead of a struggle to conform to a moral standard. This is what makes the difference between religious Christianity and living in the reality of being in Christ.

TUESDAY JULY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SPIRITUAL GROWTH BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 16:7 *"Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you"*

Spiritual growth as we learnt yesterday, happens by the ministry of the person of the Holy Spirit, in the atmosphere of divine fellowship with the substance of the Word. Today we will focus on the Holy Spirit. Jesus Christ of Nazareth rounded off His ministry of fulfilling the law, restoring earthly human authority from Satan and ushered in a new era of giving eternal life to regenerate men into sons of God according to predestination (Matthew 5:17, Genesis 3:15, Ephesians 1:4-5, Titus 1:2). Knowing that these sons of God were going to come into being in a dominant human consciousness environment, He promised sending the Holy Spirit as the comforter-Father to go along with and help, counsel, advocate for, intercede, strengthen and standby them until they come of age (Galatians 4:1-2). WEDNESDAY JULY 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SPIRITUAL GROWTH THROUGH THE WORD

1 Peter 2:2 “As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.”

As we learnt yesterday, the means of spiritual growth involves the person of the Holy Spirit, the atmosphere of divine fellowship and the substance of the Word. We will focus on the Word today. Our opening scripture clearly shows that the substance with which the Holy Spirit ministers to bring about spiritual growth, is the Word. The ministry of the Word stirs life and spirit which invigorates (John 6:63, Hebrews 4:12) and brings enlightenment that renews the mind (Psalm 119:105; Romans 12:2). The bulk of spiritual growth hinges on transformation in consciousness from the dominant fallen human consciousness to divine consciousness in Christ. This happens as the Holy Spirit through the Word, ministers wisdom and revelation in the full knowledge of Christ to flood our consciousness with such divine light that makes us aware of the hope of the calling in Christ, the Father’s inheritance invested in us and power available to us in Christ (Ephesians 1:17-19). THURSDAY JULY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE WORD FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Acts 20:32 *"And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified."*

Many read, study or even preach from the Bible but are not growing spiritually because though the entire Bible was written for our learning, it is only the Word of His grace in the Bible, that the Bible itself strongly recommends for our spiritual growth. John 1:17 helps us to know what this Word is. It says, *"For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ"*. Jesus was born under the law of Moses and lived to fulfill it. By His death and resurrection, He ushered in the era of grace. So, the Word of His grace refers to the message in the Bible that points you to who you are, what you have and what you can do because of the grace of Jesus Christ. If what you are reading, studying and imbibing from the Bible is not the Word of His grace, you will just have Bible knowledge that could puff you up, yet you won't grow spiritually. The Word of His grace is the Word for your spiritual growth.

Dear Holy Spirit, I incline my heart to decipher the Word of Christ's grace in the Bible to spiritually grow in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY JULY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SPIRITUAL GROWTH IN FELLOWSHIP - I

John 16:14 (AMP) ***"He will glorify and honor Me, because He (the Holy Spirit) will take from what is mine and will disclose it to you."***

Apart from the person of the Holy Spirit and the substance of the Word, the next aspect of the means of spiritual growth is divine fellowship. We will look at the divine fellowship in the Godhead today. Jesus Christ is the personality of the Father's Word (John 1:1, 14). To take of Jesus and disclose to you as stated above, means to minister the substance of the Word to you and this happens when there is a conscious fellowship with the Holy Spirit in the Word. If someone reads the Word legally or like any other book without the consciousness of fellowshipping in the divine community, there'll be no spiritual growth but the mere acquisition of Biblical knowledge. It is important to realize that our walk in Christ is a relationship in the divine community not a code of ethics to arrive at desired goals. There is not much spiritual progress in any Christian activity that is devoid of conscious fellowship with the Holy Spirit. Start reading and studying the Word in the consciousness of fellowship in the Godhead and observe your rapid spiritual growth.

From today, I choose to read and study the Bible in the consciousness of fellowshipping with the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit.

SATURDAY JULY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SPIRITUAL GROWTH IN FELLOWSHIP - II

1 Corinthians 14:4 (AMP) "*One who speaks in a tongue edifies himself; but one who prophesies edifies the church [promotes growth in spiritual wisdom, devotion, holiness and joy.]*"

The second dimension of divine fellowship in which we enjoy spiritual growth is in the church. When the Word is ministered indirectly to us by the Holy Spirit through shepherds and leaders, it is to promote our spiritual growth. Whether by directly teaching us from the written Word or by interpretation of a message in a tongue, the Spirit ministers when we fellowship together as members of the same body to make us grow spiritually. This is why Hebrews 10:25 (AMP) says, "*not forsaking our meeting together [as believers for worship and instruction], as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more [faithfully] as you see the day [of Christ's return] approaching*". Develop the attitude of going for fellowship meetings to receive the ministry of the Word for your spiritual growth.

Dear Father, I receive divine light to embrace moments of Church fellowship as avenues of receiving the ministry of the Word for spiritual growth.

SUNDAY JULY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Speak fervently in other tongues for five to ten minutes declaring that you are maximizing your oneness with the Holy Spirit, the ministry of the Word to you and the moments of divine fellowship, for a rapid and sustained spiritual growth in your life in Jesus' Name.

MONDAY JULY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BASIC COURSE ON THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 Corinthians 12:11 (NIV) *"All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines."*

In this basic and the following advanced course on the gifts of the Holy Spirit, we will have the teaching in a more functional approach to the subject than just a technical academic one so that you can relate with and utilize the impartation of truth. Be blessed to have more of these gifts flow through you after these courses in Jesus' name. Basically, you should know at least five truths about the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which are: (1) The Father doesn't want you ignorant - 1 Corinthians 12:2, (2) They are works or manifestations of the Holy Spirit Himself through the sons of God - 1 Corinthians 12:7, (3) They will not remain forever - they will cease when sons of God mature to be His expression in life - 1 Corinthians 13:8-12, (4) Though His manifestations can be desired, they are given according to His will - 1 Corinthians 12:31,11, (5) Every son of God has His gift(s) to be a blessing to others - 1 Corinthians 12:7. TUESDAY JULY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE GIFT OF THE WORD OF WISDOM & KNOWLEDGE

1 Corinthians 12:8 *"For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;"*

As part of the fundamentals, we will begin to study as many of the gifts as time will permit us this week. The first mentioned are the gifts of the word of wisdom and the word of knowledge. The emphasis of these two gifts is more on the "word" not the wisdom or knowledge. The "word" is from ***logos*** in Greek from the root word, ***lego*** which means to speak, utter or say. So, these gifts are best named, the gift of the speech or utterance or saying of wisdom or knowledge. What does this mean? It means the Holy Spirit manifests this gift by speaking in the son of God and the speech or utterance imparts wisdom (skill and insight to function) to the hearer or it imparts knowledge (intelligence and understanding) concerning anything that one needs at that time. The wisdom and knowledge here could be wisdom for work, family etc. and knowledge about anything scientific, academic, and so on because the verse never limited it to only what could be termed "spiritual". By this gift, knowledge of any kind comes to the Church and wisdom concerning everything comes to the church. Glory!

Confession

Dear Lord, by a strong desire of the gift of the word of wisdom and the word of knowledge, I receive supernatural wisdom into all areas of my life and knowledge concerning anything in my life, in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY JULY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE GIFT OF FAITH & GIFTS OF HEALINGS

1 Corinthians 12:9 *“...to another faith by the same Spirit; to another gifts of healing by the same Spirit;”*

Here, we have the gifts of faith and healing. So, the Holy Spirit manifests as faith. Note that it is not that He gives faith. He manifests as faith in sons of God in which case they express uncommon persuasion or convictions about the reality of invisible things in their thoughts, speech and actions that produce supernatural results that afterwards amazes the very people through whom He manifested. Now, concerning healing, it is written as “gifts of healings”. Both “gift” and “healing” are in their plural form in the Greek. Also, the usual *“therapeuo”* for healing wasn’t used but *“iama”* which refers more to the means of healing. Thus, by this gift, the Holy Spirit manifests as the means of healing so the one through whom He is operating, knows *how* to go about producing that healing. That is why the same person can heal the same condition by different means or methods when this gift is at work.

Dear Holy Spirit, I am ever grateful for these insights into the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Jesus’ Name.

THURSDAY JULY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GIFTS OF THE WORKING OF MIRACLES AND PROPHECY

1 Corinthians 12:10 *“to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:”*

This verse alone contains five of them, but we will take them in bits for the rest of the week. The first is the working of miracles. In the Greek, it is rendered the exhibition of divine ability. That means by this gift, the Holy Spirit manifests in sons of God as the exhibition of supernatural power or ability. The application of this ability could include healing the sick, but it is open ended meaning it applies to anything in life. The next is prophecy from the Greek word prophēteia, which means the Holy Spirit manifests as the expression of divine discourse that foretells God’s counsel or other events of life whose foreknowledge brings comfort, edification and exhortation (1 Corinthians 14:3).

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I understand more, and I am better positioned for greater manifestations of the Spirit in me. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY JULY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE GIFT OF DISCERNING SPIRITS

1 Corinthians 12:10 “*to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:*”

It is important that in our walk of faith we learn to be fair with the scriptures by allowing them to speak for themselves and thus communicate to us what the Father intended. This particular gift has been underutilized because it is not the gift of discernment of spirits as rendered in the English. From Greek, it is the plural phrase, “**diakrisis pneuma**” which specifically means “discerning spirits”. In other words, spirits that discern. Demons, men and even immature sons of God are unable to supernaturally discern in many issues of life resulting in a lot of mistakes and problems. By this gift, the Holy Spirit manifests in sons of God as the expression of spirits that distinguish or make supernaturally definite judgments or conclusions on matters, situations, persons or spirits. For instance, supernaturally distinguishing who is lying in a disagreement, which kind or caliber of spirit is at work, which deal is right or wrong etc. Again, this is not limited to discerning only evil spirits or demons.

Dear Lord Jesus, I am so thankful to You for these amazing truths by the Holy Spirit for by them I strongly desire and see the gifts of the Holy Spirit in my life.

SATURDAY JULY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE GIFT OF KINDS OF TONGUES

1 Corinthians 12:10 *“to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:”*

Before we dive into the gift of kinds of tongues, we need to first understand that “tongues” refer to “other tongues” as stated in Acts 2:4 and they are strange utterances given by the Spirit other than a person’s natural human language. They are given to every son of God for personal communion with God and self-edification (1 Corinthians 14:2, 4). However, some sons of God have the Holy Spirit manifesting through them as kinds of tongues that are not for prayer but to minister edification, comfort and exhortation. This is the gift of kinds or diversities of tongues. They could be heard in a human language as on the Day of Pentecost - Acts 2:4-13 or else they must be interpreted since they are a manifestation for corporate advantage (1 Corinthians 14:28). A careful study will show you that this gift is akin to the gift of the word of wisdom or knowledge except that in this case it is edification, comfort and exhortation that is imparted instead of wisdom or knowledge. Otherwise, pray the same in the human language with your understanding.

MONDAY JULY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE FISH IN A FOREST

John 15:4 "*Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.*"

Imagine you were hunting in a forest and met a big fish hopping and struggling to move around. You pause and ask, "Mr. Fish, what are you doing here?" Then you get the response, "I am seriously pursuing success in my life". I mean you will be bewildered and wonder if everything was okay with it, wouldn't you? Yes, a fish cannot begin to think of any kind of success as long as it is found in a forest because its natural habitat is water. There is no success for a tree out of the ground. There is no success for a bird in a cage. Consequently, since the natural habitat of mankind is God (Genesis 1:26; Ephesians 1:4), there is no success for any man on earth outside living in a conscious union with God. This union is possible only in Jesus Christ (John 14:6). Therefore, true success in life is only possible when a person is really abiding in God through Jesus Christ, otherwise whatever they call success is a mirage.

Raised to a Heavenly Dignity

(New Creation Conference Archives)

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren

Romans 8:29

A dignity, or **state of being**, is the resident authority and primary characteristics of any group of beings. **To be raised to a heavenly dignity means to be raised to a heavenly state of being or condition of existence.**

Plants, animals, humans, angels, the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures each have their own dignity. As such, their level (or condition) of existence is what determines their kind of glory and their level of inherent power. This is why satan still has some kind of inherent power though he's been defeated; it is because of his level of existence as an angel.

Human beings are beings of an earthly dignity. **Once a human being gets born again, he becomes a heavenly dignity.** There is a vast difference in the condition of existence of the human being and that of the born again (1 Cor 15:47, AMP). The gap between the human being and the being in Christ is so wide; 1 Sam 2:8 however gives us a view of this difference: *He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, And lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, To set them among princes, And to make them inherit the throne of glory...*

When you allow this knowledge of your heavenly dignity to settle in your consciousness, you will see life differently. You will begin to think, talk and act differently; this will make you

experience a different life from that of human beings. Your interpretation of life, including any situations you may classify as a challenge, is based on your level of maturity. For example, multiplying 4 by 6 is a challenge to a child in kindergarten, but likely not a challenge for you. In that same vein, if you develop the consciousness of being raised to the heavenly dignity, life will take on a totally different meaning.

The truth about you is that you have been raised to a heavenly dignity. ***Truth is different from fact.*** Facts are a present description of the condition of a thing within the three-dimensional world. ***Truth however is the original reality about a thing.*** Based on this, we can understand that facts change but truths don't.

For example, a dear lady had the fact of challenge with conception, proven by lab reports. But the Lord told her, "there is nothing wrong with you and your husband!" Today she has a child because of the truth she received from the Lord, not the facts.

Facts hide truth from an earthly person. Facts also deceive, frighten, kill and destroy (John 10:10). For the spiritual person, truth is plain and brings liberty (John 8:32). ***Jesus never recommended facts for you to live by*** (2 Cor 4:18). So, look at life from the truth that you are a heavenly dignity.

The heavenly dignity life is a knowledge and settled consciousness in the following aspects:

1. ***You have a heavenly origin.*** Everyone in Christ originates from heaven (1 John 5:1, 2 Cor 5:16, John 1:13, James 1:18)
2. ***You are in a membership, a union, a fellowship of the***

most superior fraternity, of the highest class of beings. You live in fellowship with Jesus (2 Pet 1:4, Rom 8:29, 1 Cor 1:9, 1 John 1:3, 2 Cor 13:14)

3. **You are a being that is in truth and speaks out of truth.** You see in spirit, you hear in spirit, and you talk in spirit (2 Cor 4:18)
4. **You have ownership of all things** (Rom 8:16-17, 1 Cor 3:21)
5. **You have supreme superiority and authority over all** (Eph 2:6)
6. **You live to meet the needs of lower dignities** (Rom 8:19)

Topic: SOME FISHES STILL STRUGGLE IN WATER, WHY?

John 8:32 (TPT) *“For if you embrace the truth, it will release true freedom into your lives.”*

Mr. X: “Dr. Bindan wait a minute! Did you teach yesterday that success in life is possible only when one gets into union with God the Father in Jesus Christ?”

Dr. Bindan: “Absolutely yes!”.

Mr. X: “But a simple objective analysis of the prayer content and the ordinary day to day communication of a good number of people who have received Jesus Christ reveals that they are still struggling to succeed in life, why? I thought by receiving Christ, I will start succeeding in life immediately”.

Dr. Bindan: “Yes! Absolutely, Sir. When you see a fish still struggling to succeed in water, then something is not in its rightful place in that fish. It is the same with any person in Christ who is struggling to succeed in life”.

Mr. X: “So what is the problem? Is it from witches, generational curses, hard economic conditions, etc.?”

Dr. Bindan: “None of the above is the true cause of Christian struggles in life but a lack of knowledge and full embrace of the life in Christ (Hosea 4:6).

Mr. X: “I don’t get it”.

Dr. Bindan: “Sir, I will explain further in tomorrow’s devotion”

Dear Father, no matter what the root cause is, I must succeed in life. I incline my heart to receive the truth for my successful living in Christ, in Jesus’ Name.

WEDNESDAY JULY 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: POSITION IS DIFFERENT FROM EXPERIENCE

Ecclesiastes 10:7 (NLT) *"I have even seen servants riding horseback like princes - and princes walking like servants!"*

Dr. Bindan: "Hello Mr. X, as you mentioned yesterday, receiving Christ should result in an immediate manifestation of success in life. This is because receiving Christ, transmutes the human into a son of God - a sudden master of life, a ruler over sin, sickness, death, demons and every contrary situation in life. But as I mentioned yesterday, some do not know this truth and have not embraced it in life. This is what makes their position as sons of God different from their experiences in life. In position, they are sons of God and princes in life yet in experience, they are slaves and struggle to survive. The scriptures reveal that in Galatians 4:4 and even in our opening verse today."

Mr. X: "Okay. So, how does just knowing what you said make one a sudden success?"

Dr. Bindan: "There is an internal principle that works out as people's experiences, it is their thoughts. When you know, it changes your thoughts, speech, actions and produces that experience. This is in Proverbs 23:7".

Mr. X: "Wow! I will ask you another question tomorrow."

Confession

I position myself to discover and embrace truths that will make my position in Christ the same as my experiences, in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY JULY 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: KNOWING THE WORD YET STRUGGLING - I

Acts 20:32 *“And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.”*

Mr. X: “Hello Dr. Bindan, yesterday you mentioned that when Christians know the truth, they will begin to succeed immediately but again, I know people who read the Bible a lot, some know a lot of Bible stuff and some even preach it to others, yet they still struggle to succeed in life, why?”

Dr. Bindan: “☺ Mr. X, there are two reasons accounting for that paradox. The first is what they know or get by their reading the Bible. Though everything in the Bible was written for our learning (Romans 15:4), not everything is applicable to us in this post resurrection era to succeed. The Bible itself says, it is the Word of His grace that can build people up into their inheritance. This is the Word that shows you who you are, what you have and what you can do because of what Christ did in His death and resurrection. In fact, trying to apply everything you read without this understanding will result in a confusing life that is puffed up with religious knowledge without reality. I will address the second part tomorrow”.

Mr. X: “Thank you”.

Topic: HOW GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT WORK

1 Corinthians 12:7 (CJB) *“Moreover, to each person is given the particular manifestation of the Spirit that will be for the common good.”*

Though everyone in the body of Christ has a unique or unique gifts of the Holy Spirit through them, some never have it realized in their lives while some others also get theirs abused through various forms of carnality. One reason accounting for this is a lack of appropriate knowledge concerning how these gifts really work. Gifts of the Spirit are the manifestations or workings of the Holy Spirit Himself. They are not like abilities or virtues that He imparts to you to use without Him. Understanding this will change your entire life along these lines. This is why the Holy Spirit will cease to do that when the Church matures to exhibit our divinity (1 Corinthians 13:8-12). He does the manifestation not us (1 Corinthians 12:11).

Topic: DESIRING SPIRITUAL GIFTS

There is a place for impartation but what it does is to equip or make you ready for the desired gift of the Holy Spirit

A careful reading of our main verse will reveal that there is no such thing as our topic today and that it was just to catch your attention for the truth about to be shared. No son of God technically operates the gifts of the Holy Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit's operation or manifestation.
