MONDAY FEBRUARY 2

1 Peter 2:2 *“As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby”*

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TUESDAY FEBRUARY 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRACTICAL GROWTH IN CHRIST

1 Timothy 4:15 *“Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all”*

Does growth in Christ appear mysterious and hard to achieve? Here is the experience of Sydney Kuvarega (South Africa) in OGT 2025, along these lines.

John 4:22 *“Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews”*

Does it feel like your prayers are empty, unsatisfactory and just bouncing off the ceiling? Dr. Nana Abena has this to share from her participation in OGT:

“Prior to OGT, anytime I start praying is when every other thing comes in my mind and it will be just wandering about. I will be expressing the words, but my mind will be on something else. After the training last year, I am now able to focus more in prayer with very little distraction and even when my mind wanders, quickly I am able to shift back to focus. It has really been amazing. Also, one dawn session, Dr. Bindan, made us imagine God before us to just talk to Him as a Father. That statement stuck with me. It transformed the way I viewed prayer. From then, anytime I prayed, I knew I was talking to my real Father who is just before me, no longer far away. I just have to speak to my Father from my heart. Oh, now I just flow. Prayer has ceased to be a religious uttering of words. It has become moments of flowing from my heart to my present and real Father. It has made everything smooth and easy for me. I can talk to my Father anywhere, anytime and about everything.”

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THURSDAY FEBRUARY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FORGIVENESS IS NOW EASY

Matthew 5:44 ***“But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you”***

Have you wondered whether you could forgive and live in harmony with people who keep hurting you? Sister Joyce Dogli (Ghana) has this to say from her participation in OGT 2025.

“I used to be impatient, bitter, unforgiving, quick tempered, self-centered etc. It was so bad that I went to the extent of holding grudges with people who offended my dead parents when they were alive. I hated people for no reason and as a result ended up hating myself unknowingly. However, through OGT, I understood my nature in Christ and went through training to manifest my true nature in Christ. As I believed and affirmed these virtues day and night according to Ephesians 4:13, I noticed that I became a master who is now expressing my true divine nature. When I was doing this exercise, Daddy Holy Spirit took me down a memory lane and showed me all the persons and circumstances, including myself, that I needed to forgive and let go for the peace I so desired. When I was praying for these people, mentioning their names one after the other, affirming that I am love and that I love them, and have forgiven them, my heart was broken. I was in pain and in tears. As I continued, I easily forgave and I now love and always pray for them. I now tolerate and love all persons equally. I’m now so patient, meek, soft spoken and everything pertaining to godliness.”

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FRIDAY FEBRUARY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FROM MOVIES TO THE WORD

Psalms 119:103 *“How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!”*

Do you find it easy to enjoy movies, newspapers and surfing the internet? Is social media more interesting to you than reading your Bible? Sister Joyce Dogli’s (Ghana) remarkable transformation in this area is here.

“Before OGT, I was struggling with my relationship with my God, so I didn’t understand the Bible either. Whenever I read it, there seemed to be no tangible impact in my life. As a result, I stayed for more than two years without opening my Bible to read. I had rather downloaded close to a hundred movies on my phone and watched them 24/7. When I finished watching one, I would delete it and replace it with another. There were instances that I had promptings to study the Word and so I would go for the Bible, open to read but did not understand what I read. There were occasions I would put the Bible under my pillow and sleep on it for days and months in the quest to develop taste for the Word, but it never worked. But through the OGT practices, I can now joyfully study the Word for at least an hour every day. I can consciously soak myself in the atmosphere of the Word. The Word is indeed active and alive. I have really developed a taste for the Word, so much that I can no longer miss a day without studying, listening and meditating on the Word even as the Holy Spirit ministers to me always through it.”

Topic: I NOW KNOW THAT THE WORD IS SPIRIT

John 6:63 ***"It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life"***

Do you read your Bible yet are unable to make contact with the life and spirit of the Word? Our Sister Diana Frimpong (South Africa) has this to share about that.

"Through OGT, I have been made to know that prayer is not only about asking for things. It is more about fellowshiping with the Godhead. It is a personal regular communion with the Godhead and should be from my heart, word-based and I must have focus. Also, I have come to know and believe that the substance of the Word of God is spirit. It is active and powerful. I have learnt that the Word is my food and nourishment because I was born by the Word. Spiritual exercise also blessed me greatly. I also discovered and accepted that love, joy, peace etc. are part of my nature. All I have to do is to express it (Philippians 2:13). Practicing to express these virtues has blessed my home, my workplace etc. There was a time that my team leader at work sent me a harsh email which really got to me. I immediately remembered that I am love and had to work it out. In fellowship with Daddy Holy Spirit, He told me to pray for my team leader. So, I mentioned her name and blessed her according to Matthew 5:44 and immediately the hurt vanished."

Topic: YOU HAVE A CHRISTIAN VISION

Acts 17:30-31, ***“And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead”***

Let us start the Christian vision series by awakening you to the truth that you have a Christian vision. Many are not aware, but whether you are aware or not, your entire Christian life is driven by a certain Christian vision that you have. A Christian vision refers to an internal perspective or framework developed by your understanding or interpretation of what being in Christ today is about and where you expect it to go in the future. For the Apostle Paul, with all that he was doing in Christ, he was doing his best (2 Corinthians 9:17-27), believing to finish well (2 Timothy 4:7) by helping people to turn towards God (***repent***) because there was coming an era (***a day***) in which God will judge all men by Jesus Christ and he will receive a crown of righteousness (2 Timothy 4:8). TUESDAY FEBRUARY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TODAY'S AVERAGE CHRISTIAN VISION

2 Corinthians 5:10, ***“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad”***

A general observation reveals that the average Christian vision today is one of, “I have received Christ therefore my sins are forgiven. Let me try my best to live as holy as I can, serve the Lord by winning souls or carry out a work of ministry and be faithful till I die or Jesus comes to take me away. Then I will face judgement and see whether I qualify to enter heaven and get some rewards or go to hell”. I am yet to tell how it is with you, but this is the dominant drive of today’s Christian living. It is a vision which has developed from many fundamental truths in scripture, but it requires a massive reconstruction. This reconstruction is strongly suggested because this is a Christian vision developed from a long western Christian heritage that missed a critical understanding of the Apostles of Jesus Christ and the first century Church.

Dear Dad, I receive grace to deconstruct and reconstruct my Christian vision according to the truth of Your Word, in Jesus’ Name.

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LIFT YOUR CHRISTIAN VISION

Matthew 16:18 ***“And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it”***

A strong call for the deconstruction of the current Christian vision is not critical but is to reveal that the right person to define the true vision of the Church, is not Christian heritage but Jesus Christ who is Himself the only builder of His own Church. So, our call here is to say, “Let Jesus’ vision of the Church, be your Christian vision”. Is it His vision that Christians will be mere humans who are doing their best to live holy and serve Him in one way or the other till they die or He comes to take them away? No! His vision is that before He returns, we must grow into Him until His fullness in us is realized because as He is, so are we here (1 John 4:17). For the accomplishment of this vision, He gave us Apostles, Prophets, Pastors etc., for our perfection and edification till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, ***unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ*** (Ephesians 4:11-13).

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THERE IS MORE FOR YOU IN CHRIST

1 Thessalonians 5:23 (NET) ***“Now may the God of peace himself make you completely holy and may your spirit and soul and body be kept entirely blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”***

Again, the current Christian vision needs deconstruction if we are to enjoy the full benefits of our being in Christ because it limits the whole purpose of being in Christ to securing a ticket of entrance into heaven one day after the normal ordinary living of struggling with sin, sickness, pain, poverty etc. But the truth is, there is much more than that for you in Christ. For instance, our verse today alone, indicates an ongoing sanctification in spirit, soul and body unto a flawless state. That means a state of perfection in spirit, soul and body. And amazingly it didn't say, "When Christ returns, He will make us perfect". It is clear, that we would be kept, preserved or maintained in that state at His coming. Can you see that? This is big. Perfection in spirit is life overflowing. Perfection in the soul is sinlessness and perfection in the body is deathlessness. These are available for you here before Jesus' return. But if you don't lift your Christian vision, you cannot see them, even in your Bible.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MORE THAN MERE HUMANITY

John 14:20 ***“At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you”***

The day your placement in the community of the Godhead is realized in you, your life will change forever. You will suddenly see that true Christianity is absolutely not a religion. It is not mere humanity struggling to perch with humans in a corrupt system but an absorption into divinity. It is a union of you and Jesus Christ in the Godhead. Oh hallelujah! Many do not understand the predestined adoption that Dad has in store for humanity before the world began (Ephesians 1:4-5). Lift your vision and see! Being in Christ is more than mere humanity. It is the divinization of the humankind in Jesus Christ. If you are in Christ, indeed, you are a new type of species, old humanity is gone. You are now a partaker of the divine nature (2 Peter 1:4)

Romans 8:32 (NET) ***"Indeed, he who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all - how will he not also, along with him, freely give us all things?"***

The current Christian vision has placed a lot of limitations on the expectations of people and heavy veils on the hearts of many as far as receiving what Dad has for them in Christ is concerned. By these limitations, they have so strongly embraced the sufferings and frustrations of mere humanity as their lot that any attempt to lift their vision to a better life in Christ now, appears to be unrealistic promises. But no one can promise another anything better than what Jesus Christ procured in His death and resurrection and has revealed in the Word and is consistent with present truth. If Dad gave Jesus Christ to take away sin and death for the reconciliation of mankind and adoption, is it too hard for Him to make you live in sinlessness, deathlessness or lacklessness? Think deeply about this and refuse to be cheated. No one can promise you more than you already have, are and can do in Christ.

Final Global Movement: Maturing the body of Christ into icons of Christ

YOUR WORLD VIEW IN 2026

(31st December Night of Word)

Your worldview begins with the thoughts you generate, and determines your entire experience of life. To experience the upgrade and remarkable advancement available in 2026, you must reframe how you see the world. The Lord has outlined six key things for how you should see life in 2026.

The 2026 Worldview

1. **Look around, think and conclude that something is not right in this world.** With all the sickness, misfortune, and death in the world, it is clear something is not right because of sin. Man is no longer in the original state or plan of God, and therefore creation has missed its purpose (Rom 5:12, Eph 4:18).
2. **Discover that the Creator did not abandon the world in that state.** Even when the world went into sin, the Creator did not leave it to its fate. He immediately instituted a plan for restoration, promising the “seed of the woman” will crush the head of the serpent (Gen 3:15).
3. **Become aware that Jesus Christ is that Creator’s solution.** The Jesus you have heard of is the specific solution promised by the Creator. He is the “Lamb of God” who took away the sin of the world (John 1:29). Through Him, we receive the adoption of sons, restoring us to God’s original plan (Gal 4:4-5).
4. **Accept the role of the people in the world to experience this solution.** Since man was responsible for the entry of sin, man must be the vessel for the solution. It is the responsibility of people to receive Jesus, become sons of God, and restore dominion. Creation is waiting for the manifestation of these sons to be liberated (Rom 8:19).

5. **Become aware of what has happened so far.** You must understand that for the past 2,000 years, God has been working to build and mature His heirs from “babes” into mature sons. We have now reached the point where the Glorious Church has begun to emerge to manifest this solution (Gal 4:1-2).
6. **Decide to live as one doing something about this truth.** Do not live a “normal” life; decide to live as a solution provider. You are not a victim of circumstances; you are here to apply your divinity to fix the brokenness around you. Hallelujah!

Succeeding with God in 2026

To succeed in this new season, you must adopt a specific posture:

1. **Express Gratitude:** 2026 is the Year of Expressing Gratitude for the emergence of the glorious church. You must talk, sing, and dance gratitude specifically for the emergence of the glorious church. Act as a midwife welcoming this new era into the world.
2. **Prioritize Maturity:** You cannot remain a spiritual babe. You must grow. Participate in FGM Academy and other Ministry programs which are designed to help you attain to the full measure of the stature of Christ, for an heir cannot manifest until he matures.
3. **Live as a Solution:** You must view every challenge—whether financial, physical, or societal—with the mindset that “I am the solution”. For as He is, so are you in this world!

MONDAY FEBRUARY 16

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEADERSHIP IN CHURCH

Philippians 1:1 ***“Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons”***

Though used in many ways in various Church settings today, Biblically, “bishop” is from the Greek, “*episkopē*”, from *epi* (over) and *skopeo* (look or watch); which simply means “**overseer**”. In simplest terms a bishop is a leader overseeing a group of people or a function in church. So, for instance the overseer of the music unit in church who may in our days be called MD, is the bishop of the musicians. The size of a group could be a whole local assembly or a cell of two or three brethren. Though used interchangeably with “elder”, the latter tends to describe the degree of maturity of the leader, while bishop deals more with the oversight assignment or work. The beautiful thing about oversight duties in church is that it is divine (Acts 20:28) and seeing it that way changes a lot.

TUESDAY FEBRUARY 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IT'S A GOOD THING TO BE A LEADER

1 Timothy 3:1 ***"This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work"***

While some people in Church are always minding their own business and not willing to take up leadership roles for concerns of offending people, there are those who are sniffing everywhere for leadership because of some advantages. Based on the scriptures, be in none of the above groups. We are to realize that it is a good thing to take up leadership or bishopric. This is because every thriving local assembly of the Church requires more hands on the job to make it effective. Open up and embrace leadership responsibilities because it is good and it is also necessary. When you do, do so for the sake of the Church family, not for fame or carnal advantages (1 Peter 5:2).

Prayer

Dear Dad, with this understanding of leadership, I am open to be of use in any capacity You entrust me with, in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TRUE LEADERSHIP

1 Timothy 1:12 ***“And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry”***

Though the bestowal of bishopric comes through many ways, every leadership must be true. True leadership is one where the leader is personally aware of receiving from Dad. Any leadership role in which the leader cannot confidently say that Daddy made him or her thus, is ‘false’ leadership. For instance, someone may be asked to oversee something or some people in Church because there is a need or a skill is noticed. Yet the person cannot relate with that service as something his Dad in Christ entrusted to him. That is not true leadership and over time, will have carnal problems. In the case of Paul, though the elders in Antioch appointed him (Acts 13:2), he knew it was a personal assignment from God. That is true leadership.

Affirmation

I affirm that I will only be a true leader in my Dad’s house all my life.

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEADERSHIP APPOINTMENT

1 Corinthians 12:28 *“And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues”*

Characteristic of all true leadership is its origin in our Dad. The entire body of Christ is His family (Ephesians 2:19), and He through our Brother and Lord Jesus Christ by the Holy Ghost, decides who should oversee what. But the means of physically getting this bestowed on someone varies. It can happen through Dad’s direct appointment like John in the pre-Church era (John 1:33). It can be a direct appointment through others like Paul (Acts 13:2). It can be an indirect appointment through other leaders (Titus 1:5), or the congregation (Acts 6:5). It could also happen providentially through ‘ordinary’ circumstances of life (Acts 18:26). Irrespective of the means of bestowal, every leadership must be true to be successful before our Dad.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LEADERSHIP BY FORCE

John 6:15 ***"When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone"***

Some leadership in the house of God has been what can be described as "by force". When someone has a skill, a status or a personality that is judged as advantageous to the Church, that person is often appointed an overseer. In some cases, the appointees themselves or their superiors, feel they are qualified to be in such roles because of such qualities. For instance, a teacher in a village, who may not even be born again, could easily pass for the elder or pastor of a church because his ability to read and teach forces him there. But in the house of God, bishopric is not based on external qualifications (as advantageous as they may be) - 1 Samuel 16:7. Though some have turned out to be providentially true leadership, we must all be aware of such and avoid it as Jesus Christ of Nazareth did.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I refuse to be a leader by force in the house of God.

Topic: WHAT SHOULD I DO?

1 Corinthians 14:33 ***“For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.”***

For someone who knows that the appointment he is in was “by force” because of a certain physical qualification but does not really have it as from Dad, you may be asking, “What should I do?”. First, realize that the Holy Spirit is not an author of confusion so do not act disorderly. Talk with Daddy as you listen from your heart to be sure it is not because of fear, inferiority complex, offenses, workload etc., that you feel your appointment is by force. Sometimes it may feel so, but it is providence at work. But if after your personal assessment, you are at peace that it is not Dad’s appointment, approach your leadership in honour, love and respect and discuss with them the way forward for your replacement.

Intercession

Dear Dad, we speak peace and order into all situations of replacement appointment that will arise from the shining of this truth in Jesus’ Name.

Isaiah 26:3 ***“Thou will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.”***

Human psychoanalysts often define enjoying life as the pleasure of having basic needs of life- food, water, shelter and clothing. That is because the bondage of corruption in life, makes the feeling of absolute freedom for pleasure appear as real enjoyment. But all of that is far below what Dad actually has for you. It puts you above the fear and experience of evil from corruption. You cannot truly enjoy life until it is well defined in you.

Isaiah 26:3 ***“Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.”***

Enjoying life irrespective of past, present or future happenings, begins with thinking well. If you think wrongly, you can never enjoy life no matter how perfect things may appear around you. Thinking well comprises thinking on God, where you meditate and stay your mind on the personalities of the Godhead and heavenly realities (Colossians 3:1-2), thinking into life, where you think on only things that are true, pure, lovely, etc. (Philippians 4:8) and thinking “weapons”, where you intentionally generate tanks and weapons of scriptural thoughts to blast, dispel and pull down strongholds of every thought against truth about you in Christ.

Topic: TO ENJOY LIFE, EAT WELL

1 Timothy 4:3 *“forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.”*

Let us begin with this disclaimer: the philosophy of “we live to eat or we eat to live” is an abomination to Dad’s purpose for life (1 Corinthians 6:13, Philippians 3:19). So, don’t eat just because you are hungry. Eat therefore on time and avoid pushing down or gulping down something to just fill your stomach because you are extremely hungry. Food is one of the sources of pleasure Dad ordained for our enjoyment in life. Eat food in this light of thanksgiving, worship and pleasure. Your eating must enhance your state of perfection, so don’t eat in ways that make you ineffective in whatever you are engaged in. No matter what is going on in life, eat well.

Other Tongues

Speak fervently in the spirit thanking Dad for food and all the pleasure He ordained in it for you. Celebrate Him for its abundance and proper handling in your body, in Jesus’ Name.

SATURDAY FEBRUARY 28

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: TO ENJOY LIFE, REST WELL

Mark 6:31 *“And he said unto them, come ye yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: for there were many coming and going, and they had nit leisure so much as to eat.”*

Until we get to deal with the advanced means of enjoying life, let us look at the third fundamental means of enjoying life, which is rest well. In today’s multi-tasking world with smart devices, people wake up early and sleep late only to eat the bread of sorrows. Don’t do that. No matter what is happening, learn to rest well. Take a break at work to think well and eat well (John 4:6). Rest well after work by sleeping early to get at least 5-6 hours of uninterrupted sleep (this is not a law). To believe on His name is to believe His nature as the Son of God (1John 4:15) or His authority as Lord (Romans 10:9-10) or His function as the Christ (1 John 5:1).

If you believe any of the above, become God's son/ daughter today by wholeheartedly declaring the following "Father, with all my heart I believe that Jesus is Your appointed person for my adoption as Your son/daughter. I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
