SATURDAY AUGUST 1

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: FEATURES OF GOOD STEWARDSHIP

Colossians 3:23 ***“And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;”***

It is important to know the features of good stewardship, so that you can carry out your God given assignment in the best possible way. Good stewardship involves working for or unto the Lord. MONDAY AUGUST 3

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ETERNAL LIFE IS A PERSON, NOT A REWARD

1 John 5:20 ***“And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life”***

According to the central theme of the scriptures, eternal life, though described in many ways, is actually a person. That person is Jesus Christ, the Son of Yahweh. The thought that eternal life is a destination after death or an impersonal reward for believing in Jesus Christ, came from an incomplete appreciation of its divine character. Secondly, the description as “eternal life” often makes people think of it as the qualification to live eternally with God. Yet again, that is far short of what eternal life really is. The description entails much more than just the longevity of life. It describes the all-surpassing superiority of the quality of His being. As succinctly captured in our main verse today, Jesus Christ is the true God and eternal life. Thus, eternal life is the person of Jesus Christ. It is His being. That dimension of being is what He absorbed mankind into, in the regeneration.

TUESDAY AUGUST 4

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ETERNAL LIFE: THE ERA AND THE VIRTUE

Luke 18:18 *“And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”*

Scriptures reveal the truth that the righteous will inherit eternal life. Eternal life was understood as a coming age in which people of God will live only without death in His presence. This was the age or era of the establishment of the kingdom of Yahweh with the promised Christ as the ruler. It was known that even when the righteous physically died, they would physically resurrect to live again in that era (Daniel 12:2, Proverbs 14:32). Jesus Christ referred to that in Mark 10:30 and Matthew 8:11 to His audience. Jesus is that era and as the life-giving spirit (1 Corinthians 15:45), His kingdom is pervaded by the virtue of His being which is eternal life. Therefore, eternal life as the person of Jesus Christ, also describes the era of His kingdom and virtues of His being, that fill it.

Affirmation

I am one with Jesus Christ my Lord. Therefore, I am eternal life to my world. I fill my world with the virtues of my divinity in Jesus' Name. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 5

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: KNOWING HIM IS ETERNAL LIFE

John 17:3 ***“And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent”***

We have so far understood that scripturally, eternal life is a person and that is Jesus Christ. We understood how that includes the era of His kingdom and the virtues of His life-giving being. What then is eternal life to us? As clearly stated in the verse above, eternal life is simply the experience of an intimate knowledge of Yahweh our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord and Brother. ***“Ginōskō”*** is the type of knowledge used here. It is the Greek counterpart of the Hebrew word, ***“yâda”*** and it means intimate knowledge of a person. When sons of God get to intimately know the Godhead, they will truly appreciate what eternal life is. It is more than words can describe. It is the state of being as a divine one. Glory!

Prayer

Dear Father, eternal life is my portion in Christ. I, therefore, yield myself to know You intimately for the experience of eternal life, in Jesus' Name.

THURSDAY AUGUST 6

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: ETERNAL LIFE IS MORE ABOUT KNOWLEDGE

John 14:8-9 *"Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?"*

It is obvious in the scriptures that Jesus came to give eternal life to mankind (John 3:16, 6:47, 1 John 5:11-12). What has been challenging for the world to appreciate is the means by which Jesus brings mankind into the experience of eternal life. A careful study of Jesus' life and words, reveal that He came to reveal the Father. He came to make the Father's name (character and person) known to the world (John 17:25-26). This was important to Him because, contrary to the human understanding, eternal life is more about the intimate knowledge of God than any acts of human righteousness. If you saw Jesus, you saw the Father. And if you knew the Father through Him, you "had" eternal life (John 17:3). Change your mind and learn to know Yahweh more intimately by His Spirit in you. That is where the key to experiencing eternal life is.

Prayer

Dear Holy Spirit, I turn my focus intensively to You that I might know the Father more in Jesus Christ. For that is eternal life. Hallelujah!

FRIDAY AUGUST 7

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: BELIEF IS THE AWAKENING

John 20:31 ***“But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name”***

Salvation has for a very long time been misunderstood, making the approach to everything else in the faith transactional. Yet, truly, salvation is not something we get by believing the gospel. All mankind was saved over 2000 years ago in the death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ. So, people are already in salvation, but the preaching of the gospel is still very necessary because it is by it that people can believe, awake to and enjoy their already saved state (Romans 1:16, 10:13-15). This salvation includes the freedom to know God and live in the experience of eternal life. So, eternal life is not imparted at the point of belief. But through the gospel, people's eyes open and they awake to it (Acts 26:18). This is what makes the difference between the believer and the unbeliever in this world. Believing, awakens to what was already real, so it can be experienced and enjoyed in physical living.

Confession

I am awake to my being born again in Christ because I have believed. I therefore, maximize my liberty to know God intimately and enjoy the full experience of eternal life here, in Jesus' Name.

SATURDAY AUGUST 8

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: THE WORD, THE MEANS OF ETERNAL LIFE

Romans 10:17 ***“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God”.***

We have clearly understood that eternal life is far more than a long life and an impersonal substance imparted. It is, the person of Jesus Christ, the era of His reign and the virtues of His being. Now, no matter from which angle a person approaches the “attainment” or the experience of eternal life, it must be by the Word. Hence our topic today. As a person, Jesus is the Word made flesh (John 1:14). As a virtue, the Word is life (John 1:4, 1 John 1:1-2). As an era, the Word is the truth of His reign (John 17:17, Psalm 96:10). Again, even our belief which is the means of awakening to eternal life, comes from hearing the Word. That is why Jesus clearly said, if you search the scriptures (the Word) you will land on Him (eternal life) - John 5:39.

Oh dear Father, You are simply amazing. I love Your Word and I have been inspired to love it more. For the Word is the means of enjoying and maximizing my eternal life.

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 12

1 Thessalonians 5:18 ***"In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you"***

Many people approach life from a negative perspective and that is why they fail in many areas. If you always approach life from an "it is possible" perspective, you will be amazed at how the wisdom, power and grace of God will flow through you to make the most challenging situation possible. Genesis 3:19 ***"In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return"***

It is so painful to observe that over 2000 years after the ascension of Jesus Christ, this world is yet to hear and see the full picture of the gospel. Many people including Christians have not heard the full gospel of Jesus Christ. As a result, the whole world is still living in history as though Jesus Christ never came. Many people, including those you may call very successful, are "working" as a means to live. That is labouring and slavery of the Adamic era. It is not working. FRIDAY AUGUST 14

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IS WORK?

Ephesians 2:10 ***“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them”***

When Adam went into delusion from Yahweh, He discovered that to survive in this created terrain he had to sweat (labour or work hard) - Genesis 3:19. When Yahweh entered His own creation in the person of Jesus Christ, He re-created everything and re-positioned mankind to work as was ordained before the “fall”. Now before the fall, Adam and Eve had everything to live. They did not need to work to eat. They were given the assignment of tilling the garden. It was the means of expressing their “God image-ness” to service the garden which would expand to the whole earth - their world. SATURDAY AUGUST 15

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHERE TO START FROM

Luke 14:28 ***“For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?”***

It is clear that we have not stepped into the meat of our subject of enjoying work, but it is already a week. So, we will pick it up next month in Jesus’ Name. But for now, I am aware that for many, this is your first time discovering that for all your life this far, you were never working but labouring. The reality of the truth made your heart leap and want to know how to move from labouring to working. This is a great step of life that will revolutionize everything about you. It, therefore, requires some thinking, planning and a gradual shift. So, start by asking, ***“Why, truly, am I engaged in this work?”***, ***“Will I still love to do this if I were not paid?”***, ***“What do I yearn to see changed in this world that I will do even if no one pays me?”***. Do this exercise with the Spirit and note your answers down and wait patiently till we continue next month. I love you.

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: PRAYER AND CONFESSION OF THE WEEK

TUESDAY AUGUST 18

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: UNDERSTANDING FAITH

Mark 11:22 (BBE) ***“And Jesus, answering, said to them, Have God's faith”***

The lack of understanding of faith makes it appear difficult, unrealistic and scary, but understanding makes it simple and easy. The first thing to understand concerning faith is that there are two main kinds: faith as revealed to men and faith as a divine life. The truth of the gospel makes us grow from one kind into another (from faith to faith - Romans 1:17). We must begin by learning to live by faith as an engagement of a divine principle to bring unseen realities into physical manifestation (Hebrews 11:1) to bring us into living in the divine state of faith (Mark 11:22). The beginning of anything often appears tough but patience and determination always bring us into the restful dimensions. The rest of this week, we will learn along the beginnings of faith. But always remember that there is more that we will come to.

Confession

In the Name of Jesus, I receive such a dimension of divine insight into faith, that faith has become simple and easy for me, now and forever. Hallelujah!

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 19

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHEN FAITH “FAILS”

Hebrews 11:39 ***“And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise”***

In a world where many are unable to differentiate between reality and deceptive literality, many people’s faith has been considered as “failed” by themselves or their observers. Maybe they stepped out in faith to pray and did not see what was expected. Or they’ve held on to the Word, and nothing has shown up as expected. Truly, faith never fails, though the expected outcome may not have become literal. What faith does in you, is more than just the physical expected outcome. Hebrews 11 is a long list of people about whom Yahweh Himself said have obtained a good report. Yet they never saw the expected outcome physically. Does that mean faith never literalizes in the physical? No! But when it appears so, realize that it has worked a far more exceeding and eternal glory in your life than you could ever imagine (2 Corinthians 4:16-18).

Thanksgiving

Oh dear Father, thank You for making me know that my faith in Your Word never failed. No matter how things appear in the physical, I have obtained a far more exceeding weight of glory! Hallelujah!

THURSDAY AUGUST 20

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: JUST A SECOND IS ENOUGH

Daniel 3:23 ***"And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace"***

Every student of the Bible is conversant with the story of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego in the whole of Daniel chapter three. These young Israelites held on to their belief in Yahweh amid the fiercest threats of life and until they were finally cast into the fiery furnace. But no sooner had they landed in the fire that divine presence succored them, and the king noticed it with astonishment (verse 24). No matter how long your expectation of the physical results of the engagement has been, don't give up. That seeming shame, pain, disappointment can change at any moment. Just a second is more than enough for a sudden change. Therefore, when faith seems to fail, remember that it doesn't fail. Hold on more tightly.

Other Tongues

Speak fervently in other tongues, declaring over and again, "My faith fails not". Even if it is only one second left, things will change.

FRIDAY AUGUST 21

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: WHAT IF ONE DIES IN FAITH?

Hebrews 11:13 ***"These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth"***

We are massively preaching and teaching on our immortality in Jesus Christ because by it death consciousness will be eradicated and sons of God will start expressing their eternal life physically. Then, death will no longer be a limitation to anything in this life. But till then, some people will continue to sleep. Then comes the question, what if someone holds on to the Word in faith concerning something and dies without physically seeing it? The scripture says, the person like others before, has a good report in God's sight (Hebrews 11:39). His or her faith was not in vain, when the restoration of all things is complete and they resurrect, all will see what their faith accomplished that was never visible. Therefore, fear not. Depending on your level, even death cannot annul your faith. Yet, you will see the expectation of your faith. Hallelujah!

Other Tongues

Speak fervently in other tongues, declaring that, "Nothing frightens you and that no matter what, you see the expectations of your faith in this life".

SATURDAY AUGUST 22

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: MAINTAIN THE GLOW OF FAITH

Hebrews 11:33 ***“Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,..”***

Whenever a person engages the principle of faith in the Word, a glow of spirit sparks up in him or her. There is a fervency of strong belief. Therefore, with what you have learnt so far, maintain the glow of your faith. Do not entertain doubt, weakness or possibilities of the failure of your faith. Keep the inspiration, maintain the vision, continue the talk, for as we have learnt, even a second is more than enough to change things. When the contrary situations roar, don't chicken out, roar louder in your prayer and thoughts. You must win. That contrary situation must lose because you are more than a conqueror in Jesus Christ.

Other Tongues

Speak fervently in other tongues, stirring and building yourself up to maintain the glow of your faith. No matter what the circumstances are, roar louder than them. For they have bowed. Hallelujah!

GOOD LIFE DEVOTION

Topic: CHRIST CONSCIOUSNESS

1 John 4:17 (NET) ***"By this love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgement, because just as Jesus is, so also are we in this world."***

1 John 4:17 (TPT) ***"By living in God, love has been brought to its full expression in us so that we may fearlessly face the day of judgment, because all that Jesus now is, so are we in this world."***

Topic: BEWARE OF FALSE CHRIST CONSCIOUSNESS

2 Corinthians 11:14 ***“And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light”***

Many of the things that the sons of God need to know to reign in this world as determined by Yahweh, have been twisted by enemy beings of His kingdom. This is to make the sons of God shy away from such truths and continue to live in bondage due to ignorance instead of boldly embracing them as revealed in the Word. Topic: INTERMEDIATE CHRIST CONSCIOUSNESS

Colossians 1:27 ***"To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory"***

Despite all the phases and kinds of challenges the body of Christ has faced in our path of maturity over the years, the Holy Spirit has consistently built the church. And along the lines of Christ consciousness the church has advanced until some have realized the dimension of the awareness of, ***"Jesus Christ in me or Christ in me"***. In other words, they live in the consciousness that Jesus Christ lives in them. This is so powerful and results in a great dimension victorious living. FRIDAY AUGUST 28

Topic: UNDERSTANDING CHRIST CONSCIOUSNESS

Hebrews 9:14 ***“How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?”***

To really understand Christ consciousness, we must first appreciate consciousness in the scriptures. From our main verse, the word conscience comes from consciousness. It is from the Greek word, “***suneidēsis***” arising from the root: ***suneidō*** and it means a joint awareness. In other words, it is a co-perception or co-knowledge. That means to be Christ conscious is to have the same personal awareness as Jesus Christ. Practically, it means to know yourself, exactly as Christ knows you. The lack of Christ consciousness makes people know themselves totally different from how Christ knows them. The Godhead knows you right now in this world, exactly as Christ. How do you know yourself? Matthew 4:16 ***"The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up"***

To fully appreciate and express our immortality in Christ, we need to also understand death and life as realms. Generally, a realm is the field or a dimension of a certain activity. In kingdom terminology, a realm is the territory of the influence or governing power of a king. Now, death and life being realms simply means, death and life are dimensions or territories of their influence. In the experience of humanity, the realm of death is in darkness. Coming to deliver man from the governing power of death, Jesus said in John 12:46, ***"I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness"***. No one can physically die, until he is in the realm of death. This is the realm into which Adam's error dragged all mankind before the era of Christ (Genesis 2:17, Romans 5:12).

Thanksgiving

I am in Christ and therefore in the realm of life and light. I walk only in life and light. There is no death in my paths.

YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

Thank You that I am born again. I am a new creation and a son of God right now. Hallelujah!"
