TUESDAY APRIL 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE DIVINE ORIGIN OF THE WORD

2 Peter 1:20 (EASY) *"It is very important that you should understand this: The prophets' messages in the Bible did not come from their own ideas. That never happens."*

Arriving at the place of enjoying the Word as we described yesterday, begins by first believing in the divine origin of the scriptures. This is very important. Though the catalogue of the scriptures we have as the Bible went through several human agents and processes, and though it contains information on history, culture, poetry and even things that God did not directly say, you cannot grow to enjoy the scriptures for what they are, until you believe that they are from God (Romans 15:7). To believe means accepting in your heart that what God says about His Word is true without any physical proof. For example, 1 Peter 1:21 (GW) says, *"No prophecy ever originated from humans. Instead, it was given by the Holy Spirit as humans spoke under God's direction."*. Believe it. You cannot get nourishment from the Word if you doubt its divine origin.

Affirmation

I believe that whatsoever things were written aforetime, were written for my learning and it is all from God, not humans!

WEDNESDAY APRIL 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE TRUE NATURE OF THE WORD

John 6:63 ***"It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life"***

Apart from the consciousness of the divine origin of the Word, being aware of the true nature of the scriptures is necessary to enjoying it. There are at least three aspects of the true nature of the Word you must know. The first is that in terms of substance, the Word is spirit in nature (John 6:63, Ezekiel 2:2). In terms of vitality, the Word is living and active (Hebrews 4:12 NIV). Finally, in terms of ability the Word is powerful and life-giving (Ecclesiastes 8:4 ASV, Luke 1:37 ASV, John 1:1). When you become conscious that every exposure to the Word is an exposure to a living, active, powerful and life giving spirit substance, you will enjoy the Word beyond description. Your life will change forever.

Prayer

Speak fervently in other tongues for 5 minutes, affirming that the Word of Yahweh your Father is alive, active, powerful and life-giving in you. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY APRIL 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR WORD-NATURE

1 Peter 1:23 *“Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever”*

Through self-application, King David arrived at experiencing the Word enjoyment (Psalms 119:103), but the easier way for us in Christ is to realize it through the awareness of our Word-nature. Naturally, people's bodies are made up of what they eat over a period. The born again, is born of the Word (1 Peter 1:23, James 1:18) and it takes the Word to feed, nourish and nurture him or her (1 Peter 2:2). Your true nature is the Word as Christ (1 John 1:1, 14; 2 Corinthians 3:1-3). Once the reality of your Word-nature dawns on you, you will discover what your real food in life is (Matthew 4:4) and your attitude towards the Word will change. This will take you into that beautiful state of Word enjoyment and speed up your growth in Christ.

Affirmation

I am born of the Word. The Word is my nature. The Word is my food indeed. By the Word am I nourished and built up into greatness in life in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY APRIL 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE MINISTRY OF THE WORD

Revelation 1:3 "***Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand***"

Though the ministry of the Word occurs in myriads of ways, we can group them into two broad categories. The first category of Word-ministry is a non-specific impartation of spirit for general edification and growth within the atmosphere of the Word. In this case, just reading or listening to the Word alone blesses and transforms a person spiritually (Revelation 1:3). The second category is the specific ministry of the Word through the impartation of revelation, understanding and insight into specific areas of the life in Christ, doctrines etc. This usually happens when there is a more intentional, prayerful, studious and meditative attention to the Word and results in specific growths like the experience of health, prosperity, transformation in glory and so on (Ephesians 1:17-19, Luke 24:45).

Oh Holy Father, Your Word is Holy and the ministry thereof is great in all the earth forever. Hallelujah!

SATURDAY APRIL 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: APPROACHES TO THE WORD

Proverbs 4:20-21 ***"My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart"***

The two categories of Word-ministry discussed yesterday, define the two broad ways of approaching the Word to arrive at Word enjoyment. The first is the general approach in which one consciously soaks himself in the atmosphere of the Word either by just reading or listening. The aim is not necessarily for any specific knowledge, understanding or revelation but to interact with the spirit and life of the Word. This results in the non-specific Word-ministry. The second is a planned, targeted and more intentional approach by which one prayerfully reads, studies, listens and meditates on the Word looking for a certain revelation, understanding or insight into a specific doctrine, subject, area of life or circumstance. The result of this is the specific Word-ministry discussed yesterday.

SUNDAY APRIL 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

MONDAY APRIL 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: OUR NORMAL

2 Corinthians 5:17 (TPT) “*Now, if anyone is enfolded into Christ, he has become an entirely new creation. All that is related to the old order has vanished. Behold, everything is fresh and new.*”

Our opening verse today says that if a human receives Christ, he is regenerated into a new creature, one that never existed before. It further says that all things are new concerning this new creature. In other words, the new creature came into being with his own reality and order of life. This order of expression of life is new to the human world. But, to the new creature, this new order, which is completely different from the old human order, is his normal. However, because of the dominance of the old human order in this world, many new creatures are unable to appreciate and live according to their normal order. Only those who through spiritual growth have renewed their minds are able to walk in their divine order (Romans 12:2). Surely, our journey of growing together this year will enable us to grow to fully function as the new creatures we are.

Confession

I am born again. My order is completely divine. This is my normal. This is how I think, this is how I talk, and this is the way I live.

TUESDAY APRIL 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: GROWING SPIRITUALLY IS NORMAL

1 Peter 2:2 (TPT) *"In the same way that nursing infants cry for milk, you must intensely crave the pure spiritual milk of God's Word. For this "milk" will cause you to grow into maturity, fully nourished and strong for life—"*

It is normal that in the same manner that human infants are fed with breast milk, the new creature must also crave for the spiritual milk of God's Word. This means there is really such a thing as spiritual growth or growing in Christ for the new creature and it is part of our normal in Christ. Until you appreciate spiritual growth as part of your normal in Christ, you will not invest in your growth as you ought to. This is why it is not uncommon to find people who are well nourished in body and have grown in mental education but are babes in the things of the spirit. A well-educated and physically fit person could be demonically oppressed by issues of life because he is famished in spirit. As discussed last week, because we are born of the Word (1 Peter 1:23), that is our source of milk, meat and bones (1Peter 2:2, 1Corinthians 3:2, Hebrew 5:12-14). It is normal to desire and approach the Word as your necessary food in life (Matthew 4:4).

Affirmation

Having been enlightened, I am enabled to give attention to the Word. I declare that I am nourished by the Word for my growth in Christ in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY APRIL 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SPIRITUAL WORKOUT; IT IS NORMAL

Philippians 2:12 *"Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling."*

The Greek word translated "work out" is "katergadzomai", which means, "to bring about a result by doing something". In the physical, many people engage in vigorous exercises which they call workout sessions. And the reason for these workouts are to build their bodies and keep them fit. Likewise, there are spiritual exercises which are part of our normal in Christ as new creatures. Without them, one cannot grow to function as a son of God in life and is likely to live as a victim instead of a victor in life. There are various kinds of spiritual workouts that the scriptures inspire us to engage in, to bring our fullness of Christ into physical manifestation. These include regular effective prayer, enjoying the Word, effective church fellowship and so on, as we are learning in our growing together challenge this year. Do not allow the devil and circumstances to make you feel that spiritual exercises are a waste of time, keep at them because they are part of your normal in Christ.

Dear Father, I thank You for who You have made me in Christ. I joyfully engage in spiritual workouts, and I grow daily into the full measure of the stature of Christ, in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY APRIL 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CELEBRATING INVISIBLE PROGRESS? IT IS NORMAL

Mark 4:26-27 (ERV) *"Then Jesus said, "God's kingdom is like a man who plants seed in the ground. The seed begins to grow. It grows night and day. It doesn't matter whether the man is sleeping or awake, the seed still grows. He doesn't know how it happens"*

When many sons and daughters grow to realize that life in Christ began by faith and must grow through faith, they will embrace the truth of walking by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7). When this happens, they will appreciate the power of celebrating invisible progress which is a key kingdom principle. The truth is that there is progress because one has engaged the Word and not because of physical manifestations. This is also part of our normal in Christ (the kingdom) as captured in our main verse. If you have engaged the Word concerning your spiritual growth, health, peace, finances etc., learn to celebrate invisible progress. For instance, in our growing together spiritual exercises you may not have noticed or perceived certain changes and progress as others have, yet you must be aware that there is ongoing progress because you are engaging the Word.

Celebration

Glory Hallelujah! I celebrate every visible or invisible progress and transformation taking place in my spirit, soul and body. They are real to me because I am acting on the Word.

FRIDAY APRIL 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

**Topic: JOINING A SPIRITUAL GROWTH GROUP? IT IS
NORMAL**

Hebrews 10:25 (TPT) *“This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together, as some have formed the habit of doing, because we need each other! In fact, we should come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning.”*

As sons and daughters of God, it is normal for us to come together to pursue a common divine course. This is so we can watch out for one another and inspire one another to not slack. The scriptures admonish us that in the last days, the love of many will grow cold (Matthew 24:12). That is why our opening verse also admonishes us to not pull away and neglect meeting together, but come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning. SATURDAY APRIL 12

TOPIC: HAVING THE END IN VIEW IS NORMAL

Hebrews 12:2 (TPT) *"Keep your eyes on Jesus, who both began and finished this race we're in. Study how he did it. Because he never lost sight of where he was headed--that exhilarating finish in and with God--he could put up with anything along the way: cross, shame, whatever. And now he's there, in the place of honor, right alongside God."*

I have always said that the Christian journey is not a hundred-meter-dash but a marathon. For instance, the growth challenge we are embarking on is expected to position and set you on your personal growth track till Jesus comes. Because many have not understood the marathon nature of the journey in Christ, they easily faint. It is, therefore, not uncommon to see many well-meaning sons and daughters of God begin spiritual exercises or projects with enthusiasm but slack back into their comfort zones after a while. Like our Lord Jesus in our opening verse, you have to keep your gaze on the joy of becoming that matured son and daughter of God (Ephesians 4:13). Such a focus will enable you to persist with the requirements of mastering prayer and the other pillars of growth and growth will surely be your result. Hallelujah!

Topic: WHY JESUS CAME INTO THE WORLD

Galatians 4:4-5 *“But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons”*

When asked, “Why did Jesus come into the world”, many people on the streets will say, “To save the world” and that is excellent according to John 12:47. Yet, “excellent” is not always 100 percent of the score. The full truth about why Jesus came into this world is that *“He came to save the world in order to bring mankind back to God’s original plan before the fall”*. The salvation of the world wasn’t just for its sake. It was a means to an end. This original plan that Yahweh had for mankind was there before creation (2Timothy 1:8-9). It was the plan to adopt mankind into the family of the God-kind (Ephesians 1:3-5). This is exactly what our main verse today corroborates. As simple as this extra knowledge is, it makes a vast difference between ordinary humanistic quality Christianity and extraordinary divine quality Christianity.

TUESDAY APRIL 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JESUS' DEATH IS NOT A HUMAN SACRIFICE

Hebrews 9:26 *"For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself."*

Until you study the scriptures for yourself in the community of the Godhead, you will have a poor quality of life from a lot of humanistic views about God. For instance, if Yahweh, our Father, doesn't entertain human sacrifices (Jeremiah 19:5) why does it appear that He sacrificed Jesus Christ for sin? It is the result of a religious understanding of sacrifices. A sacrifice is not necessarily the killing of a living thing. A sacrifice is the offering or giving up of something valuable for a worthy cause. That includes but is not limited to the offering of a living thing if that is the "substance" of the offering. So, Jesus Christ was an offering for sin and NOT a human sacrifice to God for sin. In other words, He was "what" the Father offered for the worth of putting away the sin of the world (Romans 4:24-25, John 1:29) and death was a necessary part of the process. 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
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WEDNESDAY APRIL 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHY JESUS DIED

Hebrews 9:26 (CEB) *"If that were so, then Jesus would have to suffer many times since the foundation of the world. Instead, he has now appeared once at the end of the ages to get rid of sin by sacrificing himself."*

If you take time to understand why Jesus Christ died, you will suddenly walk in freedom from sin and demons. As God's offering to save the world, death was necessary (Hebrews 2:9). Why? First, to get rid of sin and second to destroy Satan and his cohorts in the region of death. Don't miss the detailed explanations of this on our YouTube channel @davidbindanlive. By yielding to Satan in the garden, Adam plunged humanity into this terrible state of obscurity referred to as sin, death, darkness etc. It is a state of obscured judgement of God and man's life, alienation from life resulting in corruption and the experience of death, and slavery to Satan and his demons. By absorbing all the sins of mankind in Gethsemane (Luke 22:40-44, Isaiah 53:6, 1 Peter 2:24) Jesus became sin (2 Corinthians 5:21) that needed to be done away with. So, He got sin "killed" by dying with it (Colossians 2:14) and that gave Him (who couldn't know death) access into regions of death to paralyzed Satan and his cohorts (Hebrews 2:14, Colossians 2:15).

Affirmation

Jesus "killed" sin on the cross. Sin no longer has dominion over me. I live only as an expression of my righteousness in Christ. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY APRIL 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE BENEFIT OF JESUS' DEATH TO THE WORLD

Galatians 4:5 *"To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons"*

The two major benefits in which all other benefits of Jesus' death to the world are embedded are, redemption from sin and Satan's power and free access to eternal life. Having "killed" sin on the cross, Jesus Christ redeemed (ransomed, purchased) the world from the power of sin (Titus 2:14) and Satan's dominion. In other words, the separation that stood between them and God was taken away (John 1:29), the evil forces paralyzed (Colossians 1:14-15) and reconciliation enacted (2 Corinthians 5:19). The whole world is redeemed and reconciled to God in Jesus Christ. This is the first part of the good news committed to our trust that the whole world must hear, believe and experience this reality. (John 3:16, Colossians 1:12-13). Beyond these is the reception of eternal life to regenerate them into new creature sons of God (1 John 5:11-12, John 1:12-13) to reign in life. This is the second part of the gospel committed to our trust (2 Timothy 1:8-11).

Dear Father, we thank You abundantly for giving to the world redemption from sin, deliverance from Satan and the free gift of eternal life in Jesus Christ. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY APRIL 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE BENEFIT OF JESUS' DEATH TO THE CHURCH

Romans 5:17 *"For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ."*

Everyone who receives Jesus Christ gets born again as a son or daughter of God into the divine family of God (Romans 8:29). Each one is baptized by the Holy Spirit into the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:13). This body of Christ is called the Church (Ephesians 1:22-23, Colossians 1:18). This breed of new creatures or sons of God in Christ, are masters in life. They reign. Now, if you are in Christ, knowing what the death of Jesus Christ means, implies that you can safely and easily resist sin and live right. Matthew 28:9 "*And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.*"

Topic: SOUL WINNING – A RESPONSIBILITY

2 Corinthians 5:19 (MEV) *“that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their sins against them, and has entrusted to us the message of reconciliation.”*

Do you remember the last time someone stopped you to share the gospel of Christ with you? When was the last time you also shared the gospel with another person? Honest responses to these questions are likely to reveal that the urgency of soul winning is lost on many Christians. But now more than ever, in these days of the final move of the Spirit on the earth before the Lord's return, the body of Christ must be awakened to win souls. Soul winning is not an option, it is the responsibility of sons and daughters of God. Do not assume that another person is doing the job. See soul winning as your sole responsibility and it will change any lukewarmness towards it. As we learnt last week it's a ministry committed to your trust (2 Corinthians 5:17-20). Will you fail God? TUESDAY APRIL 22

Topic: DON'T BREAK THE LOVE CHAIN

1 John 4:10 ***"Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his son to be the propitiation for our sins"***

It is not that simple if you are not passionate about souls. It reveals a lack of demonstration of love to the hopeless world around you. Love is the driving force for soul winning. It was this love that got the gospel to you. Think of what missionaries of yesteryears went through to make the gospel global and come out of your comfort zone. By it we manifest our love-nature as our Father does. The scriptures say in 1 John 4:8 that God is love. Our opening scripture tells us how God manifested this love. He manifested or showed His love by sending Jesus to the world so that men may receive adoption into sonship (Ephesians 1:4-5). Anyone can receive eternal life by believing that Jesus was raised from the dead and confessing Him as Lord. This is the ultimate expression of love as shown to us by the Father and this is what soul winning is about (John 3:16). This is why everyone must hear the gospel and get born again!

Speak fervently in other tongues for 5 minutes to fan the embers of your love-nature into flames. Affirming that by the Spirit you are an effective soul-winner.

WEDNESDAY APRIL 23

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WIN A SOUL TODAY

1 Corinthians 9:22 “*...I have (in short) become all things to all men, that I might by all means (at all costs and in any and every way) save some by winning them to faith in Jesus Christ)*”

Today is World Soul Winning Day. A day set aside to win souls and dubbed “Operation No Soul, No Food” meaning until you have won a soul, you must not eat. If you are a Christian and have not won a soul since the beginning of the year, this is a great opportunity for you to begin. Spend some time this morning intentionally praying into your day, declaring that by the Spirit the hearts of all whom you will come across today will be ready to receive the gospel and get born again. On your way to work or school, in the bus or taxi, at your workplace, calmly approach someone and politely greet the person and introduce yourself. If possible, find a place that is free of noise and distractions. Find out how the person is doing and ask if he or she has heard about God’s eternal plan for his or her life. Share the gospel as we learnt last week and lead him or her to receive Christ. Remember that the gospel you have is of great value and is for everyone – young, old, educated, uneducated, male, and female therefore your appearance, manner of speech and attitude during preaching is important. You are sure to come back with testimonies.

Prayer

Spend 10 minutes speaking fervently in tongues today as you step out to win souls.

THURSDAY APRIL 24

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MAINTAIN THE DRIVE

Acts 20:20 *"And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publickly, and from house to house."*

The goal for a day like World Soul Winning Day, is to inspire your love-nature to live for Jesus Christ. Now, sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ, is not supposed to be an occasional thing you do. There should be no vacation in your soul winning drive. So, with what we started yesterday, don't quench the fire. Like the Apostle Paul and his team, keep not the good news from anyone. But share it publicly and in private too. This is the day of salvation, and the resources of heaven are massive for your success in this kingdom service. Plan on your own to have special days of reaching out to others with the gospel in addition to being on the go with it everywhere. Don't join those who aren't hearing the call of God. Rise and maintain the drive of love for your world.

Affirmation

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I am a soul winner. Souls come my way. They hear and receive Jesus Christ when I preach. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY APRIL 25

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FUEL YOUR PASSION – I

James 4:7 *"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you"*

The first way to keep your passion for souls ever boiling, is to learn to constantly resist the devil. It is important to understand that sin and the power of Satan have been destroyed by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. But if Satan can keep people from knowing the truth, he can continue to dominate their lives. Hence, he works in subtle ways to “discourage” those who have the gospel committed to their trust. He makes people afraid to open the subject of Jesus for fear of being rejected or seen as fanatical. Sometimes he inspires carnal Christians to criticize those who win souls. This is why many Christians don’t preach the gospel everywhere they go, though they freely talk about other things. In prayer, resist the devil from interfering in your soul winning mandate by casting out discouragement, fear and concern of criticisms. Also, break his influence over people’s hearts, minds and bodies so that they easily receive Jesus as you preach. The more you do, the more your passion in this area will be fueled.

Affirmation

My passion for soul winning never wanes. Discouragement, fear and concern are disabled around me. I flow easily with the gospel of Jesus Christ and people hear me, in Jesus’ Name.

SATURDAY APRIL 26

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FUEL YOUR PASSION – II

Romans 12:11 (TPT) *“Be enthusiastic to serve the Lord, keeping your passion toward him boiling hot! Radiate with the glow of the Holy Spirit and let him fill you with excitement as you serve him.”*

Apart from the opposition of the devil, your personal state is important in fueling your passion for soul winning. First, ensure that you are always prayerful. Be a master of prayer as we have taught you. Pray fervently and frequently in other tongues to keep you always edified. Second, grow to enjoy the Word. The more you study the Word, the more you'll discover how illegal it is for the world to be as it is and the more passionate you will become to preach Jesus Christ - the ultimate solution. Regularly watching the Good Life Devotion is recommended for this. Third, be well equipped with materials, so that in the few cases where it may be inconvenient to talk, you can share. John 8:36 (AMPC) ***“So if the Son liberates you [makes you free men], then you are really and unquestionably free.”***

God started project man (Genesis 1:26) with the ultimate purpose of adopting mankind unto sonship through Jesus Christ, to dwell before Him without blame and in love (Ephesians 1:4-5). However, Adam and Eve went against divine instruction and plunged all mankind into an experience of life that was contrary to God's plan for them. Romans 6:14 (NIV) ***“For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.”***

For those who have already received Jesus Christ, realize that it is not okay to continue to think you are a sinner because you are not (2 Corinthians 5:21). Confession

Being born of God, I am God's righteousness in nature. I only display righteous living because that is who I am - a master over sin, in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY APRIL 30

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FREEDOM FROM SICKNESS

1 Peter 2:24 "*Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.*"

Sickness was never a part of God's plan for mankind. It became a human experience because of Adam's error. Interestingly, sickness is not just a mere aberration in health. It is a spiritual force that corrupts perfection in the integrity of bodily substance. It is far beyond the trauma, bacteria, viruses or parasites you may see. That is why Jesus Christ, corrected them by spiritual means (Acts 10:38). Joyfully, by His death, He absorbed all sicknesses and took them away from mankind. But until you believe in Jesus Christ you cannot enter that state of total freedom from sickness. If you have already received Him, realize that it is not okay to be sick any longer. Why? You are free indeed from sickness because the eternal life in you is incorruptible (2 Timothy 1:10). Recognize your supremacy over corruption and refuse to fear sickness. If it tries to hang unto you, cast it out as you will every evil work because you have the power to (Mark 16:17-18).

Celebration

Jesus bore every disease on Himself and rendered sickness illegal in its operation on earth. I am perfect in spirit, soul and body. There is no infirmity in my body. Christ rendered disease powerless over my body and I celebrate the liberty in Jesus' Name!

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

It is easy to enter into God's ultimate and His eternal plan for your life. You must receive Jesus by believing on His name. The Bible shows two clear steps to do this. A wholehearted belief and an acknowledgement/confession. Believe that Jesus is the one whose resurrection from the dead made mankind's adoption as God's sons/daughters possible and acknowledge His Lordship. To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
