MONDAY JUNE 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: WHAT IS TRUTH?

John 18:38 ***"Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find no fault at all"***

One of the most important questions of life, apart from what purpose is, is "what is truth?". Seeking truth has been one of the foundations to the many religions, philosophies and cults in this world. After several millennia of fruitless seeking, the postmodern man has generally concluded that there is no truth or that truth is relative. Yes, there are degrees of the same truth, but truth is absolute not relative. Pilate, in our main verse today nearly got the answer to that age-long question but was not patient enough to hear it from God. Jesus the Christ, did not hide it though. He stated plainly, **"...thy word is truth"** (John 17:17). Practically, truth is from the Greek word, "alētheia" which means verity, referring to ***the fundamental reality of a thing***. When it comes to your immortality in Christ, you must know what the fundamental reality is. We shall discuss that tomorrow.

TUESDAY JUNE 2

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE REALITY OF YOUR IMMORTALITY

John 17:17 (TPT) ***“Your Word is truth! So make them holy by the truth.”***

While many believe in immortality somewhere in the future, not many are settled in the reality of their immortality now in this life. Since 2024, we have been awakening the body of Christ to the reality of our immortality in Christ right now in this world. Some rightly wonder, “How can that be real in this world considering the load of human sicknesses they either experience or see around”. That is why it is important to know the fundamental reality of your immortality. The truth (the fundamental reality) of your immortality in Christ, is not in observations of human experiences. Neither is it in the feelings of your consciousness of the corruptible body. In other words, it is not in the natural sensual perception. It is in the Word. Your immortality will not be confirmed by your feelings; it is known in the Word. Therefore, the Word is the fundamental reality of our immortality in Christ. Hallelujah!

Oh thanks be to Yahweh forever. For through Your Word only, have You settled me in the reality of my immortality in Christ. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY JUNE 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: YOUR NEW BODY IN CHRIST

2 Corinthians 5:17-18 *“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold all things are become new. [18] And all things are of God, ...”*

The wind of Greco-Roman philosophies that bombarded the church in the first few centuries, coupled with the impact of the dark ages, have woven the ***saved-out-of-the-body to go heaven*** philosophy into the fabric of the Christian faith. That is why today, the idea that the current bodies of people and everything natural must be done away with for better ones in heaven has proliferated and limited salvation to only the spirit and partially to the soul. Yet, the salvation of Jesus the Christ is complete - in spirit, soul and body. That means receiving Jesus, awakens you to a totally new self and quality of spirit, soul and body. From our verse, ***all things (not some) are new***. And they are all from God, not fallen Adam. Many are not aware that they have a new body now in Christ. Immortality is impossible in the corruptible Adamic body, but you have a new body in Christ. This is the reason for the reality of your immortality in Christ. Hallelujah!

Affirmation

I am in Christ; therefore, I am a new creation in my spirit, soul and body. My new body in Christ is immortal; therefore, I live only in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY JUNE 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: NOT IN RESURRECTION BODY

Philippians 3:20-21 *"... who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself"*

Some were at sea from yesterday's article, whether having new bodies in Christ meant we are already in the resurrection era. No. Your immortal body now in Christ, is not in the glory of resurrected bodies. At the return of our Lord and Brother Jesus the Christ, the two families (in heaven and earth - Ephesians 3:15) will be united. For those who slept, they will resurrect but those of us alive will be changed in the glory of our bodies so that we are all in the same state of glory. That is not to impart immortality, but a change of glory from terrestrial to celestial (1 Corinthians 15:40). The English rendering of "**vile**" body in the verse above carries that fabric of thought that sees no good in the physical body but in the Greek, it is "**tapeinosis**" referring to something of a lower glory that should be upgraded to the same glory as His. As far as your immortality is concerned, you woke up to it through the gospel (2 Timothy 1:10), it is not awaiting you in the resurrection.

FRIDAY JUNE 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: FEELING THE SAME BODY?

Romans 6:6 ***“knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin”***

This matter of having a new body in Christ, is quite challenging to some because they have continued to feel the same way in their bodies even after receiving Christ. That is okay but the challenge is that what you feel is not the fundamental reality, remember? It is not possible to obtain a good report in God’s sight without faith (Hebrews 11:2, 6). That means you must through the Word learn to live by the evidence of the Word which is the fundamental reality of your life in Christ. This is why we teach these over and again. To help train you beyond the natural senses to enjoy your inheritance in Christ. Truly, much of what people feel today in their bodies, are hangovers of the consciousness of the corruptible Adamic body, which does not exist any longer because Jesus Christ killed it on the cross. The ‘sick-able’ and ‘die-able’ body you are feeling does not exist. You are deathless in Christ.

Affirmation

I choose to live only by the evidence of the Word and not the senses. The corruptible Adamic body is dead, and I am right now in my in-Christ body in Jesus’ Name.

SATURDAY JUNE 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: IMMORTALITY: MOVE INTO YOUR FAITH BODY

2 Corinthians 4:18 (GNT) ***“For we fix our attention, not on things that are seen, but on things that are unseen. What can be seen lasts only for a time, but what cannot be seen lasts forever”***

Until you inspire yourself to embrace spiritual training to live by the evidence of God’s Word, all you can experience in this life will be like the joy of getting out of Egypt yet deprived of the fullness of the land flowing with milk and honey. You must agree to also train yourself to experience the Word as your fundamental reality. The days of keeping your gaze on the natural world and its happenings are past. The era of the glorious Church is the era of gazing on the Word as our fundamental reality. 1 Timothy 6:12 ***“Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses”***

THURSDAY JUNE 11

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MEDITATE INTO YOUR CHRISTNESS

1 Timothy 4:15 ***“Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all”***

Though I have taught a couple of times on meditation, I have not yet formally trained people in meditation (even in FGM Academy) because of the impact of this generation on many people’s lives. The fast-paced nature of this generation through phones, electronic devices etc., has trained people to be snappy, fast and quick at everything. This has so affected their neural pathways that they are unable to focus on one thing for a long time. Many are unable to maintain their flow of thoughts on a subject for 1, 2 or 3 hours. They sleep or doze off after only about 30 mins of monotonous listening. Yet meditation requires intense focus on the same truth for long - hours, days, months and even years. If you are willing as you do in other areas of life, grace will make you a diligent meditator. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY JUNE 12

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRESENT YOURSELF TO LIVING YOUR CHRISTNESS

1 Timothy 4:15 ***“Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all”***

It was interesting to realize from the Greek that the phrase, ***“give thyself wholly to them”*** in our English translation is a complex way of either saying, ***“be or live in them”***, ***“present yourself in them”***, or ***“totally yield yourself to them”***. This understanding is profound. It means for the practical outcome of whatever you meditate on to become overtly noticeable, you must also live in them. Simply stated, it means practice living according to what you are meditating on. Though meditation is so vital, whatever you meditate on will still largely remain an internal reality until physically practiced. This is the second thing you must employ diligence in grace to do in order to make your Christness a living reality. All you need is to say, I want to do this as you do in other areas of life, and grace will enable you.

Topic: YOU CAN DO IT

Philippians 4:13 ***“I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me”***

OUR PART IN GOD'S UNIVERSAL PURPOSE

There is something more terrible than sickness and more devastating than death: spending your entire life in pursuit of something that turns out to be a lie. Across the world, many people are doing exactly this. They are not living meaninglessly by choice. They simply have not been told what life actually is. By the grace of God, He is meeting the needs of His sons and daughters in this world and consistently lifting our vision to comprehend the life we are truly living.

Reject an Underutilized Life

There are many things in life that are acceptable to partially use. You can underutilize your shoes and your home, but you cannot afford to underutilize life. You carry eternal life, and the measure to which you live on earth should not be 90% or 99%. It should be 100%. Like the Apostle Paul, the goal is to be able to say: I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith (2 Tim 4:7). You were in heaven long before you were dispatched to the earth. The question is not about going back to heaven. Rather, it is about how much of what God called you to do will be expressed or achieved.

Awake to God's Universe

This is the first and foundational call: awake to God's universe. It is not an accident that the first book of the Bible is Genesis, meaning "beginnings," and that

its very first verse does not begin with you. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Gen 1:1). The Bible written for you begins not with you, but with a universe. God works through twenty-five verses of creation before man appears at all. Only then, in verse

26, does man emerge. And when man does appear, the very first thing God does is relate him directly to the universe He has just created: "Let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, over the cattle, over all the earth" (Gen 1:26). Man does not come and leave the universe behind. Man comes into the universe, as its steward and its manager.

This means that as you read this, you have something to relate to in the sea, in the air, in the galaxies, and in the earth beneath your feet.

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: DEEPER YET SIMPLE

Mark 8:6 *“And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before them; and they did set them before the people”*

A wrong assessment of spirituality deprives people of a deep Father-son fellowship with Yahweh. While some view spirituality as a deep reverence to Yahweh from a position of unworthiness wrapped up in an almost sleepy and quiet sanctimonious communication, others see it as a state of high emotional excitement emanating from repetitive and often hollering spiritual gymnastics. Yet the truth of a deep Father-son fellowship in Yahweh is that the deeper it is, the simpler it is, irrespective of the method and mode of communication. Here is Jesus Christ who wants bread multiplied. He doesn't jump, holler and command the bread. Neither does he do some long silent enchantments. He simply gives thanks. That joyful expression of gratitude transmits His desire into the substance of the bread to abundantly multiply. What a deeply spiritual, yet a simple and vital fellowship with His Father. You cannot mature into a Father-son chatting fellowship with Yahweh until you realize that the more realistic and deeper your relationship with Yahweh is, the simpler it becomes.

Oh dear Father, that I will know You so deeply that I become simpler in my fellowship with You in Jesus' Name.

WEDNESDAY JUNE 17

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE KEY TO BE DEEP YET SIMPLE

John 10:30 ***"I and my Father are one"***

Maturing into the level of chatting with Yahweh will be impossible without a deep but simple spirituality. The simplicity of Jesus' deep spirituality was based on a deep-seated reality of Yahweh as His Father. That is the key to being spiritually deep yet simple. Jesus the Christ, knew, thought, spoke and lived in the reality of the Fatherhood of Yahweh so much that He was accused of blasphemy (John 10:30-33). When you truly know Yahweh as Father, it settles you in such a rest of spirit reality that makes you simple. In fact, one of the amazing things that Jesus the Christ achieved when Yahweh was reconciling the world to Himself in Him, (2 Corinthians 5:19), was the deconstruction of man's delusion about Yahweh as a distant, austere and retributive creator. He revealed Yahweh to the world as the ever loving Father who never ceased to passionately pursue man's restoration since Adam's disobedience (John 17:25-26)

Worship

Oh dear Jesus, I worship You for giving me the understanding to know Yahweh as my true Father in life. Hallelujah!

THURSDAY JUNE 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: YAHWEH IS YOUR FATHER

Acts 17:28 *“For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring”*

For a long time, the body of Christ did not fully appreciate the all-inclusive nature of the salvation that Jesus, the Christ, accomplished for the world. So, for over 2000 years after the resurrection, we still traced our beginning to the fallen Adam who was undone in Jesus Christ, thereby, perceiving our beginning from a position of separation from Yahweh. Consequently, as some still do now, we have thought of salvation or being born of Yahweh as transaction that happens when we believe, when it is actually something that happened already by His resurrection to which we wake up when we believe (1 Peter 1:3, Ephesians 2:5-6). The moment you grasp this truth, you will immediately realize that you were Yahweh’s son in Christ, long before you even knew it; for in Him you live, move and have your being. From now, discard the thinking of separation from Him and embrace that of your union in the Father-Son-Holy Spirit (John 14:20). Topic: RESPOND TO YOUR SONSHIP

2 Corinthians 13:14 ***“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen”***

Still on our course of maturing into a state in Christ that we can chat freely with Yahweh as Jesus Christ does, we are now at learning to cultivate our consciousness of the Father-son relationship that we had with Yahweh in Christ long before we knew it. Yes, this was true about us, but we never knew till the truth of the gospel unveiled it to us. And so, it is with others who are yet to believe. I hope you are not surprised! As stated in our verse above, the Holy Spirit has been pouring forth the communion of the Godhead to us, but the separation mentality disabled many from responding to and enjoying that rich divine fellowship. From now, intentionally respond to His fellowship in several brief moments in a day. These brief moments of either worship, thanksgiving, mutual affirmation of love, affirmation of His testimonies about you, etc., are the means of growing in the intimacy of your son-to-Father relationship with Him. Though simple, this is the key to arriving at such a deep level settlement of His Fatherhood that results in deep spirituality with simplicity.

Topic: YAHWEH IS NOT FAR AWAY

Acts 17:27 *“That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us”*

Many have genuinely misread Apostle Paul’s perspective of salvation through the book of Romans. But here is Paul in a pagan city preaching to reveal Yahweh (the unknown God to them) and he states that Yahweh is not far from anyone of us. What? You mean even the pagans? Yes! Why? Because Jesus the Christ reconciled the world back to Yahweh (not only the Church) in His death and resurrection (2 Corinthians 5:19). That they are unaware is the reason we’re entrusted with the message of reconciliation to wake them up (vers 18-20). Start thinking of your relationship with Yahweh from a position of union with Him in Christ even before you knew it; instead of being separated from birth till you believed. It will open your eyes, mind and heart to realize that Yahweh is NEVER far away from you in any state. This awakening is a game changer in life.

Affirmation

Oh glory! I affirm that I am chosen in Christ before the foundation of the world. Yahweh has never and will never be far from me because in Him I live, move and have my being. Hallelujah!

1 Corinthians 1:9 ***“God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord”***

Being prayerful, occupied with service or activities in Church, doing good works, having supernatural experiences etc., are all excellent aspects of being a son of God in Christ (now popularly known as Christianity). Yet, all those and more without a practical living relationship with the Godhead as Father, is a religion. This is critical to the effectiveness of your entire life in Christ. Thus, the vital questions are: “You are prayerful, but do you practically know the one to whom you are praying? (John 4:22)” “Okay you are busy serving the Lord, but do you practically know this Lord that you are busy serving? (Luke 10:41-42)”. “Yes miracles, prophecies and supernatural things happen through you, but do you practically know the being from whom they come, because even demons can manifest such? (Matthew 7:22-23).” Misinterpreting the above as Christianity results in frustrations when simple issues of life cannot be addressed by one’s Christness that should be developed through a practical relationship in the Godhead.

Dear Father, I yield my entire being in spirit to Your influence to be drawn out of religion into real Christianity in Jesus’ Name.

TUESDAY JUNE 23

Topic: A PRACTICAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

John 5:19 *“Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise”*

What did we mean by a practical relationship with the Godhead in yesterday’s devotion? It is a relationship with Yahweh that is as real or even more so as relating with a physical spouse, parent or brother in this life. This is how Daddy showed me this. I will share more on this in the following days.

WEDNESDAY JUNE 24

Topic: WHEN YOU BECOME PRACTICAL WITH GOD

John 14:10 *"... but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works"*

How does the Christian life of a practical relationship feel or look like? First, becoming practical with Yahweh your Father, is not in the human sense of just telling him how you feel about anything (though you should). It is about living in the consciousness of your union with Him to the degree that you are in an incessant chat with Him concerning every thought, speech and action such that whatever you do, say or think is literally His outward manifestation. In that reality, the Godhead is so practically real to you and even more so than the people you see around. You talk, you discuss, you rejoice, you brood on and do everything in real time together. Prayer then ceases to be you calling out to Him, but you both enjoying fellowship or getting things done. Ministry ceases to be you serving Him but you both carrying out your spirit-living in a physical world. Oh boy, this is better experienced than taught.

Dear Dad, a practical relationship with You is possible, and with all my heart I am positioned to arrive at it, in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY JUNE 25

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BECOMING PRACTICAL WITH GOD

John 5:19 ***“Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise”***

My scriptural search to attain a practical relationship with Yahweh that is more real than with people around me, landed on Jesus the Christ, as my example. How can I, living physically in this world, relate with Yahweh, who is spirit (John 4:24), in a way that is more practical than that of the physical people around? I found that it is the same as, “How was Jesus, living physically in this world, able to do only what He saw the Father doing?”. The key was ***the Father in Him***. The being of the Godhead that makes spirit and material reality the same is the Holy Spirit. By Him, heaven and earth are united in one. In Him, heaven is practically on earth, and earth is practically in heaven. Jesus’ kingdom prayer of, ***“on earth as in heaven”*** is fulfilled in Him. The ‘how’ of becoming practical with the Godhead and stepping out of religion, starts by turning your attention to the Holy Spirit right inside you now.

I am excited to know that the Holy Spirit in me, is the key to my practical relationship with the Godhead. Hallelujah!

Topic: BUT I ALREADY HAVE THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Galatians 4:6 ***“And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father”***

Yes, every son of God in Christ is indwelt by the Holy Spirit. Yet some are not even aware of Him, to even talk of relating with Him. Yet still, (like I was) there are many who though have received His embrace, became filled with Him, speaking with heavenly utterance, operating in His gifts, do not have a practical relationship with Him. So, it is not uncommon to have Him in you and still function in religion. What makes the difference is when you realize His personhood, His God-ness and fully appreciate His role in you beyond just a Pentecostal or Charismatic experience. From today, intentionally relate daily with Him as a person in you, not a ‘force’ to stir up in prayer for power or miracles. Greet Him, talk with Him, listen to Him, worship Him, rejoice with Him etc. The more you do this, the more conscious you become of Him and that opens the chapters into His deeper chambers that will result in that practical relationship with the Godhead that I am talking about and will continue next month.

Oh Dear Holy Spirit, I am excited that You are in me and we can talk, chat, rejoice and enjoy together in this life. I love You, and worship You my Father, in Jesus Name.

Topic: IT'S POSSIBLE

Revelation 3:20 ***“Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me”***

Contrary to its frequent usage in “soul-winning” messages to unbelievers, this verse was addressed to sons of God in Christ (Christians). Its meaning is profound. It invites all of us into a deeper and more practical relationship with the Jesus who is already one in us. What is more practical than a relationship of sitting and dining with the Lord? Topic: ENJOY THE NOW-CHURCH

1 Corinthians 16:19 ***“The churches of Asia salute you. Aquila and Priscilla salute you much in the Lord, with the church that is in their house”***

The context in which Jesus, the Christ, spoke of building His church in Matthew 16:18, is quite different from “church” as we think of it in our days. What I refer to as the “now-church”. Technically, the usage of “church” in the mind of Jesus the Christ, referred to an assembly of the called out ones, constituting the governing body of the kingdom on earth. It carries the connotation of how Israel was called out to be the radiation of Yahweh’s kingdom to the nations (Acts 7:38). But until maturity takes the body of Christ into that appreciation, the now-church brings to mind a building or a gathering of people to worship Yahweh in Jesus’ Name. Church as a place of worship or as a people who gather to worship, has become an inseparable aspect of our lives and faith walk. Therefore, a total enjoyment of life will be impossible without the enjoyment of your now-church. If you don’t learn to enjoy the now-church, you will soon subscribe to an individualistic walk with Christ which will deprive you of the immense blessing of the community of sons of God (Ephesians 3:15-19, Hebrews 10:24-25).

Prayer

Oh dear Father, I really desire to enjoy my now-church, and I am positioned for it by the power of this Word in Jesus’ Name.

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

Thank You that I am born again. I am a new creation and a son of God right now. Hallelujah!"
