GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MENTAL FREEDOM

Proverbs 23:7 "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he..."

Proverbs 11:24 (ESV) "One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want"

MONDAY MAY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Hebrews 2:15 "And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage"

Deathlessness (immortality in Christ) as I have been given to preach, means living in Jesus Christ now and not dying till His promised physical return to the earth irrespective of when or how it will happen. If the reading or hearing of deathlessness resonates with your heart, it is time to give it enough attention to physically experience its reality. The scripture says death only reigned from Adam to Moses (Romans 5:14), meaning that by the introduction of the law of Moses, death's reign ceased. Yet according to our main verse, until Jesus Christ came into the world, all humanity still lived in bondage through its fear. Many often ask me, "If death is abolished, why do people still die?" The answer is simple, it is because of death-consciousness. This is why you must beware of it because it keeps people in fear of, and results in death through many ways. Follow carefully this week as we show from the Word, how to live above death-consciousness and its experience.

TUESDAY MAY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IS DEATH-CONSCIOUSNESS?

Ecclesiastes 9:5 "For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten"

Our verse today reveals that state of men that leads to death despite all that Jesus did over two thousand years ago. Until the light of deathlessness dawned on my heart from the scriptures, this verse was as normal as it is to many today, because of deathconsciousness. Death-consciousness is that state of absolute awareness that one will die one day. Truly, this awareness is so deep-seated that it has become a settled acceptance in human subconsciousness. It is the reason why many today are so aware and so certain that they will die. It is so accepted that some even desire to die counting it better than living because of Philippians 1:21, Psalm 89:48, Job 14:1-5 and other scriptures that reveal this death-conscious state of humanity. The good news is that Yahweh has programmed the latter Church that will mature into the full measure of the stature of Christ and constitute the glorious church to have no death-consciousness but rather reign over death underfoot as the last enemy (1 Corinthians 15:25-26).

Affirmation

I boldly declare that through the intentional renewal of my mind by the Word, death-consciousness is set to be wiped out of my files in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY MAY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE SOURCE OF DEATH-CONSCIOUSNESS

Ecclesiastes 9:5 "For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten"

An important question arises from our main verse today. "How did the living get to be so certain that they will die?". No one is born with death-consciousness; it is an acquired human trait. Death consciousness begins from the initial upbringing of children when they are told what not to do because it would kill or make them die. So, they start picking up the possibility of death. Secondly, as they hear historical accounts in stories and books, they get to learn of many relatives, and historical figures who are no longer alive. Thirdly, they begin to see people dying and being buried (parents, families, friends etc.) from common things like aging, sicknesses, accidents etc. Not long after, they accept these avenues of death as non-negotiable in life so they conclude within, "I will also die one day". Think about it, this is how you became death-conscious not because God told you in person that you were born to die.

Affirmation

I refuse to allow something that is humanly acquired, to control my life. I refuse to be death conscious. In Christ, I see no death. I am deathless conscious in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY MAY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEAL WITH DEATH-CONSCIOUSNESS (I)

Isaiah 25:7 "But now there is a veil covering all nations and people. This veil is called "death."

Death-consciousness is that veil or shroud of death that covered people of all nations since Adam's fall and has continued to produce death in them even after death has been abolished (Hebrews 2:14, 2 Timothy 1:10). God spoke ahead of Jesus' coming concerning our days, in which that veil will be removed, and death will be destroyed forever (Isaiah 15:7-8, watch, "NCC 2024: Deathlessness" on our YouTube channel @Davidbindanlive for more on this veil). So, for us to whom the mystery of deathlessness has been unveiled, dealing with death consciousness is foundationally important. This is so because one important step to physicalizing deathlessness is the replacement of deathconsciousness with deathlessness-consciousness. Therefore, having recognized the power that death-consciousness wields to produce the physical experience of death, uncompromisingly engage the practical scriptural steps that are necessary to eradicate it from our consciousness.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I declare that every operation of death-consciousness is deactivated in my life from today. I am stepping into that blissful zone of deathlessness-consciousness.

FRIDAY MAY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEAL WITH DEATH-CONSCIOUSNESS (II)

John 8:51 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death"

I love the way Jesus spoke. He uttered statements that are staggeringly tough to the vacillating mind. In the verse above, He said keeping His Word will make one unable to see death. He used the word "theōreō" which is a visionary term that describes a level of discernment, awareness or perception that results in experience. That is consciousness. Thus, Jesus was bluntly saying, in Him, we can arrive at deathlessness-consciousness, and this is the first practical step. Believe that you can arrive at never being conscious of death. Secondly, give special attention listening to people who are granted the mystery of deathlessness until the light of the scriptures cause the possibility of deathlessness to rise in you. Proceed to meditate and arrive at seeing nothing but only life in the paths of your life (Proverbs 12:28). This is such a liberating state of living that anyone who arrives there will go all out to share with others as we are doing.

Prayer

Dear Father, I affirm my confidence in You to arrive at deathlessness-consciousness by the power of the Holy Spirit through Your Word, in Jesus' Name.

SATURDAY MAY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IT IS A NEW DAY

Romans 8:18 "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us"

It is important to recognize how the early Apostles, especially the Apostles Paul and Peter, indicated that the latter end of the church will be more glorious than their time. For instance, in our verse today, Apostle Paul by the Spirit stated that the suffering of the Church in their time is unworthily incomparable to the glory that will be revealed in the latter church. People of God, I am glad to announce to us that we are in those days of the glorious church. It's a new day. This is why you are hearing and seeing large-scale trumpeting and mobilizations concerning the defeat of the last enemy of mankind and the kingdom - death (1 Corinthians 15:26). Cheer up! We have discovered that Word enjoyment is a pillar of spiritual growth in Christ. We also now know that it is that state in Christ at which one has developed a taste for the Word which has become real nourishment to him or her. Now, there is an attitude you must have that will enable you to either generally or specifically approach the Word in order to develop a taste for it and for it to become your nourishment. Like the Thessalonians, it is one of having the mind that is ready to interact with the spirit, life and active work of the Word anytime you expose yourself to its substance. Be conscious of what the Word is and can do as you hear or read it and then expect to experience it.

TUESDAY MAY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YOUR APPROACH TO THE WORD (II)

1 Corinthians 3:2 (LEB) "I gave you milk to drink, not solid food, for you were not yet able to eat it. But now you are still not able"

Apart from the attitude of the readiness of mind to experience the spirit, life and active work of the Word, the other thing that determines the degree to which your general or specific approach will translate to Word enjoyment is your current level of spiritual maturity. In the verse above, the people were not able to eat the Word that should have come to them, because of their level of maturity. Physically if you are unable to eat something for any reason, it is impossible to develop a taste for it and you surely cannot arrive at enjoying it. So, you must know your level of maturity and how to approach the Word in order to develop a taste for it. The three levels of spiritual maturity revealed in scripture and will be discussed in the days following, are children (primary), young men (secondary) and fathers (tertiary) - 1 John 2:13

WEDNESDAY MAY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRIMARY APPROACH TO THE WORD

1 John 2:1 "My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous"

The beginning of life in Christ is referred to as the babe, little children or carnal level (1 Corinthians 3:1). Characteristic of this stage is the "feeling" that everything is still the same as if one wasn't born again. Thus, one still thinks and feels like a sinner, helpless before sickness, demons etc. It is easier to develop a taste for the Word at this level by reading, listening and studying more of the portions of the gospels, Psalms and portions of the Old Testament concerning God's promises to protect, heal, forgive and so on. As your confidence in God grows, remember that there is a higher level and open up for further revelation from the Holy Spirit to take you there. If you jump straight into the Word for the mature, you may have challenges, and it might take a longer time to develop a taste for the Word.

Affirmation

The wisdom of God is at work in me. I am enabled in my approach to the Word to develop a taste in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY MAY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SECONDARY APPROACH TO THE WORD

1 John 2:14 "... I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one"

The next level of spiritual maturity is "young men" or spiritual adolescents level. Characteristic of this level is the knowledge that life in Christ ought to be better than ordinary human living and that by divine enabling, one can fight and overcome the devil and the negatives of life. This level engages the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit through prayer and faith to contend for their rights and privileges in Christ. To develop a taste when you are at this level, one must read, listen and study more of narratives of the Israelites and their victories over their enemies and the demonstration of the power of the Spirit through Jesus and the early Church. These will strengthen and establish your faith and result in more supernatural successes. As exciting as this level can be, you must remember that there is a higher level and allow the Holy Spirit to take you into more mature content of the Word.

Oh dear Father, that I will enjoy this young man level and advance into higher depths in Christ, in Jesus' Name



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
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


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FRIDAY MAY 16

Topic: TERTIARY APPROACH TO THE WORD

1 John 2:13a, "I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning"

The third level of spiritual maturity is referred to as the fathers level. Characteristic of this level is a knowledge and awareness of God as it ought to have been from the beginning before the fall. It is a knowledge of God as one's beginning, present and future. An awareness of being in God and God in you (John 14:20). Developing a taste for the Word at this level happens by feasting on the revelations of the Word that deal with Jesus' oneness with the Father and the Holy Spirit and His current oneness in us that made us just like Him now in this world (1 John 4:17). SATURDAY MAY 17

1 Corinthians 3:2 (GNT) "I had to feed you milk, not solid food, because you were not ready for it. And even now you are not ready for it,"

This issue of approach is very important. You must not be ashamed of your current level. Just don't remain there. When I was quite young in the things of God, I tried understanding everything in the Old Testament and boy, how I struggled. Not because God didn't want me to, but I couldn't get it at that level. But I kept getting inspired by the portions that I could feast on, and diving for more and my Daddy, the Holy Spirit, kept taking me deeper. It is better to approach it from your level and develop a taste that will take you deeper than struggling with bones and getting confused and discouraged. The only warning is not to get too settled on milk because it is detrimental to God's plan for you in Christ (Hebrews 5:12). Your approach matters.

MONDAY MAY 19

Topic: ARE YOU ON THE RIGHT TRACK?

Proverbs 14:12 "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death"

If you are in Christ, it is imperative to appreciate that living by common sense is sense-knowledge faith and if you choose to live that way, you will please men and yet be insignificant in eternal weight. Those in the eternal hall of fame in Hebrews 11, obtained a good report by faith, not by senses. Why is this so important? If a person follows common sense, he or she will follow a track in life that seems good but is disastrous at the end. Note that the way or track seemed good. It means it made sense to him but was it really good? Pause and examine your life. If the way you are going in life is what men and the world approve of and applaud, you are on the wrong track because the whole world is on the wrong track. Why? In Revelation 12:9, the word, "deceiveth" is in the present continuous tense, meaning in the past, now and in the future, the world is deceived. Are you following the world?

TUESDAY MAY 20

Topic: THE RIGHTNESS OF A TRACK IN LIFE

Hebrews 10:7 "Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God"

You must know what makes a track of life the right one. The rightness of a person's track in life is measured by whether he or she is living for purpose. Have you found out why you are here and at this time? If the trajectory of your life is not an answer to the question, "Why am I here at this time?", you are on the wrong track. Do not be deceived; a right track is not measured by success or advancement in what a person is pursuing. Anybody can succeed at whatever he determines whether it is good or bad. Being a success at what you desire is not the same as being successful in life. Someone can be a success in his career yet a failure in life. Success for yourself is not the same as success for God. MONDAY MAY 26

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CANAAN, THE FIGURATIVE PROMISED LAND

Genesis 12:1,5 "Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee. ... and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came"

When God called Abraham, he told him to go to a land that He would show him. We are told that the land is the land of Canaan. It is important to note that though God promised to give the land of Canaan to Abraham, His real promise was not just the physical land of Canaan. Canaan was a type or figure of the actual promised land that God wanted to give Abraham. The land of Canaan was chosen because its description typifies that of the real 'land' that God would later bring Abraham and his seed into. For instance, in Exodus 3:8 we are told that Canaan is a good land and a large land, one flowing with milk and honey; a place already occupied by the Canaanites, the Hittites, etc. Deuteronomy 6:1-3; also indicates that there are divine instructions to be followed in the promised land. So, though Abraham physically got to Canaan, that wasn't his real focus (Hebrews 11:10).

Prayer

Dear Father, by knowing the features of Canaan, I properly understand my state in Christ knowing that being in Christ, I am in the real promised land

TUESDAY MAY 27

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ZION, THE REAL PROMISED LAND

Hebrews 11:9-10 "By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God"

From this scripture we realize that though Abraham physically got to Canaan, he kept on looking for a city of God (Hebrews 12:22). By revelation, he understood that God's dealings with him were not just about a physical inheritance. Remember that God's promise was to Abraham and his seed. Abraham's seed had two generations – the physical (Isaac) and the spiritual (Jesus) - Genesis 17:7; 21:12; Galatians 3:16. Isaac was a type of Jesus (Hebrews 11:17) just as the physical promised land (Canaan) is a type of Zion (Hebrews 11:16). For the physical Abrahamic generation, their promised land was Canaan but for the spiritual Abrahamic generation (Galatians 3:29) Zion is the promised land. The exciting truth is that Zion was the actual place God had in mind when He called Abraham. So, being in Christ, is the fulfilment of God's ultimate plan that was being unfolded in the Old Testament.

Excitement

Wow, glory to God. I am so excited I am in Christ. I am God's dream come true. As a spiritual seed of Abraham, I am not in a shadow but in the reality of God's dealings in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY MAY 28

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IN CHRIST, YOU ARE IN ZION

Hebrews 12:22 "But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels"

When reading the scriptures, you need to watch out for the difference between futuristic promises and statements of present hour realities. Our verse begins by saying "Ye are come...". It didn't say "ye shall come ..." or "Ye may come if you do this or that". He said "Ye are come..." meaning you have already arrived. Where? In Zion! Where is that? The city of the living God. You remember that God prepared a heavenly city for the people of the Old Testament (Hebrews 11:16). This is the city you have arrived in. Some people erroneously think Christianity is a journey into the promised land. No! The Christian has already arrived in that heavenly city. He is a bona fide citizen of heaven (Philippians 3:20). It makes a whole lot of difference when you know you are already in Zion. It will take you from beggarly Christianity into a possessor of your possessions (Obadiah 1:17). Study this until it dawns on you that as a Christian, you are already a Zionite.

Confession

Hahaha! I know who I am and where I am. Being in Christ, I am in Zion the city of the living God right now. I am not within the range of the devil's oppression. Hallelujah in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY MAY 29

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IN ZION, YOU ALREADY HAVE POSSESSIONS

Obadiah 1:17 "But upon mount Zion shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions"

Through Prophet Obadiah, God was showing us certain features of Zion in the futuristic tense. But now Christ has brought us there and we are in the reality of those descriptions. First, He said there shall be deliverance. This doesn't mean people will be holding deliverance meetings in Zion but that in Zion will the delivered ones be found (Colossians 1:13). Secondly, the Zionites live in holiness – sin has no dominion over them (Romans 6:14). Then finally, they have possessions to possess. So, Zionites already have possessions. Theirs is to possess them. That means in Zion, everything required for a successful and great life, is already yours (1 Peter 1:3, Ephesians 1:3). We no more pray, "God bless me, God give me this or that". We get up and take a hold of what's already ours and begin to use it. If you are in Christ, you are a Zionite, stop begging for things. Recognize that all things are yours (1 Corinthians 3:21). Glory to God.

Confession

In Christ, I am a Zionite. Therefore, I am settled that peace is mine. Prosperity, success, joy and righteousness are inseparably part of me. I refuse to beg in life, in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY MAY 30

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IN ZION, YOU JUST POSSESS YOUR POSSESSIONS

Obadiah 1:17 "But upon mount Zion shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions"

Do you remember we said Canaan was a type of Zion to show us what life in Zion will be like? Canaan was already inhabited by other people, yet it was divinely designated to the children of Israel. To enjoy that good land flowing with milk and honey, they had to conquer those Canaanites. The earthly portion of heaven is Zion. This Zion is already being governed by Satan who got access to rulership through Adam's disobedience (Luke 4:6, 2 Corinthians 4:4). What this means is that though peace, prosperity, success, joy etc. are part of your life in Christ, Satan will try to prevent their expression on the earth if you allow him. Choosing to express what is yours on the earth is what it means to possess your possessions. Now you don't have to fight Satan like the Israelites did the Canaanites, just resist him in accordance with God's Word and he will flee (James 4:7)

Confession

Devil no matter what you are doing around, I refuse to be poor, barren, defeated and confused. I choose to fully express my joy, prosperity, success, health and glory in the Name of Jesus.

SATURDAY MAY 31

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: SIMPLE WAYS TO POSSESS YOUR POSSESSIONS

Psalm 27:13 "I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living"

To enjoy your lot in Christ, you must first believe. If David had not believed, he would not have seen God's goodness in his life. The problem with many is that they have been so buffeted or suffered so long that they just find it too difficult to believe. Someone has been sick for so long that he has forgotten about being healed. Someone has committed so many crimes that he cannot receive forgiveness. But listen there is hope for you in Jesus. According to Romans 10:10, if you believe, you can be aligned with God to get what is yours. Secondly, affirm your belief by speaking (2 Corinthians 4:13). Thirdly, maintain your grounds according to the Word until there is a physical expression. Never be afraid. Whatever the Word says you are, you are. No other evidence is required.

Affirmation

I believe what God's Word says about me. I am who He says I am, I have what he says I have, and I can do what He says I can do. Glory!

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

It is easy to enter into God's ultimate and His eternal plan for your life. You must receive Jesus by believing on His name. The Bible shows two clear steps to do this. A wholehearted belief and an acknowledgement/confession. Believe that Jesus is the one whose resurrection from the dead made mankind's adoption as God's sons/daughters possible and acknowledge His Lordship. To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.


