WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 5

Topic: BASIS FOR JOYFUL KINGDOM SERVICE - II

Philippians 3:8 “Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss ***for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord***: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ”

The second basis for joyful kingdom service is an advanced personal knowledge and love for Jesus Christ. THURSDAY NOVEMBER 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JOYFUL SERVICE IN CHALLENGES

Acts 5:41 *“And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name”*

Some people have allowed certain challenges of kingdom service to dampen their hearts and extinguish the expression of their joy. No, that should not be the case. Like Jesus Christ, we must embrace kingdom service with certain challenges because of the corruption in the world that is yet to be eradicated. Topic: GROWTH IN JOYFUL SERVICE - I

2 Timothy 4:5 ***“But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry”***

How does joyful kingdom service translate into spiritual growth? The first means by which joyful kingdom service produces spiritual growth, is by exposing us to challenges that we would not have ordinarily encountered without such engagements. 2 Timothy 1:5 ***“When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also”***

I have no doubt that there are some elderly people who are really excited to hear the truth of immortality profusely dispensed in their day. But genuinely, they know they will not physically experience it, and they are not disturbed. And that happens. Sometimes initial receivers of a spiritual dispensation like Apostle Paul, and the mature Israelites in Moses' days don't necessarily get to experience it themselves. If you are in that group and asking, "How can I steward this message?" It is simple. Just listen carefully, read the scriptures prayerfully with the Holy Spirit and consolidate your faith. Then diligently pass that faith into your children and grandchildren or others around you who will listen to you. Like the mother and grandmother of Timothy, you would have stewarded the deathless generation by transmitting the biblical conviction (faith) of immortality. So, get excited and ready to learn more, receive and transmit to others.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: ESTABLISH IT

Luke 2:37-38 “And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem”

The peri-incarnation era of Jesus Christ was strongly stewarded by people like Simeon and Anna. In their seeming invisible ways, they established things to make Jesus' coming a possibility. The second way to steward this message of immortality that the Lord has entrusted you with, is to get it established through intentional and consistent prayer and personal commitment to preaching and publishing it. Like the light of a dawning sun, this message will gently weave through the waves of religious, medical, social and philosophical contentions until the deathless generation emerges. Be a part of making that happen by relentlessly pushing until it becomes established in the Church, because it sure will. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: PHYSICALIZE IT

2 Corinthians 5:4 (GW) ***“While we are in this tent, we sigh. We feel distresses because we don’t want to take off the tent, but we do want to put on the eternal house. Then [eternal life] will put an end to our mortal existence.***

Though some to whom this message has come may not experience it physically, God’s goal is to produce a generation that will live and not die. Steward it by being part of that deathless generation in whom the resident eternal life swallows up all mirages of mortality. Make no mistakes about it, this will happen. It is not an empty hope, the presence of the Holy Spirit in you is the guarantee. 2 Corinthians 5:5 (GW) says, “God has prepared us for this and has given us his Spirit to guarantee it”. People of the world are sensing this hence they are seeking immortality through genetic manipulation, organ transplants and so on but unfortunately none of that has immortality, only eternal life in Jesus Christ does. Feast on the scriptures, meditate profusely and practice living immortality as described in the book, “The Deathless Generation”, and you would have stewarded it. Glory to God.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: STAND FOR IT

Ephesians 6:11 (GW) ***“Put on all the armor that God supplies. In this way you can take a stand against the devil’s strategies.”***

For those who decide to physicalize immortality, get ready for several tricks of the enemy. The moment you say to yourself, “I believe I have life and immortality in Christ and will not die”, the dis-empowered spirits of darkness will frequently try to dissuade you through bizarre and multiple symptoms. The goal is to convince you against the Word that your body is still mortal and that immortality is impossible. But take your stand. Resist them as many times as they come (1 Peter 5:8-9). Jesus Christ took away all diseases on the cross therefore, symptoms of diseases are mirages. Refuse to let them materialize by sticking to the reality of the life and immortality in you in your thoughts, speech and actions. Immortality is yours to enjoy here. Stand for it in Jesus’ Name.

Topic: WHAT IS SEEING IN THE SPIRIT?

2 Kings 6:17 ***“And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.”***

Seeing in the spirit is simply the perception of physically invisible yet definite realities in the spirit realm. There is an invisible spirit world. To deny it, is to live in deception for life. Though physically invisible, things in the spirit world are as real and definite as those in this physical world. There are beings, processes and transactions in the spirit world. When a person in this physical world is able to clearly and intelligently perceive spirit realities by spiritual sight, he or she is said to be seeing into the spirit. Though people who see into the spirit (whether by evil spirits or the Holy Spirit) are often specially regarded and even feared, yet that should be natural for everyone who believes in Jesus Christ. It only requires that one understands what seeing in the spirit really is, how to get his spiritual eyes open and how to process the realities of the spirit as they relate to your life and the physical world; and these we will study for the rest of this week.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TWO KINDS OF SEEING IN THE SPIRIT

2 Kings 6:17 *“And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.”*

The scripture reveals two kinds of seeing into the spirit world when it comes to the dealings of Yahweh, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, and how He deals with people on earth and His sons in Christ. The first one which is presently common is the divine enablement of a person's spiritual eyes to see into the spirit realm by His Spirit. This is the primary means by which prophets and seers of God operate as in the verse above. In Christ, this means a gift of the Holy Spirit and only those with such gifts or callings operate as such. The second means is seeing in the spirit as a natural way of living in Christ. This is for every son of God, though it is largely yet to be developed in the body of Christ. It is simply a state of constantly seeing the spirit realm through the Word, by reason of one's union with the Godhead. Jesus Christ of Nazareth lived this way by seeing the Father always (Acts 2:25). The good news is that as we keep teaching, every Christian will assume their place of seeing in the spirit always.

Celebration

Oh dear Father, I am excited that at last, I can receive the teaching of Your Word and assume my state of seeing always in the spirit, in Christ. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: OPENING YOUR SPIRITUAL EYES

Acts 2:4 ***“And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance”***

Recently, someone asked, ***“How can I have my spiritual eyes and ears open?”*** Truth is that after Adam and Eve got their eyes opened from the spirit into the physical senses, all humans required divine enablement to see the spirit realm but not as their natural way of life. This was what happened when Elisha prayed for his servant in 2 Kings 6:17. Now, in Christ we are begotten of the Spirit and are spirit (John 3:6). Therefore, the spirit realm is our natural realm. Yet, because of the dominant fallen human consciousness, the Holy Spirit specially embraces us, to awaken us to the realities of the spirit realm including the heavenly language. So, technically, the spiritual eyes of every son of God embraced by the Spirit are open to see in the spirit. That means all spiritual senses are permanently awakened (activated) to perceive in the spirit. So, wondering how to open your spiritual eyes? Get embraced or filled with the Holy Spirit.

Affirmation

In the name of Jesus Christ, I boldly affirm that being born again and embraced by the Holy Spirit, I am always awake to the spirit realm.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO SEE IN THE SPIRIT - I

Philemon 1:6 ***“That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.”***

When spiritual operations are gift based, you can be taught as an impartation, but it won't last if the Lord has not chosen to operate that gift in you. If you persist, you will step into spiritual error. But when a spiritual operation is part of your nature and ability in Christ, you can learn and grow to be consistent in it. We are about to study how to see the spirit realm as just sons of God not as those with that gift. The first step to seeing in the spirit, is to get yourself convinced beyond all reasonable doubt that having been embraced by the Spirit, you are now in that state that you can see, hear, smell and feel in the spirit. This is one of the good things about you in Christ that you must acknowledge profusely in prayer. Once that is settled, the next step is to begin to strongly expect to see, hear etc., in the spirit. Many don't expect to see or hear in the spirit hence they don't. Fan your expectations into flame in prayer with your acknowledgment and you will begin to see and hear.

Confession

I boldly declare that all my spiritual senses are open and from today, I strongly expect to see into and hear from the spirit world in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO SEE IN THE SPIRIT – II

Acts 2:25 (GW) ***“This is what David meant when he said about Jesus: ‘I always see the LORD in front of me. I cannot be moved because he is by my side.’”***

The third step to seeing in the spirit naturally as a son of God, is to develop your spiritual sight in the Word. When you learn to read the Word with the Holy Spirit enough and subject the seeing faculty of your soul to it through meditation, the spiritual sight that the Word is painting will get recorded in your soul. This is how always seeing in the spirit begins. God’s Word are vivid descriptions of spiritual beings, entities and transactions. I have always said that reading the Bible is my best movie times in life because it is all imagery to me. When you are “brainwashed” in the scriptures, your sight and perceptions will permanently shift from those of your optical eyes and physical senses, to those of your new creation self in Christ. God’s Word is the material or the foundation for accurate sight into the spirit realm. Note that this is not a teaching on how to see as a seer or by prophetic gift from God, which is often occasional depending on the need, but constantly seeing your natural realm as a son of God (a spirit being).

Prayer

Dear Father, as I subject the seeing faculty of my soul to reading and meditating on Your Word, I stir my divine ability to constantly see in the spirit in Jesus’ Name.

Acts 16:10 (GW) *“As soon as Paul had seen the vision, we immediately looked for a way to go to Macedonia. We concluded that God had called us to tell the people of Macedonia about the Good News.”*

When it comes to seeing, hearing and perceiving in the spirit, what is seen, heard or perceived is not as important as how it is interpreted to relate to life in the physical. Topic: HOW TO MEASURE YOUR 2025

1 Samuel 16:7 ***“But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.”***

Spiritual assessment of your life is not done with physical parameters. If you look at this from the outside, you will either over or underrate your advancement along with God. So, a proper way to assess your 2025, is to have some time alone with God, your father. Move from what the Lord told you from the beginning and travel through all the opportunities provided in the year and see how you have maximized or otherwise underutilized them and keep writing as He speaks to you until He's done with you. Enjoy and congratulations in Jesus' Name.

I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible.
