TUESDAY JULY 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: THE MEANS OF THE LIGHT OF LIFE

John 1:4 *"In Him was life; and the life was the light of men".*

According to God's Word, the Word of God is the primary channel by which the light of God shines. God's Word is the carrier or channel by which the light of His life materializes. When there was darkness in the beginning (Genesis 1:2), God's life was in Him and it was not until He uttered, "Let there be light" in verse 3, that brightness appeared from His life into being. John 1:1-4 testifies that the life of God that lights men was in the Word. Psalm 119:130 testifies that it is the unfolding or disclosure of God's Word that brings illumination, mental clarity and by implication direction to people. The implication is that now that we are born again, we have become the light of life today because we are the products of the Word (James 1:18, 1 Peter 1:23) and God's channel of light to the world (2 Corinthians 3:3, Ephesians 5:8, Philippians 2:15, Mathew 5:14-16).

WEDNESDAY JULY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: WHAT IS WALKING IN LIGHT?

Galatians 5:16 *"This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh".*

In the Bible, to “walk in something” is from the Greek Word “*peripateo*” and it means conducting your life about or carrying out all your living activities in that thing. It is more of something done as a lifestyle, than occasionally. To walk in the light, therefore, means carrying out all your living activities in light. Since we know that light is a state in which there is illumination and things are manifested enough to produce guidance, then walking in the light means carrying out all your living activities in a state of illumination and clarity that guides your steps in the right paths. That means in your education, marriage, business, ministry, parenting, daily living etc., you are in this state of illumination and clarity that guides you. This is a glorified gift of a life of complete direction where no mistakes are possible.

THURSDAY JULY 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: ONLY WALK IN THE LIGHT

Matthew 6:23 ***"But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!"***

Now that we know what it means to walk in the light, God wants us to know that when it comes to walking in the light, we must have no alternatives because it is a serious thing for light to walk in darkness. Any alternative will encase your divinity because that will be walking in darkness (Psalm 82:5-7). We are born again into divine fellowship, and we cannot afford to walk in darkness (1 John 1:3-7). When one who is born again, strays from the Word, he gets oppressed and abased by the evil systems of this world (Psalm 119:67). Having alternatives to doing God's Word, is planning for personal evil. Do not give yourself alternatives to God's Word.

FRIDAY JULY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: HOW TO WALK IN THE LIGHT (I)

1 John 1:7 “But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin”.

With what we have learnt so far, it is time to discover how to walk in the light. The first step is to awake to your being light in Christ. MONDAY JULY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: DEATHLESSNESS: BEWARE OF OBSERVATIONAL CONCLUSIONS

Job 14:1-2 *“Man that is born of a woman is of few days, and full of trouble. He cometh forth like a flower, and is cut down: he fleeth also as a shadow, and continueth not”*

An important aspect of the Bible is history, which was allowed to be written as part of scripture for us to learn how the people of those days lived, thought and perceived things and how that affected their relationship with God. An aspect of history in the scriptures is observational conclusions. These are conclusions of the writer or God based on the prevailing conditions of life. They are not necessarily statements of truth according to God's dealings but are in the Bible for our learning. If you are not aware of observational conclusions, you will hold dearly to death consciousness because you will think "God even says so" in the Bible. An example is the kind of conclusion stated by Job in our verse today. Where did he get it from? From the prevailing conditions of life in his day. There are many of such observational conclusions that we will look at this week.

Prayer

Father, I position myself to receive the light of this week's teaching so that I do not live by observational conclusions but the truth of Your Word in Jesus' Name

TUESDAY JULY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: DYING AT AGE 70 IS PAST

Psalm 90:10 (GNT) *“Seventy is all we have- eighty years, if we are strong; yet all they bring us is trouble and sorrow; life is soon over, and we are gone.”*

One observational conclusion that has for centuries cemented death, especially at 70, as a determination by God, is the one above. But when you read it carefully as explained in chapter four (4) of my book entitled “The Deathless Generation”, you will realize that it was only an observational conclusion by Prophet Moses. It was not God that said, “Seventy years is all we have— eighty years, if we are strong ...”. Moses was about to make an intercession for the troubles of his people (Psalm 90:13) and was recounting their experiences because of their sin (Psalm 90:7-12). This was just an observational conclusion that helps us to know why they lived in such troubles. By dying for all mankind to take away sin (2 Corinthians 5:14), dying at 70 ceased. If you believe, it will be your experience. If this was a compulsory experience, Moses himself would not have lived for 120 years.

Affirmation

Being alive in the post-resurrection era, dying at 70 is past and I live only without death till Jesus returns. Glory!

WEDNESDAY JULY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: DYING AT AGE 120 DIDN'T EXIST

Genesis 6:3 *"And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years"*

Even though dying at age 120 was not even stated as an observational conclusion in the scriptures, yet many made it so by a partial understanding of its context. By isolating verse 3, it has been concluded for centuries that the age limit of life is 120 years but that never existed in God's communication. Verse 7 indicated that, verse 3 was referring to how long it would take from then till He destroyed the polluted human species with the flood. When we interpret scriptures by scriptures, 1 Peter 3:20 shows that it was the time, *"when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water"*. In other words, God was saying, I will destroy them, yet I will give them 120 years to allow for the preparation of the ark to save the holy seed. So, dying at 120, never existed as a command of God.

Confession

Every observational conclusion about death is erased from my convictions by the Spirit within through this Word in the Name of Jesus Christ.

THURSDAY JULY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: NO ONE CAN ESCAPE DEATH, IS PAST

Psalms 89:48 *"What man is he that liveth, and shall not see death? shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave? Selah."*

Another observational conclusion that also cemented the convictions of death as a compulsory experience for all is in Psalm 89:48. In his contemplative poem, Ethan cries out for help from God by reminding Him of how He promised an eternal covenant with David. In his narrative, he mentions everyone dying without exception as a prevailing situation because of their sins. His observation wasn't wrong because it was true then. The problem arises when we read it as if that was a divine command to all mankind. After Jesus died and abolished sin and death, that conclusion ceased. For the scripture interpreting itself states in 1 Corinthians 15:51(GNT), that *"Listen to this secret truth: we shall not all die, but when the last trumpet sounds, we shall all be changed un an instant, as quickly as the blinking of an eye."* Clearly stated, we shall not all die meaning some will live only without death till His return. You can be one of us.

Prayer

Dear Father, once it is You that said, "we shouldn't all die" I choose to live only in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY JULY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: ENTERING HEAVEN IS NOT ONLY AFTER DEATH

2 Corinthians 5:8 "*We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord*"

Here again we have an observational conclusion not from the scriptures but the isolation of scripture from the context of others. Verse 8 above, started from verse 6, ending in, "... **whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord**". The simple question is, "Is Apostle Paul saying, Jesus is not with all of us who are living in the body now?" Obviously not. How could he then say in Galatians 2:20, that it is Christ living in him while in the flesh? How could he say, "Christ **IN** us, the hope of glory?" (Colossians 1:27). So, God was not telling us through the Apostle Paul that we must die before we enter heaven to see Jesus Christ. When you interpret scripture with scripture, you will realize that he was referring to their **state of conscious comfort** either in the body or in the presence of Jesus Christ. See details in chapter 7, of my book entitled "The Deathless Generation".

Celebration

Thank You, Jesus, that now I am consciously comfortable in my oneness with You even in this body and do not have to die before seeing You. Hallelujah!

SATURDAY JULY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: IT IS TIME TO WAKE UP

Ephesians 5:14 *“Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light”*

In Christ we are already light (Ephesians 5:8) and are not asleep as those in darkness (1 Thessalonians 5:7). Yet without truth and maturity many are likely to live as though they were asleep. So, 1 Thessalonians 5:6 says, “Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober”. Jesus Christ is really the Word of God made flesh. His coming into this world was real. His death was real. His resurrection and ascension are real. In these, He really abolished death. Let us throw away the beggarliness of the old ways and awake to the amazing realities of His mighty accomplishments and live in His victory over death. This is the time.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I have arisen from every slumber of death consciousness into my place of living only in Christ because my life is the eternal life of Jesus Christ.

SUNDAY JULY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

The impact of all observational conclusions concerning death are hereby wiped out by the power of the Holy Ghost. Jesus really came into this world. Jesus Christ truly died and resurrected. Jesus Christ truly abolished death. I choose to live in this victory over death. I am in Christ. I live only in Jesus' Name.

MONDAY JULY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: THE CHRISTIAN CULTURE

Ephesians 5:8 "***For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light***"

We who live here in Christ must recognize that we are a new family of God constituting God's kingdom and nation. As members of the heavenly kingdom, we have our own way of life in Christ. This is what is referred to as the Christian culture. It is a heavenly way of living that in itself is a guide or light to all earthly cultures (Philippians 2:15). That is why we are told to walk as children of light. To walk as used in our verse about is from the Greek word "peripateō" and it means to tread all around or conduct oneself about. TUESDAY JULY 15

THE DEATHLESS GENERATION

Chapter 5:

HOW DID DEATH BECOME A HUMAN EXPERIENCE ?

To understand how death came to be a universal human experience so much so that almost everyone knows deep down their hearts that they will one day die, let me explain another important scriptural principle about life on earth to you. I call it **the principle of experience by identification and not merit**. It is an important principle that governs people's experiences in life on this earth.

By this principle, **people have experiences because of their identification** with an individual, group, institution or system that merited that experience even when they did not personally merit such experiences.

To understand this principle, first understand that normally in life, people have experiences of what they directly merit. For instance, Abraham obeyed God, and he became a Father of many. Ananias and his wife lied, and they died. These are experiences by merit.

However, **by the principle of experience by identification, people actually experience what they did not directly merit**. For instance, we as the seed of

Abraham are heirs of the world today by our being identified with Abraham and his seed (Jesus Christ).


Experience by identification works for both evil and good situations. For instance, if a sitting president of a country makes a terrible international decision that has negative economic implications, naturally all citizens of that country who live by human economies would experience it though they did not make that decision individually. On the flip side, if the president makes a good decision, naturally everyone benefits in the country.

This is basically how death became a universal human experience due to Adam's fall. The good news is that as death became a universal experience of mankind by identification, **so has deathlessness become a universal human experience in Jesus Christ's death-abolition feat.** By the awakening of the world to this truth, this experience will be physicalized in the life of all.

TOPIC: KEYS TO A GOOD MARRIAGE (I)

Genesis 2:18 ***“And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him”***

The first key to building a good marriage is the understanding and belief that marriage is not just an association of two adults of the opposite gender. Marriage is a union that is instituted by God. Yea, many know this generally but a good number neither understand it nor believe it. This is revealed by their actions. Understanding that marriage is divinely instituted, generates a holy reverence in handling it. Believing that it is divinely instituted, reveals that it can only work by divine principles. If you are in a marriage that isn't "working", it is likely you or both of you don't yet understand or believe that it is instituted by God though you have generally accepted it to be so. Get a Word-based counselor to minister this reality to both of you until you understand and believe and there you go; it's time to enjoy.

THURSDAY JULY 24

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: KEYS TO A GOOD MARRIAGE (II)

Genesis 2:18 *"And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him"*

Apart from the truth that God was the one who originated marriage, the second key we see in our verse today, is that marriage is purpose driven. Thus, to build a good marriage, it must be based on a divine purpose. In the world, any male of age can connect with or partner with any female of age according to their choice, but it is not so in Christ. Adam had a clear assignment that needed Eve's companionship. A man without a clear vision of his life in Christ for which companionship is required is not ready for marriage, period. If you married without a word-based vision for your marriage, you cannot build a good marriage because it has no direction. Begin to pray and study the Word to discover your calling and that will give direction to the marriage. The number one purpose for marriage is fellowship for a divine assignment, then comes pleasure and procreation.

Dear Holy Spirit, I receive divine illumination into Your calling for my marriage in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY JULY 25

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: KEYS TO A GOOD MARRIAGE (III)

1 Corinthians 11:3 ***“But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God”***

Another important key to building a good marriage is headship or leadership. Every good marriage has a clear headship that both the wife and husband look up to for direction, guidance and strength. Obviously, the overall head of every good marriage is Jesus Christ in His Word through the Holy Spirit. If both the wife and the husband recognize the Word and the Holy Spirit as the non-negotiable head to whom they resort for wisdom, counsel and strength, they will be strong together and enjoy. When especially the man, believes he is the head and yet refuses to recognize the headship of Christ, danger looms. Or if the wife chooses to ignore the Word and Spirit, same thing happens. Sometimes God can minister the Word through the Holy Spirit through a matured couple whom you both trust. Maximize it if you have one.

Luke 14:28 (GNT) *“If one of you is planning to build a tower, you sit down first and figure out what it will cost, to see if you have enough money to finish the job.”*

See, let me tell you plainly in a heart-to-heart tone, you need a good marriage. Don't pretend that you don't care. Your whole world will be different if your marriage is a good one. So, think and think again. What will be too costly to give or do to build one? Absolutely nothing. The things we shared with you are basic, but they are really what you need to lay a solid foundation for a good marriage. Get your spouse's attention and let the two of you sit down and prayerfully figure out how to receive these truths and build a good marriage. You really love that man or that woman. WEDNESDAY JULY 30

TOPIC: HOW TO WALK IN LOVE (I)

2 Peter 1:4 *"Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust"*

Walking in love starts with recognizing that love is your nature in Christ. The new creature in Christ is born of God with the DNA of God. All things about the new creature is of God (2 Corinthians 5:18). This understanding is paramount. The Christian should not try to love. Trying to love through some behavioral modifications is a futile practice because it will be disappointed by failure. The Christian is to live-out his or her divine nature by the Word through the Holy Spirit. Therefore, when you recognize that love is your nature and nourish yourself in the Word and fellowship of the Holy Ghost to live as the son or daughter of God that you are, walking in love, will be the result.

THURSDAY JULY 31

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: HOW TO WALK IN LOVE (II)

2 Timothy 1:6 *"Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands"*

The second step to walking in love is to keep that divine nature of love stirred up. There are so many mental, bodily, environmental and societal factors that press against the expression of the love nature unless you keep it stirred up always. To keep your love nature stirred up, frequently affirm in prayer and fellowship that your nature is love and speak profusely in other tongues with intense focus on dispensing love to people around you and your world. The more intense and frequently you do these, the longer you keep embers of your love nature ablaze.

Stir Your Love Nature

Boldly declare that your nature is love and speak fervently in other tongues for 5 minutes while focusing on discharging it.

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

God's plan for creating mankind has always been to adopt them as His own children in the fullness of time. (Ephesians 1:4-5). When that time came, He sent Jesus Christ to be the means by which this adoption would take place (Galatians 4:4-5).

A wholehearted belief and an acknowledgement/confession. To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
