## SATURDAY MARCH 1

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: START TODAY

1 Kings 18:21 ***“And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word”***

Instead of always reading or hearing of other people's depth in God and desiring same but not getting there, start yours today. ## MONDAY MARCH 3

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: THERE ARE MYSTERIES OF GOD

Ephesians 3:9 ***“And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ.”***

Deuteronomy 29:29, says, ***“The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.”*** This means that it is not everything there is in life that God has revealed to people on the earth. These unrevealed things are called mysteries in God. As I explained in the book entitled, ***“The Deathless Generation”***, these mysteries are not things that will never be known. ## TUESDAY MARCH 4

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: SOME PEOPLE KNOW SOME MYSTERIES

***Ephesians 3:8-9 “Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ; And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ.”***

Everyone accepts that children born of the same parents are not exactly the same. Yet, many have a great challenge accepting that all of us in Christ, though born of the same Father are not exactly the same. One of such areas of difference is access into some mysteries of God. Jesus Christ made it clear that some are given to know some mysteries while others are not (Matthew 13:11). Now, access to the knowledge of some mysteries does not make those who have the mysteries better than others as Paul stated above. It only reveals the uniqueness of our callings by our Father. ## WEDNESDAY MARCH 5

#### **Topic: RECOGNIZE SOME MYSTERIES IN CHRIST**

Ephesians 3:4 ***"Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ."***

Now, apart from being a mystery Himself (1 Corinthians 2:7-8) there are things in Jesus Christ that are mysteries. These are referred to as mysteries of or in Christ. As explained in, "The Deathless Generation" (call 0534446907 for your copy or purchase your e-copy on Amazon), they are not things that are not to be known but rather things that unless unveiled by the Holy Spirit, one cannot know, understand or receive. It is important that every son of God recognizes that there are mysteries in Christ and be aware of them in order to recognize those who are given to know them and easily receive. Some mysteries in Christ to know are the mystery of the union of Jews and Gentiles in one body of Christ (Ephesians 3:6), the mystery of Christians being the actual body of Christ (Ephesians 5:28-32), the mysteries of deathlessness and bodily change in glory (1 Corinthians 15:51).

## THURSDAY MARCH 6

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: DEATHLESSNESS IS A MYSTERY IN CHRIST

1 Corinthians 15:51 ***"Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed."***

One of the mysteries in Christ as stated yesterday, is the mystery of deathlessness in Jesus Christ. It is the mystery about living and not dying till the return of Jesus Christ for the bodily change in glory. Contrary to the popular belief that everyone will die, this mystery says clearly that, ***"We will all NOT die"***. Now, someone just read this and said in his or her heart, "I don't believe that". Matthew 13:11 ***“He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given”***

As repeatedly stated, the mysteries of God aren't things that will never be known but rather things that at their time will be revealed by the Holy Spirit to be known and maximized. 1 John 4:1 ***“Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.”***

I am aware of the difficulties associated with believing in mysteries in Christ especially as we tread cautiously on the paths of conservatism to avoid deception these last days. Even the scriptures testify concerning mysteries, that when they are unfolding and being explained some will not believe no matter how detailed their explanation is (Acts 13:41). **MONDAY MARCH 10**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: THE POWER OF YOUR DIVINE FELLOWSHIP**

Genesis 2:15 ***“And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it”***

We have taught profusely on the Good Life Devotion how being in Christ is a call to fellowship in the God-kind. That is a call to live with, work with and share with the Father, the Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit (1 John 1:3, 2 Corinthians 13:14). But what is it all about? The power of your divine fellowship is that it is the foundation to the fulfillment of your purpose of reigning in life. Adam had two instructions. One was to dress and keep Eden (which was His meeting point with God) and the second was to have dominion over creation (Genesis 1:26,28). His dominion mandate was hinged on his Edenic communion. When he lost Eden, he lost dominion. Any Christian who plays with his divine fellowship cannot reign in life and cannot escape being a victim of life. Your divine fellowship is the key to your fulfillment in life.

**TUESDAY MARCH 11**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: EFFECTIVE DIVINE FELLOWSHIP**

***Exodus 34:29 “And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses’ hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.”***

Every meaningful communion with the God-kind results in a transformation in spirit, soul and body. Depending on the degree of transformation, it may or may not be noticeable. Now, when a fellowship results in a transformation of spirit, soul and body, it is said to be an effective fellowship. Moses after fellowship was so transformed that his face shone. The disciples were so transformed that it was obvious they had been with Jesus (Acts 4:13). The more effective divine fellowship you enjoy, the more the transformation in the character and quality of your personality. Any means of religiously relating with God that does not transform your personality over time is not an effective fellowship with God. This being the age of the manifestation of sons of God, means it is time to ensure that we have effective divine fellowship that will transform us into the full measure of the stature of Christ (2 Corinthians 3:18).

### **Prayer**

Dear Father, I yield my heart to learn how to effectively fellowship with You so that I will be transformed into the full measure of Christ’s stature, in Jesus’ Name.



## WEDNESDAY MARCH 12

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: JOY AND REALITY IN FELLOWSHIP

John 4:23 ***“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.”***

As mentioned yesterday it is not the engagement of every activity of fellowship that is really fellowship. Real fellowship which we referred to as effective fellowship yesterday, is a fellowship which is real and generates joy in spirit. Though there are many worshippers, only those who worship in spirit and truth are considered true or real before God. Reality in fellowship is all about being in touch with the divine personalities that you are communing with. This requires a clear and intelligent focus on the person of God based on the Word. When there is real fellowship, the intermingling and rubbing of spirits, generates joy. It is known as the joy of the Holy Ghost (Romans 14:17). Don't just engage in fellowship activities but learn to do so in reality and in spirit and then you will be effective and experience real transformation.

Reality and joy in divine fellowship is mine. Therefore, from now, I am empowered by the Spirit to enjoy rich and effective fellowship in Jesus' Name.

**THURSDAY MARCH 13**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: REMOVE SPIRITUAL DISTRACTIONS**

***Zechariah 3:1 “And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him.”***

As mentioned yesterday, a key factor to effective divine fellowship is spiritual focus. Until you master focus in prayer you cannot develop effectiveness in divine fellowship. To master focus, you must remove distractions during your momentary fellowship. One of such distractions is spiritual distractions. The enemy knows that your key to mastery over him and his evil systems is your servicing of your Eden. Like the serpent who entered Adam's Eden to distract him, spiritual beings do the same today. They bring accusations against you, sometimes darts of sleep, tiredness, mental roaming etc. But they are defeated. You can eliminate spiritual distractions by keeping your spirit well fed on the Word, maintaining a fervent spirit through speaking other tongues and separation from worldliness.

I declare that as I act on this truth, no evil spirit has a place in my divine fellowship moments from today in Jesus' Name.

**FRIDAY MARCH 14**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: REMOVE DISTRACTIONS FROM THE SOUL**

2 Peter 2:8 *“(For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)”*

I believe today's generation needs to realize that growing in our faith in Christ is a serious choice. Extreme liberality and permissiveness in the name of grace, is a concealed attack on their spiritual power and mastery in life. Beware of a spiritual contention with your progress in Christ (Ephesians 6:12) and tread cautiously (1 Peter 5:8) not fearfully (2 Timothy 1:7). To enjoy focus in divine fellowship, your soul comprising your faculties of mind, will, desire and conscience must be well positioned. This means choosing what to see, hear and think on (Philippians 4:8). You can't fill your thoughts with worries from news, social media, ungodly friendships and expect to remain focused in divine fellowship without distractions. If spiritual growth, servicing your Eden, reigning in life etc., mean anything to you, keep your soul sanctified ALWAYS to enjoy effective divine fellowship. The ball is in your court.

#### Topic: REMOVE PHYSICAL DISTRACTIONS

Mark 1:35 ***“And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.”***

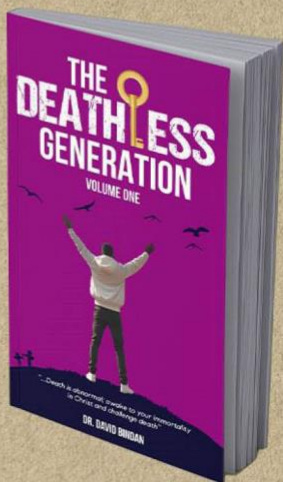
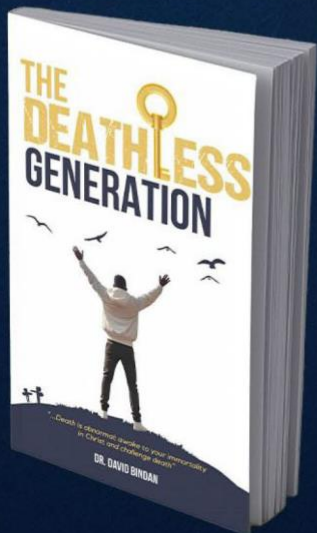
Jesus Christ of Nazareth was more in touch with God than anyone in his days (Acts 2:25). Yet, for effective fellowship, he rose up early before the noisy day started, went out of the house where the distractions are closest and actually went to a lonesome place. What do you think? That you can be effective by grace with distractions all around? No. Incessant fellowship can go on all the time no matter the “distractions” around, but you need to eliminate them as much as possible for temporal fellowship. A quiet place in your car, office, washroom, church venue; times of the day such as mornings or when there are or fewer distractions; bodily readiness of adequate rest without over or under eating and many other ways are necessary to remove physical distractions and master focus. If focus in fellowship meant so much to Jesus, decide how much it means to you by your actions from now. Grace be unto you in Jesus’ Name.

#### Confession

By the power of the Holy Spirit, I maximize the grace released to prevail over all forms of physical distractions in order to maintain focus in my divine fellowships in Jesus’ Name.

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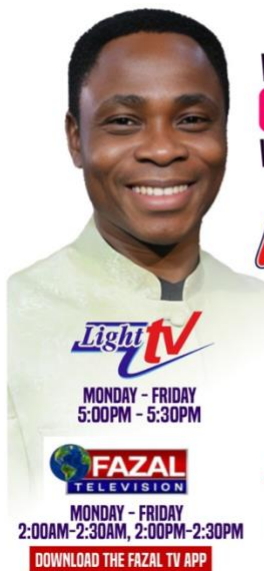

**MONDAY MARCH 17**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: CALLED TO GLORY**

1 Thessalonians 2:12 ***“That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.”***

To those who are yet to grow out of the deception in the world of darkness, our topic today is fearful because it appears as a funeral announcement. A Christian is not called to glory at death. The day a human receives Jesus Christ; he gets born again into the kingdom and the glory of God. Due to immaturity, many have lived a glory-less life on earth, expecting to enter into glory only after death. This is a deception. In Christ, you are already in glory. Shout, “I am called to glory in Jesus Christ!” Hahaha! Have you realized you are not dead? Now, the glory of God is the summation of His nature (Hebrews 1:3), appearance (Exodus 16:10) and due (Luke 17:19). That means in Christ you are made a partaker of God’s nature, appearance and due. As a son of God, you must know and live in the experience of the glory of God.

**TUESDAY MARCH 18**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: KNOWING THE GLORY OF GOD**

Exodus 33:19 ***“And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.”***

Glory is something everyone desires to know and experience because it is an innate desire. I realized the main challenge for many is knowing exactly what glory is and that spiritual search resulted in the revelation of our definition yesterday. Yet, even after I started teaching it about four years ago, I have observed that after the knowledge, people still lacked the experience thereof and I discovered that the challenge was now how to know the glory of God experientially - in a way that spills over from the heart and mind into one's entire life. The key is in knowing or experiencing His goodness and the virtues of His nature. Moses, requested to know the glory of God and what Yahweh showed Him was His goodness and virtues of His nature. We will decode these in our following lessons.

## WEDNESDAY MARCH 19

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: THE GOODNESS OF GOD

Exodus 34:6 ***“And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.”***

We learnt yesterday that the glory of God is experienced by knowing His goodness and the virtues of His nature. Now the goodness of God describes the quality of His being beneficial towards us. God is all about good towards us (James 1:17). Even when people are in a state that requires correction, His goodness doesn't wane. Your very life, creation, the people and circumstances around you are great manifestations of God's goodness towards you. But until you intelligently withdraw from the pressurized social and need-driven realm of living, God's goodness will appear nonexistent to you. All you will see are the troubles, disappointments, dissatisfaction, pain, hatred etc. If the devil succeeds at locking you up in that realm of living, you cannot experience the glory of God in this life. Learn to see, enjoy and celebrate His goodness in your life and you will begin to practically experience His glory.

## THURSDAY MARCH 20

### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: THE MERCY OF GOD

Exodus 34:6 ***“And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.”***

After knowing His goodness, experiencing the virtues of His nature is key to living in the glory of God. From Moses' encounter in Exodus, mercy is revealed first. This describes God's compassion and tender affection towards us. It is a positive force of always desiring to come along and ensure that we are in the right shape. Oh mine! This is so real but the enemy surrounds people with a pressured world that blinds them to God's mercy towards them. Mercy is the divine force by which grace accomplished salvation (Titus 3:5). So the Christian is a product of God's mercy and doesn't need to be begging for God's mercy as if it is an undeserved pity. Rather, we are to see, enjoy and celebrate His abundant mercies all around us. This is how to step into experiencing His glory in this life.

**FRIDAY MARCH 21**

**Topic: THE GRACIOUSNESS OF GOD**

Exodus 34:6 ***“And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.”***

The next virtue of divine nature in Exodus 34:6 to be experienced in order to manifestly live the glorified life is God's graciousness. This is quite different from the grace God gave us before time began (2 Timothy 1:9). Graciousness is that quality by which our Father despite His majestic loftiness is able to bend or stoop in kindness to mankind or His growing sons to bestow favour. When you appreciate His dealings with other created beings you will be amazed at His graciousness towards us. Again, if you discover the laws of living on earth (and largely people live unaware of them), you'll appreciate how Daddy's graciousness has often brought exemptions from evil to many. Oh boy! The Lord is gracious. See it, enjoy it and celebrate it then you will practically experience living in the glory of Yahweh our Father.

**SATURDAY MARCH 22**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: THE LONGSUFFERING OF GOD**

**Exodus 34:6 *“And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.”***

After mercy and graciousness comes the longsuffering of God, on the path to glorious living. Ordinarily, we have mostly seen longsuffering as the ability to suffer or bear with a situation for long. But while working on this, Daddy just flooded my heart with light showing that, His longsuffering is far more and better than that. He said, “It is good, for instance, to be angry and bear it for long before acting” but it is far better to take a long time before getting angry. Thus, longsuffering is that quality by which it takes Him a very long time to react. Wow! So brethren, God’s longsuffering is His being slow to anger, execute judgement and reward evil. Just a little looking back into life and you’ll be flat on the floor just seeing, enjoying and celebrating His longsuffering towards you.

Sing and praise Him for His amazing longsuffering towards you.

**Topic: PRACTICING LIVING BY FAITH**

1 Timothy 4:7 ***“But refuse profane and old wives’ fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.”***

Living by faith is one of the spiritual exercises in the Christian faith that you must engage in order to experience the fullness of what Jesus Christ procured for you in life. ### GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

#### Topic: GUARD YOUR FAITH EXERCISE

Jonah 2:8 ***“They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy.”***

There are many who have “tried” practicing faith and gave up. They felt disappointed and quit yet their hearts truly desire that kind of life because that is how they were begotten to live in Christ (Hebrews 10:38).
