MONDAY AUGUST 4

TOPIC: WHAT IS IMMORTALITY?

Revelation 21:4 (NLT) ***“He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever.”***

The emphasized (underlined) portion of the above scripture succinctly defines deathlessness or immortality in our context of discussion. It means the absence of death (death-less-ness). Comprehensively deathlessness as it pertains to us in Christ, means a state of living without death. It encompasses both the absence of death in our state of life in Christ (John 8:51) and the inability to die in our nature of life (2 Timothy 1:10). As explained under, “My Inspiration” in the book, The Deathless Generation, I have stuck to using deathlessness instead of immortality, so I can comprehensively communicate the mystery and also avoid some unclear perspectives about immortality.

Prayer

Dear Holy Spirit, I receive abiding insight into the comprehensive meaning of immortality in the Name of Jesus Christ.

TUESDAY AUGUST 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: THE SOURCE OF IMMORTALITY

1 Timothy 1:17 ***"Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen"***

Yahweh, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ is the source or origin of immortality or deathlessness. Exodus 6:3, says, "And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them". The Hebrew meaning of "**yehôvâh**" is "the existing One". In other words, our Father introduced Himself as the self-existent or eternal being. Thus, He lives only. This is what is re-emphasized in Revelation 1:18 (NIV), as the "**Living One**". God our Father, in Jesus Christ is the source and origin of immortality. By becoming partakers of His divine in Christ, we became immortal by nature as He is. This is not a nature we attain after physical death. It is what we are now, and through the knowledge of truth, we are growing to fully express it here as the living ones till Jesus' return. Hallelujah!

Affirmation

Being born of God, I am a partaker of His divine nature including His immortality. I live only, in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: IMMORTALITY IS AN OFFER NOT A STRUGGLE

Genesis 2:9 ***"And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil"***

In the Garden of Eden, the tree of life was made so prominent and accessible that it was in the middle of the garden. Yahweh gave mankind free access to every tree in the garden including the tree of life (Genesis 2:16). What was the tree of life for? The ending of Genesis 3:22, says, "...: ***and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever***" Clearly, it was a tree to eat and live forever. Thus, a tree to eat and never die. Meaning, a tree of immortality or deathlessness. The question is, "Did God freely offer it to mankind? Or did mankind beg God to create this tree?" Yes! It was Yahweh's free offer to mankind. Whatever Adam missed, Jesus came to restore, including access to His immortal nature and life. So, we are not those struggling to attain immortality, it is our Father's free offer in Jesus Christ (John 6:50).

Confession

Immortality is a free offer from my Father in Jesus Christ. I gladly receive, embrace and walk in it in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY AUGUST 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: THE POSSIBILITY OF IMMORTALITY NOW

John 5:24 ***“Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life”***

Yea, “Dr. Bindan, I know we have immortality in Christ but is it not after resurrection that we can enjoy it? I don’t think it is something we can experience now”, says a dear one. But my dear, we are not dealing with what people think or feel about death. We are dealing with what God says about it after Jesus Christ abolished it in His resurrection. Jesus in our verse said plainly, “if you believe in me, you have passed from death to life”. The Greek word translated “passed”, is “**metabainō**” and it means to relocate or move from one place to another. That means by believing in Jesus Christ a person through the new birth, is relocated from a spiritual state of possibility of death to one of no death (one of life). When? The moment he or she believes. Not after death. The Bible didn’t say, “He that believes will pass from death after death”. It is now! Immortality is possible now.

Celebration

Glory to God forever! Immortality is for now, I believe it and I am in to enjoy it to the glory of my Father in Jesus’ Name.

FRIDAY AUGUST 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: IMMORTALITY NOW, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

John 11:26 *“And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?”*

Oh okay, Dr. Bindan, now I believe it is possible to experience immortality in this life, so what should I do? My dear, do nothing. Only believe! Though there are a few steps outlined in the book, “The Deathless Generation” towards physicalizing deathlessness, they are all to enhance our convictions in that truth and stabilize us in the realities of our divine nature. SATURDAY AUGUST 9

TOPIC: FEAR NOT

Luke 12:32 *"Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom"*

I have noticed that something the devil instilled into the worldly system before his dethronement by Jesus Christ, is the fear of good and perfection. The long standing history of evil, pain, disappointment and so on, enabled him to make people fear every good and perfect gift from Yahweh our Father. Talking about the kingdom, Jesus Christ knew that even the Jews whose whole life was about the kingdom of God, were afraid that they would not get it. Today, some are afraid to believe in immortality because they are afraid it "won't work". They ask within, "What if I believe and still die?". TUESDAY AUGUST 12

Acts 5:42 *“And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ”*

A few times I have met people who just have a difficult time being regular at church services. Mostly, they do nothing at home during church fellowship days and times. Often, they spend the time either watching football, movies or television shows, playing games, chatting with friends or engaged in something that is unedifying. When asked why they were not in fellowship, they have no good reason. They may tell a lie or just promise they will be in church the next time. I have personally realized that it is because they have not trained themselves to be ‘church’ people. To grow spiritually, you must train yourself to attend church fellowship frequently and regularly enough until you are used to it. Otherwise, invisible forces will play on your state to keep you out of fellowship for several flimsy excuses for life, to your detriment.

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: ESTABLISHMENT IN CHURCH IS NECESSARY

Psalms 92:13 “Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God”

As we mentioned yesterday, when people perceive that the teaching of the Word is the only reason for church fellowship, they easily get deceived by today's social media world where they can get good teachings on many platforms. When this happens, though they may claim membership in a certain church for physical reasons, yet they never get established. Others even think that because they are members of the universal body of Christ, there is no need for being established in a local assembly. Beyond just being a legal member, becoming a brother or sister that the local assembly can count on for effective contribution towards the growth of younger ones, establishment of the mature and the pursuit of the corporate kingdom assignment is necessary for your own growth. It is not because for human reasons the “church” needs you but indeed it is required by God, that is why you are in the body (Ephesians 4:16 TPT)

Affirmation

No matter what it takes, once my Lord Jesus requires me to be established in a church, I will by the power of the Spirit in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY AUGUST 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: ESTABLISHMENT IN CHURCH IS NOT DIVISION

1 Corinthians 12:20, 25 ***“But now are they many members, yet but one body. That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another”***

It is important for us to appreciate that our establishment in local assemblies of the body of Christ, is similar to specialized cells in the organs of the human body. Though the muscles of the heart are specialized to be in the heart, they are not divided or separated from the rest of the body. Rather, their unique function enables them to play their role in the circulatory system for the growth and nourishment of the whole body. In the same way, our establishment in local assemblies, helps to nurture us to grow, and contribute our part together with other brethren in the same local assembly, towards the overall growth of the universal body. So, brethren in other local assemblies of the body, irrespective of the name, denomination or location are equally our brethren as those in our local assembly. So, Ephesians 4:4-6 says, “There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all”. Hallelujah!

Prayer

Dear Father, I acknowledge the role of the unique local assemblies in the entire body of Christ and affirm that I am fully established where You have placed me, to contribute to the entire body of Christ in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY AUGUST 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

TOPIC: ESTABLISHMENT IN CHURCH IS NOT STAGNATION

Hebrews 6:1 (NET) ***“Therefore we must progress beyond the elementary instructions about Christ and move on to maturity, not laying this foundation again: repentance from dead works and faith in God,”***

As important as establishment in a local assembly of the church is, we need to appreciate that the entire body of Christ is on a corporate growth journey from babyhood (Ephesians 4:14) into the full measure of Christ's stature (Ephesians 4:13). That means we (as a body) will make progress and advance in the knowledge of divine truth (Daniel 12:4, John 16:13). So, while remaining established in a local assembly, we must not become stagnated by traditions and doctrines when it becomes clear that the Holy Spirit is moving the rest of the body ahead unto the next higher level of maturity. In a few cases where maturity gap is becoming a troubling issue to handle, one may need to relocate his or her establishment into another local assembly since it is the same universal body, instead of remaining stagnant in spiritual growth.

Affirmation

I mature in my personal fellowship with the Holy Spirit and to grow as the body of Christ grows while established in my local assembly.

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Final Global Movement: Maturing you into the full measure of the stature of Christ

AMAZING LIFE COACH

Excerpt from Chapter 1: THE AMAZING COACH – THAT IS WHO HE IS

Coaching is a form of development in which an experienced person brings up a learner in achieving a specific personal goal by providing **guidance** (direction), **instruction** (skill and tutelage), **training** (preparation) and **motivation** (comfort, strength). The coach does not play or carry out the activity that He is coaching the “coachee” for. He only does that during training or instruction to impart a skill but not in real life. A brief look at John 14:16 concerning the Holy Spirit in the Amplified Classic Translation says, “*And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby), that He may remain with you forever*”. Combining these seven dimensions described above, gives us the full meaning of the paraclete ministry of the Holy Spirit. This technically, means He is a life coach. And that is who He is - **the amazing coach of life: comforting, counseling, helping, interceding, advocating, strengthening and standing-by**. It cannot get better than that, Hallelujah!

To appreciate that the Holy Spirit’s fatherhood in your life is one of coaching, you must realize that this is ‘not’ His world. In other words, He is not here to live for Himself. He is existence and He was before anything that is created and not only that He was actually part of creating everything that exists today. In fact, He came in response to Jesus’ request to the Father for Him to come for the maturing of His body on earth (John 14:16). According to John 14:26 which says, “*But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.*”, the Holy Spirit is here in the name of Jesus Christ. In other words, He is the divine personality on earth in the stead of Christ. A clear corroboration is in John 16:7 saying, “*Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.*”

So, **the living** on earth is not the Holy Spirit’s to do. We as sons of God are the

ones to be trained up to live as the fullness of Christ on this earth and made ready for the coming of our Lord and Senior Brother Jesus whose body we are. Glory! Many Christians do not understand this hence they become overly dependent on the Holy Spirit to do **their living** for them but that is not why He came. They speak more about surrendering to Him or dying to self which when understood in the context of permitting one's divine nature to operate, is correct but when applied to the Holy Spirit doing every aspect of **their living** as though they were not conscious beings, is erroneous.

Let me give you an example. According to John 16:13 which says, *"Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come."*, the Holy Spirit is to guide sons of God into all truth. For what purpose? 3 John 1:4 says, *"I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth."* Clearly, the reason for guiding sons of God into truth is so that they will walk in the truth. The walking here, is the life of God's sons, it is not the Holy Spirit's.

So, imagine the Holy Spirit leads you into truth in a particular area and instead of walking in that truth you are praying to surrender so that He will just walk for you, it will never happen. Are you getting it? Right.

We can conclude on this by saying the Holy Spirit came first to make humans the sons of God and secondly to coach these begotten sons of God to reach and function in their potential of the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. All that He wants to draw your attention to at this point, is the recognition that His oneness with you in Christ is so that He can coach you into the Father's ultimate for you. And you know what? He is amazing at that. The Holy Spirit is the most amazing life coach. That is who He is.

TOPIC: REALITY OF VIRTUAL CHURCHES

Isaiah 33:6 ***“And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure”***

In our generation of a global village world through information technology and social media platforms, the employment of such avenues of knowledge and wisdom for establishment in virtual churches where necessary is possible. Many local assemblies have well-structured virtual churches that run much the same way as in-person or onsite church fellowships. So, in cases that by the Spirit you are planted in a local assembly but by divine direction have to relocate to another part of the earth, you may not need to necessarily relocate your establishment if there is a virtual church system in that local assembly. A virtual church is a real church fellowship by virtual means. It is not just an online participation in a program. So, following someone on radio, television or a social media platform is not the same as being in a virtual church. Virtual churches have Pastors, leaders etc., just like onsite churches, just that they are virtual. So, when necessary, you can still become established in a local assembly virtually. By all means get established in a Church.

MONDAY AUGUST 18

Topic: WHAT IS ADOPTION?

Ephesians 1:5 ***“Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,”***

It will be challenging to understand who Jesus Christ is and who you are as a child of God if you do not understand the subject of biblical adoption. Adoption as used in the scriptures is from the Greek word ***“uihothesia”*** which generally means to either bring someone into the position of a son by a legal acceptance into the family or to place someone as a son by an official appointment to function as a son in the place of the father. Usually, the former, which is the legal acceptance of a non-biological child into a family by a couple and bestowing on him all the rights and privileges of a biological child is the one that is commonly known. The latter meaning of adoption though not well known was practiced by kings in the Roman Empire where a king determines at the appointed time to choose one of his biological sons and officially place him as one who can act in his stead. This son, though a biological one, is also said to be adopted. The scriptures reveal three occasions of God’s adoption that we will look over this week.

TUESDAY AUGUST 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ADOPTION OF ISRAEL

John 1:12 ***"But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God..."***

The adoption of Israel as implied in the scriptures referred to God accepting the Israelites into His family as a result of Abraham receiving His Word (Genesis 12:1,4). There were many people on earth at the time, but God called Abraham and gave him His Word. When Abraham received the Word and acted on it, God accepted him and authorized him to be a son and his descendants became children of God but not by birth (Exodus 4:22, Romans 9:4 (NLT)). This was an adoption peculiar to the Israelites. By this adoption, Abraham and all those born in his lineage were legal members of God's family. If you were not an Israelite at the time, you were described as an alien, or stranger and one without hope or God as seen in Ephesians 2:11-12. God was exclusive to the Israelites. This adoption is different from the adoption of those who believed on the name of Jesus Christ (John 1:12) because Jesus had not yet died and been raised from the dead.

Father, I pray for Israel that they will receive the truth of Your Word and become Your children by birth as You have desired before the foundation of the world. Amen

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE ADOPTION OF JESUS CHRIST - I

Acts 13:33 “God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.”

The adoption of Jesus Christ occurred in two stages. The first stage was His adoption as a Son of God by reason of becoming flesh as the seed of Abraham. During His earthly ministry as Jesus Christ of Nazareth, God referred to Jesus on two occasions (at His baptism and transfiguration) as His beloved Son (Mark 1:9-11, Luke 9:35). This was because Jesus of Nazareth who was the Word that became flesh (John 1:14) came as a seed of Abraham, whose lineage had been accepted into the family of God (Deuteronomy 32:9). He was God’s adopted son in that sense (Galatians 3:16).

THURSDAY AUGUST 21

Topic: ADOPTION OF JESUS - II

Ephesians 1:20 *“Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,”*

The second stage of Jesus' adoption was His placement as a son after His ascension into heaven (Acts 1:9-10). When Jesus died to take away sin and abolish death, He was begotten by God through His resurrection from the dead (Acts 13:33). He thus moved from being God's Son by acceptance into the family of God to a Son born by God through the resurrection and this was made clear in heaven, on earth and in hell (Romans 1:3-4). Having ascended He announced His presence at the gates of heaven (Psalm 24:7-10) and God received Him and coronated Him by placing Him at His own right hand: the sides of the North, a place far above all principality, power, might and dominion. A place where everything else is under His feet. He also gave Him a name that is above every name that is named both in this world and that which is to come (Ephesians 1:20-22). A name that when mentioned every knee in heaven, on earth and underneath the earth bows, and every tongue confesses that Jesus Christ is Lord (Philippians 2:9-11). The Father set Him on the throne. This was done in full view of all those in heaven. This is the second stage of Jesus' adoption.

Topic: ADOPTION OF MANKIND - I

Ephesians 1:4-5 "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,"

God the Father had a plan for mankind before the foundation of the world. This plan was to adopt mankind to Himself by Jesus Christ. Mankind was to have a holy and blameless existence in His presence in love. This plan was locked up in predestination meaning absolutely nothing could stop it from happening, not even the fall of Adam, which plunged all of mankind into sin and separation from God (Ephesians 1:4-5, Romans 5:12, Romans 3:23). In the fullness of time, the Word came as flesh, a seed of Abraham, that by His death and resurrection mankind would receive the adoption as sons (Galatians 4:4). Remember that the Israelites were already children of God as a result of Abraham's reception of God's Word. This was a unique adoption for only Israel. The death and resurrection of Jesus however took away this "uniqueness" of Israel because its purpose had been fulfilled. Jews and Gentiles were now the same and could step into God's original plan of adopting them as sons by birth. Jesus' death and resurrection introduced a spiritual adoption which He Jesus went through. It is the adoption of the new birth and is open to all of mankind- Jews and Gentiles alike.

Topic: ADOPTION OF MANKIND - II

John 1:12-13 “... even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.”

According to Ephesians 1:4-5, God planned that mankind will be adopted to Himself as His children through Jesus Christ. This adoption was going to be by birth (John 3:3) and result in beings just like Himself (John 3:6) who can call Him Abba Father (Galatians 4:6). This is the adoption of the new birth. The resurrection of Jesus from the dead made this adoption possible. John 1:12-13 tells us that those who believe on the name of Jesus are authorized to be sons of God by birth not just by acceptance into a family (John 1:13). To believe on the name of Jesus means to believe what the scriptures have said concerning His nature as God's Son (1John 4:15), His authority as Lord (Philippians 2:11) and His function as the Christ (1John 5:1). Jesus received all these titles when He resurrected from the dead. This adoption results in the birth of a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17) who is seated in Christ in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6) and in him is the fullness of the Godhead tabernacled (Colossians 2:9-10). If you are born again, this is who you are. You are all that Jesus Christ is now in this world (1John 4:17 (TPT)). Walk in this consciousness. If you are not born again, get born again today by praying the prayer below having believed in your heart what the scriptures have said concerning Jesus.

Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, I wholeheartedly believe that You are the appointed person for my adoption as God's son. I believe You made this possible by your resurrection from the dead. I boldly confess You as Lord and by this confession I receive eternal life and declare I am born again. Hallelujah

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

Dear Father, I thank You for a clear understanding of what adoption is. Thank You for showing me the different kinds of adoption and what exactly took place in all of them. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
