**MONDAY MARCH 2**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: THE DANGER OF LIMITED VISION**

**John 8:39 *“They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham’s children, ye would do the works of Abraham”***

If you were to look straight at 90 degrees and you decide to look just a few degrees below, over a period you’d be looking on the ground. This is how dangerous a little reduction in Christian vision becomes after some decades and centuries. From the time of Abraham till the days of Jesus Christ of Nazareth on earth, the descendants of Abraham had so wandered away from truth that they killed the very truth they were awaiting (John 8:37). As mentioned last month, the current Christian vision is so far below the level of the vision of Jesus Christ and mission on earth not willingly but from little deviations from the struggles of the dark ages. So, except by grace one receives divine revelation or comes across the teachings of truth, it is impossible to live beyond the disadvantages of a limited vision. This week we look at a few of those disadvantages.

**Confession**

In the name of Jesus Christ, I boldly declare that I will only live according to the vision of Jesus Christ for my life.

**TUESDAY MARCH 3**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: LIMITED VISION ACCEPTS SIN**

1 John 3:5 ***“And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin”***

Everyone knows that Jesus Christ died because of the sin of mankind. Okay, so what happened when He died for man’s sin? Did he just forgive or wash away past sins so that man remains the same to continue sinning? If sin was the problem and Jesus came to die because of sin and people who believe in him are still sinners just saved and hoping to make it to heaven by grace, then it’s clear Jesus Christ did a poorer work than Adam’s sin did. But it is amazing how many have accepted this as reality of Christian living simply because of a limited Christian vision. Yet the clear scriptural vision is, “...He was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin”. One danger of a limited Christian vision is that it will make you accept sin and live all your life struggling with one sinful habit or the other and never manifest your greatness in this life.

I totally reject a limited Christian vision and fully embrace the Biblical vision of Jesus Christ for my life, in Jesus’ Name.

**WEDNESDAY MARCH 4**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: LIMITED VISION ACCEPTS MERE HUMANITY**

1 Corinthians 3:3 (NIV) ***“You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere humans?”***

Mere humanity is living in the full consciousness of a fallen Adamic being. That means living in the awareness that one may live a holy or righteous life, in health, peace and so on for a period but is never fully free from sin, all sicknesses, fear, death etc. It is a life of doing one's best to survive and enjoy as much as life offers until the undesirable happens to end one's life. With a limited Christian vision, a Christian has the same mere human consciousness of himself except the knowledge that he or she believes in Jesus and will be in heaven after death. Yet from our verse, it is clear that the Apostle Paul was surprised that the Corinthian brethren were acting as mere humans. This indicates that a scriptural Christian vision, expects to live beyond mere humanity. Hallelujah! Therefore, another disadvantage of a limited Christian vision is that it will make you accept, live and suffer as a mere human no matter how religious you try to be. So don't embrace it.

I totally reject a limited Christian vision and fully embrace the Biblical vision of Jesus Christ for my life, in Jesus' Name.

**THURSDAY MARCH 5**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: LIMITED VISION ACCEPTS SICKNESSES**

Matthew 8:17 (NLT) ***“This fulfilled the word of the Lord through the prophet Isaiah, who said, “He took our sicknesses and removed our diseases.””***

It is true that the feeling of disease and sickness is frustrating and debilitating. Yes, the feeling of pain is really painful. Yet neither the painfulness of pain nor the debilitation of sickness is proof that disease and sickness are lords over your life. When there is a limited Christian vision, the feelings or perceptions of the natural senses are taken to be more real than the truth of God. As a result, one accepts disease and sicknesses as normal because every now and then, he or she feels or physically experiences it. This also is a disadvantage of a limited Christian vision. Yet one thing that our main verse today reveals is that the incarnation, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ did not only take away sin, but it also took away ALL sicknesses. That means that according to scriptural vision, you are forever free from sicknesses because Jesus took it away. So, irrespective of any pain or debilitation, you are unable to accept being a victim of disease and sicknesses.

I totally reject a limited Christian vision and fully embrace the Biblical vision of Jesus Christ for my life, in Jesus’ Name.

FRIDAY MARCH 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: LIMITED VISION ACCEPTS DEATH

2 Timothy 1:10 (ASV) ***“and which now has been manifested through the appearing of our Saviour Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,”***

Again, the death of people especially those that are closer to people in relationships is painful, devastating and sometimes simply confusing. Humanity has continued to be plagued by this seeming “omnipotent” enemy that snatches people out of life at will. Due to the physical reality of death, a limited Christian vision concludes that death will only be overcome after death. Though that is consoling for a generation that is totally powerless before death, yet our opening verse indicates the very direct opposite. It succinctly says, **“Jesus abolished death”**. Is this just a meaningless statement? No. It is an indication that a scriptural Christian vision sees death as defeated and embraces the life and immortality that the gospel unveils. This is the vision that will result in the physical annulment of the experience of death. Therefore, a limited vision has the added disadvantage of accepting and living to die and thus freely succumbing to a defeated enemy of mankind. Stand out.

I totally reject a limited Christian vision and fully embrace the Biblical vision of Jesus Christ for my life, in Jesus’ Name.

**SATURDAY MARCH 7**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: YOU CAN MAKE THE DIFFERENCE**

1 Samuel 17:26 ***“And David spake to the men that stood by him, saying, What shall be done to the man that killeth this Philistine, and taketh away the reproach from Israel? for who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?”***

I am very much aware that sin, sickness, death and so on, appear like insurmountable evil fates of mankind. Again, I know it feels safer and better to just yield to the “frustrations” of the masses compared with the seeming “lonely” path of daring to stand out with all its accompanying insults, defamation and mockery. # ADVANCING IN LOVE

*(Love Relationship Conference 2026)*

*Dr. David Bindan*

**Your experience of love depends entirely on the era in which you choose to live.** This year, God has a remarkable advancement for you with regard to love. To experience it, you must understand the era you live in, what love is, and how to practice love.

Mankind is divided into two eras: the Adamic era (characterized by sin, death, and brokenness) and the post-resurrection Jesus era (characterized by life and advancement). You cannot be in Christ and expect to love the way the old era loves.

For example, marriage is not a human invention or a natural progression of life as some people may think; it is a divine institution instituted by our Father God. The primary, fundamental purpose of marriage is fellowship, followed by a shared purpose to fulfill God's mandate (Gen 2:18). Do not marry simply because you have come of age, which is old-era thinking; marry because you are ready to share fellowship and fulfill a divine vision.

You must advance from the corrupt, painful, and pretentious love of the old creation into the new creation kind of love. If you refuse to advance, you will suffer the same relational heartbreaks common to the world. Here are three keys to help you advance in your love:

- 1. Reject Relational Mediocrity:** Eradicate the worldly

lie that “every marriage has problems” from your mind. Accepting problems as normal is a mediocre mindset that will rob you of a blissful relationship. Don’t knowingly do things your beloved does not like, with the excuse that any issues that arise will be “ironed out” eventually. You may end up wasting emotional energy repairing unnecessary damage caused by anger or retaliation, instead of using that energy to build your love. Refuse to tolerate mediocrity and determine that you can be the first in your lineage to have a flawless, perfect relationship.

*God is love, and  
love is God.*

**2. Elevate Your Understanding of Love:** Discard the definitions of love sold by societal cultures, movies, and worldly songs, and understand love as it is in Christ:

☺ **Love is a Person and a Nature:** God is love, and love is of God; love proceeds directly out of God (1 John 4:7). Love is a person and a nature. If you can’t find God in a person, you can’t find love in them. Do not look for romantic love in a person empty of the Holy Spirit.

☺ **Love is a Force (or Virtue):** Love is a virtue or force that comes out of the person; it is a spiritual force of endearment. What people feel (and call “love”) is love as a virtue, but there can be no virtue without nature (person). The intensity and heat of this virtue depends entirely on

how much you feed your divine nature. A weak spiritual life produces weak, ineffective love. Love is a virtue that is shed abroad in our hearts (Romans 5:5).

☺ **Love is Subjectively Determined, not Objectively:** With

*Love is unconditional. It is determined by person “giving” the love, not by the actions of person receiving love*

love, the subject determines the love, not the object being loved (i.e. the person receiving love). God loves unconditionally (1 John 4:10), and as a child of God, you also can love unconditionally because love is your inherent nature. Interestingly, most people wish others would love them unconditionally and not consider their errors, so why

wouldn't they wish to give that same love to others? Never allow another person's behavior to manipulate, dictate, or alter your love. When you love this way, that's when you really enjoy love.

**3. Practice Loving in the Advanced State:** Mastery requires practice. God is at work within you; do not allow fleshly pain or offenses to block the divine love from flowing out of you. Practice extending this unconditional, “un-offendable” love to your family members and friends daily. When offenses arise, consciously refuse to retaliate, kill the fleshly urge to be angry, and remind yourself of your divine nature.

**MONDAY MARCH 16**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: YOU REALLY NEED TO UNDERSTAND SIN**

Matthew 22:29 *“Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God”*

Concerning sin, the seeming universal belief that everyone will commit one sin or the other at least once in a while, is not because that is true, but because the majority just do not understand what sin is. The truth that they don't know what sin is, is revealed by the thinking that, “Everyone knows what sin is”. Son of God, I implore you not to be adamant but take time to understand what sin is according to the scriptures, and that will be the end of struggling with sin in your life. If you don't give the necessary attention to understanding what sin is according to the Word, you will live in error all your life concerning sin. You will accept sin as part of your life and you will live under its false power, lack confidence in God and frustrate your progress in Christ.

**Prayer**

Dear Father, I receive the light of divine wisdom to submit to the teaching of Your Word concerning sin in Jesus' Name.

**TUESDAY MARCH 17**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: IT IS NOT A WORDPLAY**

Matthew 15:19 *“For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies”*

Some people think, “But we all know what sin is. Is it not stealing, killing, fornicating etc.?”. Others surmise, “Are they not just playing with words to permit people to sin?”. But truly, many are so wrongly brainwashed concerning sin, that they have not taken time to look well into the Word to understand it. They do not understand the difference between the tree and its fruit when it comes to sin. They are unable to see that when the scriptures are speaking of the fruit because that is what people easily relate with, it is actually drawing their attention to the main problem which is the tree. Jesus clearly revealed this principle when He said, “Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit” (Matthew 12:33). So, the goal of listing the fruits of sin like stealing, fornication etc., is to make people know the tree.

**Affirmation**

In the name of Jesus Christ, I have advanced in my understanding of sin because now I see the difference between the tree (the root cause) and the fruit (the result) of sin.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IS SIN?

Romans 5:12 ***“Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned”***

Clearly, the one man in the verse above is Adam and that means sin cannot be understood without going back to him to know what entered the world by him. Going back to Genesis, we find that Yahweh instructed Adam concerning the danger of a certain tree, an instruction which Adam didn't keep (Genesis 2:17, 3:6). There, God did not say, ***“In the day that you eat of the tree, you will sin”*** but that, ***“you will surely die”***. But our verse today says, death came after sin. So, before Adam will experience death, something that wasn't in the world came into the world and that is sin. What is that? Genesis 3:7-8 tells us firstly, that their eyes opened and they knew their nakedness, even though they were already naked (Genesis 2:25) and secondly, they hid from the presence of God. Simply stated, they awoke to a wrong awareness of themselves and abdicated their original place in God's design. That state of distorted self-opinion is the sin that entered the world. It wasn't the act of eating of the tree.

THURSDAY MARCH 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE ETYMOLOGY OF "SIN"?

Romans 5:12 ***"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:"***

It is today's English language that blurs the understanding of certain truths of scripture but writers in the ancient languages of the scripture, didn't have much of such difficulties. For instance, the etymology of the word "sin" plainly corroborates our contextual definition of sin yesterday. "Sin" as used in our main verse is from the Greek word, "**hamartia**" which derives from "**ha**" as a negative particle and the base of "**meros**" which is from the primary form of "**meiromai**" and means to get a section, portion, share or allotment. Thus "**ha-meros**" from where we get "**harmatia**" means to lose or miss getting one's allotment or portion. In other words, it means to miss the mark or the appointed position. Therefore, Adam gained an awareness that distorted his self-image and place of function as God's image and ruler over creation. This is the technical meaning of sin.

### Confession

By the power of the Spirit, I am relocated from every distortion of my self-image and place of function in divine plan in Jesus' Name.

**FRIDAY MARCH 20**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: DON'T CONFUSE SIN WITH ITS FRUITS**

**Matthew 12:33 *“Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit”***

Mistaking the fruit of the state of sin for sin, has not only deprived many of the understanding of what sin is but also of the real redemptive work of Jesus Christ about sin. Acts of sin (works of the flesh) as listed in Galatians 5:19-21 and many more are often what people call sin. These are not sin but the fruits of a person in the state of sin. Since a person in the state of sin will commit acts of sin, the two can be used interchangeably but the difference must be well understood. When Adam wrongly saw himself and abdicated his royal place, all humanity started acting from the state of wrong personal judgment and that is the meaning of, “for all have sinned” in Romans 5:12. If you are in Ghana, you will eat Ghanaian food. If you judge yourself to be wrong, you will act wrongly. But the act is not the problem, it is the wrong self-opinion. When we take it up next month you will understand, what Jesus Christ really did on the cross.

**SATURDAY MARCH 21**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: YOU ARE A MASTER OVER SIN**

Romans 6:14 ***“For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace”***

Many Christians are living far from the reality of Scriptures like this because of lack of understanding of sin. Can you imagine that God says to you that “... Sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace” and yet your deep seated conviction is that as long as I am in this world I will sin? **Topic: DON'T BEG THE DEVIL**

Luke 10:19 ***“Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you”***

Christianity is not complex but people who don't understand it well, have made it a complex religion that is keeping them in bondage. If someone told you an evil spirit or evil orchestration was disturbing your progress, that's great news. Why? You have the authority to deal well with the highest ability of the devil. **WEDNESDAY MARCH 25**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: FAITH IS A SPIRITUAL FORCE**

Matthew 17:19 ***“Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?”***

Years ago, I was teaching a group of students how to heal the sick and one of them asked, “If the devil is not omniscient, how does he know that someone doesn’t have faith and thereby refuse to come out at his command?” The disciples of Jesus had similar questions when they tried all their best but couldn’t cast out a devil. You see, faith is a spiritual force engaged by your credit to the evidence of the Word. The devil doesn’t need to know whether you have faith or not. If the force is not engaged, it doesn’t matter how much you shout or sweat, nothing will force the devil out in the spirit. For instance, when the devil shows up and you are praying out of fear, even your vocabulary tells. Instead of clearly commanding the devil to go, if you start using invisible guns, fire and meaningless prayer jargon, the devil will just be having fun. But one word of authority will send evil spirits running as Jesus did (Mathew 8:16)

### **Confession**

With clarity of mind and full conviction in the Word, I simply give commands and demons check out in Jesus’ Name because I am their master in Christ. Hallelujah!

**THURSDAY MARCH 26**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: DEMONIC TRADITIONS**

Mark 7:8 ***“For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do”***

Luke 2:10 says “... behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people”. However, for many people, the gospel of Christ has never brought them any personal joy because of complex demonic traditions of men. Instead of the simple fact that a person in Christ is a permanent master of every kind of Satanic power (Luke 10:19), they have been enslaved by human demonic traditions. They believe demons are the reason for all their health, financial and social frustrations when it is rather their rejection of knowledge (Hosea 4:6). **FRIDAY MARCH 27**

**Topic: YOU ARE A SPIRITUAL PUBLIC FIGURE**

**Acts 19:15 *“And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?”***

Brother, Sister, if you are born again, don't be afraid of any work of the devil. Don't live in fear of so-called spiritual marriage, witchcraft, human family manipulations etc. The reason is that the devil and his cohorts know you and are afraid of you. The verse above brings out the most profound fact that demons don't only know Jesus, they know everyone of God's children including you. Meaning each son of God is a public figure in spirit. Oh hallelujah! This calls for relaxation and rest concerning demonic activities. Truly, when you are headed one way, demons are running in the opposite direction. **SATURDAY MARCH 28**

**Topic: THIS IS EVEN THE BEGINNING**

2 Peter 1:4 *“Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.”*

As powerful and liberating as what we discussed so far is, it is just the beginning. It is what we should know when we are maturing in Christ. But the Church of Jesus Christ on earth will soon arrive at the place where we understand our true nature in Christ. We will know ourselves as true partakers of the divine nature. **TUESDAY MARCH 31**

**GOOD LIFE DEVOTION**

**Topic: THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE CROSS**

**Galatians 3:13 *“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree”***

As God’s offering to take away the sin of mankind (John 1:29), Jesus Christ could have died by another means but the death on the cross is what He chose. What for? First, to take away the curse of the law which was introduced because of sin (Galatians 3:19). Recollecting our lessons some weeks ago on sin, we know sin is the state of distorted self-image and abdication of divine placement. In that state of sin all mankind was doomed never to experience the blessedness of life given to them in Genesis 1:28. So, by the death on the cross Jesus took away the cursed state so mankind can regain the blessing which was reproduced through Abraham (Galatians 3:14). Secondly, the shame of Adam that made him hide from God (Genesis 3:8) was taken away by the shameful death of Jesus Christ on the cross (Philippians 2:8). These are huge realities that we will study tomorrow. Hallelujah!

I believe that by His resurrection from the dead, He made this possible. Right now, I declare that 'Jesus is Lord'" and by this confession I receive eternal life into my spirit and so I am born again.
