FRIDAY MAY 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW GOD SPEAKS

Hebrews 1:1-2 *“God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds”*

The third aspect of inclining yourself to hear God is discovering the common way by which He speaks to you. The general rule of divine communication in the New Testament is by Jesus Christ who is the substance of the Word (John 1:1-3,14). That means to master hearing God accurately, you must develop a taste for His Word. The Word is Him talking from a book to you and it is the means of determining the accuracy of the other ways you will hear Him. In addition to the Word, you will hear Him through the inner witness of the Spirit (Romans 8:16, Acts 7:23, 1 Kings 19:12), the authoritative voice of the Spirit (Acts 13:2), the conscience (Romans 9:1) and spectacular means like dreams, trances or prophecies (Acts 11:5-7, Acts 11:27-28).

Prayer

Father, I receive the ministry of the Spirit in these teachings to be established once and for all in my life concerning hearing You clearly in the name of Jesus.

SATURDAY MAY 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MASTERING HEARING GOD

Song of Solomon 2:14 *“O my dove, that art in the clefts of the rock, in the secret places of the stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet is thy voice, and thy countenance is comely”*

The key to mastering anything is practice. If you just came into being in Christ, you may not hear His voice as perfectly as a matured person does but the good news is that you can perfect your hearing. Practice loving beholding His countenance in fellowship, then like in our opening verse you will get to know His voice with ease. Start inclining your heart to hear Him in fellowship and keep practicing and acting on what you hear, and you will perfect it. As a general guide, if you will believe God’s voice is yours (John 10:27), become scriptural in your approach (Psalm 119:105), confident that God will not allow Satan to speak to you (Luke 11:11) and start hearing to do, you will soon become a master at hearing Him (Proverbs 22:29).

Prayer

Dear Father, I receive grace to continue listening, hearing, and doing Your Word. I can see myself mastering the art of hearing You in Jesus’ Name.

SUNDAY MAY 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRACTICING HEARING

Take some 5 minutes today and be somewhere alone with Daddy. Whisper repeatedly, "***Daddy, I hear you clearly in my life. Speak and I will hear***" while listening in your heart. Note your experience for future reference.

MONDAY MAY 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RE-THINKING ON DEATH

Philippians 4:8 “...if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.”

In the name of spirituality, many have shelved their thinking faculties when it comes to the truth of life in Christ. But our minds are not evil when engaged in the Holy Spirit. When we genuinely reason through subjects in the scriptures in the Holy Spirit, we have a better understanding than just running off on unfounded hearsays. This is what Daddy is calling on us to do concerning death. Yes, the physical observation is that death is rampant everywhere but that should not define our conclusive perspective on death. The scriptures should form the basis of our conclusive perspectives in life. Just think on these: was death part of Daddy's charter for man on earth? Genesis 1:16-28 clearly indicates that it was not. Again, was death something Daddy wished for man on earth? Genesis 2:17 clearly indicates that it wasn't. In addition, did the fall make Daddy accept death as the fate of man forever on earth? Revelation 21:3-4 clearly indicates that He didn't. Just thinking through these, will delete the settled acceptance of death as if it is the fate of everyone's earthly life forever.

Worship

Dear Father, we worship You that Your charter for our lives on this earth does not include death. Our lives are a living worship to You forever in Jesus' Name.

TUESDAY MAY 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: RE-THINKING ON DEATH (2)

Romans 5:12 (NIV) *“Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned.”*

Again, let us think on scriptures to form the basis of our conclusive perspectives on death. Think on these: Was this world created with death? Romans 5:12 clearly indicates that there was no death in this world until Adam stepped into that state of distorted self-opinion we described last month. Secondly, if there was no death in this world once upon a time, can't it be taken out? 2 Timothy 1:10 clearly indicates that the death that entered this world through the first Adam was abolished by the last Adam (Jesus Christ). The goal of this thinking is to impress upon you the possibility of a deathless earthly life. If you don't do these reasonings, you will easily be carried away to accept death as a permanently unchangeable fate of life on earth because of the physical observation of death everywhere. Secondly, you will easily be deceived to devalue the truth that Jesus abolished it and that you are enabled to arise and eradicate it. Death has illegally reigned on this earth for too long, let's do some reasoning in the scriptures and take our place to eradicate it.

Affirmation

I am certain that Jesus Christ abolished the death that Adam brought into this world. I choose to see a deathless world in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY MAY 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PHILOSOPHICAL FEARLESSNESS OF DEATH

Philippians 1:23-24 (NET) *"I feel torn between the two, because I have a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is by far better, but it is more vital for your sake that I remain in the body."*

Some people say they do not fear death, or they are ready to die not because that is what they really desire or what scripture says but because they are philosophically misled. Before the incarnation of Jesus Christ, humanity sought various ways to escape death. By the influence of some evil spirit beings, numerous myths about death were postulated, many of which were supplanted by the philosophies of the Greco-Roman era. These myths and philosophies are the foundations of the religions of this world which all have one thing in common: a promise of a better place or state of life after death. Physical creation and even the body were considered the enemy of the human soul which escapes after death into its true state. When the scriptures like the one above are not well understood against the background of life that sleeps in death and resumes at the resurrection, then Christianity seems to offer the same hope as the religions of this world. Hence, some have been deceived into saying, "***We are not afraid of death, after all, it is an entrance into a better life***". Yes, you don't have to fear death, but philosophy and religion should not be your basis but the Word of God.

Confession

I live by the truth of Your Word in all areas of my life. I am never deceived by the philosophy of men in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY MAY 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DON'T FEAR DEATH

Philippians 1:23-24 (NET) ***"I feel torn between the two, because I have a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is by far better, but it is more vital for your sake that I remain in the body."***

Scripture teaches that death is a pause of sleep in life, which only resumes at the resurrection. So, the dead are not having excursions and parties in heaven. As far as life is concerned, they are asleep, till they return with Jesus Christ at the resurrection. So, if you are in Christ, you don't have to fear death, not because when you die you are going to a better place but because death has been defeated, abolished and has no power over you. In other words, death cannot force you to die. Like the Apostle Paul, if you are in Christ, you have the power to either accept death or not. Do not fret about dreams or spiritual revelations about death. Jesus Christ abolished death (2 Timothy 1:10). The evil being that had power to hurt with death has been paralyzed (Hebrews 2:14-15). Don't beg death as if it can take you out at will anytime it wants. Walk in this reality and threats of death by any means will disappear from your life. Life and incorruption are what work in you. Allow that to reign in every fiber of your being. Hallelujah!

Affirmation

That which Jesus Christ abolished is truly abolished in my life. Therefore, sin, evil and death are abolished in my life in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY MAY 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY, NOTHING BUT THE WORD

Hebrews 11:6 ***“But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him”***

When we speak of our immortality in Jesus Christ, some people want to know what to do to become immortal. Deathlessness is not a scientific ambition, it is a gift in Jesus, the Christ. Jesus the Christ, entered His own world, and squarely faced the spirit being that was bamboozling all humanity with the weapon of death (Hebrews 2:14-15). In the wisdom of dying on the cross, He paralyzed him and cancelled death. It didn't end there, He flooded the universe with eternal life (life and incorruption). God has made it clear that He gave eternal life to this world through Jesus, the Christ (1 John 5:11). So how can one receive eternal life and live immortally? It is through the gospel (2 Timothy 1:10). Once you receive the gospel of the kingdom of Jesus, the Christ, you must know and walk in the reality of your immortality. But like the people John addressed in 1 John 5:13, if one has Christ and doesn't know he has eternal life, he will accept death and will sleep only to awake at the sound of the trump of His return. In Christ, you are deathless and only God's Word is the proof, not human works.

Affirmation

My Father's Word is my only reality. It says, I have life and immortality and that is my present hour reality. I live only. I die not, in Jesus' Name.

SATURDAY MAY 9

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MAKE IMMORTALITY YOUR REALITY

1 Timothy 4:15 ***“Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all”***

The reality of your immortality in Jesus the Christ is not about whether you are immortal or not. That is who you are by the regeneration that took place in the human to produce you (Titus 3:5). It has to do with what you are aware of. When Adam’s eyes opened in the negative and he knew that he was naked, when God even asked, ***“Who told you, you are naked?”***, Adam could not hear. He stuck to his new consciousness and that brought the effects of the fall. The physical happenings in your life are a product of your consciousness. Therefore, even though you are immortal in the Christ, you must meditate heavily on these truths until every death consciousness is replaced with deathlessness consciousness. Then your immortality (deathlessness) which has been yours all this while can be experienced.

Meditation

Say this aloud to yourself over and again while focusing your mind on seeing yourself as such: ***“I ... (name) am deathless. There is no death on my paths. I live only and I live forever in Jesus, the Christ”***

SUNDAY MAY 10

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF WEEK

Say this aloud to yourself over and intersperse it with speaking with other tongues. Do this with focusing your mind on seeing yourself as such: ***“I(name) am deathless. There is no death on my paths. I live only and I live forever in Jesus, the Christ.”***

MONDAY MAY 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE FULLNESS OF CHRIST, NOT A THEORY

Ephesians 4:13 (NIV) ***“until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.”***

With our Christian vision lifted, we now understand that the goal of Yahweh for the Church of Jesus Christ on earth is to mature into a state of full Christness, righteousness and immortal reigners who are manifesting to liberate creation from the bondage of corruption. Consequently, it should be easy to now appreciate that attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ, is no longer an impossible ideal or a Christian theory. It is a possibility right in this life. We need to appreciate that in God’s dealings with humanity in time past, His vision for them was often too good or lofty for their appreciation. Yet, anyone who at any time chose to completely believe in Him irrespective of how impossible or unreasonable it appeared in human sense, enjoyed the benefits (Hebrews 11:2). TUESDAY MAY 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE FULLNESS OF CHRIST, IT'S AN UNVEILING"

1 John 4:17 (TPT) *"By living in God, love has been brought to its full expression in us so that we may fearlessly face the day of judgement, because all that Jesus now is, so are we in this world."*

One thing we emphasize in the FGM Academy is that there is nothing new we are becoming in Christ in this life. All the maturity, advancement, growth and so on that is required in Christ, is about unveiling us to ourselves and our world. It is like this, "We are 'something' in Christ that neither we ourselves nor the world is aware of". So, when you hear of maturing into the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, don't think you are going to become something that you aren't already. What it is, is that what you are already is going to be unveiled to you. Anyone in Christ is a new creation (2 Corinthians 5:17). WEDNESDAY MAY 13

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: UNVEILED THROUGH WASHING

Ephesians 5:25-26 *“Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church and gave himself for it; [26] that he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word.”*

Yahweh is so plain that His plainness appears too simple to the complex religion of humanity. Knowing that the Church was going to be birthed in a world that will still be largely human conscious, He knew how He was going to bring it into the fullness of Christ. And He plainly stated it, “by the washing of water by the Word”. Washing does not add or transform something into what it wasn’t before. Washing removes that which is not part of a thing but covers its true appearance, so that its true nature will appear. That means as much as receiving blessings, breakthroughs, miracles and so on are good, they do not mature us. In other words, they do not unveil our Christness. No matter how much we receive, our Christness will remain veiled until we learn to receive washing. Do you want to mature into the fullness of your Christness, submit to washing.

Prayer

Dear Father, from today I position my entire life to receive the washing of the water by the Word, to be unveiled as Christ, in Jesus’ Name.

THURSDAY MAY 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IT IS A WORD WASHING

John 15:3 *“Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.”*

The washing of the Church to unveil our Christness, does not refer to water baptism or ritual washings in rivers, the sea or any of the Old Testament washings in scripture. The substance or ‘detergent’ for the washing that unveils our Christness is the Word. So, Ephesians 5:26 is very clear and unambiguous about this. It says Jesus is sanctifying and cleansing the church with the washing of water **by the word**. In our verse today, this was practically demonstrated. The people were purified by the Word He spoke. Having settled on this, let us also clarify that the Word that cleanses the Church is the truth of scripture (John 17:17) not just anything from the Bible. In other words, it must be the Word that is true about the Church of Jesus Christ. Who is the Church? What does he have, and what can he do as the body of Christ? This is what cleanses and unveils his Christness and it is called the Word of His grace (Acts 20:32)

Confession

I completely yield my life to the Word of His grace so that I grow thereby through the unveiling of my Christness in Jesus’ Name.

FRIDAY MAY 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IT IS A WASHING OF CONSCIOUSNESS

1 Corinthians 6:11 *"And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."*

The sanctifying and cleansing of the Church in Ephesians 5:25-26, is sometimes misunderstood that the Church is so full of sin and Christ is washing the Church from sin through the preaching against sin. That may do something but will definitely not unveil the Christness of the Church because as far as sin is concerned, the Church is washed and sanctified in His name by the Spirit. Get it straight, when it comes to sin, Christians just need to awake to their righteousness in Christ. But though exactly Christ, righteous, holy and so on in spirit reality, many Christians still just know and think of themselves as humans. This huge debris of human consciousness is the dirt that is covering their true divine nature. This is the kind of washing that unveils the church. It is a washing of consciousness, not sin.

Confession

I submit my consciousness to the washing power of the truth of the Word. All human consciousness is washed away, and I only see my divinity in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Galatians 4:2 (TPT) ***“For until the time appointed by the Father, the child is under the domestic supervision of the guardians of the estate.”***

TUESDAY MAY 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: HOW TO BELIEVE GOD

Romans 10:17 ***“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God”***

Belief is the state of being so convinced in the evidence of God’s Word, that you begin to think, talk and act accordingly. This settled conviction in the unseen evidence of the Word is called faith (Hebrews 11:3). That means the foundation to believing God is faith. Now when it comes to faith, many people have this deep “feeling” that they don’t have “enough” faith and get inwardly discouraged concerning the things of God, but it should not be so. Daddy has made it plain that when we hear His Word, it ministers faith to us. In other words, when you truly give attention to hearing the truth in the Word, it imparts your heart in a way that results in the conviction in its reality. This is the surest means to believe God.

WEDNESDAY MAY 20

Topic: I GO TO CHURCH BUT STILL CAN'T BELIEVE GOD

Acts 20:32 *“And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified”*

While writing yesterday's article, I heard someone in spirit say, *“Yea, I have been going to Church and hearing the Word, but I still cannot believe God, why?”*. THURSDAY MAY 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: I HEAR THE WORD BUT STILL CAN'T BELIEVE GOD

Proverbs 4:20 ***“My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings”***

Apart from the challenge of the quality of what people hear from biblical teachings, the second reason someone might be going to church, hearing the Word but still cannot believe God, is the attitude with which they hear the Word. It matters how you hear or interact with the Word that is coming to you. Our verse today says, we must ***expectantly pay attention*** to the Words of Yahweh! We must recognize that this is His Word (in cases that it really is), be ready to receive or welcome it into our being, pay attention to its delivery to be able to connect the dots and absorb the life and spirit in it. Many are careless, sleepy and full of questions when they are hearing the Word. Thus, no matter how long they repeat those cycles, they cannot receive impartation for deep convictions.

From today, I am well positioned to hear the truth of God's Word that comes to me in Jesus' Name.

FRIDAY MAY 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DARE TO BELIEVE GOD

Matthew 14:29 ***“And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus”***

There was a situation of a vacant position in a certain system. A very unlikely candidate got a word from a group with the system to contest. Though unlikely, he boldly embraced it, contested and got the nod. What did he do? He dared to contest. Many think that believing God is something that comes naturally with very soothing feelings. It is not so. You need to realize that it takes daring to believe God because usually what He says is so high that it appears illogical to the human minded. Do you think it was a joke to walk on water? All Peter did was to step out because Jesus the Christ said, “Come!”. Yes, he later doubted but at least he walked on water when he dared. You too, come out of that human comfort, reasoning, pampering and believe God and you will be shocked at the results.

Numbers 13:30-31 *“And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it. But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we”*

Sometimes friends, family and colleagues may make you feel like you are being foolish when you just believe God. But I am telling you, if God’s truth is what you have accepted as your reality, you are not foolish. You are rather wiser. Don’t let your classmates, career, professional or political colleagues make you feel unwise by believing God. From our scripture, who entered the promised land? It was Caleb who believed God, not the many who were living by reasoning. According to worldly wisdom, they are living by someone’s words which will surely fail. So why shouldn’t you live by the Word of the monarch of the universe? Get bolder and more confident to believe God because you are not a fool but rather wise. Hallelujah!

TUESDAY MAY 26

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: GOD'S LOVE FOR YOU, HAS NO END

Jeremiah 31:3 ***"The LORD hath appeared of old unto me saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with loving kindness have I drawn thee."***

Again, a narrow understanding of the gospel of Jesus the Christ, makes people perceive God's love in the light of the inferior human love. God loves you because He created you in His image to be made after His likeness (Genesis 1:26-27), not because you have done something good or not done something bad. His actions towards Adam even after he disobeyed Him in Genesis 3, says it all. WEDNESDAY MAY 27

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FORGET ADAM

Romans 5:14 (NLT) *“Still, everyone died-from the time of Adam to the time of Moses- even those who did not disobey an explicit commandment of God as Adam did. Now Adam is a symbol, a representation of Christ, who was yet to come.”*

One of the great desires of the Father is to see the body of Christ on earth and the whole world forget Adam. Today, the world is still living in the pseudo experiences of a non-existent Adamic era. Jesus Christ was the last Adam. When He died, all Adams died in Him (Romans 6:8). When he resurrected, eras changed from Adam to Christ. Topic: REMEMBER CHRIST

Ephesians 1:4 *“according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation do the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.”*

When the gospel of Jesus the Christ is finally understood, the world will realize that it was first about remembering (or re-awaking) to where the human race was before Adam’s disobedience. The coming alive in Christ, results in a remembrance of our being in Him before the world began. The moment it dawns on you that you were known and chosen to be God’s before any error ever happened, all of Adam (and all consciousness of the fall and its experiences) dissolves and you awake to Christ. Remembering Christ shifts your focus from the distractions of human living unto your heavenly joint-sitting with Christ (Colossians 3:1-2). Oh boy! 2 Timothy 1:9 (GNT) ***“He saved us and called us to be his own people, not because of what we have done, but because of his own purpose and grace. He gave us this grace by means of Christ Jesus before the beginning of time.*”**

Many think that when Adam “fell”, Yahweh got confused and had to devise a plan ‘B’ to get man back. So, He “racked His brains” to pull out the grace-card. No! And a thousand times No! Very soon, the body of Christ on earth will awake to the truth that Church is the governing body (**ekklēsia**) of the kingdom of Christ to lead all humanity into God's original purpose for their lives.
